THIS WEEK: CSP SEEKS WINNING SEASON IN FINALE

Concordia heads into the 2018 season finale seeking a winning season for the first time since 2011 when they head to Winona State, a place they've won just once in school history (2014). They'll face a tall task as the Warriors are seeking their third-straight 8-win season.

Concordia's last winning season was a 6-5 overall finish in 2011 and their last winning NSIC season was its 7-3 march to the 2010 Mineral Water Bowl when they finished fourth in the league standings. A win would also put the Golden Bears with their second winning NSIC South Division record since the league went to division play in 2012, and their first since a 4-3 finish in the South in 2014 thanks to a four game winning streak to end the season.

Further, a win for CSP and a loss by Sioux Falls at home to Wayne State would put the Golden Bears in their best NSIC South finish in a three way tie with USF and WSU. With some more help around the league, the Golden Bears have a shot to finish tied for sixth in the NSIC overall standings.

"COACH C" BECOMES CSP'S ALL-TIME WINS LEADER

In just seven years as head coach, **Shannon Currier** has become the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who also coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10. Currier now carries a 41-35 career record, has a 24-12 home record and is 7-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. *More on Coach Currier on page 3.*

STREAK BREAKERS

The Golden Bears snapped 13-game road losing skid in week seven with a 17-7 win at UMary. Their win to end the 2017 season over SMSU snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South. Last week, CSP snapped a 12-game road losing streak in the NSIC South Division with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

The CSP Bears Podcast has featured a Concordia football player or alumni three times this fall, most recently featuring **Adrian Perryman** (2003-04). Adrian is now a CSP staff member in academic advising. The show has also featured German native, senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** and senior quarterback **Dom McKinzy**.

2018 TEAM CAPTAINS

CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** has announced plans to have rotating team captains each week throughout the fall season, starting back in the first week of fall training camp. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

This week's game captains features a pair of familiar faces: junior offensive lineman **Rich Kelly** (8x) and junior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** (8x) being joined by sophomore defensive end **Chris Garrett** (3x) and first time team captain junior wide receiver **MJ Williams**. *A full listing of the team captains is available on page 5.*

SERIES HISTORY: WINONA STATE 16, CONCORDIA 4

The Golden Bears hold a 4-16 all-time record against Winona State as the teams have played every year since 1998. The Warriors won the first five meetings before head coach Shannon Currier beat WSU 23-20 in overtime at Griffin Stadium in 2003 en route to the program's first NSIC Championship and trip to the Mineral Water Bowl. Concordia topped WSU two out of three years, winning again in 2005 at the Metrodome to secure its second league title and MWB trip. From there, WSU opened up a seven game winning streak when Concordia topped WSU 23-13 in the Metrodome in 2013. In the 2014 season finale, Concordia secured its first road win at WSU, 31-28 to beat the Warriors in

NOTES ABOUT THE WARRIORS

Winona State (7-3) is looking for its third straight 8-win season.

The Warriors score an average of 32.7 point (6th NSIC) while allowing an average of 23.2 points (5th NSIC). Winona State has averaged 364.7 yards on offense (10th NSIC) and allowed 360.0 yards on average (7th NSIC).

Winona State is 9th in the conference in both passing yards per game (230.1) and rushing yards per game (134.6). Their rushing defense has been a bigger strength, ranking fifth in the NSIC with 121.9 yards given up on the ground, compared to 238.1 yards passing yards allowed per contest (12th NSIC).

Winona State sophomore QB **Owen Burke** is fifth in the conference with 220.6 passing yards a game, and also has thrown 20 touchdowns with a 53.9 completion percentage. Burke has also tossed eight interceptions this season.

His top target this season has senior wide receiver **Isaiah Frandsen** with 35 catches for 639 yards and eight TDs. Frandsen also has big play potential, as he ranks third in the NSIC in average yards per catch at 18.3.

The Warriors have two RBs who have carried the load in the ground game. Sophomore **Sam Santiago-Lloyd** leads the team with 524 yards and five total TDs while junior **Javian Roebuck** has 502 yards and three total TDs. **Eric Birth** adds 249 yards and four scores.

Winona State has had a balanced defense, which features eight players with 40+ tackles. Junior DB **Cole Monckton** leads the team with 58 stops, and is fourth in the NSIC with 14 passes defended. Senior defensive end **Michael Ferrante** leads the team with 11 TFL and has one forced fumble.

Sophomore DB **Isaiah Hall** and junior DB **Romario Gayle** have also had solid seasons for Winona State's secondary. Hall has picked off three passes and has eight other breakups while Gayle has snatched four INTs.

The Warriors have been stout on 3rd down, with opponents converting just 31.9% of the time (3rd NSIC). WSU has attempted just 16 4th downs this season, the 5th least in the NSIC. The Warriors have attempted 23 FGs (making 15), the most in the NSIC.

back-to-back years. The Warriors have won the last three meetings, with the closest margin of 18 points last year (28-10).

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds a 1-5 record against Winona State and is 0-3 in Winona. CSP is 1-7 all-time in road games against the Warriors.

LAST MEETING, 2018: WINONA STATE 28, CONCORDIA 10

In their last meeting, #13 Winona State topped the Golden Bears on a cold, rainy night in Sea Foam Stadium in October.

A defensive battle for most of the game, the Warriors pulled away in the fourth quarter to claim the victory. The deciding factor in the contest was the ground game, as WSU racked up 288 yards rushing yards compared to 54 for the Golden Bears.

Concordia got the scoring going in the first quarter, as a **Dion Wallisch** INT set up a 41-yard FG by **Jonas Schenderlein**. Winona State answered back with a 5-yard rushing touchdown by **Javian Roebuck**, and the score would remain 7-3 until halftime.

Concordia's defense came to play against one of the top teams in the country, with top-notch performances from the front seven and secondary. Freshman LB **Blake Evans** and junior DB **Brian Szutkowski** led the team with 14 tackles, as Evans also recorded half a tackle for loss and Szutkowski broke up a pass.

Another top playmaker on defense was LB **Antonio Zepeda**, who was third on the team in tackles with eight (including 1.0 TFL). Zepeda also forced a fumble and blocked a FG. Other standout performers were junior DB **Dion Wallisch** (INT, FF) and sophomore DL **Dylan Wood** (1.5 TFL, forced fumble).

The second half would be scoreless until the Warriors got back on the board with another Roebuck touchdown late in the third quarter, this time on a 16-yard run. They would score back-to-back touchdowns on drives to start the fourth quarter, both on goal-line runs by **Landon Jacobson** to take a 28-3 lead. CSP would add a TD late in the fourth on a 17-yard pass from sophomore QB **Maxon Hutton** to fellow sophomore WR **Marcus Gustaveson**, but that would end the scoring for the game.

CSP's defense showed their prowess against the undefeated Warriors on third down, holding Winona State to two conversions on 10 attempts. The Golden Bears were also a bit unlucky, as they forced three fumbles and blocked a kick, but were unable to recover any of the loose balls.

LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 16, SMSU 10

Despite a 13-game road losing streak that lasted until week 7 of this year, and taking a 12-game NSIC South Division road losing streak to Marshall, Minnesota, the Golden Bears were able to come away with a 16-10 road win at SMSU to secure back-to-back road victories.

The win was also the record-breaking victory for head coach **Shannon Currier**, who is the program's all-time wins leader with 41 (41-35) in his seven seasons.

The Concordia defense used seven sacks and a run defense that contained SMSU to 15 yards on 33 attempts and held SMSU to 0-for-4 on fourth downs to offset SMSU quarterback Blake Gimbel completing 32-of-46 for 353 yards through the air.

Concordia also won the turnover margin 1-to-0, recovering a fumble to end the game and playing turnover-free football for 60 minutes.

Sophomore defensive end **Chris Garrett** racked up four sacks and assisted on a 4th-and-1 tackle for no gain, also forcing a fumble. His performance led to D2Football.com National and NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

In the low scoring affair, the leg of senior kicker **Jonas Schenderlein** was a difference maker as the German delivered three field goals including two from 50-plus (53, 28, 52) while also crushing all five of his kickoffs for touchbacks.

Offensively, junior wide receiver **MJ Williams** had his second 100-yard performance with five catches for 105 yards and a long of 44. Concordia's quarterbacks, junior **Maxon Hutton** and senior **Dom McKinzy** combined to complete 10-of-23 for 165 yards. It was Hutton who found the end zone, connecting for a 20-yard first quarter score to sophomore **Keyon Walters**.

Hutton, who completed 4-of-9 for 49 yards through the air, was leading the team on the ground with 7-34 rushing at the half before exiting due to an apparent injury. Sophomore **Lajuan Preston** ended up leading the team's ground game with 10 carries for 50 yards, including 6-for-53 in the fourth quarter alone. Hutton did return to the field as a holder in the second half.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season. Despite back-to-back two win campaigns with just three home wins, the Golden Bears ended 2017 on a high note with a win in the home finale over SMSU.

The 37-20 win in the 2017 finale over SMSU started a three game home winning streak for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history and the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 24-12 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 7-0 mark in home openers, a 4-3 mark in home finales and has the team with a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium for the third time since 2009.

HOME SWEET FOAM: HOW SWEET IS IT?

With a 3-2 home record in 2018, Concordia-St. Paul has enjoyed a home field advantage this year. The run game topped 200 yards in four out of five home games and held opponents to 131 yards four times. Concordia averages 5.1 yards per carry in home games while opponents muster just 3.1 yards per rush.

Overall, CSP holds a 403.2 to 364.2 average total offense margin and rack up 5.9 yards per play while limiting foes to 4.8.

The defense has racked up 6.8 TFL per game while the offensive line has limited the damage to just 3.4 opponent TFLs per contest. Further, the defense holds a 17-to-11 margin sacks leading to 104-to-57 difference in lost yardage. The defense is also stifling opponents on fourth down to just 2-for-12 (16.7%).

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 7-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the seven home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 29.4 to 8.3 margin of victory, a total of 206 to 58.

TOUGH ROAD SLATE IN 2018

The Golden Bears had among the strongest road schedules to start the 2018 season with three consecutive road games against ranked opponents in weeks one, three and five. In the opener, CSP nearly started off its season with an upset over #20 Sioux Falls before the Cougars scored with three seconds to play to top the Bears 27-24. In week three, CSP fell 46-13 at #3 Minnesota State and Concordia fell in week five 32-3 at #8 Minnesota Duluth. MSU has moved up to #1 in the country and UMD is now #5.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 17 straight games to ranked teams.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven with a 17-7 win at UMary and a 12-game NSIC South road losing streak in week 10 at SMSU for a second straight road win. CSP is now 2-3 on the road in 2018.

TURNOVERS MATTER

Just a year ago, Concordia was plagued by the turnover margin on both sides, creating just over one per game on defense (with just three total INTs) while committing nearly two giveaways per outing. CSP only won the turnover margin twice and had a negative in the take/give six times. The result led to Concordia being outscored 47-22 off turnovers in a 2-9 2017 season.

But a program that had four defensive coordinators in four

years from 2014 to 2017 is thriving in its second year under **Craig Stern's** direction. The squad has forced 18 turnovers in 10 games this year and its nine interceptions are triple last season's total output. Additionally, the defense forced at least two turnovers in 7 games in 2018.

In the first four weeks, CSP held a 28-0 scoring advantage behind a +5 in the take/give (9-to-4).

The team's fortunes turned in the middle of the season, though, with three straight games on the wrong end of the take/give with a -9 in those three games leading to a 44-7 scoring deficit. In a decisive turn on homecoming, CSP turned it over six times and didn't force a Northern State turnover while facing a 28-0 deficit in points off turnovers in a 35-28 loss that included a pick-6 in the NSU red zone.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 7TH SEASON



Originally the eighth head coach of Concordia football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his second stint in December, 2015.

He is second in program history in both total victories and career winning percentage.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC

Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC Championship run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman (State) University where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his third and fourth seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

SOUTH DIVISION TURNAROUND

With Concordia's 37-20 win in the 2017 season finale over SMSU, the Golden Bears snapped a 20-game losing streak in the NSIC South Division. After ending 2014 on a four game winning streak - all South Division wins - to end the year 4-3 in the NSIC South, the Golden Bears went winless in the division in 2015 and 2016 before the 2017 victory over the Mustangs in the season finale.

After snapping the 20-game division losing streak in the finale last year, the team has won four of its last seven division games. Last week, it snapped a 12-game road division losing streak with a 16-10 win at SMSU and is aiming for a 4-3 division season.

The Golden Bears have produced a 3-1 record in the second half of the season, leading to four NSIC Player of the Week selections: three on defense and one on special teams. INSIDE THE NUMBERS: BEARS SUCCESSFUL RUN GAME

Just how significant was Concordia's ground game dominance in its week two 34-7 home opener win over Upper Iowa? It carries historical significance as the program continues to rise.

The Golden Bears rushed for 271 yards on 46 carries while holding Upper Iowa to just 17 yards on 24 attempts. The 254 yard margin on the ground was the biggest disparity since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, achieved twice that year, a 346 yard margin (459-113) in a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston in week seven and a 306 yard margin (337-31) in a 46-20 win over Wayne State in week nine.

It was the first time Concordia rushed for over 200 and held an opponent under 100 yards since a 2014 week two 28-21 loss to Northern State when the Bears rushed 45 times for 223 yards and held the Wolves to 76 yards on 33 carries.

The 271 yards against UIU was the most CSP had achieved since a 2014 week 10 win over Augustana (47-328) and the fewest rushing yards allowed since a 2012 season opening 32-26 loss to UMary (29 carries, 1 yard).

It was just the third time since week three of 2015 that CSP had held an opponent under 100 rushing yards, the previous two both coming against Minot State. The last time CSP had held an NSIC South Division opponent under 100 yards rushing was a 37-34 overtime win over Upper Iowa in week eight of 2014 when the Peacocks rushed 27 times for 33 yards.

In week seven at UMary, Concordia topped 200 and held an opponent under 100 rushing again, bruising the Marauders for 206 yards on a school record and NSIC season-high 63 rushing attempts while limiting the Marauders to 61 yards on 32 carries for a +155 yard margin.

In week eight's 21-13 win over UM Crookston, Concordia rushed for a season-high 283 yards on 44 attempts (6.4 avg) and held UMC to just 1.7 yards per carry on 50 attempts (50-85).

The Golden Bears have topped 200 rushing yards five times this year and are averaging nearly 60 yards more per game (173.8) on the ground than the 2017 squad (116.1).

FLORIDIANS LEAD THE BACKFIELD

Sophomore running back **Lajuan Preston** has been thriving with increased workload out of the CSP backfield, producing three 100-yard efforts in his first four career games as the go-to running back in the offense against UMD (13-111), Northern State (21-141) and UM Crookston (13-106). Preston was ranked as high as 15th in the country (2nd NSIC) with a 6.72 rushing average after week eight, still averages 6.5 per carry but does not have enough carries to qualify on the national list. He is seventh in the league with 607 total rushing yards. Perhaps as impressive as the yards and average, Preston has only lost eight yards in 94 carries this year.

Preston's back-to-back 100 yard rushing games was the first time since **Tré Spears** achieved the feat in the 2014 season when he had 3-straight to end the season (247, 206, 131) to win the program's only NSIC rushing title (1,254) since joining the NSIC in 1999.

The Fort Myers, Florida native, along with junior **Darnell Rolle** (Miami) and sophomore **Shaq Johnson** (St. Petersburg) have provided the Golden Bears with a steady presence from the Sunshine State the past two years, with redshirt freshman transfer from Akron **Jeremiah Johnson** (Pierce-Johnson) also coming from Miami joining the squad this year.

Rolle led the 2017 team with 627 yards at 4.9 per carry along with 75 receiving yards and three total TDs but has not played in 2018 due to injury. Johnson earned the starting RB spot entering the 2018 season and was off to a big start with 367 yards rushing and 49 receiving with five total TDs in just four games before being lost for the season due to injury. He was averaging 5.6 yards per carry.

Last year, Johnson and Preston served as complimentary backs to Rolle and combined for 373 yards with a 4.8 average with Johnson breaking loose for a 17 carry, 175 yard and two TD outburst in the season finale against SMSU, also throwing a 63-yard TD pass.

Despite the injuries to Rolle and S.Johnson, CSP still employs a deep backfield. Senior Northwest Missouri State transfer **Emanuel Jones** had a breakout game against Northern State with 10 carries for 74 yards and a 36-yard touchdown run. He has 49-166 on the year with three total TDs. Junior Wyoming transfer **Garrett Gardner** ("Goo") has added 28-119 (4.2) and has not been tackled for a loss and Pierce-Johnson from Akron adds 20-54 and a TD and has only one yard lost among his 20 totes. Further, the deep backfield is bolstered by fullback **Andre Eubanks**, a junior transfer from Mississippi Valley State. He's primarily used as a blocking back but has earned carries in back-to-back games in weeks 9-10, totaling 9-33.

GROUND GAME RUNS BEHIND BIG BEARS

Concordia's ground game has been a strong group effort this season with the six running back rotation mentioned above being supplemented by senior QB **Dom McKinzy** (94-323) and junior QB **Maxon Hutton** (31-100). Six different players have rushing touchdowns led by McKinzy's three TDs.

It's a successful equation because of the offensive line. Led by veteran returning starters **Terrell Taylor** and **Rich Kelly**, the Golden Bears have also received strong play across the line from **Samuel Kessler** (center), **Ethan Aune** (guard/tackle), **Cris Wasylciw** (tackle), **Tanner Haechten** (guard) and redshirt freshmen **Matthew Montgomery** (center) and **Tyson Kauffman** (guard/tackle).

Behind the big Bears up front, Concordia ranks fifth in the league in rushing offense (173.1). CSP has topped 200 rushing yards five times this season, had a school record and NSIC-high 63 rushing attempts in week 7 at UMary and a team season-high 283 yards in week 8 against UM Crookston. Further, the offensive line is ranked fifth in the league & 38th in the country with fewest tackles for loss allowed per game (5.3).

MEET THE QUARTERBACKS

Senior graduate transfer **Dom McKinzy** (full name Dimonic Roden-McKinzy) outlasted incumbent junior **Maxon Hutton** (7 starts in 2017) and junior Alabama A&M transfer **Jared Olsgaard** in a solid three way competition in fall camp. Hutton drew the start in week 10 although McKinzy remains atop the team's official two deep in week 11.

McKinzy has passed for 1,452 yards on the season and had a season-high 262 yards in week six against Northern State, matching his season-high with 19 completions (19-31). He also completed 19 passes (32 attempts) at #20 Sioux Falls in week one (236 yds, 3 TDs).

As the season has hit the second half, McKinzy's run game hit a new gear with 201 yards across 35 carries and a pair of TDs in wins at UMary in week 7 (20-70) and against UM Crookston in week 8 (15-131). He has 323 rushing yards and combined for 14 total TDs (11 pass, 3 rush).

McKinzy, a Kansas City, Kansas native, started his career at the University of Minnesota where he redshirted before transferring to Hutchinson Community College (Kan.). From there, he went to Northeastern State (Okla.) in the MIAA where he was an All-MIAA honorable mention quarterback. In parts of two seasons, McKinzy passed for over 3,600 yards in 15 games with four 300-yard performances. In two meetings against Pittsburg State, McKinzy passed for 311 yards and two touchdowns and no interceptions in 2016 and 323 yards and three touchdowns and no interceptions in 2017.

Hutton topped 1,000 yards and had six touchdowns in 2017, adding 234 rushing and another score while playing in and starting seven games before his season ended in week nine with an injury. He has seen action under center in multiple games this year and is now 20-of-41 for 268 yards passing and

has 31 rushing attempts for 100 yards with a long of 33. He's accounted for three total touchdowns, two passing and one rushing.

Hutton produced over 200 yards of total offense after entering midway through the third quarter in week nine against Augustana, engineering a pair of TD drives on just three plays: a one play, 76-yard TD pass to **Jake Shepley** and an 8-yard TD run on a two play, 28-yard drive. He finished his 2018 breakout game completing 9-of-18 for 155 yards through the air and team-highs 10-48 on the ground. In addition to the two TDs, he turned the ball over twice: a fumble and an INT.

Olsgaard earned his way to the Division I ranks by putting together an NJCAA All-Region XIII season at Minnesota State CTC (Fergus Falls), earning MCAC Player of the Year honors with 2,463 yards in eight games (307.9/game) with 24 touchdowns.

HASKINS PUTTING UP ELITE NUMBERS AS ROOKIE CB

After starting his college football career with an INT in five straight games, redshirt freshman cornerback **Marcus Haskins** has continued his impressive rookie season by leading the country with 2.6 passes defended per game and his seven INTs lead the NSIC and rank second in Division II football. In addition to the seven INTs which is tied for the most in a season in CSP's DII era (1999-pres), Haskins has a DII-era CSP record 19 pass breakups, with at least one in every game.

He's also produced 39 total tackles (32 solo) including seven (six solo) at #2 Minnesota State and has had at least three tackles in 0-of-10 contests. He's also forced a pair of fumbles.

In a 34-7 week two win over Upper Iowa, Haskins produced an NCAA DII single-game season high of seven passes defended with six breakups and an INT, a mark that is still tied for the national lead through nine games.

His week four performance in CSP's 29-7 win over WSC featured a pair of turnovers, forcing a fumble and picking off his fourth interception and breaking up a pair of passes. It was his coverage on the league-leading wide receiver **Nate Rogers**, who had been averaging 129.3 yards per game that stole the show, holding him to 40 yards on 5 catches.

He added another shut down effort in week nine against Augustana, when his two interceptions, two pass breakups and a forced fumble were clear individual stat lines. But he also held the league's third-ranked WR, **Nickel Meyers** to just two catches for 22 yards.

Although he didn't register a pass breakup or INT at SMSU, the Mustangs' top target **Daniel Davis** was held to 35 yards on six catches. Davis entered the game leading the NSIC and ranked 12th in DII football with 954 yards.

Opposite Haskins at the other corner, junior **Dion Wallisch** returned to the starting lineup in week six after playing sparingly in week five. He missed three games (2-to-4) due to injury. On the year, Wallisch has 19 tackles (16 solo) with a pair of pass breakups. The duo has teamed up for many of the shutdown performances on opposing top wideouts.

Wallisch is coming off an All-NSIC South honorable mention season when he had 13 pass breakups, two interceptions, two forced fumbles and a recovery while ranking third on the team with 58 tackles in 2017. He also consistently held opposing top receivers to slow statistical performances.

Wallisch is a transfer from Minnesota Crookston where he was fourth on UMC with 56 tackles including 4.5 for loss as a redshirt freshman in 2015. He missed the 2016 season at UMC due to medical reasons, joining CSP in spring of 2017.

In Wallisch's absence, sophomores **Lorenzo Kendricks** and **Desmond Hudnall** shared starts and assignments and still rotate into the secondary regularly. Kendricks has 15 tackles and they have both recorded a pair of pass breakups.

BASSETT BREAKS OUT AT UMARY

Redshirt freshman safety **Dez Bassett** jumped in front of a UMary pass in week seven for his first career interception, returning it 77 yards for a TD to break a scoreless tie in the third quarter. The impact play led to a 17-7 Golden Bear road win and secured Bassett NSIC Defensive Player of the

Week honors. He also broke up UMary's final pass on fourth down to put the game away in the fourth quarter.

Bassett is third on the team with 57 tackles and is second on the team in both pass breakups (6) and passes defended (7). He's made at least six tackles in 8-of-10 games and six in a row.

Joining Bassett at the safety position have been fellow redshirt freshmen **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers**.

Sheehan has started all 10 games at the free safety spot and has 35 tackles and a pair of pass breakups. He had a high of six tackles twice and has had at least three tackles in 7-of-10 games this year.

Powers made his first career interception in his debut in the season opener at #20 USF, a one-handed highlight reel catch. He is third on the team with four pass breakups and five passes defended and has 22 total tackles (17 solo) with five games of three-plus tackles.

GARRETT EXPLODES UP NATIONAL SACK LEADERBOARD

Sophomore **Chris Garrett** has been on a tear in the second half of the season, totaling 27 tackles, 11.5 TFL and 10.5 sacks in the past five games.

He earned D2Football.com National Player of the Week and NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors with a four sack performance (7 tackles), a fumble forced and a fourth down stop for no gain in a 16-10 road win at SMSU in week 10.

He is the national leader with 1.44 sacks per game and is 22nd in the country (2nd NSIC) with 1.6 TFL per game. He's also tied for fourth on the team with 44 total tackles from the DE spot and has made at least three tackles every game.

As a freshman in 2017, Garrett was a menace in the seven games he suited up in with 9.0 TFL and 6.0 sacks with five forced fumbles, three pass breakups while averaging over six tackles per game (44 total).

He earned NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors late in the 2017 season at Augustana where he had 3 FF, 3 sacks and 3 TFL with nine total tackles - all career-highs.

In 16 career games, Garrett has 19.0 sacks, 23.5 TFL, seven forced fumbles, nine QB hurries and 88 total tackles.

He's already fourth in career sacks in CSP's DII era (1999-pres) and his 13.0 sacks on the year ranks fourth in team history dating back to 1969.

DOBBS BREAKS LOOSE AGAINST UMC

With Garrett causing so much pressure on the opposite defensive end spot, junior **Jackson Dobbs** provided even more chaos to Minnesota Crookston's backfield in a 21-13 week eight win with 4.5 TFL, 4.0 sacks and nine total tackles to earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

Dobbs ranks seventh in the NSIC with 7.5 total sacks and 16th with 9.5 TFL. His 44 total tackles are tied for fourth on the defense.

In 27 career games, Dobbs has 19.0 TFL and 12.0 sacks with 122 total tackles.

PIERCE & WOOD PRODUCTIVE ON INTERIOR DL

While Garrett and Dobbs have created the pressure from the ends, juniors **Kelly Pierce** and **Dylan Wood** have been stellar in the middle.

Pierce is third on the team with 4.5 sacks and 7.0 TFL while adding 32 total tackles while Wood has been strong as the nose tackle with 27 tackles, 4.0 for loss and 3.0 sacks.

Wood has played all 32 games over his career with 101 tackles and 16.5 tackles for loss with 11.5 sacks. He broke out in 2017 as a sophomore with 51 tackles, 8.5 TFL and 5.0 sacks.

Pierce, meanwhile, played the first five games of the 2017 season before missing the rest of the year with an injury after playing all 11 games of 2016 as a freshman. In 26 career games, he's registered 93 tackles, 15.5 tackles for loss and 8.5 sacks.

SCHENDERLEIN NABS MITCHELL AWARD PRESEASON HONOR

The Golden Bears return one of the top kickers in the country in **Jonas Schenderlein** who was named to the Fred Mitchell Award Preseason Kickoff Watch List after being a national finalist for the honor last year.

Despite the national recognition from the Mitchell Award, Schenderlein was not an All-NSIC kicker as the NSIC South Division had some of the top statistical kicker seasons in the country in 2017, including Schenderlein.

He became the 11th player to reach 100 career receptions in program history in week five at #8 UMD. He's also 10th in school history with 16 receiving TDs.

In the 2018 season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, Gustaveson hauled in 5-for-96 yards and a 33 yard TD to put CSP ahead 21-20 with under eight minutes to play.

He's second on the team with 25 catches, 431 yards, leads the team with a 17.2 average and has two TDs.

In his three seasons, he's amassed 1,651 yards (11th at CSP) on 109 catches (10th CSP) with 16 TDs (10th CSP).

Last year, he led the Golden Bears in receptions (43), yards (656), yards per catch (15.3) and TDs (9) and increased his production in all four areas as a sophomore.

MJ WILLIAMS MAKING AN IMPACT

Junior college transfer **MJ Williams** has been tough to stop since going without a reception in the season opener at #20 Sioux Falls, producing at least four catches and 58 yards in weeks two through six and a pair of 100-yard games

He broke out for his first career 100-yard game in week six against Northern State with season-highs of 7-115 and topped 100 again in week 10 at SMSU with 5-105.

He now leads the team with 39 catches (16th NSIC) and 595 yards (15th NSIC) and four TDs.

Prior to Concordia, Williams was a 2016 All-California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) and All-Golden Coast Conference performer, leading the league with 960 yards while ranking second in catches (56) and TDs (11).

Russell has racked up 102 career tackles. As a sophomore in 2016, Russell had his top season with 48 tackles including 5.0 for loss.

PORTZ LEADING CSP LINEBACKERS IN 2018

Redshirt freshman linebacker **Jake Portz** leads the team and is 16th in the NSIC with 69 tackles, and has been the team leader in tackles for nearly the entire season.

Portz is 4th on the team with 4.0 TFL, had his first career sack in his debut at #20 USF. He's made at least six tackles in 7-of-10 games including each of the last five games and has made at least four tackles in 9-of-10 games in a breakout first year after spending last year as a redshirt.

Sophomore **Blake Evans** finished his rookie season on a tear in 2017, leading the team and ranking 7th in the NSIC with 97 tackles. He's battled through injury this season, missing three starts but only sitting out one game and still managed to record 34 total tackles.

Sophomore transfer **Andy Aune** is second on the team with 60 tackles, picking up his first sack at #8 UMD. Aune has 3.5 TFL and has made at least four tackles in 8-of-10 games. He

had his first double-digit tackle game with 11 stops in week 10 in a 16-10 win at SMSU. He was a redshirt freshman at the Univ. of South Dakota where he was one of 18 redshirt freshmen to see action for the Coyotes, competing in 4 games.

DAMROW GETS DOWNFIELD

Senior tight end **John Damrow** has come on strong as a receiving target in the second half and is fourth on the team with 149 receiving yards and second on the team with a 16.6 average. After compiling just two catches for 14 yards in the first four games, Damrow has been a key situational target with 7-135 and a TD in the past five games including a breakout 3-56 with a long of 34 against Northern State.

Damrow, despite being listed as a senior, retains one more year of eligibility and intends to return in 2019.

THREE SENIORS TO COME BACK FOR 2018 SEASON

Prior to senior day against Augustana in week nine, three Golden Bears decided to utilize their final season of eligibility for the 2019 season: wide receiver **Jake Tanner**, tight end **John Damrow** and fullback **Andre Eubanks**.

All three players have been key role players on the offense, each receiving multiple starts and each player has also been vital on special teams.
