Protocol for Fans

Know Before You Go

Attendance and Ticketing:

- In accordance with MDH guidance, Concordia will limit fans to 250 for home events. All fans in attendance will receive wristband upon entry.
- Each CSP baseball student-athlete and coaching staff member will be allotted four (4) family spectator passes via a predetermined pass list. List of spectators that must be submitted 24 hours before competition
- Gates will open 30 minutes prior to game time, please do not arrive at the venue and congregate prior to this time
- Currently no outside entry to the general public, including visiting spectators for the opposing team
- Visiting teams will be allotted 70 total spectators that must be submitted 24 hours before competition.
- No pets will be allowed for home CSP contests.

Check-in Area and Parking:

- Fans should park in Lot C or other designated parking areas on-campus
- We ask that fans use the main entrance to Barnes Field only, located in center field of Barnes Field (baseball field) on the south side of the Gangelhoff Center, near Lot C. A designated check-in table will be provided
- Fans will be provided a wristband upon entry
- All fans will be asked to exit the venue immediately following the conclusion of the contest and will not be allowed to interact with team personnel within the confines of the facility

Physical Distancing and Seating:

- Fans are required to sit at least six (6) feet apart
- Previously arranged family-unit pods may sit together in groups of no more than four (4), and must sit at least six (6) feet away from other pods
- Groups larger than four (4) will break up into multiple pods

- It is recommended that fans bring their own chair, as bleacher seating will be limited to the outfield area
- While in the facility, spectators must be at least 15 feet from the closest participant whether on bench, field, or common area
- Spectators must not physically interact with Tier 1 personnel (team members, coaching staff, and officials) at any point before, during, or after the contest.
- Access to field level will be heavily restricted to student-athletes, coaches and working staff in accordance with NCAA SSI Guidelines
- Fans will not be allowed access to the field
- Fans should remain in designated seating area

Face Coverings:

- Face coverings will be mandatory for anyone that is two (2) years old and over and in-venue (fans and staff). Masks must be worn at all times
- Masks are required across all NSIC contests this season and help support a safe environment for our student-athletes, staff and community
- Fans not wearing face coverings appropriately will be asked to leave the facility

Directional Signage:

- Follow all posted signage to help maintain physical distancing.
- Spectators are not allowed to enter any area designated as “Team Personnel Only”

Food & Beverage:

- There will be no concession sales in the facility
- No outside food or beverage will be allowed in the facility, including beverages in personal water bottles or mugs

Fan Health Promise

All fans must agree that neither they, nor any of their guests, will attend a game if any one or more of the following is true on game day:

- Within the prior 14 days, they have tested positive for, or been exposed to someone who has tested positive for, COVID-19;
- Within the prior 48 hours, they have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., a fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain/achiness, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue or any other symptoms associated with COVID-19 identified by the CDC);
- Within the prior 14 days, they have travelled to any state or international territory identified by federal or applicable local governments as being subject to travel or quarantine advisories due to COVID-19.

Please note: According to the CDC, older adults and people of any age with serious underlying medical conditions may be at higher risk of death or severe illness from COVID-19. All guests should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend a game.

COVID-19 WARNING

You must follow all arena policies, including health and safety policies, and posted instructions while in the facility and on arena grounds.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the centers for disease control and prevention, senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

By entering the facility and arena grounds, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
