THE MATCHUP

The Concordia-St. Paul men's basketball team wraps up their four-game road trip this weekend as they hit the road to Sioux Falls to take on the Cougars on Friday and Saturday.

LAST TIME OUT

Last weekend, the Golden Bears dropped two games at Augustana as they fell 106-61 on Friday and 91-52 on Saturday at Sanford Pentagon.

On Friday, Concordia found themselves in an early hole and they were unable to slow down the Vikings as Augustana cruised to a comfortable win. Augie took advantage of 22 CSP turnovers to hold a 31-4 advantage in points off turnovers while also utilizing their massive front line on the offensive glass and in the paint. The Vikings used a 20-7 edge in offensive rebounds to outscore Concordia 21-8 in second chance points to go along with a 48-20 edge in points in the paint.

Carlos Barela provided a bright spot for the Golden Bears as he finished with a team-best 14 points on 4-7 shooting and 5-6 from the line while pulling down three boards. Caden Hoffman chipped in 10 points, three rebounds and two assists while hitting all six attempts from the free throw line. Matt Johns and Jacob Shields contributed nine points apiece as well.

In Saturday's loss, Concordia remained within striking distance throughout much of the first half, but Augie finished the half on a 10-3 run before carrying that momentum past the break. The Vikings followed a similar script to victory in both games on the weekend as they used a 14-2 edge on the offensive glass to build a 15-0 advantage in second chance points while also collecting a 56-16 edge in points in the paint and a 29-2 edge in points off turnovers.

Matt Johns was the top producer for Concordia in the contest as he led the team with 16 points and a pair of blocks as he hit 5-11 from the field and 4-9 from deep. Caden Hoffman led the team with seven boards and three assists while Jax Madson finished with seven points and five rebounds in the loss.

USF SERIES HISTORY

The Golden Bears and Cougars are meeting for the 26th and 27th times in the all-time series this weekend as CSP enters with a 6-19 record against USF. Concordia's best stretch in the series came back in 2015-16 as they won three of four during that span, but the Cougars have won all eight meetings since then. The Golden Bears have gone 2-9 in 11 road contests with Sioux Falls.

LAST MEETING VS USF

Back on Jan. 11, 2020, Concordia took its first loss of the calendar year, falling 74-59 on Saturday evening to NSIC leader Sioux Falls.

Junior forward Cody Carlson was one of three Golden Bears with 13 points, adding nine rebounds and a pair of blocked shots while making 5-of-8 from the field.

The Golden Bears went into halftime tied at 24 with the Cougars, holding USF to just 31.0% (9-29) shooting.

In the second half, when it appeared the Cougars were picking up momentum, Concordia junior guard Lee Higgins converted a four point play after connecting on a

corner three-pointer to tie the game at 32 with 15:31 to play. Higgins matched Carlson's 13 points and two blocked shots, coming on 4-of-7 shooting including 2-of-4 from three-point range.

USF's shooting recovered in the second half as the Cougars stopped settling on the perimeter. After going 1-of-9 from the arc in the first half against CSP's road defense, Sioux Falls attempted just two second half three-pointers and converted 64.3% (18-28) from the field after the break to finish the night at 47.4% (27-57).

CSP held USF to just 18.2% (2-11) three-point shooting overall, but the Cougars used a 46-24 scoring advantage in the paint and had a 27-to-11 edge in free throw attempts which led to a +10 scoring margin at the line.

Five Cougars reached double-figures led by Chase Grinde's 16 points while Austin Slater added 11 points and nine rebounds.

ABOUT THE COUGARS

The reigning NSIC South Division champs were tabbed to finish second in the NSIC Preseason Coaches Poll as they entered the 2020-21 season with high expectations. So far this season, Sioux Falls has met those lofty expectations as they remain unbeaten through four games.

Prior to seeing last weekend's series with Winona State canceled due to COVID-19 protocols, USF opened conference play with a sweep of Upper Iowa on their home court. In a weekend with two contrasting styles between the defensive-minded Cougars and the high-powered Peacocks, it was the suffocating defense of Sioux Falls that won out. USF claimed a 68-55 win on the back of a career night for Troy Houghton on Friday night before Teathloach Pal's double-double led the Cougars to an 87-76 win on Saturday.

Balance has been a key to USF's early season success as the Cougars have six different players that average at least 7.0 points per game and eight different players that average at least 10 minutes per game. Senior Teathloach Pal has paced the squad in points (14.3), rebounds (8.0) and blocks (1.5) on the season while Troy Houghton follows close behind with 13.3 points per game. Chase Grinde has also been a steady producer with 10.0 points, 6.5 boards and 2.8 assists per game so far this year.

NSIC LEADERS

Early in the season, the Golden Bears thrived in several statistical areas as they rank in the top half of the NSIC in three different categories. CSP has been efficient at the free throw line with a 76.0% mark, good for third, while they've collected 3.2 blocks per game, good for sixth. Concordia has also tallied 34.3 rebounds per game, registering in at eighth in the conference.

Individually, three different players rank inside the top 20 in different categories.

Carlos Barela has been productive in few areas as he sits in 16th in the NSIC with 1.3 steals per game, 16th in free throw percentage (76.2%) and 25th in assists per game (2.2).

In addition to Barela, Matt Johns ranks fifth in blocks per game (1.7) while Jacob Shields ranks 13th in free throw percentage (81.3%).

Matt Fletcher was named head men's basketball coach at Concordia-St. Paul in April, 2020, bringing four successful years of NCAA Tournament level head coaching experience in the state along with multiple years of coaching success in the Northern Sun (NSIC) as an assistant after a decorated career as a player in the NSIC.

A native of North Branch, Minnesota, Fletcher is the 10th head coach in the institution's era as a 4-year college basketball program since 1967, and the 19th in institution history dating back to 1912 to include its prep and junior college eras.

Fletcher came to Concordia following a successful stint as the head coach at Bethany Lutheran College where he spent four winning seasons compiling a 76-33 overall record and a 52-12 mark in the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) including UMAC regular season and tournament championships in his second season there in 2017-18.

The regular season and conference tournament titles earned Fletcher UMAC Coach of the Year honors, guiding the program to its first-ever NCAA Division III Tournament appearance where they defeated seventh-ranked St. John's on the road. In 2019-20, he led the Vikings to their second UMAC Tournament title, reaching the NCAA DIII Tournament for the second time in three seasons.

In addition to coaching basketball, Fletcher was head women's golf coach including being named 2019 UMAC Coach of the Year and served as head of strength & conditioning for the Vikings.

Prior to his first college head coaching position, Fletcher spent three years at Upper Iowa in the Northern Sun (NSIC) where his final season included a promotion to the associate head coach position. In his time at UIU, the Peacocks placed fourth in the NSIC South Division all three seasons, and captured NSIC Tournament first round wins each season.

His coaching experience also includes a pair of prep head coaching positions at Twin Cities metro area high schools including Anoka High School (2012-13) and South St. Paul High School (2009-10 & 2010-11) where he was the youngest head coach in MSHSL Class AAAA boys basketball.

In between Fletcher's prep head coaching gigs, he spent a year at perennial NCAA Division II Tournament participant Kentucky Wesleyan College in 2011-12 where he was part of a staff that made a run to the NCAA regional final (Sweet 16) while also serving as the women's golf coach for the Panthers.

His first coaching experience came in 2008-09 as an assistant at Concordia-Moorhead.

A graduate of Southwest Minnesota State University, Fletcher set the career records at SMSU for three-pointers made (305), free throw percentage (.853, now 2nd) and is second in career three-point percentage (.448) while holding single season records in free throw shooting (.913) and ranks second and fifth with 48.0 and 45.5 percent three-point junior and sophomore seasons. His 1,375 career points rank ninth on the Mustangs' career scoring charts and he was a three-time All-NSIC Second Team selection. In his career, Fletcher played on winning teams as a sophomore (15-14), junior (20-10) and senior (17-12).

A standout prep player for North Branch High School, Fletcher led the Vikings to an 87-27 record, played in the Minnesota State All-Star Game, is the all-time leader in points and is a member of the North Branch Athletics Hall of Fame.

He holds a bachelor's degree in sport management with a coaching minor from SMSU and earned a master's degree in education with a leadership emphasis from Upper Iowa University.

Fletcher and his wife, Aly, have two sons and are excited to relocate to the Twin Cities where their families reside.

Assistant Coach notes:



Nick Perrin is entering his first season as an assistant coach with the Concordia-St. Paul men's basketball program in 2020-21.

Perrin joins CSP after spending the last four seasons as an assistant under Fletcher at Bethany Lutheran. As Coach Fletcher's right-hand man, Coach Perrin was key in the resurgence of men's basketball at Bethany Lutheran. He also worked as the head tennis coach and assistant women's golf coach for the Vikings.



Roman Gentry enters his seventh season with the Golden Bears in 2020-21 after joining the Concordia coaching staff prior to the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant.

Gentry played two years at the University of South Dakota from 2008-10, averaging 13.5 points during his junior season as a midseason transfer. As a senior, he was named All-Great West Conference First Team, averaging 17.6 points during league play for the Coyotes. He began his playing career at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, where he played in 36 games with four starts in his first two seasons before leaving for USD.



Neil Fletcher is in his first year as an assistant men's basketball coach for the Golden Bears after serving his son at Bethany Lutheran for three years. Fletcher comes to CSP with over 40 years of coaching and 15 years of experience as a high school athletic director.

Fletcher has accumulated over 30 years of those years coaching basketball at the high school, college, and AAU levels. Fletcher was a head boys basketball coach at the high school level with stints at Plainview, Columbia Heights, and Buffalo.



Eric Ritter joined the Concordia-St. Paul men's basketball coaching staff as an assistant coach prior to the start of the 2020-21 season.

Ritter, who previously worked as an assistant coach at Pacific Lutheran, works as a mental performance coach for the program.



Sam Nicholson joined the Concordia-St. Paul men's basketball coaching staff as a graduate assistant in the summer of 2020.

A 2020 graduate of South Dakota, Nicholson worked as a student assistant with the Coyotes men's basketball program for four years, including during the team's conference championship season in 2016-17. His duties included helping set up meals, travel and film.
