MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end **Matt Bjork** (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors **Andrew Capirchio** (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and **Frantz Polimice** (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore **Rich Kelly** (OG, Plainfield, Ill.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: WINONA STATE 15, CONCORDIA 4

Although Winona State holds a decisive lead in the all-time series, the programs have split their last four meetings with CSP winning back-to-back in 2013 at the Metrodome (23-13) and 2014 in Winona (31-28) in the program's first ever win over WSU in Winona. The Warriors captured big wins the last two years, 51-7 in 2015 in St. Paul and 38-0 in 2016 in Winona.

ABOUT THE WARRIORS

The Warriors enter the weekend riding high after taking care of #6 Sioux Falls on the road in emphatic fashion with a 31-13 victory. Sioux Falls led all DII teams entering last week's game against WSU in defensive scoring (6.2 ppg) before surrendering 31 points to the Warriors.

Winona State has scored 30+ points in each of their six contests so far this season as their 36.8 points per game rank third in the league. It's been a group effort for the Warrior offense as they rank in the top half of the league in both passing and rushing touchdowns. On the ground, Sophomore Javian Roebuck has eclipsed the 100-yard mark in two consecutive weeks, rumbling for a career-best 142 yards at USF. He scored on touchdown runs of 42 and 63 yards in the upset. His 6.7 yards/carry average ranks fifth in the NSIC. Roebuck (4) and Eric Birth (5) have combined for nine of WSU's 14 rushing touchdowns which rank third in the conference. QB Darren Beenken has spread the ball around to 19 different receivers this season, including at least eight in each game, but Isaiah Frandsen has emerged as his favorite target. Frandsen leads WSU with 21 receptions and 356 yards.

While the offense has been impressive, the defense has been even better. Winona State enters Saturday's tilt at CSP tied for the DII lead in turnovers (21) and turnover margin (+13). The Warriors' scoring defense (11.8 ppg) ranks fourth nationally. Winona's 13 total interceptions rank second in the country. Andrew Spencer leads the NSIC with five INTs.

Concordia holds a 1-6 home record against WSU, defeating the Warriors 23-20 in overtime in 2003 under head coach **Shannon Currier** at Griffin Stadium. The win set up a path to CSP's first of two NSIC Championships in a three year stretch, also using a win over WSU at the Metrodome (35-21) in 2005 to pick up the league title. The Golden Bears are 0-3 against the Warriors at Sea Foam Stadium, which opened in 2009.

The Golden Bears are 1-4 against WSU under **Coach Currier**.

LAST MEETING, 2016: WSU 38, CONCORDIA 0

Concordia's defense held one of the most prolific passers in Northern Sun history, Jack Nelson, to just 15-33 for 226 yards and snapped his streak of consecutive games with a touchdown pass at 42 - the first time an NSIC member held him without a TD pass in his career in the regular season finale.

The Warriors had averaged 453.7 yards per game of total offense and 24 first downs entering the game with the CSP defense surrendering just 327 yards and 18 first downs on the day. The CSP defense held the strong Warrior offense to just 26.7 percent (4-15) on third downs, as well.

The defensive effort was led by **David Reed** with 5.0 tackles for loss, just one shy of the program's single game record held by Taylor Selby (2011). He added eight tackles and blocked a first quarter field goal.

Reed's first quarter blocked field goal helped Concordia's defense shut out the Warrior offense in the first 15 minutes of play as the game remained tied entering the second quarter despite WSU's first quarter being its highest scoring on the season with 101 points through the first 10 games.

In the first half, CSP held Winona State to just 151 yards of total offense and managed to nearly keep pace with 143. But WSU was able to score a pair of second quarter touchdowns and had a field goal for a 17-0 lead at the break.

Turnovers were costly in allowing WSU to runaway with the contest, committing two in each half leading to 17 Warrior points including an interception for touchdown in a three touchdown third quarter for WSU, putting the game out of reach at 38-0. The pick-six came after WSU returned a punt for a touchdown.

The shutout for WSU was its third of the season despite Concordia running 89 plays, just four shy of the single game school record which CSP set the prior week (93) against Augustana.

The CSP offense was led by **Darius Chapes** who combined for 83 yards (14-47 rush, 2-36 rec) while **Alex Carr** added 5-35 on the ground. Chapes had a long catch of 36 while Carr had a long run of 21 in the game.

Ron Johnson and **Trevor Tillett** combined for 172 passing yards spread around to eight different targets including seven of them for at least two receptions.

Defensively, **Jonathan Johnson** matched Reed's eight tackles and his two pass breakups gave him 14 for the season to tie James Dell for the single season school record (2002).

LAST WEEK: UPPER IOWA 34, CONCORDIA 29

Facing the fourth-ranked pass defense in the country as Upper Iowa entered play allowing just 117.4 passing yards per contest, Concordia-St. Paul had little issue moving the football against the Peacocks on their home turf.

Senior quarterback **Ron Johnson** passed for nearly that much in the first half alone, throwing for 110 yards before the break including a late second quarter touchdown strike to **Marcus Gustaveson**, the first of three touchdown connections between the pair. The score made it a 14-7 halftime margin in favor of UIU.

In the first half, UIU converted a fourth down deep in CSP territory before punching it in the end zone in the first quarter. In the second quarter, UIU's touchdown came following a strip by **Dion Wallisch** with UIU's ball carrier recovering his own fumble in the end zone.

Meanwhile, CSP missed a first quarter fourth down by inches, coming up short on a measurement and the Bears also fumbled, but UIU was able to recover the CSP miscue.

The Golden Bears were able to come back, though, tying the

game midway through the third quarter following **Elias Arlington's** blocked punt to set up a five yard **Jake Tanner** TD run.

Jonas Schenderlein connected on a 30-yard FG four minutes later to give CSP a 16-14 lead with 2:05 left in the third quarter.

After UIU broke its scoring drought on the next drive, CSP responded with the second of three Johnson-to-Gustaveson scores, this one from 15 yards out for a 22-21 CSP lead early in the fourth quarter.

Upper Iowa scored on its next possession and then forced a CSP punt, which was returned for a touchdown and a 34-22 UIU lead with 9:35 to play.

Concordia continued its comeback mode, responded with a four minute, 78 yard scoring drive capped by a 10-yard strike from Johnson to Gustaveson, cutting it to 34-29 with 5:28 left.

Concordia picked up a big stop and moved the ball into the UIU red zone courtesy of a 23-yard pass from Johnson to Gustaveson, but failed on downs at the UIU nine yard line.

Gustaveson had nine catches for 93 yards and three touchdowns as Johnson completed 23-44 for 262 yards with all three scores going to Gustaveson. Sophomore **Darnell Rolle** also had a strong game with 126 combined yards (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec) and **Lajuan Preston** broke loose with a 46 yard run, finishing with five carries for 57 yards.

Defensively, freshman **Chris Garrett** had a big game with a pair of sacks among his season high eight tackles, also batting down a pass and nearly picking up a safety. Sophomore **Dylan Wood** had three tackles for loss in a nine tackle performance and **Brian Szutkowski** led CSP with 11 tackles.

Senior punt **Sam Maedke** had a big day, averaging 47.2 yards on six punts with a long of 62 and a pair pinning UIU inside the 20.

Aside from the blocked punt, Arlington finished with 137 all-purpose yards (4-69 rec, 4-55 KR, 1-13 PR) to lead the team.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two kicking legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back **Darnell Rolle** leads the special teams with seven total tackles including three in week one. Six of the seven stops have been on punt coverage. Senior **Breon Hoosier** follows with five special teams tackles (three on punts).

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and recovered a fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense. He also has four special teams tackles.

The team has produced three blocked kicks (**Dylan Wood**, blocked FG vs Minot, **Cole Riemer** blocked PAT at BSU, **Elias Arlington** blocked punt at UIU) on the year. The special teams has not allowed a blocked kick or punt all season, either.

Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week five, CSP executed a 35-yard fake punt with punter **Sam Maedke** connecting with senior tight end **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State.

In the return game junior **Jake Tanner** opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and currently ranks 32nd in the country in punt return average (10.9) on the year (10-109). **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 22.3 yards to rank fourth in the NSIC.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** has produced touchbacks on 19-of-26 kickoffs compared to 11 of 38 by opponents. The coverage unit has held opponents to an 16.2 average (13th DII) compared to CSP's 21.3 team KR average.

Schenderlein is also 6-7 on field goals including his second career 50-plus yarder (50) at Bemidji State.

In the punt game, senior **Sam Maedke** is averaging 40.7, just

ahead of last year's career best 40.0 average. Only one of his 35 punts has been a touchback and he has seven inside the 20 with five fair catches, three of 50-plus and a long of 62.

The Golden Bears return an All-NSIC kicking tandem in 2016 All-NSIC South Division First Team kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and Second Team punter **Sam Maedke**. The duo are in their third years as the starter at the positions, with Maedke now a senior and Schenderlein a junior. Schenderlein has added kickoffs to his repertoire for 2017. HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 6TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He opened his return with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

MEET THE QUARTERBACKS: HUTTON & JOHNSON

In head coach Shannon Currier's offensive philosophy, versatility is valued across the field from up front, to the backs and receivers and includes the quarterback. The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter **Ron Johnson**, third year spot starter **Trevor Tillett** and the 2017 starter **Maxon Hutton**. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp.

In game one in his first career start, Hutton was not sacked and committed just one turnover while engineering a balanced offense that played comfortably with the lead in a 24-0 win over Minot.

Johnson relieved Hutton at the half at MSU Moorhead in week four due to injury, and earned starts in week five against Minnesota State and at Upper Iowa. Last year, Johnson passed for 2,115 yards and 14 touchdowns and added six rushing touchdowns.

Tillett has also played in 11 games in his career, passing for 863 yards and four touchdowns. All three QBs have thrown at least 15 passes in 2017.

100-YARD PERFORMERS

Three different Golden Bears have combined for four 100-yard rushing or receiving performances on the season. It started in week one when sophomores **Darnell Rolle** (17-107, TD) and **Marcus Gustavson** (6-116, TD) topped the century mark via the ground and air, respectively. The duo powered CSP's 24-0 season opening win over Minot State.

Senior **Elias Arlington** joined the club in week three with 5-126 and a touchdown through the air against St. Cloud State.

In week four, Rolle topped 100 for the second time with career-highs 22 carries for 172 yards and a touchdown.

GUSTAVSON A BIG THREAT AT WIDE RECEIVER

Sophomore **Marcus Gustavson** had a pair of 100-yard games as a true freshman when the lights were shining brightest against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career with 6-116 and a touchdown in a 24-0 win over Minot. In week six, Gustavson had a career-high three touchdown receptions, hauling in 9-93 at Upper Iowa. He's 17th in the country and third in the league with six touchdowns (1.0 per game) and ranks 15th in the NSIC in both receptions (23) and yards (333).

SLOT RECEIVERS TAKING OVER

Through six weeks, senior **Elias Arlington** has emerged as a top threat in the pass game, recording his first career 100-yard receiving game in week three against SCSU (5-126, 1 TD) before posting a career-high eight catches in week four at MSUM (8-80). He leads the team in catches (25), yards (385) and is sixth in the league in all-purpose yards with 663 (110.5/game).

Junior **Jake Tanner** is third on the team with 18-181 yards in a breakout season and is fourth with 319 all-purpose yards.

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as CSP's quarterbacks have completed at least two passes to 10 different options and has connected with 12 different receivers on the year. Six players have at least eight catches.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore **Darnell Rolle** (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen **Lajuan Preston** (Fort Myers) and **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg).

In the opener, the trio combined for 165 yards on 25 attempts (6.6 avg) led by Rolle (17-107, TD). Rolle leads the team across the board (86-450, 2 TD) and adds 8-63 with a TD receiving. Rolle is the league's fifth leading rusher. Preston adds a 4.8 average (19-91) and a long of 46 with Johnson adding 14-47 and a TD.

OFFENSIVE LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles **Ben Lawrence** and **Terrell Taylor** with a sophomore interior of **Hunter Kauffman** at center surrounded by **Rich Kelly** and **Ethan Aune** at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior.

So far in 2017, the offensive line ranks 44th in the country (5th NSIC) with just 5.2 tackles for loss per game. The group has developed continuity, with all five starting all six games with only one exception (**Caleb Sheets** at RT in week four).

The unit has also blocked for two 100-yard rushing performances by **Darnell Rolle** (week 1 vs Minot & week 4 at MSUM) in games where the team ran for 199 and 229, respectively.

WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB

Just past the midway point of 2017, junior **Dion Wallisch** has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team. He held BSU's All-NSIC second team receiver to 3-21 receiving and upped his effort against MSUM's All-American Damon Gibson to 3-24. In week five against #6 MSU, Wallisch intercepted the Mavericks in the end zone in the first quarter.

Also a sound tackler, Wallisch is fourth on the team with 32 tackles while leading the team with four pass breakups. He adds a 25.2 average on kickoff returns. As a true freshman at Minnesota Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss.

Senior captain **Andrew Capirchio** returns at the other starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts in 2016 as a junior transfer from Scottsdale CC. He's made 20 tackles with two pass breakups on the year. Redshirt freshman **Desmond Hudnall** and true freshman **Lorenzo Kendricks** provide depth.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. In the secondary, senior safety **Breon Hoosier** leads all players with 129 career tackles including 28 in 2017. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** with 115 including 21 for loss and five sacks. He's made 18 tackles so far this year. Leading the linebacking corps is **JJ Przybylka** with 101 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made three tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next closest to reaching 100 is junior safety **Brandon Russell** with 88.

DEFENSIVE LINE FEATURES EIGHT MAN ROTATION

The 2017 defensive line has experienced a number of injuries. Through week five, the statistical leaders up front have been **Dylan Wood** (22 TT, 1.0 SK) and **Kelly Pierce** (23 TT, 2.0 TFL).

Adding youth to the mix is true freshman **Chris Garrett** who produced a strip sack and recovered the fumble in his debut in a 24-0 shoutout win over Minot in the opener. Although he missed weeks two through five, he came back with a pair of sacks and eight tackles in week six at Upper Iowa.

VETERAN LINEBACKERS LEAD THE WAY

CSP's second through fourth leading tacklers are linebackers led by junior **Mitch Zillman** with 40 followed by freshman

Senior strong safety **Breon Hoosier** had a strong debut in 2017 with a pair of sacks blitzing Minot from the secondary. Now a fourth year contributor, Hoosier has 129 career tackles, 6.0 for loss, and eight pass breakups with one interception.

Junior **Brandon Russell** provides depth with 88 career tackles, 6.0 for loss and produced 48 tackles (5.0 for loss) a year ago.
