THIS WEEK: SENIOR DAY CLOSING OUT 2017 SEASON

Concordia-St. Paul hosts Southwest Minnesota State for 2017 senior day at Sea Foam Stadium. The Golden Bears will honor their 19 player senior class that includes a student assistant coach and three juniors who will graduate with additional eligibility. One senior, **Samuel Kessler**, intends to return to the program pending a medical hardship waiver.

The Mustangs held senior day last Saturday in their home finale 45-7 loss to Winona State. 15 Mustangs will be competing in their final college football game today at Sea Foam Stadium.

ROAD COMEBACKS COME UP SHORT

In his second season, head coach **Shannon Currier** and the Golden Bears had four road comebacks come up short, with CSP having possessions to tie or go ahead in all four games. CSP fell 21-20 at MSU Moorhead where a fumble at the MSUM 2 yard line in the third quarter haunted the Bears in a one point loss in week four. In week six at Upper Iowa, the Bears were stopped with three incomplete passes on downs from the UIU 9 yard line with 1:45 to play in a 34-29 loss. In week nine at Wayne State, CSP went ahead 23-20 with just under three minutes left before the Wildcats responded with a game winning drive, scoring with 23 seconds to play in the game. In week 10 at Augustana, the Bears had four turnovers on their final six possessions and had the ball twice trailing 21-13 in the fourth quarter before falling 28-13.

The result of the four narrow road losses leaves the Bears 1-9, but a razor thin margin away from a 5-5 record and a shot at a winning season this Saturday in the finale against SMSU.

SILVER LININGS PLAYBOOK

Although the Golden Bears have dropped nine in a row and enter the final week with a 1-9 record, the team has made marked improvements over a year ago. In four straight road games, CSP has had the ball with a chance to tie or take the lead in the fourth quarter, falling just short at MSU Moorhead (20-21), Upper Iowa (29-34), Wayne State (23-27) and Augustana (13-28). Further, the Golden Bears have held opponents under 30 points in four straight games, compared to last year when opponents scored at least 30 points in eight of the final nine games of the year with only one of those losses being by one score (49-52, week 3 vs UMD).

ABOUT THE MUSTANGS

The Mustangs have now lost six in a row, and like Concordia are winless in NSIC South play and last victory was against Minot State.

As a team, SMSU has gone for 38 fourth downs on the year (3.8/game), converting just 11 (29%) compared to CSP picking up 10 fourth downs in just 20 tries (50%).

SMSU's season was derailed in week four when starting quarterback **Blake Gimbel** was lost to a season-ending injury. He was off to a strong start, completing 69.6 percent (64-92) for 734 yards and seven touchdowns. Since, SMSU's second and third quarterbacks have combined to complete 57.2 percent for 1,491 yards with a 5-8 TD-INT ratio (Gimbel was 7-2).

Top receiving threat **Nate Huot** continues to shine, with 66 catches for 785 yards and 5 TD and at least four catches every game. He had back-to-back 100-plus yard games and 3 TD in the first two weeks and has had just one 100-yard game since, week 8 at Upper Iowa (9-114, TD). He's second in the NSIC in both receptions and yards and fourth among active DI players with 250 career catches, just two shy of the SMSU career record.

Ashanti Payne supplements the offense with 524 rushing yards (4.2 avg) and six touchdowns while **Max Simmons** is a dual threat with 354 rushing (3.7 avg) and 33-256 receiving and five combined scores.

Alex Ney ranks second in the NSIC with 112 tackles while **Michael Griffin** is 10th with 79. Ney is tied with CSP's **Chris Garrett** for the league lead with five forced fumbles while Griffin is tied for the NSIC lead with three fumble recoveries. **JD Jackson-Hanchett** is second in the league with 11 passes defended and sixth with four interceptions.

MEET THE 2017 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced four captains for the 2017 season with senior tight end **Matt Bjork** (De Pere, Wis.) repeating as a two-time captain. He's joined by seniors **Andrew Capirchio** (CB, Fountain Hills, Ariz.) and **Frantz Polimice** (LB, Palm Bay, Fla.) and fourth year sophomore **Rich Kelly** (OG, Plainfield, Ill.).

To become a captain, players had to go through an formal application process that also included reading three books, community service and obtain letters of recommendation. The team voted on the applicants who completed the process to select its captains.

SERIES NOTES: CONCORDIA 10, SMSU 10

The series between Concordia and Southwest goes back to when the schools were named Concordia College and Southwest State in 1979 and 1980. Then nicknamed the Comets, CSP dropped those two meetings to SSU.

The series was revived in 1999 when Concordia joined the Northern Sun, and the teams have played every year since. The Mustangs won the first Division II-era meeting in 1999 in Marshall 44-0. Then head coach **Shannon Currier** took over at Concordia in 2000 and started a six game winning streak as CSP scored 30-plus points in each of the first five wins during the streak. SMSU won the three games from 2006-08 before CSP opened back up a three game winning streak from 2009-12. In the recent history, the Mustangs have won four of the last five including each of the last two.

SMSU has only made one visit to Sea Foam Stadium, which opened in 2009. The Mustangs won their only game at Sea Foam Stadium 48-24 in 2015. The teams have played twice at the Metrodome since opening Sea Foam Stadium in 2009, and the schedule has placed five games in Marshall during the same duration. Overall, CSP is 2-4 in St. Paul against SMSU and Currier is 1-0 against the Mustangs at home, winning in 2000 at Griffin Stadium. The Bears are 3-1 against SMSU at neutral sites.

The Golden Bears are 4-1 against SMSU under Currier.

LAST MEETING, 2016: SMSU 28, CONCORDIA 14

Last year Concordia had the tall task of slowing down one of the top passing games in the country as Mustang quarterback **Blake Gimbel** entered play ranked second in the country in completions, third in completion percentage and 13th in both passing yards and touchdowns.

A cool fall day with a stiff wind and cold precipitation helped, but the Concordia secondary did the rest. CSP held Gimbel to 9-17 passing for 122 yards. But the Mustangs countered by hitting the ground game for 312 rushing yards.

A season-long trend, Concordia also won the red zone, converting both of its chances to touchdowns while holding SMSU to 1-4 in the red zone, turning them over on downs twice as SMSU went 1-4 on fourth down in the game.

SMSU turned the tables by forcing two Concordia turnovers and holding the Bears to 2-15 (13.3%) on third downs to offset SMSU's own troubles in the red zone and fourth down.

Darius Chapes led the ground game with 14-59 rushing and a three yard touchdown run in the first quarter to make it a 14-7 SMSU lead.

Ron Johnson completed 16-35 for 165 yards and a touchdown, with five targets to **Marcus Gustaveson** for 74 yards and a 13 yard touchdown to make it 21-14 late in the second quarter.

Deceon Schumann had a team high seven catches going for 34 yards and added 3-22 on the ground along with 66 kickoff return yards for 122 all-purpose yards.

Two Mustangs topped 100 rushing yards in the game, **Hudson Walton** (26-145, TD) and **Max Simmons** (23-138, TD). **Nate Huot** led SMSU's pass game with 5-60 and a touchdown.

The Golden Bear defense was led by linebacker **JJ Przybylka** with 13 tackles while **Dylan Wood** had a sack with **David Reed** and **Chazz Roberts** teaming up for a half sack.

LAST WEEK: AUGUSTANA 28, CONCORDIA 13

Looking to make another road comeback charge, the Golden Bears fell short in the end for a fourth straight road comeback by turning the ball over four times on its final six possessions spanning the entire fourth quarter and late in the third.

Concordia trailed just 7-6 when **Jonas Schenderlein** hit his second field goal of the game with 10:05 to play in the third quarter. The one point margin held up until 1:13 to play in the quarter, nearly nine scoreless minutes when Augie pulled ahead 14-6. An interception on the ensuing drive set the Vikings up with the ball on the 25 yard line, scoring on the next play to make it a two-score game (21-6) at the end of the third quarter.

The defense was able to keep the Vikings off the scoreboard in the fourth quarter, but the offense was intercepted on 1st and goal at the Augie 6 yard line with 7:16 to play in what could have trimmed the lead to a one score game. CSP then scored on its longest drive of the year, a 91-yard march capped by a **Ron Johnson** to **Marcus Gustaveson** 7-yard touchdown with 2:09 to play.

The Vikings responded by converting a 3rd and 17 from the CSP 39 yard line with a 32 yard first down run inside the 10 yard line. Despite CSP being short of timeouts to get the ball back, the Vikings punched the ball in for a touchdown, allowing CSP another shot down two scores with under a minute to play before Augie intercepted CSP on the game's final play near the Augie goal line.

Concordia freshman defensive end **Chris Garrett** was a force in the game, compiling new highs of nine tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks and three forced fumbles to eventually earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week. Fell freshmen linebackers **Blake Evans** and **Dalton Smerchek** added 13 and nine tackles, respectively to give CSP's defense three out of its top four tacklers as true freshmen. The other leading tackler, senior corner **Andrew Capirchio**, had 10 tackles and an interception.

Offensively, Johnson had a career-high 349 yards on a career-high 54 passing attempts (27-54). He threw one touchdown, the 7-yard strike to Gustaveson who tied his career high of 10 catches for a new high of 135 yards.

Augie was led by **Kyle Saddler** (24-40-1) with 302 passing yards and three touchdowns with two of them going to **Jake Welsheimer** among his 8-111 receiving day. **Trevor DeSchepper** finished with six catches for 90 yards and a touchdown and **Ryan Bradberry** added 25-145 and a touchdown on the ground.

NSIC tackling leader **Kirby Hora** finished with 11 tackles for Augie, adding 2.0 for loss and 2.0 sacks while **Avram Tynes** had five pass breakups and six tackles.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

A preseason emphasis was placed on the importance of special teams across all of the units under special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**: kickoff and punt coverage, kickoff and punt return, kick and punt block and the kicking game. CSP already brought a pair of All-NSIC specialists to the kicking game, and invested heavily on practice time to ensure the rest of the units would be as efficient as the two kicking legs.

On coverage, sophomore running back **Darnell Rolle** leads the special teams with 14 total tackles including three in week one against Minot and four in week 10 at Augie. Of the 14 tackles, 12 have been on punts. His 16 total tackles on the year, which ranks 18th on the roster.

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and was credited with a recovered fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy touchdown for the offense and is second on the team with eight special teams tackles (all on punts).

The team has produced five blocked kicks led by two blocked punts by **Elias Arlington** (at UIU & at WSC). The other three came from: **Dylan Wood** (FG vs Minot); **Cole Riemer** (PAT at BSU), and **Antonio Zepeda** (FG vs WSU). The kicking unit, by comparison, has only allowed one blocked kick (54 yd FG vs USF, wk 8).

Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week 5, CSP executed a 35-yard fake punt with **Sam Maedke** connecting with senior TE **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State. A 2016 All-NSIC Second Team performer, Maedke is once again among the upper echelon of DII punters, ranking 15th in DII and 1st in the NSIC (41.5).

In the return game junior **Jake Tanner** opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and currently ranks 51st in the country in punt return average (8.3) on the year. **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averages 21.7 yards to rank sixth in the NSIC.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** has produced touchbacks on

26-of-43 kickoffs (best rate in DII football) compared to 17 of 60 by opponents.

Schenderlein is also 15-22 on field goals including three from 50-plus (50, wk 2 at BSU; 58, wk 8 vs USF & 55, wk 10, at Augie). His 58 yard field goal is the second longest in DII this year and second longest in CSP history. He ranks 11th in the country in field goals made (1.50/game) and 60th in percentage (.682).

ALL-CONFERENCE KICKING GAME

The Golden Bears return an All-NSIC kicking tandem in 2016 All-NSIC South Division First Team kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and Second Team punter **Sam Maedke**. The duo are in their third years as the starter at the positions, with Maedke now a senior and Schenderlein a junior. Schenderlein has added kickoffs to his repertoire for 2017. HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 6TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He entered his fifth season leading the team in 2016 and remains the program record holder for career winning percentage in year six.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to the teams as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

The Golden Bears have three multi-faceted quarterbacks on the roster, 2016 starter **Ron Johnson**, third year spot starter **Trevor Tillett** and the 2017 starter **Maxon Hutton**. While comfortable with all three in the huddle, Hutton claimed the starting nod out of camp. He missed two and a half games in weeks 4-6 and left week 9 at Wayne State injured. He's not listed on the two deep for week 11. Johnson is the expected starter in Hutton's absence.

Tillett has also played in 11 games in his career, passing for 863 yards and four touchdowns. All three Concordia QBs have thrown at least 15 passes in 2017.

100-YARD PERFORMERS

Three different Golden Bears have combined for five 100-yard rushing or receiving performances on the season. It started in week one when sophomores **Darnell Rolle** (17-107, TD) and **Marcus Gustaveson** (6-116, TD) topped the century mark via the ground and air, respectively. The duo powered CSP's 24-0 season opening win over Minot State.

Senior **Elias Arlington** joined the club in week three with 5-126 and a touchdown through the air against St. Cloud State.

In week four, Rolle topped 100 for the second time with career-highs 22 carries for 172 yards and a touchdown.

In week 10, Gustaveson tied a career high with 10 catches for a new career high of 135 yards with a TD at Augustana, his fourth 100-yard game of his career and second of 2017.

GUSTAVESON A BIG THREAT AT WIDE RECEIVER

Sophomore **Marcus Gustaveson** had a pair of 100-yard games as a true freshman against UMD (7-115, 2) in week three and Augustana in week 10 (10-129, 1). He led the team in catches (41), yards (564) and touchdowns (5) as a true freshman while missing one game and being slowed in parts of others due to injury. In the spring, he became a two-sport star by breaking the program record in the shot put at the NSIC Outdoor Track & Field Championships hosted on his home turf at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened 2017 with his third 100-yard receiving game of his career (6-116, TD) in a 24-0 win over Minot, and added his fourth 100-yard game in week 10 at Augustana by tying his career high in catches (10) for a new career high in yards (135) along with his eighth touchdown of the year. In week six, Gustaveson had a career-high three TD receptions, hauling in 9-93 at Upper Iowa and nearly hit 100 again in week 9 at Wayne State (5-98).

Gustaveson is 33rd in the country and third in the league with eight receiving TDs and ranks eighth in the NSIC in yards (611) and ninth in catches (42, 4.2 per game).

ARLINGTON & TANNER EXCEL AT WR & KR/PR

Senior **Elias Arlington** has emerged as a top threat in the pass game, recording his first career 100-yard receiving game in week three against SCSU (5-126, 1 TD) before posting a career-high eight catches in week four at MSUM (8-80). He's 10th in the league in receiving yards/game (60.9), 11th in catches (4.0), sixth in KR average (21.7) and fifth in all-purpose (113.22) while adding two blocked punts (at UIU & at WSC).

Junior **Jake Tanner** is the league's seventh ranked punt returner (8.3) and is fourth on the team in catches (20) and receiving yards (235) while compiling 400 all-purpose yards (4th on CSP).

Overall, the receiving corps is based on depth as CSP's quarterbacks have completed at least two passes to 13 different options and have connected with 14 different receivers on the year. Six players have at least 11 catches and five have at least 17 grabs.

YOUTH IN THE SUNSHINE STATE BACKFIELD

Led by true sophomore **Darnell Rolle** (Miami), Concordia's running backs share multiple common traits: the top three in the rotation all come from Florida, and all three are underclassmen as Rolle is joined by freshmen **Lajuan Preston** (Fort Myers) and **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg).

Rolle is 14th in the NSIC in rushing yards (121-589) and is a dual threat with 11-75 receiving and three total TDs (2 rush, 1 rec). He has two 100-yard performances (17-107, TD vs Minot & 22-172, TD at MSUM) and a combined 100-yard game (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec at UIU).

Preston (29-113, long 46) and Johnson (29-66, TD) have been solid as rookies in relief of Rolle.

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four offensive linemen. In 2016, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play as true freshmen, gaining valuable experience early in their careers. This year, the starting five up front include junior tackles **Ben Lawrence** and **Terrell Taylor** with a sophomore interior of **Hunter Kauffman** at center surrounded by **Rich Kelly** and **Ethan Aune** at the guard spots. The team is not expected to play a true freshman up front this year and only has one senior. The five have started all but one game in 2017.

WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB

Sophomore **Dion Wallisch** has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team. He held BSU's All-NSIC second team receiver to 3-21 receiving and upped his effort against MSUM's All-American Damon Gibson to 3-24. He's also picked off passes against nationally-ranked opponents in the first quarter: against #6 MSU in the end zone and #13 Winona State on its opening drive in CSP territory with a 45-yard return to the WSU red zone, setting up a field goal.

Also a sound tackler, Wallisch is sixth on the team with 44 tackles while leading the team with seven pass breakups. He adds a 23.8 average on kickoff returns. As a redshirt freshman at Minnesota

Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss. He missed last year at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP at the semester break last winter.

Senior captain **Andrew Capirchio** has been solid at the other starting corner spot after working his way into spot starts in 2016 as a junior transfer from Scottsdale CC. He's third on the defense with 48 tackles along with six pass breakups on the year. He's had 4+ tackles in seven straight games with a career-high of 10 at Augie in week 10 to go with his first INT of 2017 (2nd career). He also had 5 tackles, 2.0 TFL and 3 PBU in week 9 at Wayne State.

True freshman **Lorenzo Kendricks** provides depth at the corner and has worked his way into a starting role as a safety late in the year. He forced a fumble and adding a high of seven tackles against USF in week 8, following it up with the start at safety at WSC in week 9 with six tackles, 1.0 TFL and a pass breakup.

100 TACKLE CLUB

Three senior Golden Bears have topped the 100-tackle plateau and represent each level of the defense. Up front, its fourth year starting nose tackle **Chazz Roberts** with 134 including 23.5 for loss and five sacks. He's made 37 tackles and 4.0 TFL so far this year. In the secondary, senior safety **Breon Hoosier** has 131 career tackles including 30 in 2017. Leading the linebacking corps is **JJ Przybylka** with 101 career tackles including 5.5 for loss. He's made three tackles while battling injury during his senior campaign. The next closest to reaching 100 is junior safety **Brandon Russell** with 89 followed by sophomore safety **Brian Szutkowski** (88) with 78 coming this year, senior linebacker **Billy Brown** at 87 and freshman linebacker **Blake Evans** at 84 in a big rookie year.

DEFENSIVE LINE BATTLING THROUGH INJURIES

The 2017 defensive line has experienced a number of injuries. Through week nine, the statistical leader up front has been **Dylan Wood** (45 TT, 7.5 TFL, 4.0 SK). Wood had back-to-back 3.0 TFL games against #13 WSU & #15 USF including his first 2.0 sack game against USF. Senior **Chazz Roberts** has had a strong year inside, creating chaos for opposing lines while piling up 37 tackles and 4.0 TFL. The two have played every game and made nine starts each.

Adding youth to the mix is true freshman **Chris Garrett** who produced a strip sack and recovered the fumble in his debut in a 24-0 shutout win over Minot in the opener. Although he missed weeks two through five, he now ranks seventh on the team with 40 tackles. He's had at least a half TFL in every game this year (6 GP), leads the league in FF (5) and is fourth in the NSIC in sacks (6.0). He was named NSIC Defensive Player of the Week in week 10 at Augie with new highs of 9 tackles, 3.5 TFL, 3.0 sacks (2nd most in the NSIC in 2017), and an NSIC single game high of 3 forced fumbles.

Garrett finally got to play his first snaps with veteran **Jackson Dobbs** in week eight against USF as each lineman had missed four contests this year. Dobbs has piled up 28 tackles, 3.5 TFL and 3.0 sacks.

EVANS BREAKING THROUGH AT LINEBACKER

Freshman **Blake Evans** broke into the starting lineup midseason and now leads the team tackles (84), ranking seventh in the NSIC. He's had double-digit tackles in five of the last six games and four in a row and has 63 tackles in the last six games and at least three tackles every game in 2017.

Senior **Billy Brown** is third on the team with 48 stops including 21 over a two game period against SCSU (8 TT, 1.0 TFL, 1 SK) and at MSUM (13 TT).

Sophomore **Antonio Zepeda** earned his first start of 2017 against Winona State (wk 7), creating a disturbance with eight tackles, 1.0 TFL, a forced fumble and blocked a third quarter field goal. Zepeda followed it up with a career-high 14 tackles in week eight against #15 Sioux Falls and has now amassed 35 stops on the year.

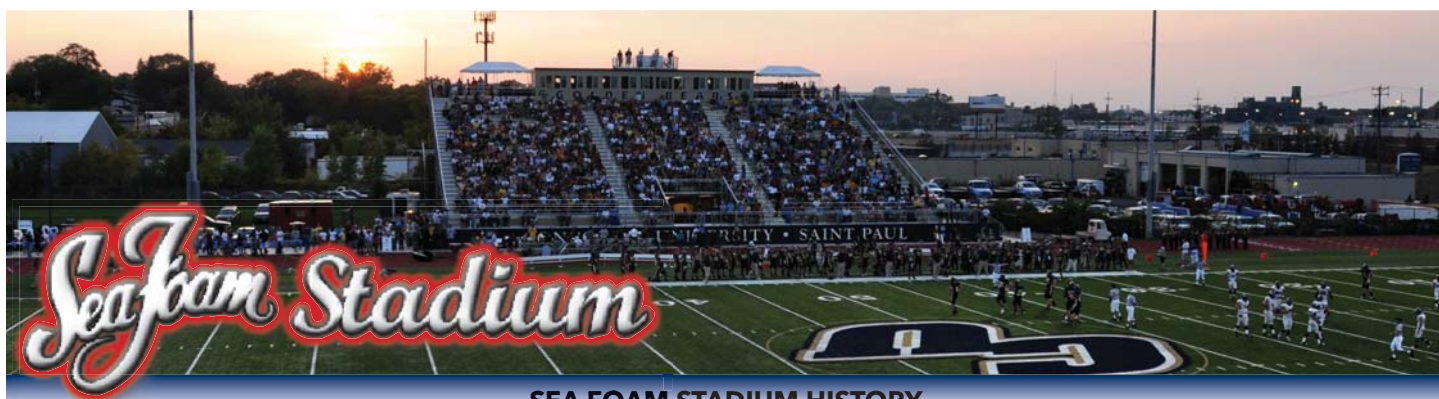
