THE MATHCUP

The Concordia-St. Paul women's basketball team (7-3, 5-3 NSIC) is set to take on the Upper Iowa Peacocks (1-9, 0-8 NSIC) in a pair of conference games this weekend at Dorman Memorial Gymnasium.

LAST TIME OUT

Last weekend, the Golden Bears took on the SMSU Mustangs in a pair of road games at the R/A Facility. The Golden Bears split the series, losing the first game 58-50 and winning the second game 68-63.

Neither team was particularly sharp in the first quarter of game one, with each squad shooting under 27% from the floor. The Golden Bears struggled to generate offense, going 0-6 from beyond the arc and 4-19 from the floor in the first frame. At the end of one, the Mustangs carried a 13-10 lead.

Each offense heated up some in the third quarter, with the Golden Bears shooting 5-15 and the Mustangs shooting 6-13. The teams kept pace with each other throughout the quarter, but it was the Mustangs closing it out stronger as they jumped back on top 38-35 heading into the fourth.

The Mustangs remained in control for the duration of the fourth, outscoring the Bears 20-15 to seal the victory.

The Bears had their worst shooting day of the season so far, going just 18-67 (26.9%) from the floor and registering a season-low 50 points. Despite the poor offensive showing, the Bears played well defensively, holding the Mustangs to an identical shooting percentage of 26.9% on 18-67 shooting.

Senior guard Riley Wheatcraft carried much of the load for Concordia as she registered the team's first double-double of the season with 22 points and 11 rebounds. Freshman forward Lindsey Becher had another strong defensive showing, tying her career-high of seven blocks in a game and falling just one block short of the school record of eight blocks set by Kionda Nicks in 2014. Becher and junior guard Meghan DuBois each contributed six points while senior forward Ayla Lemke led all bench scorers with seven points.

On Sunday, the Bears bounced back after a tough shooting day in their previous game, shooting 43.1% through the game and holding the Mustangs to just 31.4% shooting. CSP also outrebounded SMSU 44-39 in the game and won the battle in the paint 36-30.

Lindsey Becher put on a show as she notched her first career double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds. She also had another strong defensive performance as she blocked 6 SMSU shots. Jadyn Hanson tied her career-high of 18 points as she connected on 6-11 shooting from the floor and made all five of her free throw attempts. Junior guard Meghan DuBois was the only other Golden Bear to finish in double figures as she put up 14 points, five rebounds, and six steals.

UIU SERIES HISTORY

The Golden Bears have a 26-5, all-time record against the Peacocks. The Bears' record in road games against UIU is 12-3. CSP has dominated the series in recent years as they have won seven of the last 10 against the Peacocks.

LAST TIME AGAINST UIU

When the teams last met on Feb. 22 last year at the Gangelhoff Center, the Golden Bears came away with a 90-39 victory.

The Golden Bears held the Peacocks to 18 points in the first half of the game, keeping them to just 23.1% shooting from the floor (3-13) in the first quarter and 18.2% (2-11) in the second. While CSP had eight scoring contributors in the first half, UIU had just three players put points on the scoreboard in the first 20 minutes.

At the half, Concordia was shooting 13-of-24 from the field (54.2%) and were led by Danielle Schaub with eight points and four rebounds. As a team, the Golden Bears were able to score 15 of their 36 points off Peacock errors.

With their 18-point advantage at the start of the second half, the Golden Bears came out ready to attack the boards starting with an offensive board from Sydney Schultz where she provided the assist for Cassidy Byrd to drain the put-back off the glass for two. That momentum carried on up the court when Byrd collected back-to-back steals from the Peacocks.

The Bears were the most effective from the floor in the third quarter and made four of their six three-pointers. They shot 64.7% from the field (11-17) and were 4-for-8 from downtown. The Peacocks also had their best shooting performance of the game, going 35.7% (5-14) but were outscored by CSP 29-15.

Concordia continued to build upon their lead and use their defense to stifle the Peacocks offense in the fourth quarter. With the shooting opportunities the same on both ends, the Golden Bears dropped eight of their 16 from the floor while the Peacocks could get just three to fall. CSP went on a 25-6 run in the final ten minutes to glide towards their tenuous 51-point lead at the final buzzer.

It was an active night for Golden Bear assists, as they dished out 20 passes that led to CSP points while UIU contributed four on their side. Danielle Schaub was the top-scoring contributor with four assists and acted as the scoring leader along with Sydney Zgutowicz and Jadyn Hanson, all of which put up 14 points.

As a team, the Golden Bears shot 56.1% from the floor (32-57) and 40% from three (8-20). The Peacocks struggled from the floor the entire night and ended on 24.1% shooting (13-54) which is the lowest Concordia has held a team since the 2014-15 season. Jessica Musgrave scored 17 UIU points as the scoring leader and was also the top rebounder with eight rebounds.

SCOUTING THE PEACOCKS

The Peacocks have struggled to score points this year as they average just 58.3 points per game this season, good for 14th in the NSIC. Their defense also ranks near the bottom of the conference as they sit in 15th place allowing 78.3 points per game.

The player to watch for the Peacocks is Lydia Haack. The freshman is averaging 15.8 points per game on 50-133 shooting from the field while also contributing 3.4 assists and 2.5 rebounds per game.

Sophomore guard Brooke Evenson is also a key contributor for UIU as she is averaging 8.9 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.

Rounding out the Peacocks' scoring attack is sophomore guard Katie Tornstrom. Tornstrom is scoring 8.5 points per game and shooting 32.2% from the field to go along with 4.5 rebounds per game.

KEY STATS

Heading into this weekend's matchup, the Golden Bears rank first in the NSIC in four different key statistical categories. CSP leads the conference in defensive field goal percentage (31.5%), 3-point percentage (40.2%), blocked shots per game (7.8), and assists per game (15.2). The Bears also rank third in the NSIC in field goal percentage (43.8%).

On the individual side, three Golden Bears rank in the conference top-ten in different statistical categories. Lindsey Becher ranks first in the NSIC and third in the NCAA with 3.8 blocks per game.

Riley Wheatcraft ranks third in the conference in field goals made with 51 and fifth in field goal percentage (47.2%).

Meghan DuBois sits third in the NSIC with 4.1 assists per game so far.

Amanda Johnson enters her fifth full season after officially being named the program's ninth head basketball coach in April, 2016 following a successful stint as interim head coach in the second half of the 2015-16 season.

One of the top post players in Concordia basketball history, Johnson assumed the interim head coach position during winter break of the 2015-16 season and led the program to a 9-10 record highlighted by a 9-6 finish that included an NSIC Sanford Health Tournament first round victory.

In her first full season in 2016-17, Johnson led the team to a fifth place finish in the NSIC and a third place finish in the South Division as the team compiled a record of 19-10 (15-7 NSIC) on the season.

She's completed her year coaching in the program, spending the first two as a graduate assistant before a promotion to the top assistant position on staff for a year and a half.

Johnson returned to the Golden Bears in 2012-13 after a strong stint as a professional player in Australia. She returned to pursue a master's degree in sport management and initially was tabbed with working with the post players. As a graduate assistant, the Golden Bears captured two NSIC Championships and an NCAA Central Region Championship with a trip to the Elite Eight during her first two years on staff.

Concordia Playing Career

The two-time All-Region performer led the Golden Bears to back-to-back NSIC regular season and tournament championships and was two-time NSIC Player of the Year in the process. Johnson set the school single-season scoring record with 551 points as a junior in 2006-07 as she led the Golden Bears to the NCAA Central Region Championship game and the school's second Sweet 16 run.

She averaged 16.8 points and 8.6 rebounds while shooting 52.4% from the floor and finished as Concordia's seventh all-time leading scorer despite playing three years for the Golden Bears (2005-08).

She had a 30-point, 20-rebound performance in the 2006-07 region title game. Her 726 career rebounds rank second in Concordia's Division II-era (1999-present), just 16 shy of the school record. She also scored 1,426 career points in 94 games, adding 112 steals and 81 blocked shots.

The St. Croix Lutheran High School graduate was a business and marketing major at Concordia as an undergraduate. She began her college career at Division I Winthrop University, playing in 27 games with three starts with a Big South Freshman of the Week award.

Coaching Beginning

Johnson brings prior coaching experience to the Golden Bear huddle, working as an assistant coach at New Life Academy.

Professional Playing Career

After her Concordia playing career came to a close, Johnson pursued professional basketball in Australia, playing for the Ringwood Hawks where she was a 2010 Big V League MVP and helped the Hawks to a Victoria State Championship. She posted averages of 15.6 points and 14.3 rebounds most recently.

She had also worked at Freedom Mortgage in the Twin Cities between Australian seasons.

Amanda is married to Eric Johnson. They currently reside in Hudson, Wis with their son, Jase, and daughter, Skylar.

Assistant Coach notes:



Kristen Lee joined the Concordia women's basketball coaching staff in the summer of 2018. The Dawson, Minnesota native and graduate of St. Catherine University (exercise sports science) in St. Paul will primarily work with guards while assisting in all aspects of the program.

Her college coaching career began as a graduate assistant at SMSU where she earned a master's degree in physical education. She also served as a coach with the Minnesota Fury AAU program. Lee was most recently the top assistant at Northwestern (Iowa), which made a run to the NAIA DII national semifinals.



Madison McKeever enters her first season as a graduate assistant for the Golden Bears in the 2020-21 season. The Erskine, Minnesota native joins the coaching staff after a successful four year playing career at the University of South Dakota.

As a player, McKeever helped the Coyotes to an overall record of 110-24 in her four years. She was also a part of a Coyotes team that was the first team in Summit League history to go undefeated en route to a Summit League regular season crown and Summit League Tournament championship. In her senior season, she averaged 8.8 points, 3.3 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.8 steals per game.
