Prior to each game, Golden Bear parents, alumni & supporters can gather together and enjoy fellowship in preparation of Golden Bear football.



BELLINGHAM HIGH SCHOOL - BELLINGHAM, WA



As it stands, Preston is one of the best cornerbacks in division II college football. He is ranked as the preseason fourth-best Division II cornerback per CFB Network. Preston has been in the program since 2019. Preston played and started in all 11 games of 2019, leading the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in pass breakups (11), whiling finishing second in passes defended (13), and also led the team in interceptions (2). The Florida native is greatly respected by his peers. Preston brings a lot of swagger and confidence to the cornerback room at CSP.

When asked why he chose to come to CSP, Preston talked about the family atmosphere within the team and how much the coaches care. He also stated how close they are with the other players on the team.

Preston's mom, Nene Amachree, was born in Nigeria and moved to California at a young age. His dad Michael Piltoff was born in Pennsylvania. Both Nene and Michael played a huge part in shaping who Preston is today.

Preston is an accomplished athlete for the Golden Bears, and he has a promising future ahead of him. He is studying criminal justice at Concordia and is impressively on the Dean's List. His future plans are to build non-profit foundations and youth programs for underprivileged children.

The goal that Preston has set for himself for the upcoming year is to win the NSIC and make the playoffs. This is something that Concordia has never accomplished. Preston has a personal goal of becoming an All American and being able to accomplish his dream of playing in the NFL.
