#### THIS WEEK: FINAL NSIC NORTH-SOUTH CROSSOVER GAME

This week's game marks the fourth and final NSIC North-South Division crossover game, with CSP entering 1-2 against the North and UMC with an 0-3 record against the South. In addition to attempting to even its crossover record at .500, the Bears are also attempting to reach .500 overall heading into the final three weeks against the South Division, where CSP is already .500 (2-2).

#### STREAKS ON THE LINE

After snapping a 13-game road skid last week with a 17-7 win at UMary, Concordia is now looking to protect an 11-game winning streak against Minnesota Crookston, dating back to November 3, 2001. Further, Concordia has never lost a home game to Minnesota Crookston with a 4-0 all-time home record in the series. UMC has only made two trips to Sea Foam Stadium since it was constructed in 2009, a 38-20 win for CSP in 2011 and a 44-3 win for the Bears in 2014.

While CSP is aiming to protect streaks, Minnesota Crookston is looking to snap a 23-game losing streak against the NSIC South Division where they hold a 1-26 all-time record since division play started in the league in 2012. Concordia, by comparison, is 10-17 against the NSIC North and has won at least a game against the opposite division every year and will be aiming for its third .500 or better finish against the North.

#### **FACULTY/STAFF APPRECIATION DAY**

#### **NEW THIS YEAR: COACH CURRIER SHOW HITS THE RADIO!**

This week's Coaches Show with Shannon Currier was aired

on Wednesday night on KYCR 1440 AM radio with host **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score. The show featured player interviews with senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and redshirt freshman safety **Dez Bassett**, the reigning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week.

The show typically airs Friday evening in the 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. hour following the prep football game of the week which is broadcast on KYCR 1440 AM. This week's show was moved due to MEA weekend impacting the high school schedule.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show is accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, iTunes, Stitcher and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

For the second time this year, the CSP Bears Podcast featured a Concordia football player, with last week's guest senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein**. The German native talked about his upbringing, first experiences with American football and what it's like being scouted by multiple NFL franchises. The first-ever episode featured senior transfer quarterback **Dom McKinzy**.

#### **2018 TEAM CAPTAINS**

CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting back in the first week of fall training camp. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

For the third straight week, juniors **Rich Kelly** and **Kelly Pierce** will walk out to midfield for the pregame coin toss which will be the fifth time overall for Kelly on the offensive side. Joining them for the second week in a row is sophomore **Chris Garrett** while junior **Marcus Gustaveson** is now a three-time game captain this season.

#### NOTES ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES

UMC comes into the contest with a 1-6 record. The Golden Eagles snapped a 26-game losing earlier this season with a 29-21 win over Minot State earlier this season. The win was also broke a 56-game road losing streak, dating back to the 2007 season. The Golden Bears claimed four wins at home against the Golden Eagles in that stretch.

UMC averages the least amount of points (10.7) and allows the most (46.0) in the league.

UMC averages 240.3 yards of total offense (16th, NSIC), including 99 yards per game on the ground (14th) and 179.4 yards through the air (16th).

Junior QB **Jalin Scott** has led the Golden Eagles offense, passing 46-91 for 653 yards and two TDs. Scott has also rushed 103 times for 1.4 yards per carry, also running for four TDs. UMC has featured multiple QBs in 2018, as **Tristan Robbins** and **Jeremy Neuman** both have over 100 yards passing.

Freshman **Andy Groebner** has been the leader in catches (21), yards (405) and TDs (2) for the Golden Eagles.

Elijah Todd has led the ground game for the Golden Eagles, averaging 48 yards a game and 4.3 yards per carry. Kevin Evans is also a big part of the rushing attack for UMC, carrying the ball 51 times for 101 yards at 2.0 per carry.

The Golden Eagles have the second-worst turnover margin in DII football, as they have turned the ball over 22 times (10 interceptions, 12 fumbles) and forced six turnovers (one interception, five fumbles recovered).

The leading defensive player in most statistical categories for UMC has been **Ali** Alkhatib. The senior LB ranks 11th in the NSIC with 55 tackles, and leads the Golden Eagles with 5.0 TFLs, 1.0 sack, and an INT. Defensive back **Will Cole** is second on the team with 51 tackles and 4.0 TFL.

UMC has allowed opponents to convert 47% on 3rd down while converting just 32% on offense. The Golden Eagles have been more effective on 4th down, converting on 58.8% (4th NSIC).

The kicking game for the Golden Eagles has struggled, as they have knocked home just 2-of-5 field goals and 7-of-9 extra points. They are also 15th in the NSIC in net kickoff coverage, averaging 33.0 yards per kickoff.

when Concordia joined the Northern Sun. The Golden Eagles were not kind to the Golden Bears in the early NSIC years, with UMC winning three in a row from 1999 to 2001. But the Golden Bears picked up a 48-7 home win at Griffin Stadium in 2002 and have won every meeting since, scoring at least 28 points each game while UMC has not scored more than 24. Concordia has topped 40 points seven times during the current 11 game winning streak and produced back-to-back shutouts in 2006 (49-0) and 2007 (48-0) in games played at the old Metrodome in Minneapolis. Concordia has only hosted UMC four times in St. Paul, winning all four matchups and the Golden Eagles have only made two trips to Sea Foam Stadium which opened in 2009: a 38-20 win for CSP in 2011 and a 44-3 win in 2014.

**LAST MEETING, 2016: CONCORDIA 41, UM CROOKSTON 18**The last time the Golden Bears and Golden Eagles faced off, Concordia traveled to northern Minnesota and took home a 41-18 win on September 10th, 2016.

Junior QB **Ron Johnson** had a big game in the win, as he passed 18-27 for 239 yards and three TDs. He also pitched in 14 yards on the ground and a rushing TD.

CSP did most of its damage in the first half in that contest, as the Golden Bears led 31-7 midway through the game. Johnson completed 14 of his his first 15 passes, including a string of 13 in a row.

CSP first cashed in on a one-yard Johnson TD run to start the scoring, but the Golden Eagles were able to even the score at 7-7 with a two-yard TD rush of their own.

The Golden Bears took control from there, as **Jonas Schenderlein** knocked home a 42-yard field goal at the end of the first quarter. A big second quarter for the Golden Bears included two touchdown passes from Johnson to senior tight end **Bruce Russell** (9, 40) and a 70-yard interception return for a TD by senior defensive back **Dominic Nabak**.

Senior running back **Darius Chapes** also had a big game for the Golden Bears, as he rushed 11 times for 97 yards and caught two passes for 21 yards and a touchdown. Chapes was one of eight Golden Bears to catch a pass on the day.

Nabak was the second-leading tackler (6) for the Golden Bears on the day, trailing senior linebacker **JJ Przybylka** who amassed 17 stops (4th most in team history) on the afternoon. Eleven of Przybylka's tackles were of the solo variety, and he also chipped in a half of sack.

After a Chapes 10-yard receiving TD to start the second half, UMC answered back with a field goal and a safety on botched snap to make the score 38-12. The Golden Bears scored their final points of the game midway through the fourth quarter on a Schenderlein 52-yard field goal, the 4th longest in team history at time time (now 6th longest)

Along with a big game from Johnson, the CSP defense executed in the important moments to help lead the Golden Bears to victory. Concordia held Minnesota Crookston to 4-of-12 on third down and 0-of-3 on fourth down.

#### LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 17, UMARY 7

Last weekend, CSP traveled to Bismarck, N.D. to take on UMary. The Golden Bears came home with a hard fought win in the wind and cold, claiming a 17-7 victory over the Marauders.

The defense and the ground game were the keys to victory for CSP, as the Golden Bears rushed for 206 yards on a school record 63 rushing attempts in the contest while holding UMary to just 150 yards of total offense – just 50 coming in the final three quarters.

The first half was a stalemate, as neither team could muster any points against the opposing defense. With temperatures below 40 degrees and winds upward of 20 mph and gusting as high as 40 mph, ball movement was scarce in the first two quarters. CSP had a chance to put points on the board in the first quarter, but a **Jonas Schenderlein** 57-yard FG attempt missed just wide right to keep the game scoreless, and the Bears had a pair of strong drives stalled by turnovers in Marauder territory in the second.

The complexion of the game changed quickly on one play in the third quarter. UMary quarterback **Jason Hoekstra** was picked off by **Dez Bassett**. The redshirt freshman safety took the ball 77 yards to the end zone to give the Golden Bears a 7-0 lead.

Concordia tacked on another score later in the quarter, this time on a drive that took 6:44 off of the clock. Starting on their own one-yard line after a 70-yard UMary punt, the Golden Bears orchestrated a 14-play, 92-yard drive which culminated in a Schenderlein 24-yard field goal.

With a 10-0 lead heading into the fourth quarter, CSP was once again driving when disaster struck and QB **Dom McKinzy** was sacked from behind, fumbling near the sideline. The Marauders took the ball back to the CSP three-yard line, and punched in a TD on the next play on a rush by TE **Colton Farmer**.

Concordia was able ice the game in the fourth quarter, as the team put together a 10-play, 85-yard drive that resulted in a McKinzy 26-yard TD run on a 4th-and-2 play. With a 17-7 lead, the defense held strong for the remainder of the game to capture the win.

Along with the big day from Bassett (INT, six tackles), defensive end **Chris Garrett** also posted a quality game. The sophomore sacked Hoekstra three times, and also pitched in six tackles. Defensive linemen **Kelly Pierce** and **Jackson Dobbs** also each added a half sack and contributed six and seven tackles, respectively. Linebacker **Jake Portz** led the team in tackles with eight.

On the offensive side of the ball, the Golden Bears had four rushers contribute 35 yards or more, including McKinzy (20-70), Lajuan Preston (15-57), Garrett Gardner (9-38), and Emanuel Jones (11-35). McKinzy also passed 12-22 for 129 yards with his main target being receiver Marcus Gustaveson (6-70).

CSP converted 24 first downs to UMary's 7, and controlled the time possession, 38:18 to 21:42. The Golden Bear defense also came up big on 3rd and 4th down, holding UMary to 4-14 on 3rd downs and 0-2 on 4th downs.

#### FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In his first two seasons, Currier and the Golden Bears won just three home games (3-8), but the 2017 team won its home finale, setting the stage for the 2018 squad's first two home wins to give the program its first three game winning streak in Sea Foam Stadium history.

The three game streak, which was snapped with a 35-28 homecoming loss to Northern State in week six, was the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season when the team played down the street at Griffin Stadium on the campus of neighboring St. Paul Central High School.

That 2005 team was the final unit of a full four season perfect home stretch, dubbed "The Griff Myth" - a 19 game home winning streak that started during the last two years of Coach Currier's

first run leading the Bears. "The Griff Myth" featured perfect home seasons in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Currier posted an 18-2 home record during his first reign as CSP's football boss from 2000-03 and is now 23-12 at home. The Bears can secure a winning home season for the third time at their new digs on campus with a win against UMC, which would also provide the program with three home wins in a season at Sea Foam Stadium for the fourth time.

#### **HOME OPENER SUCCESS**

Concordia head coach Shannon Currier has improved to 7-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the seven home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 29.4 to 8.3 margin of victory, a total of 206 to 58.

#### **TOUGH ROAD SLATE IN 2018**

The Golden Bears had among the strongest road schedules to start the 2018 season with three consecutive road games against ranked opponents in weeks one, three and five. In the opener, CSP nearly started off its season with an upset over #20 Sioux Falls before the Cougars scored with three seconds to play to top the Bears 27-24. In week three, CSP fell 46-13 at #3 Minnesota State and Concordia fell in week five 32-3 at #8 Minnesota Duluth. MSU has moved up to #1 in the country and UMD is now #5.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 17 straight games to ranked teams, but the 2018 schedule does not feature another ranked opponent in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven with a 17-7 win at UMary and is now 1-3 on the road with two more road trips remaining in 2018.

#### **CSP TOPS QUALITY OPPONENTS**

Although Concordia has dropped three games at nationallyranked opponents, it has enjoyed a 63-14 scoring margin in home victories over Upper Iowa (34-7) and Wayne State (29-7).

The wins were quality decisions, not just for scoring margin, but the 2017 Golden Bears were 2-9 NSIC, 1-6 South, with Upper Iowa

## **HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON**



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He s second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC

Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

#### THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak.

#### CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

#### PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

#### **NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION**

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his mas-

ter's degree in physical education.

and Wayne State both posting 6-5 overall seasons in 2017, the Wildcats 4-3 in the division and Peacocks a 3-4 division squad.

Entering 2018, Concordia was tabbed 14th in the NSIC Preseason Coaches Poll, with Wayne State picked ninth and Upper Iowa 11th overall. In the NSIC South, CSP was picked seventh, behind Wayne State (5th) and Upper Iowa (6th).

Through six weeks, Concordia has faced the #1, #3 and #4 teams in the 16-team NSIC according to the preseason poll and Concordia's schedule overall ranks as #39 in the country (17-13).

#### SOUTH DIVISION TURNAROUND

With Concordia's 37-20 win in the 2017 season finale over SMSU, the Golden Bears snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. After ending 2014 on a four game winning streak - all South Division wins - to end the year 4-3 in the NSIC South, the Golden Bears went winless in the division in 2015 and 2016 before the 2017 victory over the Mustangs.

The Golden Bears have now won three of their last five NSIC South contests, with all three wins coming at Sea Foam Stadium.

#### **TURNOVERS MATTER**

Just a year ago, Concordia was plagued by the turnover margin on both sides, creating just over one per game on defense (with just three INTs) while committing nearly two giveaways per outing. CSP only won the turnover margin twice and had a negative in the take/give six times. The result led to Concordia being outscored 47-22 off turnovers in a 2-9 2017 season.

But a program that had four defensive coordinators in four years from 2014 to 2017 is thriving in its second year under **Craig Stern's** direction. The squad has already forced 12 turnovers in seven games this year and its seven interceptions are more than double last season's total output. Additionally, the defense forced at least two turnovers in five out of seven games in 2018.

In the first four weeks, CSP held a 28-0 scoring advantage behind a +5 in the take/give (9-to-4).

The team's fortunes have turned in the middle of the season, though, with three straight games on the wrong end of the take/ give with a -9 in those three games leading to a 44-7 scoring deficit. In a decisive turn on homecoming, CSP turned it over six times and didn't force a Northern State turnover while facing a 28-0 deficit in points off turnovers in a 35-28 loss that included a pick-6 in the NSU red zone.

#### INSIDE THE NUMBERS: WEEK 2 GROUND DOMINATION

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It carries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper lowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over Wayne State in week nine.

It's the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards against UIU was the most CSP had achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary when the Marauders rushed for one yard on 29 attempts.

It was just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP had

held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State, holding the Beavers to 64 yards each in 2015 week three and 2017 week one. The last time CSP had held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper lowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

Last week at UMary, Concordia topped 200 and held an opponent under 100 rushing again, bruising the Marauders for 206 yards on a school record 63 rushing attempts while limiting the Marauders to 61 yards on 32 carries for a 155 yard margin.

The Golden Bears have topped 200 rushing yards four times this year and are averaging over 60 yards more per game (178.9) on the ground than the 2017 squad (116.1) and are just 25 yards shy (1,252) of last year's total (1,277) with four games to play.

#### FLORIDANS LEAD THE BACKFIELD

Sophomore running back **Lajuan Preston** has been thriving with increased workload out of the CSP backfield, producing back-to-back 100-yard efforts in his first career games as the go-to running back in the offense against UMD (13-111) and Northern State (21-141). The Fort Myers, Florida native, along with junior **Darnell Rolle** (Miami) and sophomore **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg) have provided the Golden Bears with a steady presence from the Sunshine State the past two years, with redshirt freshman transfer from Akron **Jeremiah Johnson** (Pierce-Johnson) also coming from Miami joining the squad this year.

Rolle led the 2017 team with 627 yards at 4.9 per carry along with 75 receiving yards and three total touchdowns but has missed all seven games due to injury in 2018. Johnson earned the starting running back spot entering the 2018 season and was off to a big start with 367 yards rushing and 49 receiving with five total touchdowns in just four games before being lost for the season due to injury. He was averaging 5.6 yards per carry.

Last year, Johnson and Preston served as complimentary backs to Rolle and combined for 373 yards with a 4.8 average with Johnson breaking loose for a 17 carry, 175 yard and two TD outburst in the season finale against 5MSU, also throwing a 63-yard TD pass.

Preston is known for his breakaway speed as evidenced by his 73-yard touchdown in week two against Upper lowa this year, his first career score. But as the team's feature back the last three weeks with Rolle and Johnson sidelined, Preston has also been a steady source of positive yardage as he has not been tackled for a loss against UMD, NSU or UMary while rushing for 309 yards on 49 carries (6.3 avg).

Preston's back-to-back 100 yard rushing games is the first time since **Tre Spears** achieved the feat in the 2014 season when he had three straight to end the season (247, 206, 131) to win the program's only league rushing title (1,254) since joining the Northern Sun in 1999.

Preston is now climbing the league leaderboards, ranking ninth in total rushing yards (445) and sixth in yards per carry (6.4).

His 6.4 yards per carry average on the season ranks sixth in the league among Northern Sun players with at least 25 carries and also ranks third in CSP's Division II era for a single season (1999-present). In his young career, his 5.71 average (101-577) is currently third since the program jumped to DII in 1999.

He's joined in the backfield by senior Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** who had a breakout game against Northern State with 10 carries for 74 yards and a 36-yard touchdown run, junior Wyoming transfer **Garrett Gardner** ("Goo") with 24 carries for 96 yards and Pierce-Johnson from Akron who scored his first CSP touchdown against NSU. Further, the deep backfield is bolstered by fullback **Andre Eubanks**, a junior transfer from Mississippi Valley State and although he hasn't received a carry he has been a strong blocking back.

#### **GROUND GAME RUNS BEHIND BIG BEARS**

Concordia's ground game has been a strong group effort this season with the five running back rotation mentioned above being supplemented by senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy** (63-162) and backup junior **Maxon Hutton** (14-18) have also been featured prominently in the run game. Five different players have rushing touchdowns and only **Shaq Johnson** and McKinzy have reached paydirt on the ground two times.

It's a successful equation because of the one one constant: the offensive line. Led by veteran returning starters **Terrell Taylor** and **Rich Kelly**, the Golden Bears have also received strong play

across the line from Samuel Kessler (center), Ethan Aune (guard/tackle), Cris Wasylciw (tackle), Tanner Haechten (guard) and redshirt freshmen Matthew Montgomery and Tyson Kauffman.

Behind the big Bears up front, Concordia ranks third in the league in time of possession (31:47) and fifth in rushing offense (179.3). CSP has topped 200 rushing yards four times this season and is coming off a school record of 63 rushing attempts at UMary in week seven. Concordia's season low of 94 yards came against the top team in the country on the road (28-94) and is the only time the team has been held under 100 rushing yards. Further, the offensive line is ranked fifth in the league with fewest tackles for loss allowed per game (5.43).

#### MEET THE STARTING QB: DOM MCKINZY

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition in fall camp.

Just past the halfway point, McKinzy has passed for 1,192 yards on the season and had a season-high 262 yards in week six against Northern State in CSP's last home game, matching his season-high with 19 completions (19-31). He also completed 19 passes (32 attempts) against #20 Sioux Falls in week one (236 yds, 3 TDs).

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He has seen action under center in multiple games this year and is now 7-of-14 for 64 yards passing and has 14 rushing attempts for 18 yards with a long of 17.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

#### HASKINS OFF TO STRONG START AT THE CORNER

After starting his college football career with an INT in five straight games, redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** had the streak come to a close in week six against Northern State. But he still continues to lead the country with 19 passes defended (5 INT, 14 PBU) and leads the league across the three categories while ranking seventh in the country in interceptions. He is also tied for the team lead with 21 solo tackles.

In a 34-7 week two win over Upper Iowa, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an INT, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through seven weeks.

His week four performance in CSP's 29-7 win over WSC featured a pair of turnovers, forcing a fumble and picking off his fourth interception and breaking up a pair of passes. It was his coverage on the league-leading wide receiver **Nate Rogers**, who had been averaging 129.3 yards per game that stole the show, holding him to 40 yards on 5 catches.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** returned to the starting lineup in week six after playing sparingly in week five. He missed three games (2-to-4) due to injury. In three full games, Wallisch has nine tackles (eight solo) with a pair of pass breakups.

Wallisch is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances.

Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on UMC with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a redshirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons, joining CSP in spring of 2017.

In Wallisch's absence, sophomores **Lorenzo Kendricks** and **Desmond Hudnall** shared starts and assignments and will still rotate into the secondary regularly. Kendricks has 13 tackles and they have both recorded a pair of pass breakups.

#### **BASSETT BREAKS OUT AT UMARY**

@winona st

Redshirt freshman safety **Dez Bassett** jumped in front of a UMary pass in week seven for his first career interception, returning it 77 yards for a touchdown to break a scoreless tie in the third quarter. The impact play led to a 17-7 Golden Bear road win and secured Bassett NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors. He also broke up UMary's final pass on fourth down to put the game away in the fourth quarter.

Bassett is second on the team with 37 tackles and is second on the team in both pass breakups (3) and passes defended (4). He's made at least six tackles in five of CSP's seven games.

Joining Bassett at the safety position have been fellow redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers**.

Sheehan has started all seven games at the free safety spot and is seventh on the team with 25 tackles, adding a pair of pass breakups. He had a high of six tackles in week three at MSU and has had at least three tackles in six of the team's seven games this year.

Powers made his first career interception in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF, a one-handed highlight reel catch. He is tied with Bassett for second on the team with three pass breakups and four passes defended and had a high of four solo tackles against Wayne State in week four.

#### GARRETT EXPLODES UP NATIONAL SACK LEADERBOARD

Sophomore **Chris Garrett** has posted back-to-back seasonbest sack totals in weeks six (2.5 vs NSU) and seven (3.0 at UMary). The 5.5 sacks in two games give him 8.0 on the year in six games played, ranking third in the country and leading the NSIC in sacks per game. He is also sixth in the NSIC with 8.5 tackles for loss.

A rarity for a defensive end, Garrett is also fourth on the team with 30 total tackles, has made at least three tackles in every game and reached five-plus tackles in five of seven contests.

As a freshman in 2017, Garrett was a menace in the seven games he suited up in with 9.0 TFL and 6.0 sacks with five forced fumbles, three pass breakups while averaging over six tackles per game (44 total).

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the 2017 season at Augustana where he had 3 FF, 3 sacks and 3 TFL with nine total tackles - all career-highs.

In 13 career games, Garrett has 14.0 sacks, 17.5 TFL, six forced fumbles, nine quarterback hurries and 74 total tackles.

#### JUNIORS BRING MAJOR EXPERIENCE TO D-LINE

Joining Garrett up front are three juniors who have all been three year starters in the program: **Jackson Dobbs** on the other end with **Kelly Pierce** and **Dylan Wood** in the middle.

Providing depth as a breakout player is redshirt freshman **Shawn Aarhus** with 2.5 TFL, 1.0 sack, a pair of fumble recoveries and a forced fumble.

Six different linemen have recorded at least 1.0 sack and seven have at least 1.0 TFL.

Pierce ranks second on the team with 4.5 TFL and 3.5 sacks and is tied with Dobbs for the team lead with five quarterback hurries while Dobbs is third on the team with 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks.

In 24 career games, Dobbs has 102 tackles, 13.0 TFL, 7.0 sacks, 3 fumble recoveries and a pair of forced fumbles.

Wood has produced 2.0 TFL and 1.0 sacks among his 18 tackles on the year. He has played all 28 games over his career with 92 tackles and 14.5 tackles for loss with 9.5 sacks. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 23 career games, he's registered 81 tackles, 13.0 tackles for loss and 7.5 sacks.

## SCHENDERLEIN NABS MITCHELL AWARD PRESEASON HONOR

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017, including Schenderlein.

#### **GUSTAVESON REACHES 100 CAREER CATCHES**

Wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** has established himself as Concordia's top target as a three year starter, boasting four career 100-yard performances.

He became the 11th player to reach 100 career receptions in program history in week five at #8 UMD. He's also 10th in school history with 16 receiving touchdowns.

In the 2018 season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, Gustaveson hauled in five catches for 96 yards and a 33 yard touchdown to put CSP ahead 21-20 with under eight minutes to play.

In seven games, Gustaveson leads the team with a 17.9 per catch average (9th NSIC), is tied for the team lead and ninth in the league with 411 yards and is second on the team with 23 catches.

In his three seasons, he's amassed 1,631 yards (11th at CSP) on 107 catches (10th CSP) with 16 TDs (10th CSP).

Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and touchdowns (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore.

#### WILLIAMS MAKING AN IMPACT

Junior college transfer MJ Williams has been tough to stop since going without a reception in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, producing at least four catches and 58 yards in weeks two through six.

He broke out for his first career 100-yard game in week six against Northern State with season-highs of 7-115.

He now leads the team with 29 catches (14th NSIC) and is tied for the team lead with 411 yards (9th NSIC).

Prior to Concordia, Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league

#### PORTZ LEADING CSP LINEBACKERS IN 2018

Through seven weeks, redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** leads the team and is 29th in the NSIC with 44 tackles. The starting LBs, with sophomores **Andy Aune** (36) and **Blake Evans** (30) joining Portz, are 1-3-4 on the team with 110 total tackles as a unit.

Portz is fourth on the team with 3.0 TFL while Aune and Evans each have 1.5 TFL. Aune picked up his first sack at CSP in week five at #8 UMD while Portz had his first career sack in his debut at #20 USF.

Evans finished his rookie season on a tear in 2017, leading the team and ranking seventh in the NSIC with 97 tackles while Portz spent the year gaining strength and experience in the program as a redshirt and Aune was a redshirt freshman at the University of South Dakota where he was one of 18 redshirt freshmen to see action for the Coyotes, competing in four games.

#### SHEPLEY OFF TO STRONG START AS PUNTER

It was quite the debut for sophomore **Jake Shepley** at the punter position in week one. He averaged 47.3 yards on six punts with three eclipsing the 50-yard mark including a long of 66 which was pinned at the four yard line as CSP went toe-to-toe with #20 Sioux Falls on the road.

The 47.3 yard average in the opener was the fourth-best single game average in CSP history.

He doubled-down on the performance by averaging 46.0 yards on four punts with a long of 52 and two inside the 20 against Upper lowa in week two.

Through seven weeks, Shepley ranks sixth in the league with a 39.3 average.

Shepley is also a wide receiver, seeing action in four games with two catches as a true freshman in 2017 and continuing to get looks on offense this year in the dual role.
