#### THIS WEEK: BEARS HOST WOLVES FOR HOMECOMING

In the second week of NSIC North-South Division crossover play, Concordia (2-3 NSIC, 2-2 South) hosts Northern State (1-4 NSIC, 1-3 North). Saturday's game is Homecoming 2018: "Come Together" and features Comet's Carnival opening up just outside the stadium on Sea Foam Plaza at 2 p.m. in the second half of the game.

#### LISTEN TO SHANNON CURRIER'S COACHES SHOW

New this year, the **Coach Shannon Currier Show** debuted on 1440 AM KYCR radio in the Twin Cities following the prep football game of the week. The show is hosted by **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score, and will be a weekly airing following the prep football game of the week, typically in the 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. hour. This week's show is the third episode and features player guest interviews with sophomore running back **Lajuan Preston** and junior defensive lineman **Kelly Pierce**.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show will also be accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, iTunes, Google Play Music, Stitcher and TuneIn Radio. It will be available either late Friday night after the initial airing or on Saturday morning.

#### 2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting back in the first week of fall training camp. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and in general day-to-day activities.

For the sixth straight week, junior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** has been named a captain, joined on defense by fellow junior defensive lineman **Kelly Pierce**; while junior offensive guard **Rich Kelly** earns the honor for the third time this season and is joined on special teams by senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein**.

#### SERIES NOTES: CONCORDIA 7, NORTHERN STATE 7

The Golden Bears and Wolves tangle for the 15th time in a series that began when Concordia joined the NSIC in 1999. NSU

won the first two and the last three meetings with CSP winning 7-of-9 in the middle between 2001 and 2011. The Golden Bears are 5-2 at home against NSU, while the Wolves make their third trip to Sea Foam Stadium with the teams even at 1-1 since CSP moved back to campus in 2009. Under head coach Shannon Currier (2000-03 & 2016-present), CSP is 3-2 in five contests with NSU's wins on the bookend of Currier's tenures.

It's been a closely contested series, with 10 of the 14 games being decided by 10 points or less, eight decided by one score (8 pts) or less and three games decided by three points or less with two of those being one point final margins.

#### LAST MEETING, 2016: NSU 31, CONCORDIA 7

Concordia and Northern State last faced off in the 2016 season, when the Wolves beat the Golden Bears 31-7 on their home turf in Aberdeen, South Dakota.

Northern State got the scoring started with a 3-yard rushing TD halfway through the first quarter and doubled their lead to 14-0 with a 46-yard TD late in the opening period.

A two-yard touchdown pass by the Wolves widened the margin to 21-0, which would be the score at halftime.

After a field goal in the third quarter put the Wolves up 24-0, the Golden Bears got on the scoreboard with a 15-yard touchdown from **Ron Johnson** to **Marcus Gustavson**. The Wolves would close out the scoring with a 15-yard passing touchdown of their own as the third quarter expired.

R.Johnson led the Golden Bears in yards, as the then-junior quarterback passed 11-23 for 163 yards, a touchdown, and an interception. Senior running back **Darius Chapes** led the rushing attack, running for 33 yards on nine carries. Receiver **Gabe Steed** led the team with three catches for 51 yards.

NSU quarterback **Christian McAlvain** had a big day for the Wolves. The senior passed 14-19 for 128 yards and two touchdowns. He also rushed 17 times for 157 yards and a touchdown. Junior running back **Nicholas Truen** ran for 87 yards on 17 carries and also recorded a touchdown.

## NOTES ABOUT THE WOLVES

Northern State comes into the matchup sporting a 1-4 record. However, the Wolves have been competitive in nearly every game, averaging 23.2 points compared to 27.4 for opponents.

The passing game has big a part of the offense for the Wolves. Sophomore **Hunter Trautman** has thrown for 1,314 yards, 11 TDs, and five INT on 54.5% passing. Trautman has thrown for 262.8 yards per game through five games.

Senior running back **Chacka Kelly** has led the rushing attack for the Wolves with 57.0 yards per game at 3.2 per carry. Trautman is second on the team with 32.4 yards per game and 2.5 yards a rush.

A pair of receivers have caught a majority of Trautman's passes. Freshman **Dakota Larson** is second in the league with 457 receiving yards (23-457, 3 TDs) while redshirt freshman **Jacob Streit** is sixth in the league with 25 catches (25-322, 4 TDs).

Senior linebacker **Noah MacPherson** is seventh in the NSIC with 40 tackles on the season (8.0 per game). He also has recorded 4.5 TFLs. Linebacker **Preston Droessler** has also posted 4.5 TFLs, and has collected 34 total tackles.

In the secondary, seniors **Alex Gray** and **Etienne Ezeff** have been playmakers. Gray is third on the team with 33 tackles (3.0 TFL) with one INT. Ezeff has 19 tackles on the season and racked up seven pass break-ups, which ranks tied for fourth in the NSIC.

Northern State's defense has been stingy on 3rd down this season, 3rd in the NSIC at 29.9%. They have also been tough on 4th down this season, leading the NSIC at 33.3%.

Northern State leads the NSIC with 16 4th down conversion attempts, converting on half of their tries. They have attempted just six field goals on the season, converting just two with a long of 32 yards.

The Wolves are last in the NSIC in kickoff return average, gaining an average of just 12.4 yards per return. The also rank 12th and 13th in the NSIC in net punting (32.7) and net kickoff yards (36.6), respectively.

Linebacker **David Reed** led the Golden Bears in tackles on that Saturday afternoon, as he collected 14 (including one for loss). Seven Golden Bears collected a tackle for loss, including one by current CSP defensive lineman **Kelly Pierce**. **Jamie Fore** also forced a fumble in the loss while pitching in six tackles (one for loss).

Northern State also recorded seven tackles for loss, and were led by defensive lineman **Chad Stoterau**. The senior racked up eight tackles and also recorded a tackle for loss and a forced fumble.

The biggest difference on the afternoon was Northern State's 311 yards rushing compared to 32 for the Golden Bears. CSP did edge the Wolves in passing yards, 163-128.

## LAST WEEK: #8 UMD 32, CONCORDIA 3

In their last contest, the Golden Bears traveled to Malosky Stadium to take on #8 Minnesota Duluth. The Bulldogs continued their undefeated season (5-0 NSIC, 4-0 North), claiming the victory by a score of 32-3.

Playing the role of visitor for the third time against a ranked opponent this season, the Golden Bears were competitive early in the game before the Bulldogs took control in the second half.

UMD received the opening kickoff and were driving down the field before being stopped by the Golden Bears on a 4th-and-1. After CSP was forced to punt, the Bulldogs completed a drive with a 10-yard touchdown pass from **John Larson** to **Tyler Lattery**.

After stopping UMD on a another 4th down attempt, CSP was able to get into field goal range for a 34-yard **Jonas Schenderlein** field goal made the score 8-3.

UMD answered back with a scoring drive of their own, going 75 yards on seven plays, culminating in a one-yard touchdown rush by **Zach Ojile**. CSP would drive down to the UMD 25 on their next possession, but were unable to get any points from the drive. After a CSP fumble in their own territory, the Bulldogs tacked on a field goal to make the score 19-3 at the half.

After the Golden Bears turned the ball over with an interception in their own territory, the Bulldogs capitalized by punching in another score with 9-yard touchdown rush by Larson. CSP was once again able to drive down to the UMD 25, but couldn't convert on fourth down.

The Bulldogs put the game away early in the fourth quarter, as **Wade Sullivan** scored a six-yard rushing touchdown to cap the scoring at 32-3.

Leading the CSP offense in total yards was sophomore running back **Lajuan Preston** in his first career 100-yard rushing performance. Preston rushed for 111 yards on 13 carries, also catching a pass for eight yards.

The Golden Bears couldn't get much going through the air, as quarterback **Dom McKinzy** went 10-23 for 83 yards. **Maxon Hut-ton** also completed three passes in six attempts for 23 yards.

Wide receiver **MJ Williams** led the Gold Bears in receptions and yards, as the junior corralled five passes for 61 yards.

UMD's QB Larson had a big day, passing 20-32 with 238 yards and a touchdown. He also ran for 69 yards and score.

**Marcus Haskins** once again intercepted a pass for the Golden Bears, and extending his streak of five straight games to start the season with a pick. The sophomore was third on the team in tackles with five on the day, trailing only **Dez Bassett** (7) and **Andy Aune** (6). Aune also recorded a sack, his first of the season.

It was a combined effort for the Bulldogs on defense, as UMD collected six tackles for loss, forced two fumbles, and picked off two CSP passes.

## FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In his first two seasons, Currier and the Golden Bears won just three home games (3-8), but the 2017 team won its home opener and home finale, starting the season on a high note and then finishing strong.

The 37-20 win in the 2017 finale over SMSU started a three game home winning streak for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history and the first three game home winning streak since the 2005

NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears, he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth" a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 23-10 career record in home games at Concordia and has the Bears off to a 2-0 start to the 2018 home slate.

## HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 7-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the seven home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 29.4 to 8.3 margin of victory, a total of 206 to 58.

## TURNOVER MARGIN CORRELATING TO SUCCESS

Just a year ago, Concordia was plagued by the turnover margin with just over one turnover created per game on only three interceptions while committing nearly two giveaways per outing. CSP only won the turnover margin twice and had a negative in the take/give six times. The result led to Concordia being out-scored 47-22 off turnovers.

But a program that had four defensive coordinators in four years from 2014 to 2017 is thriving in its second year under **Craig Stern's** direction. It wasn't until a week five road game at #8-ranked UMD that CSP finally lost the turnover margin (3-to-1) and has finished positive in the take/give three times.

On the year, CSP has forced 10 turnovers and committed seven while holding a 28-9 scoring margin in points off turnovers. UMD was the first time to capitalize on a CSP turnover as the Golden Bears held a 28-0 scoring margin through four weeks.

Concordia's defense had created at least two turnovers in each of the first four games of the year.

## TOUGH ROAD SLATE IN 2018

The Golden Bears have had among the strongest road schedules to start the 2018 season. Last week's 32-3 loss at #8 Minnesota Duluth marked the third-straight nationally-ranked opponent to start the 2018 season. Concordia opened the year with a heart-breaking 27-24 loss at #20 Sioux Falls despite leading 24-20 after a field goal extended the lead with 32 seconds left. The Cougars started on their own 40 with 26 seconds to play and scored in four plays, completing three straight passes and scoring with three seconds to play. Concordia then fell 46-13 at #2 Minnesota State in week three, taking a 14-6 deficit into the second quarter despite being even in first downs (6-6) and trailing by just five yards of total offense (139-134) at the quarter break. Minnesota State then converted a 3rd-and-17 with a 27-yard touchdown pass early in the second quarter. The back-breaking score not only put MSU ahead 21-6 in the second quarter in Mankato, it was the start of a 32-0 quarter for MSU that included a pair of safeties on back-to-back defensive plays for MSU.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 17 straight games to ranked teams, but the 2018 schedule does not feature another ranked opponent in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

## CSP TOPS QUALITY OPPONENTS

Although Concordia has dropped three games at nationally-ranked opponents, it has enjoyed a 63-14 scoring margin in home victories over Upper Iowa (34-7) and Wayne State (29-7).

The wins were quality decisions, not just for scoring margin, but the 2017 Golden Bears were 2-9 NSIC, 1-6 South, with Upper Iowa and Wayne State both posting 6-5 overall seasons in 2017, the Wildcats 4-3 in the division and Peacocks a 3-4 division squad.

Entering 2018, Concordia was tabbed 14th in the NSIC Preseason Coaches Poll, with Wayne State picked ninth and Upper Iowa 11th overall. In the NSIC South, CSP was picked seventh, behind

Wayne State (5th) and Upper Iowa (6th).

Through five weeks, Concordia has faced the #1, #3, #4, #9 and #11 teams in the 16-team NSIC according to the preseason poll with a collective 2017 41-14 overall record (19-9 South). This year, CSP's five opponents are a combined 16-9 overall.

## SOUTH DIVISION TURNAROUND

With Concordia's 37-20 win in the 2017 season finale over SMSU, the Golden Bears snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. After ending 2014 on a four game winning streak - all South Division wins - to end the year 4-3 in the NSIC South, the Golden Bears went winless in the division in 2015 and 2016 before the 2017 victory over the Mustangs.

The Golden Bears have now won three of their last five NSIC South contests, with all three wins coming at Sea Foam Stadium.

## INSIDE THE NUMBERS: WEEK 2 GROUND DOMINATION

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It carries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper Iowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over

Wayne State in week nine.

It's the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards is the most CSP has achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary when the Marauders rushed for one yard on 29 attempts.

It's just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP has held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State, holding the Beavers to 64 yards each in 2015 week three and 2017 week one. The last time CSP has held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper Iowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

The Golden Bears reached the 200 yard mark again in a week four home win over Wayne State, their third straight 200-yard rushing performance at home - all victories - including the 252 yard effort in the 2017 finale win over SMSU.

## HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He is second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC

Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

## THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak.

## CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

## PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

## NSIC BACKGROUND &amp; ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

**MEET THE STARTING QUARTERBACK: DOM MCKINZY**

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition.

McKinzy is off to a strong start to 2018. He's posted a 122.2 quarterback efficiency and carries an 8-to-4 TD-INT ratio on the year.

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He has seen action under center in each of the last three games and is now 6-of-13 for 62 yards passing and has 13 rushing attempts for 22 yards with a long of 17.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

**SHAQ ATTACKS THE END ZONE**

Sophomore running back **Shaq Johnson** has reached five games on his TD streak which started in his breakout game to end the 2017 season. The streak features eight total TDs (4 rush, 3 rec, 1 pass) with five of the scores coming this year (2 rush, 3 rec).

The three receiving TDs came in the first two weeks and set a new DII-era (1999-pres) record for most receiving TDs in a season by a running back.

His breakout performance was memorable as Johnson burst onto the scene with 17-175 rushing and two TDs along with a 63 yard TD pass in beating SMSU 37-20 to end his freshman year.

He opened 2018 with a pair of receiving TDs at #20 Sioux Falls and hasn't looked back since. In addition to his five total TDs, Johnson has averaged 5.5 per carry as he ranks fifth in the NSIC with 357 rushing yards. Adding six catches for 49 yards, Johnson has 406 combined yards, averaging more than 100 per game.

He left the week four game against Wayne State with an injury and is no longer on the team's official 2-deep.

**PRESTON STEPS UP**

With the injury to **Shaq Johnson**, fellow Florida sophomore run-

ning back **Lajuan Preston** ascended on the depth chart and produced his first career 100-yard rushing game at #8 UMD in week four, rushing 13 times for 111 yards and was not tackled for a loss by the Bulldogs.

Featured as the team's second most-used running back through four weeks, Preston has averaged 7.5 yards per carry on 33 attempts for 247 yards including a 73-yard TD run in a 34-7 week two win over Upper Iowa. He's only been tackled for a loss of two total yards on the season, as well.

The Bears are now down two of their three Florida-back rotation from a year ago as junior **Darnell Rolle** has yet to appear in a game and is not listed as part of the team's 2-deep for NSU. Rolle led the team in 2017 (127-627, 4.9 avg), had two 100-yard rushing performances and a third game with 126 combined yards (21-86 rush, 3-40 rec). He had a career-high 22-172 rushing at MSU Moorhead in week four of 2017 including a TD.

Shaq Johnson, Preston and Rolle are all from Florida and all three backs have produced at least one career 100-yard rushing game with four total between the trio.

Aside from the three Florida returners, the staff added three Division I transfers: **Jeremiah Pierce-Johnson** from Akron (also via Florida), **Garrett Gardner** from Wyoming and **Andre Eubanks** from Mississippi Valley State. Pierce-Johnson and Gardner have been featured multiple times in short yardage and Eubanks has seen multiple looks as a blocking back. Gardner has rushed 11-for-44 yards (4.0) in five games.

Additionally, Concordia picked up Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** who rushed for over 600 yards and 11 touchdowns in his three years for the Bearcats that also included a pair of undefeated NCAA Division II championship campaigns. He was the team's leading ball carrier in last year's playoff loss, and had key carries in all three playoff runs.

Jones, a late addition in camp, adjusted quickly and received three carries and a reception in the opener at #20 Sioux Falls for a total of 16 yards including a long run of nine. In week two he returned a blocked punt 17 yards for a TD and added a 35 yard kick return. He is third among CSP running backs with 17 carries but has just 25 yards (1.5 avg) and also leads the team with seven kickoff returns, 106 kickoff return yards and a 15.1 return average.

**HASKINS OFF TO STRONG START AT THE CORNER**

Redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** is off to an incredible start to his college career, registering an interception in each of Concordia's five games while tallying 11 pass breakups. The 16 passes defended (INT & PBU) lead the nation while his five interceptions are second in the country. His 11 pass breakups lead the Northern Sun, as well.

In week two, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an interception, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through four weeks.

His week four performance in CSP's 29-7 win over WSC featured a pair of turnovers, forcing a fumble and picking off his fourth interception while tying for the team-high of four tackles (three solo) and breaking up a pair of passes. It was his coverage on the league-leading wide receiver **Nate Rogers**, who averaged 129.3 yards per game, that stole the show, though, holding him to 40 yards on 5 catches.

He is also a strong tackler with 24 tackles (20 solo), ranking fourth on the defense and leading the secondary. His 20 solo stops leads the team, adding one forced fumble.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** has three full games due to injury (week 2-4), but returned for limited work at #8 UMD in week five. Wallisch made five tackles (four solo) in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls.

Wallisch is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances.

Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on the team with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a red-shirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons and joined CSP the following spring semester.

four of five games. He's 12th in the NSIC in receiving yards and seventh in the league in yards/catch.

In three seasons, he's amassed 1,545 yards on 100 catches with 16 touchdowns.

Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and touchdowns (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore.

Junior college transfer **MJ Williams** joins him with a team high 21 catches and three TD catches and is second on the team with 291 yards, averaging 13.9 per catch. After being held without a catch at #20 Sioux Falls in the opener, Williams had a TD in three straight games and has had at least four catches and 58 yards in each of the last four games.

Prior to Concordia, Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCCAA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and TDs (11).

#### OFFENSIVE LINE GROWS IN STRENGTH, CONTINUITY

When head coach **Shannon Currier** was hired in December, 2015 he inherited four returning offensive linemen. Over the previous two seasons, the Golden Bears provided the young offensive line a chance to compete and play early in their careers, gaining valuable experience despite the tough physical challenge.

Now the team features more depth, experience, strength & physicality and most importantly, more continuity. The depth has allowed the team to be flexible up front and outlast injuries so far in 2018.

Three starters returned up front on opening day: senior left tackle **Terrell Taylor**, junior left guard **Rich Kelly** and junior right guard **Ethan Aune**. They were joined by redshirt freshman center **Matthew Montgomery** and sophomore right tackle **Cris Wasylciw**. The team has also started redshirt freshman **Tyson Kauffman** at right guard and senior **Samuel Kessler** at center this year.

Sophomore **Tanner Haechten**, who missed the first four games of the season, made his debut in week five at #8 UMD. Senior **Davarus Clark** had his best fall camp and contributes on field goal/PAT block and in short yardage as well.

#### RUSSELL WEARS #26 TO HONOR LATE FRIEND BILLY BROWN, JR.

Senior safety **Brandon Russell** changed jersey numbers from 23 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May. Billy passed away while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Russell has racked up 95 career tackles. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

Redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan**, **Parker Powers** and **Dez Bassett** have all played significant roles in the secondary at the safety position as well.

Bassett, a Mankato native, made his first career start at #2 MSU in his hometown. He had six tackles in week two at UIU and seven each at MSU and UMD. Bassett is fifth on the team with 23 tackles.

Sheehan has started all five games at the free safety spot and is sixth on the team with 18 tackles, adding a pair of pass pickups and a half tackle for loss. He had a high of six tackles in week three at MSU and contributed five tackles in the win over Upper Iowa.

Powers made his first career interception on a play deep down the sideline in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF, had four solo tackles against Wayne State in week four. and also has a pair of pass pickups on the year.

#### STEADY DEFENSIVE LINE PRODUCTION

Through the first four weeks, Concordia's defensive line has produced 9.0 of the team's 10.0 sacks, 18 of the 20 quarterback hurries and 15.0 of the team's 27.0 tackles for loss as a unit.

It's been a complete group effort as the team lead is just 3.0 TFL and is shared between sophomore **Chris Garrett** and junior **Kelly Pierce**. That duo also has the team high with 2.5 and 2.0 sacks, respectively. Garrett, Pierce and junior **Jackson Dobbs** each have four quarterback hurries as well.

On the second line, redshirt freshman **Shawn Aarhus** has been an impact player with 2.5 TFL, 1.0 sack, a pair of forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.

Six different linemen have recorded at least 1.0 sack and seven have at least 1.0 TFL.

Garrett broke onto the scene in a big way as a true freshman in 2017, racking up six sacks (all solo) and forcing five fumbles. He added 44 total tackles and 9.0 tackles for loss in just seven games. He had at least six tackles in five of the seven games.

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the year at Augustana where he forced three fumbles, had three sacks and tackles for loss and nine total tackles - all career-highs.

In 2018, Garrett has been in on at least a half tackle for loss in three of four games including a 1.5 sack/TFL performance against Upper Iowa.



Having missed a few games due to injury, Garrett has now played 11 games in his year and a half with the Bears, racking up 61 total tackles, 12.0 tackles for loss, 8.5 sacks, six forced fumbles and nine QB hurries.

Opposite Garrett at the other end is Dobbs who tied for the team lead with seven tackles in week one and has 2.5 TFL, 1.5 sacks, a fumble recovery and four QB hurries. In 22 career games, Dobbs has 93 tackles, 12.0 TFL, 6.0 sacks, 3 fumble recoveries and a pair of forced fumbles.

Pierce and junior **Dylan Wood** have manned the interior with Pierce producing 3.0 TFL and 2.0 sacks among his 10 tackles. Wood has produced 2.0 TFL and 1.0 sacks among his 13 tackles.

Wood has played all 27 games over his career and has now recorded 87 tackles and 14.5 tackles for loss with 9.5 sacks. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 21 career games, he's registered 71 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss and 6.0 sacks.

#### CSP'S STARTING LB'S LEAD TEAM IN TACKLES

Through five weeks, redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** leads the team and is 29th in the NSIC with 29 tackles. The starting LBs, with sophomores **Blake Evans** (27) and **Andy Aune** (26) joining Portz, are 1-2-3 on the team with 82 total tackles as a unit.

Portz is tied for the team lead with 3.0 TFL while Aune and Evans each have 1.5 TFL. Aune picked up his first sack at CSP in week five at #8 UMD while Portz had his first career sack in his debut at #20 USF.

Evans finished his rookie season on a tear in 2017, leading the team and ranking seventh in the Northern Sun with 97 tackles while Portz spent the year gaining strength and experience in the program as a redshirt and Aune was a redshirt freshman at the University of South Dakota where he was one of 18 redshirt freshmen to see action for the Coyotes, competing in four games.

#### SHEPLEY OFF TO STRONG START AS PUNTER

It was quite the debut for sophomore **Jake Shepley** at the punter position in week one. He averaged 47.3 yards on six punts with three eclipsing the 50-yard mark including a long of 66 which was pinned at the four yard line as CSP went toe-to-toe with #20 Sioux Falls on the road.

The 47.3 yard average in the opener was the fourth-best single game average in CSP history.

He doubled-down on the performance by averaging 46.0 yards on four punts with a long of 52 and two inside the 20 against Upper Iowa in week two.

Through five weeks, Shepley ranks 50th in the country and fifth in the league with a 40.6 average which puts him on pace for one of the top punting average seasons in school history and just shy of former All-NSIC punter **Sam Maedke's** school record pace set last year (41.3) which led the conference in 2017.

Shepley is also a wide receiver, seeing action in four games with two catches as a true freshman in 2017 and continuing to get looks on offense this year.

#### KEYON WALTERS FACTORS INTO RETURN GAME

Sophomore **Keyon Walters** has quietly put together a strong start to the 2018 season and his 13.8 punt return average ranked 25th in the country and would be third in the NSIC with enough returns to qualify for the leaderboard.

He's also emerged as a consistent threat in the pass game, third on the team with nine catches going for 61 yards. He is sixth on the team in all-purpose yards with 149.
