The Golden Bears and Wildcats tangle at Sea Foam Stadium for the NSIC Thursday Night Football Game of the Week, aired where Midco Sports Network is available (ND, SD, parts of MN). The two teams are attempted to even their record at .500 following the first four weeks of NSIC South Division play as the league slate pivots to four weeks of NSIC North-South competition.

COACHES SHOW DEBUTS THIS FRIDAY NIGHT!

Starting this Friday night following the high school football game of the week on KYCR 1440 AM radio in the Twin Cities, **Wally Langfellow** of the Minnesota Score will host the **Coach Currier Show** in the 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. hour. The show will be a 30 minute format, beginning at the conclusion of the high school game, and is expected to include a player each week.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show will also be accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, iTunes and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 7-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the seven home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 29.4 to 8.3 margin of victory, a total of 206 to 58.

2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting with the first week of fall training camp. Cap-

tains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and in general day-to-day activities.

For the fourth straight week, junior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** has been named a captain, joined by redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** while junior guard **Rich Kelly** has been named a captain for the second time and is joined by junior wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson**.

ERIES NOTES: CONCORDIA 8, UPPER IOWA 4

The Golden Bears and Wildcats have met every year since CSP joined the Northern Sun in 1999 with Wayne State holding the slight edge, 10-9 entering the 20th meeting between the clubs. WSC has won four in a row and is 8-3 against Concordia in the last 11 contests dating back to 2007. Concordia opened the series by winning six of the first eight including wins in each of head coach **Shannon Currier's** first term of four years from 2000 to 2003. Currier is now 4-2 against WSC, falling 45-10 in WSC's last trip to Sea Foam Stadium in 2016 before last year's close contest, a 27-23 decision in Wayne, Nebraska. Overall, Concordia is 5-5 against the Wildcats in St. Paul but just 1-4 when Wayne State comes to Sea Foam Stadium.

LAST YEAR: WAYNE STATE 27, CONCORDIA 23

The last time the Golden Bears and the Wildcats met Wayne State recorded a 27-23 victory on their home turf in Wayne, Nebraska. The Golden Bears took the lead late in the fourth quarter, but Wayne State scored the game-winning touchdown with 23 seconds to play.

It was one of three road losses decided by one score or less.

Leading the Golden Bear offense in that contest was quarterback **Maxon Hutton**. The sophomore went 11-17 for 136 passing yards and contributed 86 rushing yards on 17 carries to lead the team before an injury ended his day (and season) early in the fourth quarter.

Also contributing to CSP's offense on that Saturday were sophomores **Darnell Rolle** and **Marcus Gustaveson**. Rolle rushed 13 times for 57 yards and Gustaveson collected five catches for

NOTES ABOUT THE WILDCATS

The Wildcats fell at home last week to Augustana by a score of 27-21, falling to 1-2 NSIC (1-2 South).

Picked to finish 9th in the NSIC and 5th in the NSIC South, WSC lost its first contest to Winona State (41-28) and picked up a week 2 win against SMSU (23-14).

Wayne State's offense has been led by junior QB **Aaron Bleil** with 291.7 passing yards per game and 8 TDs. Bleil's main target has been senior wideout **Nate Rogers**, who leads the NSIC with 129.3 yards per game and 5 receiving TDs.

On the ground, sophomore RB **Marlon Warren** leads WSC with 251 yards at a 3.9 rushing average.

Defensively, junior **Tyler Thompson** leads the league with 35 tackles. Junior DL **Jacob Protzman** has been a force disrupting opposing backfields with league-highs 9.0 TFL and 6.0 sacks. Junior DB **Shaq Paddy** leads the team with four passes defended, adding 10 tackles.

Ball security has been an issue for the Wildcats through the first three games of the season, as they have lost six fumbles and thrown three INTs. They also have attempted four 4th downs, succeeding on just one. On the flip side, WSC has recovered no fumbles and recorded just one interception for a 1-9 deficit in take/give. They have been stout on 4th down defense, holding opponents 2-for-7.

Wayne State has been able to win the battle in the passing game, throwing for 291.7 yards per game and holding opponents to 186.7. They have been vulnerable in the ground game though, with opponents rushing for 163.7 yards per game compared to the Wildcats' mark of 84.3

On special teams, punter **Cody Netusil** has had a solid start to the year, averaging 40.5 yards per punt with 5 inside the 20 and 3 of 50-plus. The Wildcats haven't done much in the kicking game, going 1-for-3 on field goals with a long of 27.

98 yards to lead the team.

On the defensive side of the ball, freshman **Blake Evans** led the team with 10 tackles, including two tackles for loss. Fellow freshman **Chris Garrett** also collected eight tackles (including a tackle for loss) and forced a fumble. Senior defensive back **Andrew Capircchio** also pitched in five tackles, two tackles for loss, and broke up three passes.

The teams combined for six turnovers and three punt miscues. WSC won the turnover battle 4-2 but Concordia won the punt miscue battle 2-1 with CSP's only punt miscue also resulting in one of its four turnovers.

Rashad Trimble led WSC with 96 rushing yards on 12 carries including a 70 yard touchdown run. The Wildcats produced 200 team rushing yards on 43 attempts in the game to offset a meager 109 yard passing production from its two quarterbacks. **Layne Sullivan** led WSC through the air with 4-47 and a 20-yard touchdown catch from Taylor Reedy.

Concordia held standout receiver **Nate Rogers** to just one catch for 15 yards in the game.

The Wildcat defense had 11 tackles for loss, a pair of sacks, three interceptions and a fumble recovery. **Ben Elznec** had nine tackles, 1.5 for loss and a fumble recovery while **Ian Ailts** had eight tackles, one for loss, forced the fumble and had an interception.

The Wildcats opened the scoring with the Trimble 70 yard touchdown run, and went up 14-0 after a 20 yard touchdown pass. The Golden Bears answered with a nine yard Hutton touchdown run, and the teams traded field goals for a 17-10 halftime score in the favor of Wayne State.

After two field goals from CSP's **Jonas Schenderlein** and one from the Wildcats, Concordia took the lead with 2:56 on touchdown pass from reserve quarterback **Ron Johnson** to **Deceon Schumann**. The Wildcats marched down the field and completed a 15 yard touchdown pass to Rogers on 3rd and 14 to take the 27-23 lead with 23 seconds to go.

LAST WEEK: #2 MINNESOTA STATE 46, CONCORDIA 13

Last weekend, Concordia traveled down to Mankato to take on #2 Minnesota State. The Golden Bears fell to the Mavericks by a score of 46-13, haunted by a 32-0 second quarter deficit.

Sophomore **Shaq Johnson** led the Golden Bear offense in rushing yards, carrying the ball 14 times for 87 yards and a touchdown. **MJ Williams** caught a team-high four receptions for 58 yards and score.

The Golden Bears started senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy**, who went 5-13 for 93 yards and a touchdown. He was relieved in the second half by junior **Maxon Hutton**, who completed three passes on seven attempts for 39 yards.

On the defensive side of the ball, redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** intercepted a pass for the third straight game and collected seven tackles (six solo). Redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** led the team with 12 tackles and junior defensive lineman **TJ Diallo** recorded his first career tackle for loss to lead the Golden Bears in the category for the game.

Sophomore **Jake Shepley** continued his strong start to his punting career at Concordia, dropping two punts inside the 20-yard line. Shepley averaged 38.2 yards per punt on five punts in the game.

After MSU got out to a 14-0 lead, the Golden Bears answered back with 16 yard touchdown pass from McKinzy to Williams. CSP would head into the second quarter down by just one score, 14-6.

The quarter stats also indicated a battle as CSP and MSU were tied with six first downs each and the total offense favored the Mavericks by just five yards (139 to 134).

The Mavericks proceeded to ambush the Golden Bears in the second quarter, scoring 32 points over a period of nine minutes and 32 seconds for a 46-6 lead going into the half, powered by 270 yards of total offense in the second quarter including a pair of safeties on back-to-back defensive plays.

In the second half, Concordia would hold Minnesota State scoreless. CSP scored their second TD of the game on a 1-yard S.Johnson TD early in the fourth quarter, but couldn't shrink the deficit any further in the second half.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: WEEK 2 GROUND DOMINATION

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It car-

ries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper Iowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over Wayne State in week nine.

It's the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards is the most CSP has achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary when the Marauders rushed for one yard on 29 attempts.

It's just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP has held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State, holding the Beavers to 64 yards each in 2015 week three and 2017 week one. The last time CSP has held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper Iowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

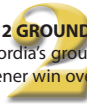

MEET THE STARTING QUARTERBACK: DOM MCKINZY

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition.

Senior graduate transfer quarterback **Dimonic Rhoden-McKinzy (Dom McKinzy)** is off to a strong start to 2018. He's posted a 143.8 quarterback efficiency on the year, fourth best in the NSIC and his 14.3 yards per completion is 29th in the country. He has connected for six passing touchdowns, ranking sixth in the league and 32nd nationally and is ninth in the league with 513 passing yards and a 54.5 completion percentage..

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.) From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and

no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He made his 2018 debut in the second half at MSU, engineering a scoring drive while completing 3-of-7 for 39 yards in the game.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

SHAQ ATTACK BLITZES THE END ZONE

Sophomore running back **Shaq Johnson** has now scored six TDs, accounting for seven total scores over the last four games dating back to last year's breakout game in a season finale win over SMSU. In that game to end 2017, Johnson burst onto the scene with 17-175 rushing and two TDs and had a 63 yard TD pass.

He opened 2018 with a pair of receiving TDs at #20 Sioux Falls, picked up his third receiving TD of the year, the first RB in CSP's DI era to reach three receiving TDs, in a 34-7 win over UIU in week two and secured his first rushing TD of the year at MSU in week three.

He's emerged as one of the top RBs in the NSIC in a deep CSP backfield that features speed, power, blocking and versatility as a group. Johnson is the league's seventh leading rusher with

263 yards (5.0 avg) and adds 6-49 receiving. Sophomore **Lajuan Preston** is the speedster, breaking loose for a 73 yard TD against UIU in week two and is averaging 8.0 yards on the year (13-100). Junior **Darnell Rolle** has been out early due to injury, and led the team in 2017 (127-627, 4.9 avg).

Shaq Johnson, Preston and Rolle are all from Florida, as well.

Aside from the three Florida returners, the staff added three Division I transfers: **Jeremiah Pierce-Johnson** from Akron (via Florida), **Garrett Gardner** from Wyoming and **Andre Eubanks** from Mississippi Valley State. Pierce-Johnson and Gardner have been featured multiple times in short yardage and Eubanks made his debut in week two as a blocking back. Gardner has six carries for 25 yards on the year to lead the trio.

Additionally, Concordia picked up Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** who rushed for over 600 yards and 11 touchdowns in his three years for the Bearcats that also included a pair of undefeated NCAA Division II championship campaigns. He was the team's leading ball carrier in last year's playoff loss, and had key carries in all three playoff runs.

Jones, a late addition in camp, has adjusted quickly and received three carries and a reception at Sioux Falls for a total of 16 yards including a long run of nine and in week two he returned a blocked punt 17 yards for a touchdown and added a 35 yard kick return.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He's second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

BALL CONTROL PLAYS KEY ROLE EARLY

Despite taking a heart breaking 27-24 loss at #20 Sioux Falls in the 2018 opener, Concordia was solid in ball control on the Cougars' home turf, controlling the ball for 33:06 to USF's 26:54.

The trend continued in week two as CSP used a 33:15 to 26:45 time of possession edge in a 34-7 win over Upper Iowa.

Additionally, Concordia has forced seven turnovers with four interceptions (one more than all of last season) including one each week from redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins**. Through three games, CSP is averaging a +1 per game in the take/give and used that to play to a 21-0 scoring advantage in points off turnovers.

HASKINS OFF TO STRONG START AT THE CORNER

Redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** is off to an incredible start to his college career, registering an interception in each of Concordia's three games while tallying eight pass breakups. The three interceptions and 11 passes defended (INT & PBU) each rank second in the country, while the eight pass breakups is an NSIC high. In week two, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an interception, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through three weeks. He is also a strong tackler with 15 tackles (13 solo), ranking fourth on the defense and leading the secondary. His 13 solo stops are tied for the team lead.

His three interceptions match Concordia's season total as a defense from a year ago.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** has missed the previous two games due to injury and is not listed on the week four two deep. Wallisch made five tackles (four solo) in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls. He is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances. Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a redshirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP the following spring semester.

In his absence, expect a combination of sophomore **Lorenzo Kendrick** and **Desmond Hudnall**, who have traded starts the past two weeks.

SCHENDERLEIN NABS MITCHELL AWARD PRESEASON HONOR

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017, including Schenderlein.

GUSTAVESON CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

Wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** has established himself as Concordia's top target as a three year starter, boasting four career 100-yard performances.

In the 2018 season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, Gustaveson hauled in five catches for 96 yards and a 33 yard touchdown to put CSP ahead 21-20 with under eight minutes to play. He also had a long of 38 in the game.

In three games, Gustaveson is tied for the team lead with 10 catches, and leads the squad with 205 yards and a 20.5 average, adding one TD catch.

In three seasons, he's amassed 1,425 yards on 94 catches with 15 touchdowns. Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and touchdowns (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore.

Junior college transfer **MJ Williams** joins him with a team high 10 catches, adding 151 yards (15.1 avg) and two TDs. Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and touchdowns (11).

Williams broke out in week two against Upper Iowa with 6-93 and a 61-yard touchdown. He reached the end zone a second straight week at #2 MSU, a 16 yard score in the first quarter.

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four returning offensive linemen. Over the previous two seasons, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play early in their careers, gaining valuable experience despite the tough physical challenge.

Now the team features more depth, experience, strength & physicality and most importantly, more continuity. The depth has allowed the team to be flexible up front and outlast injuries.

Three starters returned up front on opening day: senior left tackle **Terrell Taylor**, junior left guard **Rich Kelly** and junior right guard **Ethan Aune**. They were joined by redshirt freshman center **Matthew Montgomery** and sophomore right tackle **Cris Wasylciw**. The team has also started redshirt freshman **Tyson Kauffman** at right guard and senior **Samuel Kessler** at center.

Sophomore **Tanner Haechten** who missed the first three games of the season, is also on the 2-deep for the first time this year. Senior **Davarus Clark** had his best fall camp and contributes on field goal/PAT block and short yardage.

RUSSELL TO WEAR #26 TO HONOR LATE FRIEND BILLY BROWN

Senior safety **Brandon Russell** changed jersey numbers from 23 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May. Billy passed away while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Russell has racked up 94 career tackles. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

Redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan**, **Parker Powers** and **Dez Bassett** have all played significant roles in the secondary at the safety position as well.

Powers made his first career interception on a play deep down the sideline in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF. Bassett, a Mankato native, made his first career start at #2 Minnesota State. He had six tackles in week two at UIU and seven at MSU and is tied for fifth on the team with Sheehan with 14 tackles.

Junior **Brian Szutkowski** piled up 88 tackles as a sophomore starter in 2017, adding six pass breakups. He's been a key contributor on special teams in 2018 and is listed as a reserve cornerback for the second straight week on the 2-deep.

STEADY DEFENSIVE LINE PRODUCTION

Through the first three weeks, Concordia's defensive line has produced six sacks, 11 quarterback hurries and 9.5 tackles for loss as a group. But it's been a complete group effort as sophomore **Chris Garrett** leads the team with 2.0 TFL, 1.5 sacks and four hurries while veteran starters **Kelly Pierce**, **Jackson Dobbs** and **Dylan Wood** each have 1.5 TFL. Newcomers Shawn Aarhus, **Cole Marmor** and **TJ Diallo** have also contributed to the various DL statistics, as well.

Garrett broke onto the scene in a big way as a true freshman in 2017, racking up six sacks (all solo) and forcing five fumbles. He added 44 total tackles and 9.0 tackles for loss in just seven games. He had at least six tackles in five of the seven games.

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the year at Augustana where he forced three fumbles, had three sacks and tackles for loss and nine total tackles - all career-highs.

Opposite Garrett at the other end is Dobbs who tied for the team lead with seven tackles in week one and has 1.5 TFL, a half sack and a fumble recovery to start his 2018. After missing his sophomore season in 2016 with an injury, Dobbs returned midseason in 2017 in his redshirt sophomore campaign and made 33 tackles with 3.5 for loss in seven games.

Pierce and Wood have manned the interior and it was Wood who came up with a big third down sack in the fourth quarter at #20 Sioux Falls, finishing the game with four tackles. He has nine tackles on the year while Pierce adds six with 1.5 TFL and 1.0 sacks.

Wood played all 11 games each of the last two years and has now recorded 83 tackles and 14.0 tackles for loss with 9.5 sacks in his career. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 19 career games, he's registered 67 tackles, 10.0 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Junior college transfers **TJ Diallo** (NT) and **Cole Marmor** (DE) add depth and experience up front. Marmor secured his first sack in week two at UIU after starting the opener at USF in week one. Diallo picked up his first TFL at #2 MSU in week three, securing four tackles against the Mavericks.

Redshirt freshman defensive end **Shawn Aarhus** had a big debut, making three tackles with a sack, tackle for loss, forced fumble and fumble recovery. He's up to seven tackles on the year in three games.

CSP'S STARTING LB'S LEAD TEAM IN TACKLES

Through three weeks, redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** leads the team and is 13th in the NSIC with 23 tackles. The starting linebackers, with sophomores **Blake Evans** (18) and **Andy Aune** (16) joining Portz, are 1-2-3 on the team with 57 total tackles.

Evans finished his rookie season on a tear in 2017, leading the team and ranking seventh in the Northern Sun with 97 tackles. Portz spent the year gaining strength and experience in the program as a redshirt while Aune was a redshirt freshman at the University of South Dakota.

SHEPLEY OFF TO STRONG START AS PUNTER

It was quite the debut for sophomore **Jake Shepley** at the punter position. He averaged 47.3 yards on six punts with

three eclipsing the 50-yard mark including a long of 66 which was pinned at the four yard line as CSP went toe-to-toe with #20 Sioux Falls on the road.

The 47.3 yard average in the opener was the fourth-best single game average in CSP history.

He doubled-down on the performance by averaging 46.0 yards on four punts with a long of 52 and two inside the 20 against Upper Iowa in week two.

Through three weeks, Shepley ranks 15th in the country and second in the league with a 43.9 average which would be ahead of former All-NSIC punter Sam Maedke's school record pace set last year (41.3).

Shepley is also a wide receiver, seeing action in four games with two catches as a true freshman in 2017 and continuing to get looks on offense this year.
