THIS WEEK: HOST 3RD STRAIGHT RANKED OPPONENT

Concordia-St. Paul welcomes #15 Sioux Falls, its third consecutive home game against a top-15 team in the country. Three weeks ago, CSP tangled with #6 Minnesota State (now #4), keeping the Mavericks within a touchdown until just before half before falling 47-10. Last week, it was #13 Winona State (now #11) where CSP led 3-0 at the quarter and trailed just 7-3 late in the third quarter before falling 28-10.

This week's opponent, Sioux Falls, had been ranked in the top-10 in the country for much of the season before falling 31-13 to Winona State two weeks ago in Sioux Falls.

ABOUT THE COUGARS

Outside of the loss to Winona State when USF surrendered 31 points, the Cougars have allowed just 38 points in their other six games and rank second in the country in limiting opponents to 9.9 points per game, 55.1 rushing yards per game and 236.0 total yards per game. The red zone defense is third in the country (54.5% scoring rate), they've allowed the third fewest first downs (84), rank ninth in the country in sacks (3.57), 12th in tackles for loss (8.7), 15th in third down defense (29.4%), 21st in passing efficiency defense (103.26) and second in fourth down defense (17.6%).

The defense is led by the nation's leader in sacks, Dennis Gardeck with 1.43 per game while ranking 10th nationally with 1.9 tackles for loss per contest.

While the defense is among the best in the nation, the offense has been average statistically, averaging 192.4 passing yards (112th DII, 12th NSIC) and 200.0 rushing yards (37th DII, 4th NSIC) for a total offense putting up 392.4 yards (70th DII, 3rd NSIC) leading to 29.0 points per game (68th DII, 5th NSIC).

USF quarterback lan Fieber has passed for 1,132 yards and five touchdowns but it's been the ground game led by Max Mickey where USF has done its damage. Mickey ranks 10th in the country and second in the league with 873 rushing yards and his eight rushing touchdowns rank second in the NSIC despite missing the last two weeks. He's not excpected to play this week, though. He's backed up Jason Towns, younger brother of former CSP offensive lineman Steven Davis, who has 327 yards and has also taken back two punts for touchdowns.

MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end **Matt Bjork** (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors **Andrew Capirchio** (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and **Frantz Polimice** (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore **Rich Kelly** (OG, Plainfield, Ill.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an formal application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: SIOUX FALLS 10, CONCORDIA 1

CSP won the first meeting between the programs in 1971 in Concordia's third year sponsoring college football, a 24-16 win when the program was known as the Comets and competing at the NAIA level. The teams met six times between 1971 and 1983 when both programs were NAIA members. But it was Sioux Falls who took control of the series during those seasons, winning three in a row from 1971-74 before winning back-to-back years in 1982-83. CSP failed to score more than eight points and hold Sioux Falls (then known as Sioux Falls College) to fewer than 23 points.

The series was revived after a near-30 year hiatus in 2012 when USF joined the NSIC and the NCAA Division II ranks. The first meeting between the programs as DII opponents was a closely played 31-23 game in Sioux Falls while the Cougars have won each year since by at least a 29 point margin. Overall, Sioux Falls carries a 10 game winning streak into this week's contest.

The Golden Bears are 0-1 against USF under head coach **Shannon Currier**.

LAST MEETING, 2016: USF 51, CONCORDIA 17

Concordia-St. Paul was able to pass for 261 yards on the road against the sixth-ranked Cougars en route to 334 yards of total offense. But they couldn't halt the USF run game which totaled 249 yards to improve to 8-0 on the year.

Concordia's defense had a tough task, facing an offense that averaged 560.1 yards per game to lead the country entering play, and slowed the Cougars down to 432 yards in the game. Further, the USF run game was ranked second in the country at 354.6 yards per game, making CSP's performance in slowing them to a still strong 249 yards out of character for the Cougars.

But USF still managed to rumble for over 50 points on its home turf including a 30-7 halftime advantage.

Concordia also held USF to 35.3 percent (6-17) on third downs as the Bears had more first downs (18) than the Cougars (16). CSP also held a strong 34:53 to 25:07 time of possession advantage.

Sioux Falls' play on fourth downs proved to be critical in building momentum and putting the game out of reach. CSP's opening drive featured a nine yard run by **Darius Chapes** and after the Bears couldn't pick up the short first down on the next two plays, **Ron Johnson's** pass to the flat to **Elias Arlington** was halted at the line of scrimmage to give USF the ball with excellent field position for its first possession at the CSP 34 yard line.

Chapes had a solid day against one of the top defenses in the country, rushing 14 times for 59 yards and a touchdown while Johnson completed 24-42 for 261 yards and a touchdown. Johnson connected with nine different targets including seven completions to **Deceon Schumann** for 46 yards while Arlington (4-61) and **Marcus Gustaveson** (4-57) having solid days.

Three plays after CSP's missed 4th and 1, the defense had USF stopped to a 4th and 7 at the 31 facing a Cougar offense that was 0-4 in the first seven games on fourth downs. The Cougars elected to go for it, with quarterback **Luke Papillion** completing a 31-yard touchdown to running back **Max Mickey**.

The Bears persisted through the early game momentum shift, converting a pair of third downs on the ensuing drive including a 3rd and 12 where Johnson was forced from the pocket, throwing on the run near the sideline back over the middle to Sammy Baucham for 23 yards into the USF red zone. Chapes

would convert for CSP, rushing in from four yards for a score to tie the game midway through the first quarter.

After a defensive stop, the CSP offense began a punt streak with Sam Maedke punting on the next six possessions including five in the first half although the CSP offense was able to produce 11 first half first downs. Maedke finished the day with a 42.3 punting average on eight punts including a career long 65 yarder.

Concordia moved the ball into USF territory four times in the opening half but had just the Chapes touchdown to show.

In the first quarter, CSP held USF's powerful run game to just 25 yards on seven rushing attempts before Mickey and the Cougars broke loose in the second quarter. Mickey had a 76 yard touchdown run midway through the second quarter before USF had a three play, 49 yard yard scoring drive - all on the ground. The result was 125 rushing yards on four carries in the second quarter as USF had 9-132 on the ground in a 17-0 second quarter.

Mickey finished with 158 combined yards, 16-128 on the ground (8.0 average) and three combined touchdowns.

Concordia was able to block a pair of kicks in the game, a blocked PAT by **Brian Lanier** in the first quarter and a blocked punt in the third quarter by **Jamie Fore**. Fore had a strong game with five tackles (all solo), a tackle for loss and two pass breakups.

LAST WEEK: WINONA STATE 28, CONCORDIA 10

On a chilly and rainy fall evening, Concordia-St. Paul captured the momentum early as sophomore corner **Dion Wallisch** intercepted a third down pass in CSP territory, taking it back 45 yards to the WSU 15. The opening drive pick set up a 41 yard field goal by junior **Jonas Schenderlein** to give Concordia its first lead in the first quarter of the season while the Warriors would trail in the first quarter for the first time. The 3-0 margin held at the quarter break, and the field goal was also the first time anyone had even scored on WSU in the opening quarter of 2017.

The Wallisch interception allowed Concordia to win the turnover margin 1-0 in the game despite WSU entering play leading the country with a 21-8 turnover margin (+2.17 per game) while CSP had forced just four turnovers all year.

The field goal for Schenderlein was his 14th straight make from inside of 50 yards dating back to his freshman season in 2015 as he improved to 7-8 overall on the season.

Winona State needed a Concordia miscue to claim the lead in the second quarter, as the Bears had a snap misfire on a fourth down punting situation, setting up the Warriors with the ball at the 33 yard line. The Warriors finally scored on a five yard run on the first play of the second quarter, and the teams continued to shut each other down until halftime with WSU taking a 7-3 lead into the break.

At the half, the two teams combined to completed just five passes in 11 attempts for 28 yards with one interception (by Wallisch). CSP was just 2-5 for 12 yards passing, but sophomore **Darnell Rolle** was able to find some room with 23 rushing yards on five carries (4.6 avg) and quarterback **Maxon Hutton** had a 25 yard run as the team produced 16-53 on the ground. WSU countered with an efficient 24-146 rushing effort in the half, although the Warriors had a missed field goal and threw the interception in CSP territory to stunt a pair of scoring drives.

In the third quarter as the rain and wind intensified, the Bears offense continued to struggle, failing to gain any yards of total offense on nine plays. But playing turnover free football allowed CSP to keep the game close, combined with a blocked field goal by sophomore **Antonio Zepeda** - CSP's fourth blocked kick of the season. The block kept the game 7-3 with 5:56 to play in the third quarter as CSP was hunting for an upset.

The Warriors countered by keeping the ground game rolling, rushing 13 times for 86 yards in the quarter while completing its only two pass attempts for 24 yards. **Javian Roebuck** added his second touchdown of the game on a catch out of the backfield to make it 14-3 with 1:47 to play in the third quarter. He finished with 26-170 on the ground and 2-24 receiving with the two scores and would earn NSIC Player of the Week honors.

WSU extended its lead to 28-3 with a pair of **Landon Jacobson** touchown runs in the fourth quarter, the second combing with 6:51 to play in the game to put it away.

As the rain subsided late in the game, Hutton found success through the air, completing 5-8 for 50 yards while adding three runs for 12 yards on a late scoring drive capped by a 17-yard touchdown pass to sophomore Marcus Gustaveson, his seventh receiving touchdown of the year on a 4th and 5.

Concordia's defense held the Warriors to 2-10 on third downs while the Wallisch-led secondary stifled the Warriors to 7-11-1 for 104 passing yards. Freshman linebacker Blake Evans and sophomore safety Brian Szutkowski led CSP's defense with team season highs of 14 tackles. Zepeda had seven tackles to go with his blocked field goal, adding a tackle for loss. Sophomore **Dylan Wood** had a strip sack in the game while senior **Andrew** Capirchio and freshman Chris Garrett each made seven tackles.

Rolle finished the day with 34 rushing yards on eight carries. Hutton was 11-25 on the ground and 7-16 passing for 62 yards and a touchdown.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator Jake Munkwitz: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two kicking legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back Darnell Rolle leads the special teams with eight total tackles including three in week one. and seven total on punt coverage.

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and recovered a fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense and is second on the team with six special teams tackles (all on punts).

The team has produced four blocked kicks: Dylan Wood FG vs Minot; Cole Riemer PAT at BSU, Elias Arlington punt at UIU and Antonio Zepeda FG vs WSU. The special teams has not allowed a blocked kick or punt all season, either.

Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week five, CSP executed a 35yard fake punt with punter Sam Maedke connecting with senior tight end **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State. A 2016 All-NSIC Second Team performer, Maedke is once again among the upper echelon of Division II punters, ranking 38th in DII and 3rd in the NSIC (40.1).

In the return game junior Jake Tanner opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and currently ranks 28th in the country in punt return average (10.9) on the year (10-109). Elias Arlington added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 22.3 yards to rank fourth in the NSIC.

Meanwhile, Jonas Schenderlein has produced touchbacks on

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 6TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Champion-

ship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

19-of-29 kickoffs (best rate in DII football) compared to 13 of 43 by opponents. The coverage unit has held opponents to an 20.7 average (6th NSIC) compared to CSP's 22.0 team KR average.

Schenderlein is also 7-8 on field goals including his second career 50-plus yarder (50) at Bemidji State. He ranks seventh in the country in field goal accuracy (87.5%).

ALL-CONFERENCE KICKING GAME

The Golden Bears return an All-NSIC kicking tandem in 2016 All-NSIC South Division First Team kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and Second Team punter **Sam Maedke**. MEET THE QUARTERBACKS: HUTTON & JOHNSON

In head coach Shannon Currier's offensive philosophy, versatility is valued across the field from up front, to the backs and receivers and includes the quarterback. The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter **Ron Johnson**, third year spot starter **Trevor Tillett** and the 2017 starter **Maxon Hutton**. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp.

In game one in his first career start, Hutton was not sacked and committed just one turnover while engineering a balanced offense that played comfortably with the lead in a 24-0 win over Minot.

Johnson relieved Hutton at the half at MSU Moorhead in week four due to injury, and earned starts in week five against Minnesota State and at Upper Iowa. Last year, Johnson passed for 2,115 yards and 14 TDs and added six rushing TDs.

Tillett has also played in 11 games in his career, passing for 863 yards and four touchdowns. All three QBs have thrown at least 15 passes in 2017.

100-YARD PERFORMERS

Three different Golden Bears have combined for four 100-yard rushing or receiving performances on the season. It started in week one when sophomores **Darnell Rolle** (17-107, TD) and **Marcus Gustaveson** (6-116, TD) topped the century mark via the ground and air, respectively. The duo powered CSP's 24-0 season opening win over Minot State.

Senior **Elias Arlington** joined the club in week three with 5-126 and a touchdown through the air against St. Cloud State.

In week four, Rolle topped 100 for the second time with careerhighs 22 carries for 172 yards and a touchdown.

GUSTAVESON A BIG THREAT AT WIDE RECEIVER

Sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** had a pair of 100-yard games as a true freshman when the lights were shining brightest against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career (6-116, TD) in a 24-0 win over Minot. In week six, Gustaveson had a career-high three TD receptions, hauling in 9-93 at Upper lowa. He's 12th in the country and second in the league with seven touchdowns (1.0 per game) and ranks 18th in the NSIC in yards (357) and 17th in catches (25). He's had a TD catch in five of CSP's seven games this year.

ARLINGTON & TANNER EXCEL AT WR & KR/PR

Senior **Elias Arlington** has emerged as a top threat in the pass game, recording his first career 100-yard receiving game in week three against SCSU (5-126, 1 TD) before posting a careerhigh eight catches in week four at MSUM (8-80). He's eighth in the league in receiving yards/game (64.2), 12th in catches (4.2), third in KR average (22.3) and sixth in all-purpose (110.5).

Junior **Jake Tanner** is the league's third ranked punt returner (10.9) and is third on the team in catches (18) and receiving yards (181) while compiling 347 all-purpose yards (4th on CSP).

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as CSP's quarterbacks have completed at least two passes to 11 different options and have connected with 13 different receivers on the year. Six players have at least nine catches and five have at least 12 grabs.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore **Darnell Rolle** (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen **Lajuan Preston** (Fort Myers) and **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg).

Rolle is seventh in the NSIC in rushing yards (94-484) and is a dual threat with 9-64 receiving and three total TDs (2 rush, 1 rec). He has two 100-yard performances (17-107, TD vs Minot & 22-172, TD at MSUM) and a combined 100-yard game (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec at UIU).

Preston (21-93, long 46) and Johnson (18-57, TD) have been solid as rookies in relief of Rolle

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles **Ben Lawrence** and **Terrell Taylor** with a sophomore interior of **Hunter Kauffman** at center surrounded by **Rich Kelly** and **Ethan Aune** at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior.

So far in 2017, the offensive line ranks 49th in the country (4th NSIC) with just 5.3 tackles for loss per game. The group has developed continuity, with all five starting all seven games with only one exception (Caleb Sheets at RT in week four).



WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB Just past the midway point of 2017, sophomore Dion Wallisch has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team. He held BSU's All-NSIC second team receiver to 3-21 receiving and upped his effort against MSUM's All-American Damon Gibson to 3-24. He's also picked off passes against nationally-ranked opponents in the first quarter: against #6 MSU in the end zone and #13 Winona State on its opening drive in CSP territory with a 45-yard return to the WSU red zone, setting up a field goal.

Also a sound tackler, Wallisch is fifth on the team with 36 tackles while leading the team with four pass breakups. He adds a 25.2 average on kickoff returns. As a redshirt freshman at Minnesota Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss. He missed last year at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP at the semester break last winter.

Senior captain **Andrew Capirchio** returns at the other starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts in 2016 as a junior transfer from Scottsdale Cc. He's made 26 tackles with two pass breakups on the year. Redshirt freshman **Desmond Hudnall** and true freshman **Lorenzo Kendricks** provide depth at CB.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. In the secondary, senior safety **Breon Hoosier** leads all players with 129 career tackles including 28 in 2017. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** with 121 including 22 for loss and five sacks. He's made 24 tackles and 2.5 TFL so far this year. Leading the linebacking corps is **JJ Przybylka** with 101 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made three tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next closest to reaching 100 is junior safety **Brandon Russell** with 88.

DEFENSIVE LINE BATTLING THROUGH INJURIES

The 2017 defensive line has experienced a number of injuries. Through week seven, the statistical leader up front has been **Dylan Wood** (37 TT, 4.5 TFL, 2.0 SK) who had 3.0 tackles for loss at Upper lowa and had a strip sack last week against #13 WSU. Senior **Chazz Roberts** has had a strong year inside, creating chaos for opposing lines while piling up 24 tackles and 2.5 TFL.

Adding youth to the mix is true freshman **Chris Garrett** who produced a strip sack and recovered the fumble in his debut in a 24-0 shoutout win over Minot in the opener. Although he missed weeks two through five, he came back with a pair of sacks and eight tackles in week six at Upper lowa and has amassed 17 tackles, 3.5 TFL and 3.0 sacks in just three games. Garrett has yet to play a down with veteran **Jackson Dobbs** as each lineman has played in three contests this year. Dobbs has 13 tackles, 1.0 TFL and 1.0 sacks.

SMSU

EVANS BREAKING THROUGH AT LINEBACKER

Freshman **Blake Evans** has nudged his way into the starting lineup the last two weeks and is now second on the team in tackles (50) following a team-season high 14 tackles against #13 Winona State. He has 29 tackles in the last three games and at least three tackles every game in 2017. Senior **Billy Brown** has registered 34 stops including 21 over a two game period against SCSU (8 TT, 1.0 TFL, 1 SK) and at MSUM (13 TT). Junior **Mitch Zillman** has started five of the seven games and is third on the team with 40 stops as he made at least four tackles each of the first six games. Sophomore **Antonio Zepeda** earned his first start of 2017 against Winona State, creating a disturbance with eight tackles, 1.0 TFL, a forced fumble and blocked a third quarter field goal.

SZUTKOWSKI A TACKLES MACHINE AT SAFETY

Sophomore **Brian Szutkowski** has led the team in tackles for a majority of the season, producing 60 tackles in seven to rank seventh in the Northern Sun. He's had three double-digit effort and ius coming off a careerhigh 14 tackles against Winona State. He's also had a pair

Senior strong safety **Breon Hoosier** had a 2017 season opener with a pair of sacks blitzing Minot from the secondary in a 24-0 shutout win. Now a fourth year contributor, Hoosier has 129 career tackles, 6.0 for loss, and eight pass breakups with one interception.

Sophomore **Jason Barto** emerged as a key contributor with his first career start against Winona State, producing seven tackles against the Warriors.

Junior **Brandon Russell** provides depth with 88 career tackles, 6.0 for loss and produced 48 tackles (5.0 for loss) a year ago but has been hampered by injuries in 2017.
