THIS WEEK: BEARS FACE #8 MINNESOTA DULUTH

The Golden Bears head to #8 Minnesota Duluth for a Saturday afternoon clash at Malosky Stadium. In CSP's third road game of the year, it's also the third time they'll face a nationally-ranked opponent on the road. The CSP-UMD affair is also the start of a four week NSIC North-South Division series in weeks 5-to-8.

It will be available either late Friday night after the initial airing or on Saturday morning.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 7-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the seven home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 29.4 to 8.3 margin of victory, a total of 206 to 58.

2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall

season, starting with the first week of fall training camp. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and in general day-to-day activities.

For the fifth straight week, junior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** has been named a captain, joined on defense by redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** while senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy** earned the nod for the fourth time in five games and junior wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** repeated.

SERIES NOTES: UMD 9, CONCORDIA 3

The Golden Bears surprised everyone on October 9, 1999 in securing a 35-27 win over UMD at Griffin Stadium in the Golden Bears' first year in NCAA Division II and the Northern Sun. CSP did it again one year later on October 7, 2000 with a 37-27 win at Malosky Stadium.

While in the first year, CSP improved to 2-3 overall and 2-2 NSIC, the second win over UMD sent the Golden Bears to a 5-1 start overall and 3-1 in the Northern Sun in the first year under head coach **Shannon Currier**.

UMD won the next three meetings before a lopsided 38-6 home win at Griffin Stadium in 2004 evened the series.

Although Concordia hasn't won since that 2004 triumph and is on a six game skid against UMD, the teams have played sparingly after playing every year from 1999 to 2005 when UMD left the Northern Sun for the now-defunct North Central Conference. The Bulldogs rejoined the league in 2008 and promptly won the NCAA Division II championship, opening the year with a 40-0 win over Concordia in the final year CSP played at Griffin Stadium.

But Concordia will be making just its third trip north to Malosky Stadium since heading there for a 56-0 loss in 2009. In the only meeting in between, Concordia nearly pulled off an upset of the third-ranked Bulldogs, falling 20-13.

In their last meeting, Concordia nearly knocked off the 23rd-ranked UMD squad, falling short in a 52-49 shootout with CSP having a shot to take the lead in the closing minutes.

NOTES ABOUT THE BULLDOGS

UMD has gone 4-0 start the season, and is currently ranked #8 in nation. The Bulldogs have defeated Minot State, MSU Moorhead, St. Cloud State, and Bemidji State en route to their undefeated start.

UMD has averaged 44.0 points per game, while giving up just 11.5 points a game to their opponents.

The Bulldogs have dominated in the ground game, rushing for 955 yards (238.8 per game) and holding opponents to 278 yards on the season (69.5 yards per game). The Bulldogs have run for 14 TDs compared to one for their opponents.

UMD also holds a wide positive margin in passing statistics, throwing for 1,018 yards through four games (254.5 yards per game) compared to 539 for their opposition (134.8 yards per game). The Bulldogs have a 10-to-4 passing TD advantage.

The Bulldogs' offense averages 38:23 minutes per game in possession of the football. That mark is first in the NSIC by over six minutes.

A combo of Bulldogs lead in the running game, quarterback **John Larson** and running back **Wade Sullivan**. Larson has rushed for 257 yards (6.4 ypc) and three TDs while Sullivan has gone for 236 yards (5.2 ypc) and five scores.

Larson has also thrown for 211.0 yards per game and eight TDs. The QB has completed 60.8 percent of his passes and also has three INTs.

A trio of receivers have been the main targets for Larson, including **Jason Balts** (14-264, 2 TDs), **Johnny McCormick** (12-213, 3 TDs) and **Nate Ricci** (10-151, 2 TDs).

On the defensive side of the ball, UMD has had 10 players record 10 or more tackles on the season and seven that have recorded 15+. Linebacker **Bill Atkins** leads the team with 18 tackles through four games.

Leading the secondary for the Bulldogs is defensive back **Tareq Abulebeh**, who is tops on the team with two interceptions and four passes defended.

As a team, the Bulldogs have amassed 38 TFL for a total of 175 yards with 15 players recording a TFL, led by linebacker **A.J. Naatz** with 6.0. Linebacker **Gus Wedig** has also been a force on defense, collecting 17 tackles, five tackles for loss, and forcing two fumbles.

In the last five meetings in the series, UMD has been nationally-ranked in all five dating back to 2008, and this will be the fourth time the teams will play with UMD sporting a top-10 ranking (#3 in 2009, #2 in 2012, #3 in 2014).

Concordia's only win in Duluth was in its first trip in 2000, falling in the last five contests held at Malosky Stadium.

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds a 1-4 career record against UMD and is 1-2 in Duluth.

LAST MEETING: #23 UMD 52, CONCORDIA 49

CSP got a out to a quick 14-0 lead, scoring on a 14-yard TD pass from **Ron Johnson** to **Marcus Gustaveson** and 34-yard interception TD return from **Jonathan Johnson**. UMD struck back with two TDs of their own, sandwiched by a 1-yard TD catch by TE **Matt Bjork**.

With the scoreboard reading 21-14 entering the second quarter, the Golden Bears widened their lead with a 1-yard R.Johnson TD run. The Bulldogs then scored TDs on back-to-back possessions, nearly tying the game (28-27) after missing the PAT. CSP took the lead with a 73-yard trick play TD pass from receiver **Al-quawn Vickers** to receiver **Elias Arlington**, leading at the half by a score of 35-27.

UMD came out scoring to start the second half, converting a FG and rushing for two TDs to take a 37-35 lead. CSP answered back with two TDs of their own, including a 20-yard TD from Johnson to Gustaveson and 31-yard TD run by R.Johnson. UMD then scored the eventual game winning TD with 2:03 left in the contest to take a 52-49 lead.

CSP had a strong last look, though, driving down to the UMD 30-yard line, but a series of penalties, sacks, and incomplete passes pushed the Golden Bears out of field range and into a 4th and 29 scenario which they unable to convert.

The junior quarterback Johnson led the Golden Bears offense with five total TDs, including three passing and two rushing. Johnson also threw 16-32 for 252 yards and rushed for 70 yards. The freshman Gustaveson was a force in the passing game, catching seven passes for 115 yards for two TDs.

Leading the team in rushing was **Darius Chapes**. The senior running back collected 75 yards on eight carries, averaging 9.4 yards per rush.

Leading the defense in tackles was senior **Sam Johnson**, who collected 14 on the day. J.Johnson also collected six tackles and an interception in the loss.

CSP amassed 511 yards of offense on the day, averaging 8.8 yards per play. The game featured 1,093 yards of total offense and 101 total points.

LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 29, WAYNE STATE 7

Last Thursday, the Golden Bears (2-2 NSIC, 2-2 South) battled the Wildcats (1-3 NSIC, 1-3 South) - and the weather - and came out with 29-7 victory.

After a 30 minute delay before the game, CSP got out to a fast start with a blocked punt by **Grant Ericksen**, his second of the season. Two plays later, the Golden Bears scored on a 13-yard TD run by **Shaq Johnson**, set up by a 28-yard run by **Dom McKinzy** for a 7-0 lead less than four minutes into play.

The thunderstorms then kicked back in and caused another delay, which lasted an hour and 29 minutes. When the action resumed, CSP quickly got back to putting points on the board, this time in the form of safety on a botched snap by the Wildcats.

With a 9-0 lead heading into the second quarter, the Golden Bears amped up the offense. After a **Jonas Schenderlein** 30-yard field goal, CSP scored again on 31-yard touchdown pass from McKinzy to **Marcus Gustaveson**.

Leading 19-0, the Golden Bears got the ball back on an interception by **Marcus Haskins** with 26 seconds to go before halftime. CSP then struck again with a 40-yard touchdown pass from McKinzy to **MJ Williams**, widening their lead to 26-0 at the break.

After a scoreless third quarter, the Wildcats punched in a 1-yard touchdown in fourth, but CSP answered with another Schenderlein 36-yard field goal for the 29-7 final.

A team effort on defense propelled the Golden Bears to stop the

Wildcats offense, who entered the day averaging over 291 yards passing and had the leading receiver in the NSIC in **Nate Rogers**. The Golden Bears held Wayne State to just 160 yards passing and limited Rogers to just 40 yards on five catches.

The redshirt freshman cornerback Haskins led the secondary's effort, tying for the team lead with four tackles, intercepting a pass, forcing a fumble, and breaking up two passes. Six Golden Bears tied for the team lead with four tackles, and 11 had at least three. The defense also collected six tackles for loss on the game.

Leading the offensive attack for CSP was the senior quarterback McKinzy and the sophomore running back Johnson. McKinzy passed 15-31 for 198 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for 43 yards. Johnson rushed 12 times for 94 yards and also punched in a score.

McKinzy's main targets on the day were Williams and Gustaveson. Williams corralled six passes for 79 yards and score while Gustaveson totaled 85 yards on four catches, adding a touchdown grab.

CSP CRUSHING TURNOVER MARGIN

Just a year ago, Concordia was plagued by the turnover margin with just over one turnover created per game on only three interceptions while committing nearly two giveaways per outing. CSP only won the turnover margin twice and had a negative in the take/give six times. The result led to Concordia being out-scored 47-22 off turnovers.

But a program that had four defensive coordinators in four years from 2014 to 2017 is thriving in its second year under **Craig Stern's** direction. Concordia has not lost the turnover margin in 2018 and has finished positive in the take/give in three of the four games, averaging +1.25 per game. The team has already forced nine turnovers and its five interceptions is two more than its total from 2017.

The flip has led to a 28-0 scoring margin off turnovers and while Stern's defense has created two or more turnovers every week, senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy** has excelled under center with an 8-to-2 TD-INT ratio with a 137.2 efficiency rating on 97 pass attempts.

RED ZONE CHANGES

A key ingredient to CSP's 2-2 start following a pair of 2-9 campaigns and a stretch of five wins in three seasons has been a trend in a positive direction in the red zone on both sides.

Last year, CSP converted 16 red zone touchdowns in 11 games at a 43 percent rate, reaching the opposition's 20 just over three times per game (37 in 11 games) and converting it to points 70 percent of the time (26-37). This year, Concordia is scoring touchdowns 60 percent of the time and has scored on 90 percent of its 10 trips to the red zone. Although the Bears aren't reaching the red zone as frequently, the reason has been the team averaging two scores outside of the red zone per game through a combination of big plays, long field goals along with a special teams TD.

Defensively, the Bears allowed opponents to reach the red zone 48 times, or over four times per game. Opposing offenses scored 11 more red zone TDs (1 more per game) and had put points on the board nine more times overall (35 to 26). In 2018, Concordia has allowed eight opponent red zone touchdowns in 13 trips (62 percent) but more importantly is that CSP hasn't allowed a red zone field goal, holding opponents scoreless inside the 20 five times while the Golden Bears have cashed in nine of their 10 trips for points, leading to a small 55-50 scoring deficit through four games compared to last season's 211-140 scoring deficit.

CURRIER RECREATING HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In his first two seasons, Currier and the Golden Bears won just three games (3-8), but the 2017 team won its home opener and home finale, starting the season on a high note and finishing strong.

The 37-20 win in the 2017 finale over SMSU started a three game home winning streak for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history and the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears, he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 23-10 career record in home games at Concordia and has the Bears off to a 2-0 start to the 2018 home slate.

TOUGH ROAD SLATE IN 2018

The Golden Bears have had among the strongest road schedules to start the 2018 season. Saturday's game at #8 Minnesota Duluth marks the third-straight nationally-ranked opponent to start the 2018 season. Concordia opened the year with a heart-breaking 27-24 loss at #20 Sioux Falls despite leading 24-20 after a field goal extended the lead with 32 seconds left. The Cougars started on their own 40 with 26 seconds to play and scored in four plays, completing three straight passes and scoring with three seconds to play. Concordia then fell 46-13 at #2 Minnesota State, taking a 14-6 deficit into the second quarter despite being even in first downs (6-6) and trailing by just five yards of total offense (139-134) at the quarter break. Minnesota State then converted a 3rd-and-17 with a 27-yard touchdown pass early in the second quarter. The back-breaking score not only put MSU ahead 21-6 in the second quarter in Mankato, it was the start of a 32-0 quarter for MSU that included a pair of safeties on back-to-back defensive plays.

Concordia looks to pick up a win over a ranked opponent at #8 UMD after being within a score of the Bulldogs each of the last two meetings, a 20-13 loss in 2014 when UMD opened the year third in the country and a 52-49 loss at Sea Foam Stadium in week three when UMD was ranked #23 while CSP was attempting to open Currier's return with a 3-0 record.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has lost 16 straight games to ranked teams entering Saturday.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He is second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC

Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

CSP TOPS QUALITY OPPONENTS

Although Concordia has dropped a pair of games at nationally-ranked opponents, it has enjoyed a 63-14 scoring margin in home victories over Upper Iowa (34-7) and Wayne State (29-7).

The wins were quality decisions, not just for scoring margin, but the 2017 Golden Bears were 2-9 NSIC, 1-6 South, with Upper Iowa and Wayne State both posting 6-5 overall seasons in 2017, the Wildcats 4-3 in the division and Peacocks a 3-4 division squad.

Entering 2018, Concordia was tabbed 14th in the NSIC Preseason Coaches Poll, with Wayne State picked ninth and Upper Iowa 11th overall. In the NSIC South, CSP was picked seventh, behind Wayne State (5th) and Upper Iowa (6th).

Through four weeks, Concordia has faced the #1, #3, #9 and #11 teams in the 16-team NSIC according to the preseason poll with a collective 32-12 overall record (19-9 South). This year, CSP's four opponents are a combined 9-7 with all games played in the division.

SOUTH DIVISION TURNAROUND

With Concordia's 37-20 win in the 2017 season finale over SMSU, the Golden Bears snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. After ending 2014 on a four game winning streak - all South Division wins - to end the year 4-3 in the NSIC South, the Golden Bears went winless in the division in 2015 and 2016 before the 2017 victory over the Mustangs.

The Golden Bears have now won three of their last five NSIC South contests, with all three wins coming at Sea Foam Stadium.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: WEEK 2 GROUND DOMINATION

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It carries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper Iowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over Wayne State in week nine.

It's the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards is the most CSP has achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary when the Marauders rushed for one yard on 29 attempts.

It's just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP has held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State, holding the Beavers to 64 yards each in 2015 week three and 2017 week one. The last time CSP has held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper Iowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

The Golden Bears reached the 200 yard mark again in a week four home win over Wayne State, their third straight 200-yard rushing performance at home - all victories - including the 252 yard effort in the 2017 finale win over SMSU.

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition.

terback efficiency (5th NSIC) courtesy an 8-to-2 TD-INT ratio on the year. He's also fourth in the league and 31st nationally with eight TD passes.

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He made his 2018 debut in the second half at MSU, engineering a scoring drive while completing 3-of-7 for 39 yards in the game.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

SHAQ ATTACKS THE END ZONE

Sophomore running back **Shaq Johnson** has reached five games on his TD streak which started in his breakout game to end the 2017 season. The streak features eight total TDs (4 rush, 3 rec, 1 pass) with five of the scores coming this year (2 rush, 3 rec).

The three receiving TDs came in the first two weeks and set a new DII-era (1999-pres) record for most receiving TDs in a season by a running back.

His breakout performance was memorable as Johnson burst onto the scene with 17-175 rushing and two TDs along with a 63 yard TD pass in beating SMSU 37-20 to end his freshman year.

He opened 2018 with a pair of receiving TDs at #20 Sioux Falls and hasn't looked back since. In addition to his five total TDs, Johnson has averaged 5.5 per carry as he ranks fifth in the NSIC with 357 rushing yards. Adding six catches for 49 yards, Johnson has 406 combined yards, averaging more than 100 per game.

He left the week four game against Wayne State with an injury and is no longer on the team's official 2-deep.

PRESTON A BIG PLAY THREAT

With the injury to Johnson, fellow Florida sophomore running back Lajuan Preston has ascended on the depth chart. Featured as the team's second most-used running back through four weeks, Preston has averaged 6.8 yards per carry on 20 attempts for 136 yards including a 73-yard TD run in a 34-7 week two win over Upper Iowa.

The Bears are now down two of their three Florida-back rotation from a year ago as junior Darnell Rolle has yet to appear in a game and is not listed as part of the team's 2-deep for UMD. Rolle led the team in 2017 (127-627, 4.9 avg), had two 100-yard rushing performances and a third game with 126 combined yards (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec). He had a career-high 22-172 rushing at MSU Moorhead in week four of 2017 including a TD.

Shaq Johnson, Preston and Rolle are all from Florida.

Aside from the three Florida returners, the staff added three Division I transfers: **Jeremiah Pierce-Johnson** from Akron (via Florida), **Garrett Gardner** from Wyoming and **Andre Eubanks** from Mississippi Valley State. Pierce-Johnson and Gardner have been featured multiple times in short yardage and Eubanks has seen multiple looks as a blocking back. Gardner has rushed 10-for-35 yards (3.5) in four games.

Additionally, Concordia picked up Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** who rushed for over 600 yards and 11 touchdowns in his three years for the Bearcats that also included a pair of undefeated NCAA Division II championship campaigns. He was the team's leading ball carrier in last year's playoff loss, and had key carries in all three playoff runs.

Jones, a late addition in camp, adjusted quickly and received three carries and a reception in the opener at #20 Sioux Falls for a total of 16 yards including a long run of nine. In week two he returned a blocked punt 17 yards for a TD and added a 35 yard kick return.

HASKINS OFF TO STRONG START AT THE CORNER

Redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** is off to an incredible start to his college career, registering an interception in each of Concordia's four games while tallying 10 pass breakups. The 14 passes defended (INT & PBU) rank second in the country while his four interceptions are fifth nationally. His 10 pass breakups is an NSIC high.

In week two, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an interception, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through four weeks.

His week four performance featured a pair of turnovers, forcing a fumble and picking off his fourth interception while tying for the team-high of four tackles (three solo) and breaking up a pair of passes. It was his coverage on the league-leading wide receiver **Nate Rogers**, who averaged 129.3 yards per game, that stole the show, though, holding him to 40 yards on 5 catches.

He is also a strong tackler with 19 tackles (16 solo), ranking fourth on the defense and leading the secondary. His 16 solo stops leads the team, adding one forced fumble.

His four interceptions top Concordia's season total of three as a defense from a year ago.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** has missed three games due to injury and is not listed on the week five 2-deep. Wallisch made five tackles (four solo) in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls.

Wallisch is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances.

Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a redshirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP the following spring semester.

In Wallisch's absence, sophomores **Lorenzo Kendricks** and **Desmond Hudnall** have shared starts and assignments. Kendricks has 10 tackles and two pass breakups while Hudnall has two tackles and a pass breakup.

SCHENDERLEIN NABS MITCHELL AWARD PRESEASON HONOR

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017, including Schenderlein.

GUSTAVESON CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

Wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** has established himself as Concordia's top target as a three year starter, boasting four career 100-yard performances.

In the 2018 season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, Gustaveson hauled in five catches for 96 yards and a 33 yard touchdown to put CSP ahead 21-20 with under eight minutes to play. He also had a long of 38 in the game.

In four games, Gustaveson leads the team in receiving yards (290) and average (20.7) and is second with 14 catches and has two receiving TDs. He's had at least 50 receiving yards in each of Concordia's four games. He's 12th in the NSIC in receiving yards and seventh in the league in yards/catch.

In three seasons, he's amassed 1,510 yards on 98 catches with 16 touchdowns. He's on the verge of becoming the 11th player in team history to reach 100 career catches, ranks 10th in touchdown catches and is approaching the top-10 in career receiving yards.

Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and touchdowns (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore. Junior college transfer **MJ Williams** joins him with a team high 16 catches and three TD catches and is second on the

team with 230 yards, averaging 14.4 per catch. After being held without a catch at #20 Sioux Falls in the opener, Williams has had a TD each game since with at least four catches and 58 yards in each game.

Prior to Concordia, Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCAA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and TDs (11).

OFF. LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four returning offensive linemen. Over the previous two seasons, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play early in their careers, gaining valuable experience despite the tough physical challenge.

Now the team features more depth, experience, strength & physicality and most importantly, more continuity. The depth has allowed the team to be flexible up front and outlast injuries so far in 2018.

Three starters returned up front on opening day: senior left tackle **Terrell Taylor**, junior left guard **Rich Kelly** and junior right guard **Ethan Aune**. They were joined by redshirt freshman center **Matthew Montgomery** and sophomore right tackle **Cris Wasylciw**. The team has also started redshirt freshman **Tyson Kauffman** at right guard and senior **Samuel Kessler** at center this year.

Sophomore **Tanner Haechten**, who has missed the first four games of the season, has been part of the reserves on the official 2-deep for week four against Wayne State and week five at UMD. Senior **Davarus Clark** had his best fall camp and contributes on field goal/PAT block and short yardage as well.

RUSSELL WEARS #26 TO HONOR LATE FRIEND BILLY BROWN, JR.

Senior safety **Brandon Russell** changed jersey numbers from 23 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May. Billy passed away while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Russell has racked up 95 career tackles. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

Redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan**, **Parker Powers** and **Dez Bassett** have all played significant roles in the secondary at the safety position as well.

Bassett, a Mankato native, made his first career start at #2 MSU in his hometown. He had six tackles in week two at UIU and seven at MSU and is fifth on the team with 16 tackles.



Sheehan has started all four games at the free safety spot and is sixth on the team with 15 tackles, adding a pair of pass breakups and a half tackle for loss. He had a high of six tackles in week three at MSU and contributed five tackles in the win over Upper Iowa.

Powers made his first career interception on a play deep down the sideline in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF and is coming off a new high of four solo tackles against Wayne State in week four.

Junior **Brian Szutkowski** piled up 88 tackles as a sophomore starter in 2017, adding six pass breakups. He's been a key contributor on special teams in 2018 and has been listed as a reserve cornerback on the official 2-deep since week two.

STEADY DEFENSIVE LINE PRODUCTION

Through the first four weeks, Concordia's defensive line has produced 9.0 of the team's 10.0 sacks, 16 of the 18 quarterback hurries and 13.5 of the team's 23.0 tackles for loss as a unit.

It's been a complete group effort as sophomore **Chris Garrett** leads the team with 3.0 TFL, 2.5 sacks and four hurries while veteran starters **Kelly Pierce** has 3.0 TFL and **Jackson Dobbs** has 2.5 TFL. Pierce adds 2.0 sacks and Dobbs 1.5. **Dylan Wood** contributes 2.0 TFL and a sack. Newcomer defensive ends **Shawn Aarhus** and **Cole Marmor** each have a sack and TFL, as well, with Aarhus coming up with a pair of fumble recoveries and a forced fumble.

Garrett broke onto the scene in a big way as a true freshman in 2017, racking up six sacks (all solo) and forcing five fumbles. He added 44 total tackles and 9.0 tackles for loss in just seven games. He had at least six tackles in five of the seven games.

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the year at Augustana where he forced three fumbles, had three sacks and tackles for loss and nine total tackles - all career-highs.

In 2018, Garrett has been in on at least a half tackle for loss in three of four games including a 1.5 sack/TFL performance against Upper Iowa.

Opposite Garrett at the other end is Dobbs who tied for the team lead with seven tackles in week one and has 2.5 TFL, 1.5 sacks and a fumble recovery. In 21 career games, Dobbs has 90 tackles, 12.0 TFL, 6.0 sacks, 3 fumble recoveries and a pair of forced fumbles.

Dobbs and Garrett lead CSP's defensive line with 12 total tackles.

Pierce and Wood have manned the interior and it was Wood who came up with a big third down sack in the fourth quarter at #20 Sioux Falls, finishing the game with four tackles. He has 11 tackles on the year while Pierce adds nine with 3.0 TFL and 2.0 sacks.

Wood played all 11 games each of the last two years and has now recorded 85 tackles and 14.5 tackles for loss with 9.5 sacks in 26 career games. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 20 career games, he's registered 70 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss and 6.0 sacks.

Junior college transfers **TJ Diallo** (NT) and **Cole Marmor** (DE) add depth and experience up front. Marmor secured his first sack in week two at UIU after starting the opener at USF in week one. Diallo picked up his first TFL at #2 MSU in week three, securing four tackles against the Mavericks. They each have six tackles on the year.

Redshirt freshman defensive end **Shawn Aarhus** had a big debut, making three tackles with a sack, tackle for loss, forced fumble and fumble recovery at #20 Sioux Falls. He's up to seven tackles on the year and has a pair of fumble recoveries to go with a forced fumble.

CSP'S STARTING LB'S LEAD TEAM IN TACKLES

Through four weeks, redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** leads the team and is 22nd in the NSIC with 27 tackles. The starting LBs, with sophomores **Blake Evans** (22) and **Andy Aune** (20) joining Portz, are 1-2-3 on the team with 69 tackles.

Evans finished his rookie season on a tear in 2017, leading the team and ranking seventh in the Northern Sun with 97 tackles. Portz spent the year gaining strength and experience in the program as a redshirt while Aune was a redshirt freshman at the University of South Dakota.

SHEPLEY OFF TO STRONG START AS PUNTER

It was quite the debut for sophomore **Jake Shepley** at the punter position in week one. He averaged 47.3 yards on six punts with three eclipsing the 50-yard mark including a long of 66 which was pinned at the four yard line as CSP went toe-to-toe with #20 Sioux Falls on the road.

The 47.3 yard average in the opener was the fourth-best single game average in CSP history.

He doubled-down on the performance by averaging 46.0 yards on four punts with a long of 52 and two inside the 20 against Upper Iowa in week two.

Through four weeks, Shepley ranks 39th in the country and fifth in the league with a 41.7 average which would be ahead of former All-NSIC punter **Sam Maedke's** school record pace set last year (41.3).

Shepley is also a wide receiver, seeing action in four games with two catches as a true freshman in 2017 and continuing to get looks on offense this year.

KEYON WALTERS FACTORS INTO RETURN GAME

Sophomore **Keyon Walters** has quietly put together a strong start to the 2018 season, ranking 25th in the country with a 13.8 punt return average, fourth best in the NSIC.

He's also emerged as a consistent threat in the pass game, third on the team with eight catches going for 59 yards. He ranks fourth on the squad in all-purpose yards with 146, trailing only starting running back **Shaq Johnson** (406) and starting receivers **Marcus Gustaveson** (290) and **MJ Williams** (230).
