THIS WEEK: FINAL NSIC NORTH-SOUTH CROSSOVER GAME
 Saturday's game marks a return to NSIC divisional play as the Golden Bears host the Vikings in the home finale at Sea Foam Stadium, honoring the program's 11 seniors. The game is presented by Summit Orthopedics, the official team physicians for Golden Bear athletics, who will be handing out CSP/Summit Ortho branded rally towels.

The 11 seniors include transfers **Dom McKinzy**, **Emanuel Jones**, **Isaiah Walker**, **Samuel Kessler**, **Davarus Clark** and **Cleandre Robinson** along with four year contributors **Jonas Schenderlein**, **Brandon Russell**, **Terrell Taylor** and **Adam Miller**. Those 10 will be joined by fourth year junior Brian Szutkowski, who will graduate following his junior football season.

There are three players listed as seniors with one more season of eligibility who intend to return next fall: **Jake Tanner**, **Andre Eubanks** and **John Damrow**.

"COACH C" TIES PROGRAM WINS RECORD

In just seven years as head coach, **Shannon Currier** has tied the school record for victories, winning his 40th game 21-13 against Minnesota Crookston at home in week eight. He reached 40 wins in five fewer games than **Mark Maurer** (40-39), who also coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10. Currier carries a 40-34 career record, has a 24-11 home record and is 7-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. **More on Coach Currier on page 3.**

STREAK BREAKERS

The Golden Bears snapped 13-game road losing skid in week seven with a 17-7 win at UMary. Their win to end the 2017 season over SMSU snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. This week, the club will look to snap a three game skid against Augustana.

NEW THIS YEAR: COACH CURRIER SHOW HITS THE RADIO!

This week's Coaches Show with **Shannon Currier** will air on Friday night on KYCR 1440 AM radio with host **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score. The show features player interviews with senior tackle **Terrell Taylor** and junior defensive lineman **Dylan Wood**.

The show typically airs Friday evening in the 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. hour following the prep football game of the week which is broadcast on KYCR 1440 AM.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show is accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, iTunes, Stitcher and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

For the third time this year, the CSP Bears Podcast featured a Concordia football player or alumni, this week featuring **Adrian Perryman** (2003-04). Adrian is now a CSP staff member in academic advising. The show has also featured German native, senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy**.

2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting back in the first week of fall training camp. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

This week's game captains feature familiar leadership faces, with senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy** (5x) and junior offensive lineman **Rich Kelly** (6x) on offense while junior defensive lineman **Kelly Pierce** returns to the role for the fourth straight week and junior defensive lineman **Dylan Wood** earns the nod for the second time this year (also in week 1).

SERIES HISTORY: CONCORDIA12, UM CROOKSTON 3

Concordia won three of the four meetings in the series when Augustana was a member of the now-defunct North Central Conference (NCC) from 2000 to 2007. But since Augie has been a Northern Sun member (2008-present), the Vikings have won nine of the last 10 contests including the last three. CSP's last win was a 17-7 home win in 2014 and Concordia is now 2-5 at home against the Vikings and 1-3 at Sea Foam Stadium (2009-present).

Coach **Shannon Currier** is 0-2 against Augustana, as the Bears didn't face the Vikings under his leadership from 2000-2003.

NOTES ABOUT THE VIKINGS

The Vikings come into the matchup 5-3 in the NSIC and 2-2 in the NSIC South. All of their wins have come against teams with losing records while all of their losses have been against teams with winning records to this point in the season.

The Vikings rely on a high-powered offense, as they rank 5th in the NSIC in points (34.9) and 11th in points allowed (27.9).

Augustana has the top passing attack in the NSIC led by sophomore QB **Kyle Saddler**, averaging 313.9 passing yards. That mark is 30+ yards more than the next highest team in the NSIC, SMSU. They also have the most passing TDs with 22.

Saddler has also attempted the second most passes in the NSIC (337), completing 51 percent. He has also thrown 11 INTs, the second most in the NSIC.

The Vikings have one of the top WRs in the league in junior **Nickel Meyers**, third in the NSIC in yards per game (100.4) and tied for second in TDs (9). He also ranks fourth in receptions (48).

Aside from Meyers, the Vikings spread the ball around to a variety of pass catchers. WRs **Brett Shepley** (47.35) and **Sean Engel** (49.86) are both averaging nearly 50 yards per game. TE **Chet Peerenboom** is averaging 16 yards per catch and has hauled in four TDs.

In the running game, sophomore **Rudolph Sinflorant** leads the way with 98.4 yards per game (4th NSIC) on 4.5 per carry. Sinflorant has also collected seven rushing TDs this season.

On defense, senior LB **Kirby Hora** leads the team with 8.9 tackles per game (4th NSIC). Hora is also second on the team with 7.0 TFL and an INT. Senior DE **Joey Newman** is 5th in the NSIC with 11.5 TFLs.

In the secondary, junior S **Michael Kloza** has four INTs and is fourth on the team with 39 tackles. Senior DB **Avram Tynes** has nine passes defended while redshirt freshman DB **Eli Weber** has eight, both top 15 in the conference.

Teams have been able to gain yardage against Augustana through the air, the Vikings are 12th in the conference in passing defense, giving up 225.5 passing yards per game.

The Vikings are the best in the conference when it comes to kickoff return yardage, as they average 26.1 yards per return. AU has also been stout on kickoff coverage, as they rank 2nd in the conference with a net average of 39.9 yards per kickoff.

LAST YEAR: AUGUSTANA 28, CONCORDIA 13

The Golden Bears traveled to Sioux Falls, South Dakota to take on the Vikings last season, falling 28-13 in a matchup held on November 4th at Kirkeby-Over Stadium.

The Golden Bears did nearly all their damage through the air in that contest, and were within one score in the closing minutes of the contest. Senior **Ron Johnson** passed 27-54 for 349 yards, a touchdown, and three interceptions.

Marcus Gustavson was the biggest benefactor of the pass-heavy game script, as the sophomore wide receiver caught 10 passes for 135 yards and a touchdown.

On the defensive side of the ball, freshman **Chris Garrett** dominated with his biggest game of the season. The defensive end racked up nine tackles (including 3.5 for loss), three sacks, and three forced fumbles, leading to NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors. Freshman linebacker **Blake Evans** led the team with 13 tackles and senior defensive back **Andrew Capirchio** collected 10 stops and picked off an Augustana pass.

Missed opportunities was the name of the game for CSP on a cold Saturday afternoon. From late in the third quarter to the end of the game, Concordia turned the ball over on four of its last six possessions. The Bears also had a pair of missed field goals, one in the first and one in the second quarter.

The first half of the game did not feature much offense for either team, as they traded empty possessions until late in the first when the Vikings scored on a 26-yard TD pass from **Kyle Saddler** to **Jake Welsheimer**. The Golden Bears were able to get on the board with a 55-yard field goal from junior **Jonas Schenderlein** in the second quarter, and the score would remain 7-3 until halftime.

After Concordia forced a turnover to start the second half, Schenderlein drilled another field goal (42 yards) to bring CSP to within one (7-6). Augustana scored on two passing touchdowns at the end of the quarter, with an interception thrown by CSP giving the Vikings the ball deep in Concordia territory on the second possession.

Concordia would score a TD on a pass from Johnson to Gustavson, but couldn't put more points on the board as the TD was sandwiched by interceptions, one of which was thrown in the end zone. The Vikings ran in a TD from a yard out late in the fourth quarter to seal the game.

LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 17, UMARY 7

Last weekend the Golden Bears hosted UM Crookston at Sea Foam Stadium. The Golden Bears defeated the Golden Eagles 21-13 on another cold and windy Saturday afternoon contest.

The running game and defense propelled Concordia to the victory for the second straight week, as the Golden Bears rumbled for 283 yards on the ground while holding Minnesota Crookston to 83 yards and just 1.7 yards per carry.

Concordia had two 100-yard rushers on the afternoon, including QB **Dom McKinzy** and RB **Lajuan Preston**. McKinzy rushed 15 times for 131 yards and a score, while Preston had 13 carries for 106 yards. The last time the Golden Bears had two 100+ yard rushers in a game was in 2005 against Wayne State College, when both **James McNear** and **Brian Holmes** accomplished the feat.

On defense, junior **Jackson Dobbs** had a huge game. The defensive lineman racked up nine tackles, including 4.5 TFLs (for 28 yards) and four sacks. Junior DL **Kelly Pierce** also posted impressive numbers, collecting eight tackles (1.5 for loss) and forcing one fumble. Sophomore LB **Dalton Smerchek** led the team in tackles with 12.

CSP got on the board quickly with a 75-yard touchdown drive, culminating in a 7-yard TD run by McKinzy. UMC hit a 19-yard field goal to bring the score to 7-3, which would remain the margin until halftime.

The defense came out swinging in the second half, with a **Dylan Wood** forced fumble leading to a 5-yard TD rush by RB **Emanuel Jones**. A forced fumble by Kelly Pierce on the next drive gave the Golden Bears the ball in UMC territory, and they struck on the next play with a 31-yard touchdown pass from McKinzy to WR **MJ Williams**.

Minnesota Crookston would score a TD and FG in the fourth quarter, but the Golden Bears would hold the Golden Eagles off for a 21-13 win.

Though the Golden Eagles held a 36:28 to 23:32 time of possession advantage, the Golden Bears used a 14-7 edge in points scored off turnovers to defeat UMC. The Golden Bears also held a substantial 6.4 to 4.1 advantage in yards per play.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season. Despite back-to-back two win campaigns with just three home wins, the Golden Bears ended 2017 on a high note with a win in the home finale over SMSU.

The 37-20 win in the 2017 finale over SMSU started a three game home winning streak for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history and the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears, he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 24-11 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 7-0 mark in home openers, a 4-2 mark in home finales and has the team with a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium for the third time since 2009 with a chance to produce the program's first 4-win season at Sea Foam Stadium today.

In week eight, Currier tied the program record for all-time wins with 40 (40-34), doing so in five fewer games than Mark Maurer (40-39, 2004-10).

HOME SWEET FOAM: HOW SWEET IS IT?

With a 3-1 home record in 2018, Concordia-St. Paul has enjoyed a strong home field advantage this year. The Golden Bears have outscored opponents by an average of 28.0 to 15.5 and nearly tripled up the opposition in rushing yardage with 986 to 333 (246.5 to 83.2 averages). The run game has topped 200 yards in all four games and held opponents to 131 yards or less each outing. Concordia averages 5.5 yards per carry in home games while opponents muster just 2.2 yards per rush.

Overall, CSP holds a 425.0 to 337.8 average total offense margin and rack up 6.2 yards per play while limiting foes to 4.3. The Bears have won the total offense tally in three of the four home games with the exception being a two yard disparity against UMC (353 to 355).

The defense has racked up 8.25 TFL per game while the offensive line has limited the damage to just 4.0 opponent TFLs per contest. Further, the defense holds a 17-to-8 margin sacks leading to 104-to-41 difference in lost yardage. The defense is also stifling opponents on fourth down to just 1-for-10.

SOUTH DIVISION TURNAROUND

With Concordia's 37-20 win in the 2017 season finale over SMSU, the Golden Bears snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. After ending 2014 on a four game winning streak - all South Division wins - to end the year 4-3 in the NSIC South, the Golden Bears went winless in the division in 2015 and 2016 before the 2017 victory over the Mustangs in the season finale.

The Golden Bears have now won three of their last five NSIC South contests, with all three wins coming at Sea Foam Stadium.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He is second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC

Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

TOUGH ROAD SLATE IN 2018

The Golden Bears had among the strongest road schedules to start the 2018 season with three consecutive road games against ranked opponents in weeks one, three and five. In the opener, CSP nearly started off its season with an upset over #20 Sioux Falls before the Cougars scored with three seconds to play to top the Bears 27-24. In week three, CSP fell 46-13 at #3 Minnesota State and Concordia fell in week five 32-3 at #8 Minnesota Duluth. MSU has moved up to #1 in the country and UMD is now #5.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 17 straight games to ranked teams, but the 2018 schedule does not feature another ranked opponent in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven with a 17-7 win at UMary and are now 1-3 on the road with two more road trips remaining in 2018 to end the season.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

TURNOVERS MATTER

Just a year ago, Concordia was plagued by the turnover margin on both sides, creating just over one per game on defense (with just three total INTs) while committing nearly two giveaways per outing. CSP only won the turnover margin twice and had a negative in the take/give six times. The result led to Concordia being outscored 47-22 off turnovers in a 2-9 2017 season.

But a program that had four defensive coordinators in four years from 2014 to 2017 is thriving in its second year under **Craig Stern's** direction. The squad has already forced 15 turnovers in eight games this year and its seven interceptions are more than double last season's total output. Additionally, the defense forced at least two turnovers in six out of eight games in 2018.

In the first four weeks, CSP held a 28-0 scoring advantage behind a +5 in the take/give (9-to-4).

The team's fortunes turned in the middle of the season, though, with three straight games on the wrong end of the take/give with a -9 in those three games leading to a 44-7 scoring deficit. In a decisive turn on homecoming, CSP turned it over six times and didn't force a Northern State turnover while facing a 28-0 deficit in points off turnovers in a 35-28 loss that included a pick-6 in the NSU red zone.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: BEARS SUCCESSFUL RUN GAME

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It carries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper Iowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over Wayne State in week nine.

It's the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards against UIU was the most CSP had achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary (29 carries, 1 yard).

It was just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP had held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State. The last time CSP had held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper Iowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

In week seven at UMary, Concordia topped 200 and held an opponent under 100 rushing yards again, bruising the Marauders for 206 yards on a school record 63 rushing attempts while limiting the Marauders to 61 yards on 32 carries for a +155 yard margin.

In week eight's 21-13 win over UM Crookston, Concordia rushed for a season-high 283 yards on 44 attempts (6.4 avg) and held UMC to just 1.7 yards per carry on 50 attempts (50-85).

The Golden Bears have topped 200 rushing yards five times this year and are averaging over 75 yards more per game (191.9) on the ground than the 2017 squad (116.1) have already surpassed last year's total (1,277) with 1,535 yards with three games to go.

FLORIDANS LEAD THE BACKFIELD

Sophomore running back **Lajuan Preston** has been thriving with increased workload out of the CSP backfield, producing three 100-yard efforts in his first four career games as the go-to running back in the offense against UMD (13-11), Northern State (21-14) and UM Crookston (13-106). Preston ranks 15th in the country (2nd NSIC) with a 6.72 rushing average and is seventh in the league with 551 total rushing yards. Perhaps as impressive as the yards and average, Preston has only lost two yards in 82 carries this year.

Preston's back-to-back 100 yard rushing games is the first time since **Tre Spears** achieved the feat in the 2014 season when he had 3-straight to end the season (247, 206, 131) to win the program's only NSIC rushing title (1,254) since joining the NSIC in 1999.

The Fort Myers, Florida native, along with junior **Darnell Rolle** (Miami) and sophomore **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg) have provided the Golden Bears with a steady presence from the Sunshine State the past two years, with redshirt freshman transfer from Akron **Jeremiah Johnson** (Pierce-Johnson) also coming from Miami joining the squad this year, transferring in from Akron.

Rolle led the 2017 team with 627 yards at 4.9 per carry along with 75 receiving yards and three total TDs but has not played in 2018 due to injury. Johnson earned the starting RB spot entering the 2018 season and was off to a big start with 367 yards rushing and 49 receiving with five total TDs in just four games before being lost for the season due to injury. He was averaging 5.6 yards per carry.

Last year, Johnson and Preston served as complimentary backs to Rolle and combined for 373 yards with a 4.8 average with Johnson breaking loose for a 17 carry, 175 yard and two TD outburst in the season finale against SMSU, also throwing a 63-yard TD pass.

Despite the injuries to Rolle and S.Johnson, CSP still employs a deep backfield. Senior Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** had a breakout game against Northern State with 10 carries for 74 yards and a 36-yard touchdown run. He has 43-155 on the year with three total TDs. Junior Wyoming transfer **Garrett Gardner** ("Goo") has added 28-119 (4.2) and has not been tackled for a loss and Pierce-Johnson from Akron adds 15-42 and a TD and has only one yard lost among his 15 totes. Further, the deep backfield is bolstered by fullback **Andre Eubanks**, a junior transfer from Mississippi Valley State and although he hasn't received a carry he has been a strong blocking back.

GROUND GAME RUNS BEHIND BIG BEARS

Concordia's ground game has been a strong group effort this season with the five running back rotation mentioned above being supplemented by senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy** (78-293) and backup junior QB **Maxon Hutton** (14-18). Five different players have rushing touchdowns led by McKinzy's three TDs.

It's a successful equation because of the one one constant: the offensive line. Led by veteran returning starters **Terrell Taylor** and **Rich Kelly**, the Golden Bears have also received strong play across the line from **Samuel Kessler** (center), **Ethan Aune** (guard/tackle), **Cris Wasylciw** (tackle), **Tanner Haechten** (guard) and redshirt freshmen **Matthew Montgomery** and **Tyson Kauffman**.

Behind the big Bears up front, Concordia ranks third in the league in time of possession (30:45) and fifth in rushing offense (191.0). CSP has topped 200 rushing yards five times this season, had a school record 63 rushing attempts in week 7 at UMary and a season-high 283 yards in week 8 against UM Crookston. Concordia's season low of 94 yards (28-94) came against the top team in the country on the road at MSU and is the only time the team has been held under 100 rushing yards. Further, the offensive line is ranked fifth in the league & 26th in the country with fewest tackles for loss allowed per game (4.88).

MEET THE STARTING QB: DOM MCKINZY

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Ols-gard** in a solid three way competition in fall camp.

McKinzy has passed for 1,262 yards on the season and had a season-high 262 yards in week six against Northern State, matching his season-high with 19 completions (19-31). He also completed 19 passes (32 attempts) at #20 Sioux Falls in week one (236 yds, 3 TDs).

As the season has hit the second half, McKinzy's run game has hit a new gear with 201 yards across 35 carries and a pair of TDs in wins at UMary in week 7 (20-70) and against UM Crookston in week 8 (15-131).

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He has seen action under center in multiple games this year and is now 7-of-14 for 64 yards passing and has 14 rushing attempts for 18 yards with a long of 17.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/ game) with 24 touchdowns.

BACK-TO-BACK NSIC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

The Golden Bears had back-to-back NSIC Defensive Players of the Week in wins at UMary in week 7 and against UM Crookston in week 8. Redshirt freshman **Dez Bassett** secured the honor at UMary with his first career interception, returning it 77 yards for a TD to break a scoreless tie in the third quarter in a 17-7 win. Junior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** followed with a 4.5 TFL, 4 sack, 9 tackle performance in a 21-13 win over UM Crookston. The 4 sacks are the second most in the NSIC and third most in Division II on the season.

HASKINS PUTTING UP ELITE NUMBERS IN ROOKIE YEAR

After starting his college football career with an INT in five straight games, redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** has continued his impressive rookie season by leading the country with 2.8 passes defended per game and his five INTs are tied for the NSIC lead and rank 10th in Division II football. In addition to the five INTs which is third most in a season in CSP's DII era (1999-pres), Haskins has a DII-era CSP record 17 pass breakups, with at least one in every game.

He's also produced 30 total tackles (23 solo) including seven (six solo) at #2 Minnesota State and has had at least three tackles in seven of eight contests.

In a 34-7 week two win over Upper Iowa, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an INT, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through eight games.

His week four performance in CSP's 29-7 win over WSC featured a pair of turnovers, forcing a fumble and picking off his fourth interception and breaking up a pair of passes. It was his coverage on the league-leading wide receiver **Nate Rogers**, who had been averaging 129.3 yards per game that stole the show, holding him to 40 yards on 5 catches.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** returned to the starting lineup in week six after playing sparingly in week five. He missed three games (2-to-4) due to injury. On the year, Wallisch has 13 tackles (12 solo) with a pair of pass breakups.

Wallisch is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances.

Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on UMC with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a redshirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons, joining CSP in spring of 2017.

In Wallisch's absence, sophomores **Lorenzo Kendricks** and **Desmond Hudnall** shared starts and assignments and still rotate into the secondary regularly. Kendricks has 14 tackles and they have both recorded a pair of pass breakups.

Redshirt freshman safety **Dez Bassett** jumped in front of a UMary pass in week seven for his first career interception, returning it 77 yards for a TD to break a scoreless tie in the third quarter. The impact play led to a 17-7 Golden Bear road win and secured Bassett NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors. He also broke up UMary's final pass on fourth down to put the game away in the fourth quarter.

Bassett is second on the team with 43 tackles and is third on the team in both pass breakups (3) and passes defended (4). He's made at least six tackles in six of eight games.

Joining Bassett at the safety position have been fellow redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers**.

Sheehan has started all eight games at the free safety spot and has 27 tackles and a pair of pass breakups. He had a high of six tackles in week three at MSU and has had at least three tackles in six of the team's eight games this year.

Powers made his first career interception in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF, a one-handed highlight reel catch. He is second on the team with four pass breakups and five passes defended and has 14 total tackles (11 solo) with three games of three-plus tackles.

GARRETT EXPLODES UP NATIONAL SACK LEADERBOARD

Sophomore **Chris Garrett** has been a tear the past three weeks, totaling 16 tackles, 7.5 TFL and 6.5 sacks. He's now third in the country with 1.29 sacks per game and is fourth in the NSIC with 1.5 TFL per game (38th DII). He's also tied for fourth on the team with 33 total tackles from the DE spot and has made at least three tackles every game.

As a freshman in 2017, Garrett was a menace in the seven games he suited up in with 9.0 TFL and 6.0 sacks with five forced fumbles, three pass breakups while averaging over six tackles per game (44 total).

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the 2017 season at Augustana where he had 3 FF, 3 sacks and 3 TFL with nine total tackles - all career-highs.

In 14 career games, Garrett has 15.0 sacks, 19.5 TFL, six forced fumbles, nine quarterback hurries and 77 total tackles.

He's already tied for the fifth most career sacks in CSP's DII era (1999-pres) and his 9.0 sacks on the year is tied for sixth most in a season since moving to DII 20 years ago.

DOBBS BREAKS LOOSE AGAINST UMC

With Garrett causing so much pressure on the opposite defensive end spot, junior Jackson Dobbs provided even more chaos to Minnesota Crookston's backfield in a 21-13 week eight win with 4.5 TFL, 4.0 sacks and nine total tackles to earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

With the huge outburst, Dobbs is now fourth in the NSIC

with 6.5 total sacks and 12th with 8.0 TFL. His 33 total tackles are tied for fourth on the team with Garrett, giving CSP a pair of playmaking defensive ends.

In 25 career games, Dobbs has 17.5 TFL and 11.0 sacks with 111 total tackles.

PIERCE & WOOD PRODUCTIVE ON INTERIOR DL

While Garrett and Dobbs have created the pressure from the ends, juniors **Kelly Pierce** and **Dylan Wood** have been stellar in the middle.

Pierce is third on the team with 3.5 sacks and 6.0 TFL while adding 28 total tackles while Wood has been strong as the nose tackle with 23 tackles, 3.0 for loss and a pair of sacks.

Wood has played all 30 games over his career with 97 tackles and 15.5 tackles for loss with 10.5 sacks. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 TFL and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 24 career games, he's registered 89 tackles, 14.5 tackles for loss and 7.5 sacks.

SCHENDERLEIN NABS MITCHELL AWARD PRESEASON HONOR

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017, including Schenderlein.

Wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** has established himself as Concordia's top target as a three year starter, boasting four career 100-yard performances.

He became the 11th player to reach 100 career receptions in program history in week five at #8 UMD. He's also 10th in school history with 16 receiving TDs.

In the 2018 season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, Gustaveson hauled in 5-for-96 yards and a 33 yard TD to put CSP ahead 21-20 with under eight minutes to play.

He's second on the team with 23 catches, 411 yards and a 17.9 average and adds a pair of TD grabs.

In his three seasons, he's amassed 1,631 yards (11th at CSP) on 107 catches (10th CSP) with 16 TDs (10th CSP).

Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and TDs (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore.

MJ WILLIAMS MAKING AN IMPACT

Junior college transfer **MJ Williams** has been tough to stop since going without a reception in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, producing at least four catches and 58 yards in weeks two through six.

He broke out for his first career 100-yard game in week six against Northern State with season-highs of 7-115.

He now leads the team with 30 catches (15th NSIC) and 442 yards (15th NSIC).

Prior to Concordia, Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and TDs (11).

RUSSELL WEARS #26 TO HONOR LATE FRIEND BILLY BROWN, JR.

Senior safety **Brandon Russell** changed jersey numbers from 23 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May. Billy passed away while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Russell has racked up 100 career tackles. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

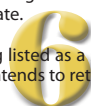
