THIS WEEK: 2018 SEASON OPENER

For the first time in head coach Shannon Currier's second term at Concordia, the Golden Bears will open the season on the road at #20 Sioux Falls for a Thursday night game at Bob Young Field.

2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach Shannon Currier has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting with the first week of fall training camp. Captains will be selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and in general day-to-day activities.

The week one game captains are senior Dom McKinzy and juniors Jackson Dobbs, Dylan Wood and Rich Kelly.

SERIES NOTES: SIOUX FALLS 11, CONCORDIA 1

The series between Sioux Falls and Concordia dates back to 1971 when Concordia College topped Sioux Falls College 24-16. Since, Sioux Falls has won 11 in a row, holding Concordia in single-digits in nine of the games and scoring at least 30 points eight times.

The teams have played every year since 2012, alternating locations with three meetings in Sioux Falls and three in St. Paul.

Head Coach Shannon Currier holds an 0-2 record against the Cougars, trimming a 51-17 loss in 2016 to a 27-9 loss last year.

LAST MEETING, 2017: SIOUX FALLS 27, CONCORDIA 9

Concordia was able to get into scoring position to attempt six field goals against the second-ranked total defense and scoring defense in the country. The six field goal tries came in the first three quarters and entering the final frame, CSP was only facing a 251-202 margin in total yards and piled up 91 rushing yards against a USF front that surrendered under 70 yards per game to opposing teams by season's end.

But in the fourth quarter, Sioux Falls used the wind at their back for a 135-to-37 yardage margin. They turned a one-possession lead (17-9) into a 27-9 victory by adding a touchdown and field goal to the lead in the fourth.

Kicker Jonas Schenderlein tied the single game school record, which he would do two more times down the stretch last year, connecting on three of his six kicks. Two of his misses were from long range, just missing on a 63-yard attempt while a 54-yard try was blocked at the end of the third quarter. It was his 44-yard miss just before half that snapped a streak of 16 straight field goals made inside of 50 yards. He also converted a 58-yard field goal in the game, the second longest in school history and second longest in NCAA Division II football on the season.

Also strong in the kicking game was 2017 NSIC punter leader Sam Maedke, averaging 45.8 yards on five punts with a pair inside the 20 and a long of 58.

Receiver/returner Elias Arlington led Concordia with 168 all-purpose yards with 5-82 receiving (long 31) and three kick returners for 86 yards (long 34).

2017 STORYLINE: ROAD COMEBACKS COME UP SHORT

The Golden Bears had five road comebacks come up short in 2017, with CSP having possessions to tie or go ahead in all four games. CSP fell 21-20 at MSU Moorhead where a fumble at the MSUM 2 yard line in the third quarter haunted the Bears in a one point loss in week four. In week six at Upper Iowa, the Bears were stopped with three incomplete passes on downs from the UIU 9 yard line with 1:45 to play in a 34-29 loss. In week nine at Wayne State, CSP went ahead 23-20 with just under three minutes left before the Wildcats responded with a game winning drive, scoring with 23 seconds to play in the game. In week 10 at Augustana, the Bears had four turnovers on their final six possessions and had the ball twice trailing 21-13 in the fourth quarter before falling 28-13.

The result of the four narrow road losses left the Bears 1-9, but a razor thin margin away from a 5-5 record and a shot at a winning season this Saturday in the finale against SMSU - a game Concordia won 37-20.

2017 SILVER LININGS PLAYBOOK

Although the Golden Bears finished with back-to-back 2-9 campaigns, the team made marked improvements over the 2016 season, Shannon Currier's first year back on campus. Aside from the four straight narrow road losses, the Golden Bears held opponents under 30 points in five straight games to end

ABOUT THE COUGARS

The Cougars enter 2018 having achieved 9-win seasons in five of the last six years, reaching the NCAA Super Region 4 Playoffs last year, falling in the first round 24-20 to Midwestern State (Texas) to conclude a 9-3 season.

USF is led by second year head coach Jon Anderson who had the Cougars off to a 5-0 start to keep a streak of winning their first five games since 2014. Their three losses last season were to nationally-ranked opponents, #17 Winona State (13-31), #1 Minnesota State (23-27) and #5 Midwestern State (20-24).

The Cougars ranked fifth in total offense (381.2 yards) a year ago and sixth in scoring (26.1 points). Sophomore quarterback Mitch Martin has been named the starting quarterback and will make his debut on Thursday night, backed up junior college transfer Caden Walters from Dodge City CC (Kan.).

Two-time All-American Trey Pipkins leads a veteran offensive line to protect Martin. He's allowed just two sacks and tallied 146 pancakes in his career.

He'll be opening holes for a new ground game with the departure of All-American Max Mickey who dashed for 3,720 rushing yards and 44 total touchdowns in his career. Jason Towns also departs with his 958 rushing yards and six touchdowns.

Juniors Colton Myles (47-200, 2 TDs) and Winston Maxwell (81-377, 3 TDs) bring experience to complement newcomer Gabriel Watson.

The receivers bring more experience paced by senior Anthony Holmes (34-528, 2 TDs), sophomore Ty Smith (34-496, 3 TDs) and senior AJ Garrow (28-248, 3 TDs).

USF's also had the second-ranked defense in hte country (244.3 yards & 12.5 points), issuing just 67.1 yards on the ground (3rd NCAA) while putting up 40 sacks (9th NCAA) - tops in the NSIC across the board.

They'll have to replace All-America linebacker Dennis Gardeck, All-NSIC defensive back Joshua Butler, All-NSIC linebacker Michael Antonio, All-NSIC defensive end Derek Landis & All-NSIC defensive tackle Brian Mayberry. Logan Dykstra, a def. lineman, is the only All-NSIC returner on defense.

MEET THE STARTING QUARTERBACK: DOM MCKINZY

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Rhoden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition.

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Missouri native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transfer-

ring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

CROWDED BACKFIELD

The Golden Bears return three talented young running backs from Florida led by 2017 leading rusher **Darnell Rolle** who had 627 yards and three total touchdowns and a pair of 100-yard games. His 127 carries were more than the next two running backs, **Shaq Johnson** (46) and **Lajuan Preston** (32), combined.

Johnson ended the season with a 17 carry, 175 yard and two touchdown performance in which he also tossed a 63-yard touchdown pass. He finished the year with 241 yards on 5.2 per carry and three touchdowns.

Preston added 32 carries for 132 yards and was placed at the top of the fall camp depth chart as Rolle did not make the trip due to injury and Johnson wasn't able to start practice until late in training camp.

Aside from the three returners, the staff added three Division I transfers: **Jeremiah Pierce-Johnson** from Akron, **Garrett Gardner** from Wyoming and **Andre Eubanks** from Mississippi Valley State.

Additionally, the program picked up Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** who rushed for over 600 yards and 11 touchdowns in his three years for the Bearcats that also included a pair of undefeated NCAA Division II championship campaigns. He was the team's leading ball carrier in last year's playoff loss, and had key carries in all three playoff runs.

STANDOUT SPECIAL TEAMS UNITS

Head coach Shannon Currier places a strong emphasis on special teams, noting that more yards are exchanged on special teams plays than any other situation.

On coverage, feature unning back **Darnell Rolle** led the special teams with 14 total tackles including three in week one against Minot and four in week 10 at Augie. Of the 14 tackles, 12 have been on punts. He finished the year with 17 total tackles.

Long snapper **Dalton Smerchek** forced and was credited with a recovered fumble on punt coverage in the red zone at BSU, setting up an easy early season touchdown for the offense. He finished second on the team with eight special teams tackles (all on punts) and had a nine tackle performance with more defensive reps at Augustana in week 10 in his true freshman season.

The team also produced five blocked kicks led by two blocked punts by **Elias Arlington** (at UIU & at WSC). The other three came from: **Dylan Wood** (FG vs Minot); **Cole Riemer** (PAT at BSU), and **Antonio Zepeda** (FG vs WSU). The kicking unit, by comparison, has only allowed one blocked kick (54 yd FG vs USF, wk 8).

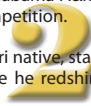
Adding a wrinkle to the mix in week 5, CSP executed a 35-yard fake punt with **Sam Maedke** connecting with tight end **Justin Axelson** against Minnesota State. Maedke was a two-time All-NSIC punter and ranked 19th in DII and led the NSIC with a school record 41.3 punting average.

With one of the top punters in team history graduated, the Golden Bears will turn to sophomore wide receiver **Jake Shepley** in the opener while junior **Danny Laudet** also has a strong leg in the program.

In the return game **Jake Tanner** opened the year 3-68 on punt returns with a long of 43 and finished the year with an 8.3 average. **Elias Arlington** added a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in week two and averaged 21.6 yards to rank sixth in the NSIC.

Meanwhile, **Jonas Schenderlein** produced touchdowns on 30-of-51 kickoffs (best rate in DII football) compared to 17 of 64 by opponents to master the field position advantage.

Schenderlein also went 18-25 on field goals including a school

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He is second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named

NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

GUSTAVESON LEADS WIDE RECEIVERS

Wide receiver **Marcus Gustavson** enters 2018 as Concordia's top target, already boasting four career 100-yard performances. In two seasons, he's amassed 1,220 yards on 84 catches with 14 touchdowns. Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and touchdowns (9) and increased his production in all four areas.

While the team loses its second and third leading targets in **Elias Arlington** (36-548) and **Deceon Schumann** (22-242), senior **Jake Tanner** (20-235) is poised to play a bigger role along with Gabe Steed (19-273).

Joining the mix is junior college transfer **MJ Williams** who was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCAA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and touchdowns (11).

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four returning offensive linemen. In he two seasons since, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play early in their careers, gaining valuable experience despite the tough physical challenge.

Now the team features more depth, more experience, more strength & physicality and most importantly, more continuity. Three starters return up front: left tackle **Terrell Taylor**, left guard **Rich Kelly** and right guard **Ethan Aune**. They are joined by redshirt freshman **Matthew Montgomery** and sophomore right tackle **Cris Wasylciw**.

Further, the program features experienced depth behind the front five with players who have started in the past like senior **Samuel Kessler** and sophomore **Tanner Haechten** who are primarily guards but able to play multiple spots on the line. Senior **Davarus Clark** has had his best fall camp and redshirt freshman **Tyson Kauffman** has impressed at the tackle position.

WALLISCH EMERGES AS DEFENSIVE STOPPER AT CB

Junior **Dion Wallisch** has emerged as one of the top defensive players on the team and is coming off an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention season in his first year at CSP. While he was able to fill the stat sheet with 13 pass breakups, a pair of interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery, he was also impressive with the stats that *weren't* recorded. He shut down top receivers on a consistent basis in 2017 including MSU Moorhead standout Damon Gibson.

With a prep wrestling background, Wallisch is also a sound tackler as he finished the year third on the team with 58 tackles. He ill also be a key member of the kick return team where he produced a 23.8 average last year.

As a redshirt freshman at Minnesota Crookston in 2015, he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP the following spring semester.

Redshirt freshman **Marcus Haskins** is expected to start at the other corner and brings speed and footwork to the secondary.

Sophomore **Lorenzo Kendricks** gained quality experience as a true freshman last year, working his way into a starting role with four starts between the safety and corner spots. He finished his first year with 25 tackles, a pair of pass breakups and forced a fumble against USF.

Sophomore **Desmond Hudnall** also backs up at the corner spot, playing all 11 games last year as a redshirt freshman.

RUSSELL TO WEAR #26 TO HONOR LATE FRIEND BILLY BROWN

The only senior starter in the two deep is **Brandon Russell** at strong safety. The veteran defensive back has changed jersey numbers from 23 to 26 to honor Billy Brown, Jr., a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May. Billy passed away while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach Shannon Currier has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Russell has racked up 89 career tackles in three seasons, battling through injuries as a junior and playing in six games. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

The other safety position will be a combination of redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers** while another redshirt freshman, **Dez Bassett** will backup Russell. Junior **Brian Szut-**

kowski piled up 88 tackles as a sophomore starter, adding six pass breakups.

GARRETT EXPLODES IN FRESHMAN SEASON

Sophomore **Chris Garrett** broke onto the scene in a big way as a true freshman in 2017, racking up six sacks (all solo) and forcing five fumbles. He added 44 total tackles and 9.0 tackles for loss in just seven games. He had at least six tackles in five of the seven games and his big effort was at Augustana where he forced three fumbles, had three sacks and tackles for loss and nine total tackles - all career-highs.

Garrett is not listed as a week one starter up front, behind juniors **Jackson Dobbs** and transfer **Cole Marmor** on the ends with juniors **Kelly Pierce** and **Dylan Wood** on the interior.

After missing his sophomore season in 2016 with an injury, Dobbs returned midseason in 2017 and made 33 tackles, 3.5 for loss in seven games.

Wood has played all 11 games each of the last two years, combining for 74 tackles and 12.5 tackles for loss with 8.5 sacks. Last year, he broke out with 51 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 16 career games, he's registered 61 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks.

EVANS COMING OFF BIG FRESHMAN YEAR

Sophomore **Blake Evans** broke into the starting lineup midseason as a true freshman last year and led the team with 97 tackles. He had double-digit tackles in six of the last seven games and five in a row.

Sophomore Golden Valley, Minnesota native **Andy Aune** came back to the Twin Cities to play with the Golden Bears after spending his first two years in Vermillion at the University of South Dakota. He's expected to start opposite Evans on the strong side.

Redshirt freshman **Jake Portz** will handle the mike linebacker role.
