Concordia-St. Paul concludes 2017 NSIC North-South Division play with a road trip to face MSU Moorhead under the lights with a 6 p.m. start at Nemzek Stadium.

MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end **Matt Bjork** (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors **Andrew Capirchio** (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and **Frantz Polimice** (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore **Rich Kelly** (OG, Plainfield, Ill.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an formal application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: CONCORDIA 9, MSU MOORHEAD 2

The Golden Bears hold a commanding 9-2 series lead over the Dragons in a series that commenced in 2001 as Concordia won the first five contests. CSP's only loss in Moorhead broke the 5-0 streak, a 20-18 loss in 2006 before CSP ripped off four more wins in a row. MSUM won the last matchup in 2015 in their only trip to Sea Foam Stadium, 30-28. MSUM's two wins in the series were each by two points while CSP holds three double-digit victories. The rest (six games) have all been decided by eight points (one score + two point conversion) or less. Further, Concordia is 8-0 when scoring 30-plus points against the Dragons and has scored at least 27 points in all but one of the 11 meetings between the programs.

The Golden Bears are 3-0 against the Dragons under head coach **Shannon Currier**, scoring over 30 points each year between 2001 and 2003.

ABOUT THE DRAGONS

After taking care of Augustana in a 38-7 season-opening victory, MSU Moorhead has dropped their last two contests while allowing a combined 93 points to Southwest Minnesota State and Winona State to enter the weekend on a two-game losing streak. Despite the consecutive losses, the Dragons still rank second in the NSIC in total offense (469.7 yards per game) and seventh in total defense (348.3 total yards per game) through the first three games.

A big reason for the impressive offensive totals for the Dragons has been senior wide receiver Damon Gibson. Gibson, a 2016 AFCA All-America Second Team selection, leads the Dragons in catches (29) and receiving yards (399) while his three receiving touchdowns are tied for fifth in the league. Joining up with Gibson to form an impressive receiving duo for quarterback Demetrius Carr is senior Hunter Braaten. Braaten ranks close behind Gibson with 20 catches (good for third in the NSIC) and 224 receiving yards (sixth in the NSIC) to go with a touchdown. Carr, meanwhile, leads the league in passing yards with 933 and completions with 76.

Defensively, the Dragons have been stout against the run, allowing just 96.0 yards per game on the ground on the season. Abe Roehrich has paced the unit with 18 total tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss while also recovering a pair of fumbles this season. Miles Baggett has also been disruptive with a team-high 5.5 tackles for loss as well as 2.0 sacks.

LAST MEETING, 2015: MSUM 30, CONCORDIA 28

Concordia quarterback **Ben Schramski** connected with receiver **Vantwon Melton** for an 11-yard touchdown with 1:31 to play to give the Golden Bears a 28-24 lead in their home opener in week two. A high-powered Dragon offense moved the ball near mid-field when **Chazz Roberts** hit MSUM quarterback Jake Hodge as he attempted to scramble up the middle, forcing a fumble that was recovered by **Jackson Dobbs** to give CSP the ball on the MSUM 40 yard line with 49 seconds to play.

The Dragons were able to stop CSP's run game and had all three timeouts when punter **Sam Maedke** pinned the Dragons on their own six yard line with 28 seconds left.

Hodge connected with his favorite target Damon Gibson twice, a 39-yard hookup on the first play and a 40 yarder two plays later on 3rd and 10. The Dragons spiked the ball at the CSP 15 yard line with three seconds left giving them one final play.

Hodge was pressured by linebacker **Jordan Halverson** and flushed out of the pocket by **Hank Goff**, throwing on the run towards the far sideline. He once again looked to Gibson, but the ball went off his finger tips where Dragon teammate Cory Ambrose had hustled across the back of the end zone to come down with the deflected pass for the game-winning touchdown with no time remaining.

Schramski had a strong day for CSP, completing 14-29 for 264 yards and two touchdowns and led the team in rushing with 15 attempts for 55 yards and a score. He added a 69-yard touchdown pass in the game to **Sammy Baucham** that gave CSP an early fourth quarter lead for 21-17.

Hodge countered by completing 22-39 for 330 yards and two touchdowns with seven rushes for 26 yards. Gibson had four catches for 137 yards including 2-79 on the final drive.

The CSP defense came up big often in the game against a strong MSUM offense, forcing them to 2-13 on third downs including 0-9 on their first nine third down attempts.

CSP was more efficient, converting 9-18 on third down and converting all three trips to the red zone into touchdowns while playing turnover-free football.

LAST WEEK: ST CLOUD STATE 56, CONCORDIA 21

The Golden Bears were unable to recover from a slow start in which the offense wasn't able to pick up a first down in the opening quarter while SCSU scored three first quarter touchdowns and mounted a 28-0 lead midway through the second quarter.

Once the CSP offense got rolling, sophomore **Maxon Hutton** went on to set career highs in completions (15), passing yards (249) and passing touchdowns (3).

The scoring got started with 6:16 to play in the second quarter when Hutton found sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** for a 33 yard play and finished the drive two plays later on a touchdown strike to Gustaveson from 30 yards, capping a 78-yard scoring drive in just 25 seconds.

Gustaveson finished with three catches for 66 yards on the day.

Concordia closed the half with another touchdown as Hutton found sophomore **Darnell Rolle** for a two yard pass play to wrap up a 12-play, 75 yard drive that spanned 2:35.

In the second half, it was **Elias Arlington** who was the benefactor as the senior had a career day. Arlington scored on a 65 yard reception in which he did much of the work with his feet and behind downfield blocking.

Arlington posted career highs in receptions (5) and all-purpose yards (207) and had his first career 100-yard receiving day (126) while adding 84 kickoff return yards on four attempts.

Brian Szutkowski led the defense with a career high 11 tackles including one for loss. Linebackers **Billy Brown**, **Mitch Zillman** and **Blake Evans** all made eight tackles with Brown contributing a sack.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back **Darnell Rolle** leads the special teams with five total tackles including three in week one. Senior **Billy Brown** follows with three tackles - all in punt coverage.

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and recovered a fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at Bemidji State, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense.

The team has produced a pair of blocked kicks (**Dylan Wood**, blocked FG vs Minot, **Cole Riemer** blocked PAT at BSU) in each of the first games. The special teams has not allowed a blocked kick or punt all season, either.

In the return game in week one, **Jake Tanner** had three punt returns for 68 yards with a long of 43 and is among the nation's top-15 in punt return average (15.4) on the year (5-77). **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 32.7 yards to rank 15th in the country in return average on the year.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** has produced touchbacks on eight of his 12 kickoffs and the coverage unit has held opponents to an 18.5 average compared to CSP's 27.3 average.

Schenderlein is also 2-2 on field goals including his second career 50-plus yarder (50) at Bemidji State.

ALL-CONFERENCE KICKING GAME RETURNS

The Golden Bears return an All-NSIC kicking tandem in 2016 All-NSIC South Division First Team kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and Second Team punter **Sam Maedke**. The duo are in their third years as the starter at the positions, with Maedke now a senior and Schenderlein a junior. Schenderlein has added kickoffs to his repertoire for 2017. MEET THE STARTING QB: MAXON HUTTON

In head coach Shannon Currier's offensive philosophy, versatility is valued across the field from up front, to the backs and receivers and includes the quarterback. The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter **Ron Johnson**, third year spot starter **Trevor Tillett** and the 2017 starter **Maxon Hutton**. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp and is expected to be a versatile playmaker with his feet and arm while minimizing turnovers and avoiding pressure.

In game one in his first career start, Hutton was not sacked and committed just one turnover while engineering a balanced offense that played comfortably with the lead in a 24-0 win over Minot State.

Backups Johnson and Tillett bring plenty of experience to the group. Last year, Johnson passed for 2,115 yards and 14 touchdowns and added six rushing touchdowns. Tillett has played in 10 games in his career, passing for 859 yards and four touchdowns.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 6TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

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THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

SOPHOMORES SPEARHEAD OFFENSE

In week one, the skill positions were led by a sophomore trio that could be a playmaking force for years to come. Quarterback **Maxon Hutton** engineered the offense effectively, using big plays with the arm in the first half in building a lead before ceding to the run game in the second half to preserve the win. He finished with 199 yards of total offense (168 pass, 31 rush).

His top target was sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** (6-116, 1 TD) as the duo connected for a career-long (for each) 45 yard play to set-up an 11 yard touchdown between the pair in the second quarter. Gustaveson topped 100 yards in the first half.

On the ground, sophomore **Darnell Rolle** rushed for the bulk of his 107 yards in the third quarter (6-84), finishing with 17-107 and a touchdown after going for just 11 yard for 23 in the first half. In his first career 100-yard day, Rolle wasn't used in the fourth quarter as the deep backfield helped preserve the big lead.

After three weeks, Hutton has passed for 580 yards and five touchdowns, Rolle leads the team with 173 rushing yards at 5.1 per carry and two total touchdowns (1 rush, 1 rec) and Gustaveson leads the team in catches (9), yards (182) and receiving scores (2).

GUSTAVESON READY TO BREAK OUT

Sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** had a pair of 100-yard games as a freshman when the lights were shining brightest against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career with 6-116 and a touchdown in a 24-0 win over Minot. After three weeks he leads the team in catches (9), yards (182) and touchdowns (2).

Through three weeks, senior **Elias Arlington** is emerging as the top compliment to Gustaveson and is coming off his first career 100-yard receiving game (5-126, 1 TD). He's second on the team in catches (8), yards (168) and has a touchdown. Gustaveson (20.2) and Arlington (21.0) are each sporting solid 20-plus yard per catch averages.

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as **Maxon Hutton** has completed at least two passes to nine different options and has connected with 10 different receivers on the year.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore **Darnell Rolle** (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen **Lajuan Preston** (Fort Myers) and **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg).

In the opener, the trio combined for 165 yards on 25 attempts (6.6 avg) led by Rolle (17-107, TD). The backfield is deeper than the three youngster from Florida, however, as junior **RaQuan Cunnigan** is second on the team among running backs in attempts (13), yards (57) and average (4.4) with Rolle leading the team across the board (34-173, 1 TD). Johnson (10) and Preston (8) are right there with Cunnigan on carries with Johnson adding 42 yards and a touchdown and Preston bringing 18 yards.

OFFENSIVE LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles **Ben Lawrence** and **Terrell Taylor** with a sophomore interior of **Hunter Kauffman** at center surrounded by **Rich Kelly** and **Ethan Aune** at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior.

So far in 2017, the offensive line ranks 21st in the country and third in the Northern Sun with just 4.33 tackles for loss per game allowed while ranking fifth in the league and 43rd nationally in fewest sacks allowed (1.33/game).

The experience of playing together with game experience, along with spring football and offseason workouts to gain strength will pay dividends as the 2017 season progresses as well as into future seasons.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. In the secondary, senior safety **Breon Hoosier** leads all players with 116 career tackles including 15 in the first three games of 2017. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** with 106 including 20 for loss and five sacks. He's made nine tackles in three games as a senior. Leading the linebacking corps is **JJ Przybylka** with 100 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made a pair of tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next closest to reaching 100 is junior safety **Brandon Russell** with 84.

DEFENSIVE LINE FEATURES EIGHT MAN ROTATION

The 2017 defensive line two deep features a bright future with fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** as the only senior and junior defensive tackle **Adam Miller** as the only junior on the unit. Sophomores **Dylan Wood**, **Cole Riemer** and **Kelly Pierce** start along side Roberts and all three made an impact as freshmen a year ago.

Roberts has made 106 tackles with 20.0 for loss and five sacks in his career to lead the group.

Adding youth to the mix on the second line are redshirt freshmen **Rahiem Ladson** and **Malik Patterson** and true freshman **Chris Garrett**. Garrett had a strip sack in the red zone to help preserve the 24-0 shutout win in his career debut. Riemer and Pierce each have seven tackles with 1.5 for loss while Wood and Roberts have six and five, respectively. Wood and Riemer have each blocked a kick on special teams as well.

VETERAN LINEBACKERS LEAD THE WAY

The starting linebackers for CSP are among the most experienced position on the roster with seniors **Billy Brown** and **Frantz Polimice** on the outsides and junior **Mitch Zillman** at the Mike. Senior **JJ Przybylka** also sees significant time at the Mike and junior **Isaiah Walker** adds experience at SLB behind Brown. The veteran players are joined by true freshmen **Blake Evans** and **Gabe Nkumu**.

Zillman leads the unit and is second on the defense with 19 tackles followed by Evans with 16.

Przybylka's two tackles in the season opener put him at the 100 milestone for his career.

HOOSIER MAKES AN IMPACT FOR THE SAFETIES

Senior strong safety **Breon Hoosier** had a strong debut in 2017 with a pair of sacks blitzing from the secondary. Now a fourth year contributor, Hoosier has 116 career tackles, 5.0 for loss, the sacks were the first of his career and he has seven pass breakups with an interception.

He's flanked by sophomore **Brian Szutkowski** at the free safety position who leads the team with 23 tackles including a career high of 11 in week three against St. Cloud State.

Junior **Brandon Russell** provides depth with 84 career tackles, 6.0 for loss and produced 48 tackles (5.0 for loss) a year ago.

TRANSFERS START AT THE CORNER

Senior captain **Andrew Capirchio** returns at one starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts as a junior transfer from Scottsdale Community College. He's made seven tackles with two pass breakups in the first three games.

Opposite him is first year junior transfer **Dion Wallisch** from Minnesota Crookston. He's tied for third on the team with 16 tackles (one for loss) and has three pass breakups. Wallisch played in 10 games in 2015 as a redshirt freshman at UMC, finishing fourth on the team with 56 tackles with 4.5 for loss and a sack.

Providing depth at the position are redshirt freshman **Desmond Hudnall** and true freshman **Lorenzo Kendricks**.

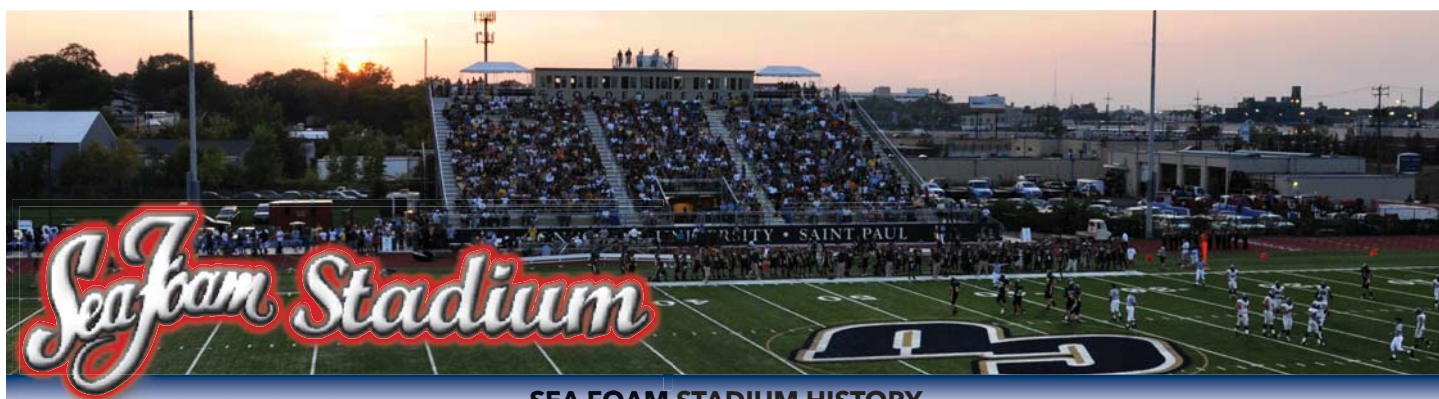
