THIS WEEK: FIRST NSIC SOUTH DIVISION ROAD GAME

Concordia-St. Paul will play an NSIC South Division opponent on the road for the first time in 2017, travelling to Fayette, lowa to take on Upper Iowa. Each team is seeking its first South Division victory of the year. CSP is seeking its first road win, sporting an 0-2 away mark while UIU is 1-1 at home.

MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach Shannon Currier has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end Matt Bjork (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors Andrew Capirchio (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and Frantz Polimice (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore Rich Kelly (OG, Plainfield, III.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an formal application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: CONCORDIA 8, UPPER IOWA 3

Concordia controls a strong advantage in the all-time series entering the 12th meeting between the programs. CSP won the first seven matchups as the series opened when UIU joined the NSIC in 2006. The teams have played every year since. Concordia won its first two visits to Fayette, Iowa in 2006 (41-14) and 2009 (57-56, OT) but have dropped their last two road games to the Peacocks in 2013 (24-28) and 2015 (20-52). The teams met on a neutral site at a high school field in 2011 in West Union, Iowa when UIU's stadium underwent renovations, a 20-19 CSP win. The series has featured five games decided by four points or less with CSP edging UIU 3-1 in those games. The winning team in the series has always scored at least 20 points.

The Golden Bears and Peacocks will meet for the second time under head coach Shannon Currier, with CSP falling 41-21 last

ABOUT THE PEACOCKS

UIU

The Peacocks are off to a 3-2 overall start thanks in large part to elite performance from the secondary. UIU is fourth in the country and leads the NSIC by allowing just 117.4 passing yards per game. They also boast a 92.1 pass efficiency defense (12th NCAA, 2014) NSIC) and are strong in third down defense (32.1%), ranking 34th nationally and third in the league.

Jordan Rommes leads the unit with three interceptions and seven passes defended.

The secondary is aided by a pass rush that racks up 2.8 sacks per game, ranking 33rd nationally and third in the league.

The Peacocks have been opportunistic as well with five blocked kicks (1st NCAA) and three blocked punts (4th NCAA, 1st NSIC) and have recovered six fumbles (21st NCAA, 2nd NSIC) and returned three punts for touchdowns (three different players).

It's led to a 44-24 advantage in points off turnovers for the Peacocks. The aggressive play hasn't led to an increase in penalties, either, as UIU is flagged just 4.8 times per game (12th NCAA, 2nd NSIC) for 47.0 yards (22nd NCAA, 4th NSIC).

Offensively, UIU is 22nd in the country and fourth in the league with 223.4 yards per game. Antoine Conner is 24th in the country and second in the league, average 6.6 yards per carry. He's one of three UIU players with 250-plus rushing yards (269), trailing Ryan Parmely (329) while quarterback Brent Lamers adds 254. Lammers has passed for 1,029 yards (4th NSIC) and is 44th nationally with 256.4 yards of total offense per game. He has 10 total touchdowns (7 pass, 3 rush).

Lammers' top target is Jarred Edmonds with 32 catches for 477 yards and three TDs. He's among the nation's top 35 in catches and yards.

year at Sea Foam Stadium. This marks Currier's first visit to Upper Iowa as head coach at Concordia.

LAST MEETING, 2016: UPPER IOWA 41, CONCORDIA 21

First half turnovers and miscues allowed visiting Upper lowa to capitalize in building a 21-0 lead early in the second quarter. UIU scored on a 34-yard drive following an interception and used a 50-yard interception return for touchdown to claim a 14-0 lead in the first quarter.

The turnovers halted productive CSP drives into UIU territory. CSP's third drive late in the first quarter with a 14-0 deficit once again plowed into UIU territory to the 23 yard line. But a pair of negative rushing plays were followed by a sack and penalty to take the Bears out of field goal range.

Upper lowa used a key 3rd and 11 pickup on a quarterback keeper by **Brent Lammers** rushing for 20 yards. He followed by hitting **Trey MacTaggart** for 56 yards to put UIU in the red zone at the end of the quarter, setting up an early second quarter touchdown for a 21-0 lead.

CSP scored twice before halftime as quarterback **Ron Johnson** threw touchdown passes to his running backs, a 27-yarder to **Darnell Rolle** and a 9-yard score to **Alex Carr**. But Lammers added a 22-yard rushing score in the middle to make it a 28-14 UIU lead at the break.

In the third quarter, the defense was able to hold UIU to a pair of red zone field goals but the offense wasn't able to keep pace.

Johnson threw his third touchdown of the day early in the fourth quarter, a 19-yarder to **Deceon Schumman** to make it a two-score game again (21-34) with 12:48 to play.

UIU responded by putting down the comeback by with a scoring drive lasting nearly four minutes.

Johnson finished the game 27-44 for 271 yards and three touchdowns although the Peacocks were able to sack him four times with the two first quarter interceptions.

He found Schumann four times for 53 yards and a score while **Alquawn Vickers** had eight catches for 46 yards and five carries for 21 yards. Rolle added three catches for 43 yards and a touchdown and five carries for 17 yards.

Johnson connected with nine different targets including three passes to six different players.

While Johnson had the Bears moving efficiently through the air, CSP only mustered 30 rushing yards on 33 team attempts.

Lammers passed for 190 yard (16-27-1) and rushed for 100 (15-100, 2 TD) to guide the UIU offense.

David Reed led Concordia's defense with 11 tackles (1.0 TFL) with **JJ Przybylka** adding eight tackles (1.0 TFL). **Jamie Fore** had seven tackles, an interception and a pass breakup in the secondary.

LAST WEEK: MINNESOTA STATE 47, CONCORDIA 10

Concordia-St. Paul was able to hold Minnesota State to just three points on the Mavericks' first three possessions of the game: slowing a scoring drive in the red zone to a field goal on MSU's first drive, **Dion Wallisch** picking off a pass in the red zone to shut down a scoring threat on their second chance and forcing a punt on MSU's third drive.

Wallisch also had a 39-yard kickoff return in the first quarter to give CSP's offense strong field position.

The result was a close contest deep into the second quarter. MSU finally put the ball in the end zone early in the second quarter on a 3-play, 80-yard drive, but missed a two-point conversion attempt.

Following the fast drive by MSU, Concordia responded with a strong 15-play, 61-yard drive to drain 6:18 off the clock. Concordia picked up a pair of short third downs on the drive (2 & 1) and also converted a 4th and 1. Although the drive stalled in the red zone, junior **Jonas Schenderlein** made his 12th straight field goal inside of 50 yards dating back to October, 2015.

The Schenderlein field goal made it 9-3 with 6:42 to play in the half. Minnesota State responded by stealing CSP's gameplan with a six and a half minute drive, punching the ball in at the goal line with 12 seconds to play - a pivotal point in the contest.

Following the score before halftime, MSU received to start the second half and continued its momentum with another touchdown drive for a 23-3 lead.

Two more key moments were mixed in as CSP looked to keep pace with the sixth-ranked team in the country: the ensuing kickoff was popped up short and to the right sideline, with CSP unable to make the fair catch as MSU caught the ball in the air to retain possession.

Although Concordia stopped MSU on the bonus drive, Concordia's next chance on offense moved the ball back to the MSU red zone but an interception thwarted Concordia's chance to put more points on the scoreboard.

Three plays and 68 yards later, MSU added another touchdown for a 30-3 lead with 4:55 to play in the third quarter.

Concordia would score again as senior **Ron Johnson** found senior **Deceon Schumann** for a 25-yard touchdown. The touchdown was set-up by a fake punt as senior punter **Sam Maedke** connected with senior tight end **Justin Axelson** for a 35 yard gain over the middle.

From there, MSU used the run game and the clock to its advantage. Entering play, the Mavericks featured the second ranked run game in the country at over 300 yards per contest. They finished with 479, averaging 9.8 per carry to grind out the rest of the contest.

CSP held MSU to 146 yards through the air (11-19-1) while the Golden Bears passed for 210 yards as a team with four different players participating in the pass game led by Johnson at 15-34 for 171 and a touchdown. Maedke (1-1, 35), backup quarterback **Trevor Tillett** (1-2, 4) and receiver **Jake Tanner** (0-1) all threw passes as well.

Tanner led CSP with six catches, going for 57 yards while senior **Elias Arlington** had a team-high 68 receiving yards on five grabs

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two kicking legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back **Darnell Rolle** leads the special teams with seven total tackles including three in week one. Six of the seven stops have been on punt coverage. Senior **Breon Hoosier** follows with four special teams tackles (three on punts)

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and recovered a fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense and has three special teams tackles.

The team has produced a pair of blocked kicks (**Dylan Wood**, blocked FG vs Minot, **Cole Riemer** blocked PAT at BSU) in each of the first two games. The special teams has not allowed a blocked kick or punt all season, either.

Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week five, CSP executed a 35-yard fake punt with punter **Sam Maedke** connecting with senior tight end **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State.

In the return game junior **Jake Tanner** opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and currently ranks 29th in the country in punt return average (12.6) on the year (7-88). **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 26.6 yards to rank 36th in the country and second in the NSIC in return average on the year.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** has produced touchbacks on 14 of his 20 kickoffs compared to 11 of 32 by opponents. The

Schenderlein is also 5-6 on field goals including his second career 50-plus yarder (50) at Bemidji State.

In the punt game, senior Sam Maedke is averaging 39.3, right in line with last year's career best 40.0 average. Only one of his 29 punts has been a touchback and he has five inside the 20 with four fair catches.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Champion-

ship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

MEET THE STARTING QB: MAXON HUTTON

In head coach Shannon Currier's offensive philosophy, versatility is valued across the field from up front, to the backs and receivers and includes the quarterback. The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter Ron Johnson, third year spot starter Trevor Tillett and the 2017 starter Maxon Hutton. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp.

In game one in his first career start, Hutton was not sacked and committed just one turnover while engineering a balanced offense that played comfortably with the lead in a 24-0 win over Minot.

Backups Johnson and Tillett bring plenty of experience to the group. Last year, Johnson passed for 2,115 yards and 14 touchdowns and added six rushing touchdowns. Johnson rejoined the mix in week 4, playing the second half at MSUM and getting the start against MSU in week 5. He's 23-50 for 284 and 2 TD in six quarters. Tillett has played in 11 games in his career, passing for 863 yards and four touchdowns. All three QBs have thrown at least 15 passes in 2017.

100-YARD PERFORMERS

Three different Golden Bears have combined for four 100-yard rushing or receiving performances on the season. It started in week one when sophomores Darnell Rolle (17-107, TD) and Marcus Gustaveson (6-116, TD) topped the century mark via the ground and air, respectively. The duo powered CSP's 24-0 season opening win over Minot State.

Senior Elias Arlington joined the club in week three with 5-126 and a touchdown through the air against St. Cloud State.

In week four, Rolle topped 100 for the second time with careerhighs 22 carries for 172 yards and a touchdown.

GUSTAVESON A BIG THREAT AT WIDE RECEIVER

Sophomore Marcus Gustaveson had a pair of 100-yard games as a true freshman when the lights were shining brightest against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career with 6-116 and a touchdown in a 24-0 win over Minot. After five weeks, he's the top red zone threat with three receiving touchdowns as well as the top big play threat with a team best 17.1 receiving average. He's third on the team in receptions (14) and second in yards (240).

SLOT RECEIVERS TAKING OVER

Through five weeks, senior Elias Arlington has emerged as a top threat in the pass game, recording his first career 100-yard receiving game in week three against SCSU (5-126, 1 TD) before posting a career-high eight catches in week four at MSUM (8-80). He leads the team in catches (21), yards (316) and has a touchdown with a 15.0 average.

Junior Jake Tanner is second on the team with 18 receptions and third with 181 vards in a breakout season.

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as CSP's quarterbacks have completed at least two passes to 10 different options and has connected with 12 different receivers on the year. Six players have at least five catches.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore Darnell Rolle (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen Lajuan Preston (Fort Myers) and Shaq Johnson (St. Petersburg).

In the opener, the trio combined for 165 yards on 25 attempts (6.6 avg) led by Rolle (17-107, TD). Rolle leads the team across the board (65-364, 2 TD) and adds 5-23 with a TD receiving. Johnson (14-47) and Preston (14-34) each have 14 carries.

OFFENSIVE LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach Shannon Currier was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles Ben Lawrence and Terrell Taylor with a sophomore interior of Hunter Kauffman at center surrounded by Rich Kelly and Ethan Aune at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior.

So far in 2017, the offensive line ranks 32nd in the country (4th NSIC) with just 4.6 tackles for loss per game allowed while ranking 6th in the league in fewest sacks allowed (1.8/game).

The unit has also blocked for two 100-yard rushing performances by Darnell Rolle (week 1 vs Minot & week 4 at MSUM) in games where the team ran for 199 and 229, respectively.

WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB

Nearing the midway point of 2017, junior Dion Wallisch has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team. He held BSU's All-NSIC second team receiver to 3-21 receiving and upped his effort against MSUM's All-American Damon Gibson to 3-24. In week five against #6 MSU, Wallisch intercepted the Mavericks in the end zone in the first quarter.

Also a sound tackler, Wallisch is fifth on the team with 24 tackles while leading the team with three pass breakups. He adds a 25.2 average on kickoff returns. As a true freshman at Minnesota Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss.

Senior captain Andrew Capirchio returns at the other starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts in 2016 as a junior transfer from Scottsdale CC. He's made 15 tackles with two pass breakups on the year, Redshirt freshman **Desmond** Hudnall and true freshman Lorenzo Kendricks provide depth.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. In the secondary, senior safety Breon Hoosier leads all players with 125 career tackles including lowed by freshman Blake Evans with 31. Seniors Billy 24 in 2017. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Brown** (27) and **Frantz Polimice** (24) round out the Roberts with 108 including 20 for loss and five sacks. He's made 11 tackles so far this year. Leading the linebacking corps is JJ Przyb- high 13 tackles at MSU Moorhead in week four. ylka with 101 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made three tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next SZUTKOWSKI A TACKLES MACHINE AT SAFETY closest to reaching 100 is junior safety Brandon Russell with 88.


