THIS WEEK: BEARS EMBARK ON FINAL ROAD TRIP

In Concordia-St. Paul's only two game road swing of the season, the Bears will head to Augustana for the 2017 road finale in what is senior day for the Vikings in their 2017 home finale.

3 PLAYS AWAY FROM PLAYING FOR .500

In his second season, head coach Shannon Currier and the Golden Bears are just three plays away from playing for a .500 record this Saturday. CSP fell 21-20 at MSU Moorhead where a fumble at the MSUM 2 yard line in the third quarter haunted the Bears in a one point loss in week four. In week six at Upper Iowa, the Bears were stopped with three incomplete passes on downs from the UIU 9 yard line with 1:45 to play in a 34-29 loss. In week nine last week at Wayne State, CSP went ahead 23-20 with just under three minutes left before the Wildcats responded with a game winning drive, scoring with 23 seconds to play in the game.

The result of the three narrow road losses leaves the Bears 1-8, but a razor thin margin away from a 4-5 record entering this week's road game at Augustana.

ABOUT THE VIKINGS

The Vikings enter their senior day having lost five of their last six games including the last two by a touchdown to crosstown rival Sioux Falls (14-21) and a one point loss to Upper Iowa (20-21). Their lone win during the stretch was a 30-8 victory at home over Southwest Minnesota State.

Ryan Bradberry has led the Viking offense with 600 rushing yards, a 4.9 per carry average and five touchdowns, adding a sixth score through the air.

The passing game has been a mix between Kyle Sadler (67-161-12) with 841 yards and seven touchdowns in eight games and Ryan Rubley (69-125-3) with 690 yards and five touchdowns. Rubley also brings a rushing presence, second on the team with 275 yards (3.9 avg) and two more scores. Together, they've combined for 12 touchdowns and 15 interceptions, a 46.9 completion percentage and 1,595 yards.

Their top target is Trevor DeSchepper with 33 catches for 380 yards and two scores while Jake Welsheimer has four receiving touchdowns on 23-211 receiving.

The Viking defense features the nation's fourth-leading tackler, league-leader Kirby Hora with 12.2 per game while Matt Wagner (10.3) ranks 18th in the country and fourth in the NSIC. Hora also leads the team with 8.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks while Wagner adds 3.5 TFL, 2.0 sacks and an interception.

The Viking secondary is led by Trevor Naasz with three of the team's 10 interceptions while Jordan Johnson has a pair of picks and a team-high eight pass breakups.

SENIOR DAY TO BE AT SEA FOAM STADIUM IN SEASON FINALE

Concordia athletics and the football team announced that the season finale on November 11 against Southwest Minnesota State has been relocated back to campus at Sea Foam Stadium. The originally scheduled home game was moved to Hamline University's Klas Field prior to the season starting to accommodate the inflation of the Concordia Dome over the Sea Foam Stadium turf. The athletic department and football team were able to push the date of the bubble inflation back, securing a complete six game home schedule. This will be the third six game home schedule since opening Sea Foam Stadium in 2009 joining the 2010 and 2015 seasons.

MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end **Matt Bjork** (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors **Andrew Capirchio** (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and **Frantz Polimice** (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore **Rich Kelly** (OG, Plainfield, Ill.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an formal application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: AUGUSTANA 9, CONCORDIA 4

Concordia controlled the early years of the all-time series, winning by three points or less in three of the first four annual meetings between 2004 and 2007. Augustana has responded by winning eight of the previous nine contests between the clubs including a 139-52 margin in the last two years. Concordia's last win in Sioux Falls was in 2007, a 20-19 victory as CSP won its first two trips, also picking up a 17-16 win in 2004 in the first ever game in the series. Concordia has yet to win a game since Augie opened Kirkeby-Over Stadium in four trips. Concordia's last win in the series was in 2014, a 17-7 win over the Vikings at Sea Foam Stadium in St. Paul.

The Golden Bears are 0-1 against Augustana under head coach **Shannon Currier**, as the series began the year after Currier's first stint at CSP (2000-03). Last year, Augie picked up a 63-31 win at Sea Foam Stadium.

LAST MEETING, 2016: AUGUSTANA 63, CONCORDIA 31

Concordia ran a school record 93 plays and produced 487 yards of total offense, running up season highs of 29 first downs for 41:09 time of possession on senior day. But the Golden Bears couldn't keep pace on the scoreboard as Augustana scored from distance with five 25-plus yard touchdowns and four of their scoring drives consisting of either one or two plays. Their longest scoring drive on a day in which the Vikings score nine touchdowns lasted just 2:37.

Concordia passed for a team season high 380 yards, the second 300-yard passing day of the year behind senior **Ron Johnson** who had a career day with 30-48 for 334 yards and two touchdowns, adding a rushing touchdown to give him 14 passing and six rushing scores on the year as he surpassed 2,000 passing yards on the season in the game.

Marcus Gustaveson was the primary beneficiary, hauling in 10 catches for 129 yards. He scored on a four yard touchdown with just under a minute to play in the second quarter - the first points of the quarter in a game that featured 94 total points. It capped a 7:46 drive as CSP methodically went 80 yards in 16 plays, looking to keep the Augie offense off the field.

The touchdown cut into Augie's lead, making it 21-3 seemingly entering halftime.

The Vikings struck back quickly, though, with a 34 yard pass setting up a 41-yard touchdown in a 36 second drive to make it 28-10 at the break.

Johnson finished one completion shy of matching the single game school record while Gustaveson was two receptions shy of tying the school record.

Augustana quarterback **Trey Heid** completed 18-29 for 374 yards and five touchdowns, adding three rushing touchdowns on 5-37 rushing in the game. **Matt Heller** was the top target, with eight catches for 250 yards and three touchdowns.

He led a Viking offense that topped 600 yards (602) on 53 plays.

While Johnson and Gustaveson had the passing game rolling for CSP, the run game also topped 100 yards behind **Darius Chapes'** 16 carries for 77 yards, adding 4-49 in the pass game for 126 combined yards. **Alex Carr** added three carries for 25 yards and **Darnell Rolle** had a fourth quarter touchdown run.

Entering the game, CSP featured the 11th ranked red zone of-

fense (90.5%), averaging 6.0 points per trip. They converted all five red zone trips to points against Augie with four touchdowns and a field goal.

LAST WEEK: WAYNE STATE 27, CONCORDIA 23

For the third consecutive road game, the Golden Bears appeared poised to steal a fourth quarter comeback. This time, the offense punched in the go-ahead touchdown with just under three minutes to play when senior **Ron Johnson** found senior **Deceon Schumann** for a five yard score.

The touchdown put CSP ahead 23-20, but Wayne State countered as a key third down defensive holding penalty on the first series extended the ensuing drive. The Wildcats moved into the CSP red zone with under 30 seconds to play, when the Bears had WSC backed up for a 3rd and 14 from the 15 yard line. WSC was able to complete the game winning touchdown in tight coverage with 23 seconds to reclaim the lead and interception on CSP's final possession in the closing seconds ended the game.

Concordia out-gained Wayne State in the game 315-309, with 70 of WSC's yards coming on the second play from scrimmage to make it an early 7-0 lead under a minute into play. The Wildcats extended the lead to 14-0 in the first and 17-7 in the second quarter.

Sophomore **Maxon Hutton** carried in from nine yards out for CSP's first score of the game at the end of the first quarter. He finished the game 17-86 rushing - both career-highs, while completing 11-17 for 136 yards through the air. He left due to injury early in the fourth quarter and did not return.

Sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** had five catches for 98 yards including a pair of 30-plus yard catches.

Concordia went on a 9-0 scoring run covering over 25 minutes of the middle of the contest to get back into the game, trailing 17-16 when WSC finally added a field goal early in the fourth quarter. The scoring run was courtesy the right leg of junior **Jonas Schenderlein**, who converted field goals of 38, 22 and 37 yards to tie the school record for field goals (3) for the second time in as many weeks. It's now been done 10 times.

In the contest, the two teams combined for six turnovers and three miscues on punts. WSC won the turnover battle 4-2 but Concordia won the battle on punting miscues 2-1, with CSP's only punting issue being a lost fumble on a fake punt attempt, also accounting for one of the turnovers.

The result was a game that features seven possessions starting in opposing territory with Concordia accounting for five of those, with one of the two by Wayne State coming in the game's closing seconds following the game-ending interception.

Concordia held a starting field position advantage of 10 yards (C41 to W31) which was accentuated in the second half when CSP averaged a start nearly at midfield at its own 49 compared to WSC average start at its own 28 in the second half.

Concordia was only able to score on three of those possessions, though, accounting for 13 points on five drives that started in Wildcat territory. CSP also scored just three points on the two forced turnovers and three points off the WSC failed punts.

CSP also threw an interception in the WSC end zone to open the second half, ending another excellent scoring chance. Concordia made it to the WSC red zone seven times, scoring just 23 points (3.3 per trip) while WSC was more efficient with five points per trip to the red zone on four total visits (20 points).

The Golden Bears came out looking to run, starting seven offensive linemen and calling running plays on the first eight plays of the game and on 11 of the first 12 plays. Sophomore **Darnell Rolle** added 13-57 rushing to Hutton's team leading 86 yards.

Defensively, the CSP secondary held Wayne State to 109 passing yards on 10-24 completions. The Wildcats had averaged 233 yards per game through air entering play.

The defensive front provided pressure with 12.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks while the secondary had six pass breakups on WSC's 14 incompletions. Defensive ends **Jackson Dobbs** and **Chris Garrett** each forced fumbles that were recovered by linebackers **Billy Brown** and **Antonio Zepeda**, respectively. Dobbs' was a strip sack while Garrett finished second on the team with eight total tackles, Dobbs adding six.

Freshman linebacker **Gabe Nkumu** had a big game, with two of his three tackles in the game being for loss, adding a sack and a forced fumble.

The linebackers were led by freshman **Blake Evans** with 10 tackles, 2.0 for loss and a sack.

In the secondary, senior corner **Andrew Capirchio** had five tackles, 2.0 for loss and three pass breakups.

On special teams, senior **Elias Arlington** had his second blocked punt of the year, this one coming in the fourth quarter.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two kicking legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back **Darnell Rolle** leads the special teams with 10 total tackles including three in week one, and nine total on punt coverage. His 12 total tackles rank 18th overall on the team.

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and recovered a fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense and is second on the team with eight special teams tackles (all on punts).

The team has produced five blocked kicks led by two blocked punts by **Elias Arlington** (at UIU & at WSC). The other three came from: **Dylan Wood** FG vs Minot; **Cole Riemer** PAT at BSU, and **Antonio Zepeda** FG vs WSU. The kicking unit, by comparison, has only allowed one blocked kick (54 yd FG vs USF, wk 8).

Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week five, CSP executed a 35-yard fake punt with punter **Sam Maedke** connecting with senior tight end **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State. A 2016 All-NSIC Second Team performer, Maedke is once again among the upper echelon of Division II punters, ranking 35th in DII and 3rd in the NSIC (40.6).

In the return game junior **Jake Tanner** opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and currently ranks 41st in the country in punt return average (9.1) on the year (12-109). **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 21.6 yards to rank fourth in the NSIC.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** has produced touchbacks on 26-of-39 kickoffs (best rate in DII football) compared to 16 of 55 by opponents.

Schenderlein is also 13-18 on field goals including a pair of 50-plus yard makes (50, wk 2 at BSU & 58, wk 8 vs USF). His 58 yard field goal is the second longest in DII this year and second longest in CSP history. He ranks 13th in the country in field goals made (1.44/game) and 44th in percentage (.722).

ALL-CONFERENCE KICKING GAME

The Golden Bears return an All-NSIC kicking tandem in 2016 All-NSIC South Division First Team kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and Second Team punter **Sam Maedke**. The duo are in their third years as the starter at the positions, with Maedke now a senior and Schenderlein a junior. Schenderlein has added kickoffs to his repertoire for 2017. More on the pair in the next 2 sections:

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 6TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage in year six.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

2017 QUARTERBACK NOTES

Head coach Shannon Currier values versatile players at every position, with an emphasis at the QB position. The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter **Ron Johnson**, third year spot starter **Trevor Tillett** and the 2017 starter **Maxon Hutton**. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp. He missed two and a half games in weeks 4-6 and left week 9 at Wayne State injured. He's not listed on the two deep for week 10. Johnson is the expected starter in Hutton's absence.

Tillett has also played in 11 games in his career, passing for 863 yards and four touchdowns. All three Concordia QBs have thrown at least 15 passes in 2017.

100-YARD PERFORMERS

Three different Golden Bears have combined for four 100-yard rushing or receiving performances on the season. It started in week one when sophomores **Darnell Rolle** (17-107, TD) and **Marcus Gustaveson** (6-116, TD) topped the century mark via the ground and air, respectively. The duo powered CSP's 24-0 season opening win over Minot State.

Senior **Elias Arlington** joined the club in week three with 5-126 and a touchdown through the air against St. Cloud State.

In week four, Rolle topped 100 for the second time with career-highs 22 carries for 172 yards and a touchdown.

GUSTAVESON A BIG THREAT AT WIDE RECEIVER

Sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** had a pair of 100-yard games as a true freshman when the lights were shining brightest against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career (6-116, TD) in a 24-0 win over Minot. In week six, Gustaveson had a career-high three TD receptions, hauling in 9-93 at Upper Iowa and nearly hit 100 again in week 9 at Wayne State (5-98). He's 37th in the country and fourth in the league with seven receiving TDs and ranks 14th in the NSIC in yards (476) and 15th in catches (32).

ARLINGTON & TANNER EXCEL AT WR & KR/PR

Senior **Elias Arlington** has emerged as a top threat in the pass game, recording his first career 100-yard receiving game in week three against SCSU (5-126, 1 TD) before posting a career-high eight catches in week four at MSUM (8-80). He's ninth in the league in receiving yards/game (60.3), 11th in catches (4.0), fourth in KR average (21.6) and sixth in all-purpose (111.0) while adding two blocked punts (at UIU & at WSC).

Junior **Jake Tanner** is the league's sixth ranked punt returner (9.1) and is third on the team in catches (18) and receiving yards (181) while compiling 347 all-purpose yards (4th on CSP).

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as CSP's quarterbacks have completed at least two passes to 12 different options and have connected with 13 different receivers on the year. Six players have at least nine catches and five have at least 16 grabs.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore **Darnell Rolle** (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen **Lajuan Preston** (Fort Myers) and **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg).

Rolle is 11th in the NSIC in rushing yards (116-578) and is a dual threat with 9-64 receiving and three total TDs (2 rush, 1 rec). He has two 100-yard performances (17-107, TD vs Minot & 22-172, TD at MSUM) and a combined 100-yard game (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec at UIU).

Preston (27-112, long 46) and Johnson (24-58, TD) have been solid as rookies in relief of Rolle.

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles **Ben Lawrence** and **Terrell Taylor** with a sophomore interior of **Hunter Kauffman** at center surrounded by **Rich Kelly** and **Ethan Aune** at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior. The five have started all but one game in 2017.

WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB

Sophomore **Dion Wallisch** has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team. He held BSU's All-NSIC second team receiver to 3-21 receiving and upped his effort against MSUM's All-American Damon Gibson to 3-24. He's also picked off passes against nationally-ranked opponents in the first quarter: against #6 MSU in the end zone and #13 Winona State on its opening drive in CSP territory with a 45-yard return to the WSU red zone, setting up a field goal.

Also a sound tackler, Wallisch is sixth on the team with 39 tackles while leading the team with seven pass breakups. He adds a 23.8 average on kickoff returns. As a red-shirt freshman at Minnesota Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss. He missed last year at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP at the semester break last winter.

Senior captain **Andrew Capirchio** has been solid at the other starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts in 2016 as a junior transfer from Scottsdale CC. He's made 38 tackles with six pass breakups on the year. He's had 4+ tackles in six straight games with a career-high of seven against USF in week 8; and had 5 tackles, 2.0 TFL and 3 PBU in week 9 at WSC.

True freshman **Lorenzo Kendricks** provides depth at the corner and has worked his way into a starting role as a safety late in the year. He forced a fumble and adding a high of seven tackles against USF in week 8, following it up with the start at safety at WSC in week 9 with six tackles, 1.0 TFL and a pass breakup.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. In the secondary, senior safety **Breon Hoosier** leads all players with 131 career tackles including 30 in 2017. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** with 127 including 23.5 for loss and five sacks. He's made 30 tackles and 4.0 TFL so far this year. Leading the linebacking corps is **JJ Przybylka** with 101 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made three tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next closest to reaching 100 is junior safety **Brandon Russell** with 89 followed by senior linebacker **Billy Brown** (84) and sophomore safety **Brian Szutkowski** (83) with 73 coming this year.

DEFENSIVE LINE BATTLING THROUGH INJURIES

The 2017 defensive line has experienced a number of injuries. Through week nine, the statistical leader up front has been **Dylan Wood** (45 TT, 7.5 TFL, 4.0 SK). Wood had back-to-back 3.0 TFL games against #13 WSU & #15 USF including his first 2.0 sack game against USF. Senior **Chazz Roberts** has had a strong year inside, creating chaos for opposing lines while piling up 30 tackles and 4.0 TFL.

Adding youth to the mix is true freshman **Chris Garrett** who produced a strip sack and recovered the fumble in his debut in a 24-0 shutout win over Minot in the opener. Although he missed weeks two through five, he came back with a pair of sacks and eight tackles in week six at Upper Iowa and has amassed 31 tackles, 5.0 TFL and 3.0 sacks in just five games. Garrett finally got to play his first snaps with veteran **Jackson Dobbs** in week eight against USF as each lineman had missed four contests this year. Dobbs has 22 tackles, 2.0 TFL and 2.0 sacks.

EVANS BREAKING THROUGH AT LINEBACKER

Freshman **Blake Evans** broke into the starting lineup midseason and is now second on the team in tackles (71) following three-straight double-digit tackle games against team #13 Winona State (14), #15 Sioux Falls (11) and at Wayne State (10). He has 50 tackles in the last five games and at least three tackles every game in 2017. Senior **Billy Brown** has registered 45 stops including 21 over a two game period against SCSU (8 TT, 1.0 TFL, 1 SK) and at MSUM (13 TT). Sophomore **Antonio Zepeda** earned his first start of 2017 against Winona State (wk 7), creating a disturbance with eight tackles, 1.0 TFL, a forced fumble and blocked a third quarter field goal. Zepeda followed it up with a career-high 14 tackles in week eight against #15 Sioux Falls and has now amassed 35 stops on the year.

SZUTKOWSKI A TACKLES MACHINE AT SAFETY

Sophomore **Brian Szutkowski** has led the team in tackles for a majority of the season, producing 73 tackles in nine games (8.1/game) to rank ninth in the Northern Sun. He's had three double-digit effort and is coming off a career-high 14 tackles against Winona State. He's also had a pair of games with 11 tackles and has made at least five tackles in every game this year.

Senior strong safety **Breon Hoosier** had a big 2017 season opener with a pair of sacks blitzing Minot from the secondary in a 24-0 shutout win. Now a fourth year contributor, Hoosier has 131 career tackles, 6.0 for loss, and eight pass breakups with one interception.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

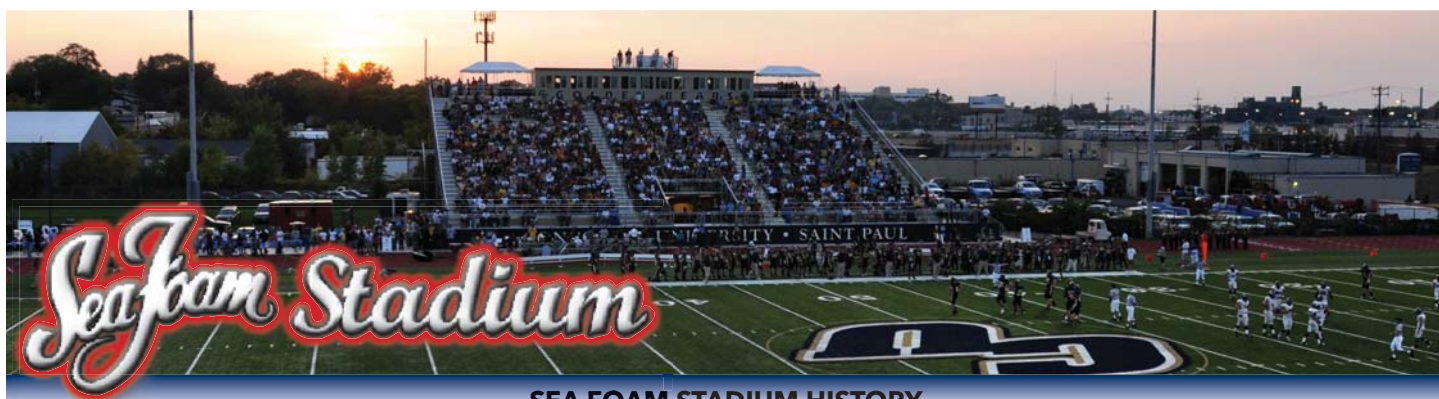
