#### THE MATHCUPS

The Concordia-St. Paul women's basketball team (21-6, 17-6 NSIC) is set to host Bemidji State (5-21, 3-19 NSIC) for the first round of the NSIC Tournament on Wednesday, Feb. 27 at 6 p.m. at the Gangelhoff Center. The Golden Bears are the number one seed in the NSIC South, while Bemidji State is the eighth seed in the NSIC North.

Ticket prices for the first round game NSIC Tournament at the Gangelhoff Center will be as as follows: Adults - \$10, Students - \$2, Kids five and under - free.

If the Golden Bears defeat the Beavers in the first round of the tournament, they will advance to play the winner of St. Cloud State and Minnesota State at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls on Saturday, March 2nd. The remainder of the tournament is also held at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, with the semifinal and final games on March 4th and 5th, respectively.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

In the last weekend of the regular season, the Golden Bears traveled to Winona State and Upper Iowa. Concordia came away with two wins, shooting 59.3% on the weekend.

On Friday against the Warriors, the Golden Bears set a new Dll-era school record for shooting percentage in a game with a mark of 65.3%, claiming a 80-68 win. Concordia had five players score in double digits.

Winona State took an early lead in the first quarter, but the Golden Bears stormed back to create a significant gap in the second and third quarters. CSP outscored WSU 26-10 in the second quarter and the Golden Bears shot 11-13 (84.6%) in third quarter.

Lindsay Dorr led CSP with 19 points and 10 rebounds, followed by 15 points from Meghan Du-Bois. Anna Schmitt (12 points), Sidney Wentland (11 points), and Kyrah Fredenburg (10 points) were also significant contributors.

In the matchup against Upper Iowa, Schmitt set a new school record for career scoring, topping Anika Whiting's record with a pull-up jumper late in the second quarter. Schmitt ended the game with 20 points on 7-9 shooting, and now has 1990 career points.

The Golden Bears held the lead for the entire game, shooting an efficient 55.0% from the floor. CSP also outrebounded the Peacocks 40-28.

Dorr led the Golden Bears with 23 points on an extremely efficient 10-11 shooting. Wentland also had a productive game with 16 points, seven assists, and five rebounds and DuBois added 10 points for CSP.

#### **BEMIDJI STATE SERIES HISTORY**

The Golden Bears hold a 31-11 edge in the all-time series against the Beavers. Concordia has been especially successful against BSU at home, with a 16-1 record at the Gangelhoff Center. CSP has won the last five matchups in the series and 15 of the last 16.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST BSU

The Golden Bears faced off against the Beavers just a few weeks ago, with the Golden Bears claiming a 83-52 win in Bemidji. Concordia outshot BSU 54.2% and 37.0% to capture the victory.

The Beavers were able to cut CSP's lead to two early in the second half (38-36), but it was all Golden Bears from there. Concordia outscored the Beavers 45-16 from that point on, cruising to the victory.

Anna Schmitt led the offensive charge for the Golden Bears, as the senior poured in 22 points on 8-14 shooting from the floor, including 3-3 from three. Three other Golden Bears also posted double-digit scoring totals, as Lindsay, Dorr, Lexi Lee, and Riley Wheatcraft each added 11 points. Dorr also secured her tenth double-double of the season with 13 rebounds and provided rim protection with three blocks. Lee made an efficient 5-8 from the floor with two steals while Wheatcraft matched Schmitt for the team lead with three triples.

#### **SCOUTING THE BEAVERS**

Bemidji State doesn't have a main scorer or two that they rely on consistently, instead with five players averaging between 6.7 and 9.5 point per game. That group is led by Taylor Bray, who averages 9.5 points per game on 56.1% shooting.

Trinity Meyer has been heating up lately for the Beavers, as the freshman has posted double digit scoring totals in nine of the last ten games. Meyer has also been efficient from downtown, hitting 44.1% of her three-point shots on the season.

Bemidji State had won three of out of a stretch of four games during the middle of the conference season, but they have tailed off at the conclusion of the year. The Beavers dropped their last eight games of the season, including the last four by 18 **SEASON RECORDS** points or more.

BSU has shot the fifth most-three point attempts in conference play among the 16 NSIC teams, averaging 22.27 per game. However, the Beavers are last in the conference with a 29.8% mark from three.

#### **KEY STATS**

The Golden Bears have been at the top of their game at the Gangelhoff Center this season, winning 13 of their 14 contests. CSP has held their last 12 home opponents to less than 40% shooting.

The Golden Bears now have two school record holders on the team. Anna Schmitt just recently claimed the school record in career scoring (1990 points) while Kyrah Fredenburg has the school's top rebounding mark (925 rebounds).

Lindsay Dorr ended the regular season ranked fourth in the conference in scoring (16.6 ppg), third in rebounding (9.8 rpg) and field-goal percentage (51.7%). The senior center shot 18-20 (90%) from the field last weekend, earning NSIC South Player of the Week by averaging 21 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.

Three-point shooting has been a key this season for the Golden Bears. When making five or more three, CSP is 21-1. When making more threes than the opposition, the Golden Bears are 15-0.

Concordia leads the NSIC in conference play in defensive field goal percentage with a mark of 35.6%. The Golden Bears have not allowed an opponent to shoot above 40.5% since January 4th against the University of Mary.

Amanda Johnson enters her third full season after officially being named the program's ninth head basketball coach in April, 2016 following a successful stint as interim head coach in the second half of the 2015-16 season.

One of the top post players in Concordia basketball history, Johnson assumed the interim head coach position during winter break of the 2015-16 season and led the program to a 9-10 record high-lighted by a 9-6 finish that included an NSIC Sanford Health Tournament first round victory.

In her first full season in 2016-17, Johnson led the team to a fifth place finish in the NSIC and a third place finish in the South Division as the team compiled a record of 19-10 (15-7 NSIC) on the season.

She's completed her sixth year coaching in the program, spending the first two as a graduate assistant before a promotion to the top assistant position on staff for a year and a half.

Johnson returned to the Golden Bears in 2012-13 after a strong

stint as a professional player in Australia. She returned to pursue a master's degree in sport management and initially was tabbed with working with the post players. As a graduate assistant, the Golden Bears captured two NSIC Championships and an NCAA Central Region Championship with a trip to the Elite Eight during her first two years on

**Concordia Playing Career** 

The two-time All-Region performer led the Golden Bears to back-to-back NSIC regular season and tournament championships and was two-time NSIC Player of the Year in the process. Johnson set the school single-season scoring record with 551 points as a junior in 2006-07 as she led the Golden Bears to the NCAA Central Region Championship game and the school's second Sweet 16 run.

She averaged 16.8 points and 8.6 rebounds while shooting 52.4% from the floor and finished as Concordia's seventh all-time leading scorer despite playing three years for the Golden Bears (2005-08).

She had a 30-point, 20-rebound performance in the 2006-07 region title game. Her 726 career rebounds rank second in Concordia's Division II-era (1999-present), just 16 shy of the school record. She also scored 1,426 career points in 94 games, adding 112 steals and 81 blocked shots.

The St. Croix Lutheran High School graduate was a business and marketing major at Concordia as an undergraduate. She began her college career at Division I Winthrop University, playing in 27 games with three starts with a Big South Freshman of the Week award.

**Coaching Beginning** 

Johnson brings prior coaching experience to the Golden Bear huddle, working as an assistant coach at New Life Academy.

**Professional Playing Career** 

After her Concordia playing career came to a close, Johnson pursued professional basketball in Australia, playing for the Ringwood Hawks where she was a 2010 Big V League MVP and helped the Hawks to a Victoria State Championship. She posted averages of 15.6 points and 14.3 rebounds most recently.

She had also worked at Freedom Mortgage in the Twin Cities between Australian seasons.

Amanda is married to men's basketball assistant coach Eric Johnson. They currently reside in Hudson, Wis with their son, Jase.

#### Assistant Coach notes:

Kristen Lee joined the Concordia women's basketball coaching staff in the summer of 2018. The Dawson, Minnesota native and graduate of St. Catherine University (exercise sports science) in St. Paul will primarily work with guards while assisting in all aspects of the program.

Her college coaching career began as a graduate assistant at SMSU where she earned a master's degree in physical education. She also served as a coach with the Minnesota Fury AAU program. Lee was most recently the top assistant at Northwestern (lowa), which made a run to the NAIA DII national semifinals.

**Haydn Becker** enters her first season as a graduate assistant for the Golden Bears in 2018-19. Prior to joining the coaching staff, Becker was an NSIC All-Academic selection for Concordia. She made 53 appearances, including 13 starts, over her two seasons after transferring in from Sioux Falls. Becker graduated from CSP with a degree in Elementary Education and is currently pursuing a Master's degree in Educational Leadership.
