THIS WEEK: LAST TWO UNBEATENS IN SOUTH SQUARE OFF

The Golden Bears, off to a 2-0 start for the first time since 2016 and the third time since 2004, hosts fellow unbeaten #3 Minnesota State on Saturday at noon.

CSP and MSU are the last two unbeaten teams in the NSIC South Division. Concordia is seeking to snap an eight game losing streak to the Mavericks, last defeating them in 2010 in CSP's run to the Mineral Water Bowl.

In that 2010 season, Concordia achieved a 5-win turnaround, going from 3-8 to 8-4 including the 28-26 win over a nationally-ranked opponent on the road (MSU) in Mankato.

CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

Last year in his seventh as head coach at Concordia, **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his eighth season, carries a 43-36 career record, has a 25-12 home record and is 8-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship. *More on Coach Currier on page 3*.

COACHES SHOW RETURNS TO TWIN CITIES RADIO IN 2019

The Coaches Show with **Shannon Currier** is back for a second year, once again hosted by **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score. The show airs following the Minnesota high school football game of the week, typically on Friday evenings in the 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. hour on KYCR 1440 AM radio, available in the Twin Cities metro area. This week's guests include sophomores **Shaq Johnson**, a running back, and **Jake Portz**, a linebacker.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show is accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, iTunes, Stitcher and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

CSP MAKES FROGTOWN RADIO DEBUT IN ST PAUL

Concordia continues to make a positive impression in the St. Paul community with local radio station WFNU (94.1 FM) starting a regular segment to air on Saturday mornings at 9:30 a.m. The first air time is set for Saturday, September 21, but the station has started recording interviews for a podcast titled "Concordia-St. Paul Scoreboard" which is available on Spotify and Anchor. CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** will have rotating team captains each week for the second year in a row. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

DOBBS HONORS FALLEN FRIEND WITH NUMBER CHANGE

Senior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** changed jersey numbers from 98 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown**, **Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May, 2018. Billy passed away shortly after graduating while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Dobbs has racked up 133 career tackles, 21.5 TFL and 13.0 sacks in 30 games and is a sixth year senior.

NOTES ABOUT THE MAVERICKS

Established as one of the top programs in the country, Minnesota State is coming off a season in which they earned a trip to the NCAA Semifinals. The Mavericks have ranked inside the top-five in the country all season, ranking #3 heading into the week. They were also picked at the top of the NSIC Overall and South Division in the preseason coaches poll.

The Mavericks improved to 2-0 last weekend as they bested the Augustana Vikings 27-7 at Blakeslee Stadium

As a team, MSU is averaging 32.5 points and 550.0 yards of offense a game this season. The Mavericks are averaging 364 rushing yards a game, while allowing just 42.5 rushing yards a game.

Senior **Nate Gunn** leads the Maverick rushing attack with 380 yards and four touchdowns, while junior **JD Ekowa** has tallied 112 rushing yards. Ekowa has also thrown for 180 yards and a touchdown this season, while senior **Ryan Schlichte** has tallied 192 passing yards and two touchdown passes.

Senior **Shane Zylstra** is pacing the Maverick receiving corps with nine catches for 186 yards and three touchdowns. Senior **Justin Arnold** has tallied seven catches for 99 yards also.

The Maverick defense has allowed just 15.0 points and 338 yards of offense per game this season. Opposing teams own a 26% conversion rate on third down this season and have reached the red zone just three times. As a unit, MSU has notched eight sacks, while giving up just one.

Senior **Zach Robertson** is leading the MSU defense with 13 tackles, including 3.0 for a loss and 2.0 sacks. Junior **Cole Schroedermeier** has tallied 10 tackles and a pair of interceptions as well, while junior **Jack Leius** has tallied 11 tackles and an interception as well.

Sophomore kicker **Luke Williams** is 4-for-4 in field goal attempts including a pair of 36 yard field goals last weekend against Augustana.

SERIES HISTORY: MINNESOTA STATE 11, CONCORDIA 2

Entering the 14th meeting between the programs, Minnesota State holds an 11-2 advantage and 8-game winning streak over Concordia. The Golden Bears have not scored more than 13 points against MSU in seven straight defeats and CSP has never held MSU under 21 points in the previous 13 meetings.

While one of CSP's wins over MSU was in St. Paul, that came at Griffin Stadium in 2005, a 35-21 win prior to MSU joining the NSIC. That year, CSP went on to win the NSIC and reach the Mineral Water Bowl.

In CSP's other win in 2010, the Golden Bears secured the victory with blocked field goal by sophomore **Zach Moore**, who went on to be drafted by the New England Patriots in the sixth round of the 2014 NFL Draft. Moore had 10.0 sacks in nine games that season, helping CSP to a 5-win turnaround, finishing 8-4 and reaching the Mineral Water Bowl for the third time in program history and first since 2005 - the only other time CSP defeated MSU.

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds an 0-3 record against Minnesota State and is 0-1 at home against the Mavericks. In Currier's first term in 2000-to-2003, the all-time series had not yet started with the teams first meeting in 2004. Concordia is 0-5 against MSU at Sea Foam Stadium, and the Mavericks have been ranked at least #11 nationally in each of their five prior trips to Sea Foam.

LAST MEETING, 2018: MINNESOTA STATE 46, CSP 13

Facing the number two team in the country on the road, the Golden Bears found themselves unable to pull out of a second quarter tailspin that led to a 46-13 loss at Blakeslee Stadium.

The Mavericks' 32-0 second quarter included back-to-back safeties to not only add to its own point total, but also kept Concordia's offense off the field after a strong showing in the first quarter.

The Golden Bears opened the game's first 15 minutes by matching MSU's six first downs and had piled up 134 yards of total offense compared to 139 for MSU. In a key momentum shift, CSP had a drive stall at the MSU 33 yard line, and facing a stiff wind elected to punt. When punter/wide receiver **Jake Shepley** pinned MSU at its own two yard line, the Mavericks were able to convert a third and short. Two plays later, they struck with an 83-yard touchdown run by **Justin Taormina**.

The Golden Bears were able to get on the scoreboard late in the first quarter when **Dom McKinzy** connected with **MJ Williams** for a 16-yard score. Williams finished with four catches for 58 yards and **Marcus Gustaveson** added 3-for-58.

In MSU's decisive second quarter, the Mavericks scored on a 3rd-and-18 with a 27-yard passing TD from **JD Ekowa** to **Jalen Sample** and a 53-yard TD pass from Ekowa to **Shane Zylstra**. Then the two safeties, with MSU scoring touchdowns after each.

From the 7:35 mark of the second quarter to the 7:22 mark of the third, which spanned over 15 minutes of game clock, CSP had the ball for only one minute and 13 seconds and ran four offensive plays resulting in two safeties.

After the statistically even first quarter, the Golden Bears saw MSU rally for a 12-0 margin in second quarter first downs and a 270 to -14 margin in total offense.

Without the second quarter, MSU outscored CSP 14-13 in the other three quarters and had a 270-to-230 edge in total offense.

But the cumulative totals painted the 46-13 outcome, with MSU featuring 541 yards of offense to CSP's 216, 27-to-11 in first downs and 37:44 to 22:16 in time of possession.

The Concordia offense was led by **Shaq Johnson** who had 14 carries for 87 yards including a 2-yard TD run in the fourth quarter. **Jake Portz** led the defense with 12 tackles.

Taormina led MSU with 158 rushing yards on 13 carries while CSP held one of the league's best running backs, **Nate Gunn**, to 14 carries for 54 yards (3.9 avg) and a touchdown.

LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 28, UPPER IOWA 23

The Golden Bears snapped a 10-game losing streak in road night games, rushing for 300 yards and four ground scores in a 28-23

win at Upper lowa. It was CSP's first win in a road night contest since 2013, a 17-14 win at Bemidji State.

Concordia pulled out to a 28-10 lead early in the second half before Upper lowa attempted to rally in front of a strong crowd on their home opener in Fayette.

UIU scored a pair of touchdowns and had the ball multiple times with a chance to take the lead late before the CSP defense secured back-to-back fourth down stops to seal the win.

Concordia reached the 300 rushing yard mark for the first time since hitting the total in back-to-back games in November, 2014.

Sophomore **Shaq Johnson** was a catalyst, rushing for 118 yards on 12 carries including a first half touchdown. He had long runs of 51 and 46 yards along with a 36 yard reception and a 25 yard kickoff return. By game's end, Johnson had totaled 179 all-purpose yards on 14 touches.

He was just one of four in CSP's deep backfield who reached the end zone, however, as senior **Cole Kirchoff** had CSP's first score of the game from three yards out to tie the game in the first quarter prior to Johnson's late first quarter touchdown for the lead.

Freshman **Darios Crawley-Reid**, making his CSP debut, had a 10yard touchdown midway through the second quarter and junior **Lajuan Preston** had a 17-yard touchdown in the middle of the third to put CSP ahead 28-10.

Preston also had a strong day, rushing for 72 yards on 12 carries (6.0 avg).

The run game was aided by quarterback **Maxon Hutton** with nine carries for 62 yards and a long of 18. The senior also completed 8-of-16 for 94 yards and a long of 36.

His top target was senior **Jabril Clewis** with three catches for 35 yards and a long of 18.

Defensively, sophomore linebacker **Jake Portz** was all over the field, leading the team with 18 tackles - second most in a game in school history and enough to earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

He was a key part of a CSP defense that held Upper Iowa to 3.1 yards per rush on 35 carries (109 yards).

Junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** racked up 1.5 sacks and TFLs for the second straight game among his six total tackles and senior **Kelly Pierce** was second on the team with eight tackles, 1.0 for loss and a half sack.

Upper lowa, playing from behind, found success through the air as Jake Schuman completed 27-of-44 for 239 yards and three touchdowns. He connected for all three scores with **Alexander Stevens** who had 7-81 receiving.

PRESEASON & RETURNING ALL-AMERICAN: CHRIS GARRETT Junior defensive end Chris Garrett comes into 2019 as a D2Football.com Preseason All-America First Team selection. He is off to a strong start with 1.5 sacks and TFLs in each of the first two weeks for 3.0 sacks and TFLs on the year.

He is coming off a year in which he was named All-America First Team by the AFCA and Associated Press, Second Team by D2C-CA and Third Team by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

Last year, he led the country with 1.65 sacks per game and was fourth in the nation with 1.90 tackles for loss per game.

He set the school single season sacks record with 16.5 in just 10 games.

After finishing his sophomore year on a torrid pace with 14.0 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss and 36 total tackles in the last six games, Garrett's streak has carried over into 2019, giving him 17.0 sacks, 19.0 TFL and 47 total tackles in an eight game stretch.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM

Prior to head coach Shannon Currier returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU started a three game home winning streak including the first two games of 2018 for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

HEAD COACH SHANNON **CURRIER | 8TH SEASON**



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference

title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 8-0 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 25-12 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji

State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a guar-

terback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 25-12 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 8-0 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

HOME SWEET FOAM: HOW SWEET IS IT?

With a 3-2 home record in 2018, Concordia-St. Paul enjoyed a home field advantage a year ago. The run game topped 200 yards in four out of five home games and held opponents to 131 yards or less four times. Concordia averaged 5.1 yards per carry in home games while opponents mustered just 3.1 yards per rush.

Overall, CSP held a 403.2 to 364.2 average total offense margin and racked up 5.9 yards per play while limiting foes to 4.8 in 2018 home games.

The defense also racked up 6.8 TFL per game while the offensive line limited the damage to just 3.4 opponent TFLs per home contest. Further, the defense held a 17-to-11 margin in sacks leading to 104-to-57 difference in lost yardage. The defense also stifled opponents on fourth down to just 2-for-12 (16.7%).

In the 2019 home opening win over Sioux Falls (41-17), Concordia won the turnover margin 2-0, registered six sacks adn held the Cougars to 0-of-3 on fourth down and 4-of-13 on third down.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 8-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 4-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the eight home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.9 to 9.4 margin of victory, a total of 247 to 75.

TOUGH HOME SLATE IN 2019

After playing a tough road schedule a year ago, the flipped opponents in the South Division lead to a rough home slate in 2019. Concordia's six home opponents in 2019 combined for a 45-21 overall record last year, and only one of them (SMSU) had a losing season (4-7). The Golden Bears host, in order, Sioux Falls (7-4), Minnesota State (11-0), MSU Moorhead (8-3), Bemidji State (7-4). SMSU (4-7) and Winona State (8-3) in 2019.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 17 straight games to ranked teams.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven in 2018 with a 17-7 win at UMary, snapped a 12-game NSIC South road losing streak in week 10 at SMSU in 2018 and in 2019 the program snapped a 10 game road night game losing streak with a 28-23 win over Upper lowa in a streak that dated back to 2013.

TURNOVERS MATTER

As CSP's program has grown under head coach **Shannon Currier**, the team's steady veteran offensive line has provided more protection for its quarterbacks, leading to more consistent ball control. Defensively, a talented and deep defensive line has helped create pressure in opposing backfields, leading to more forced fumbles and hurried passes leading to interceptions down field under third year defensive coordinator **Craig Stern**.

Since Currier has rejoined the program in 2016, Concordia has produced a 5-3 record when winning the turnover battle including three straight wins. In week two at Upper lowa, the Golden Bears lost the turnover battle (2-0) but came away with a 28-23 win, just the second time they've done so in 17 games since 2016 when losing turnove margin. When turnovers are even, CSP is 4-6 since 2016.

DEVIN FLAKES BLOCK PARTY

Freshman defensive back **Devin Flakes** is off to an exceptional start to his college career, blocking a pair of punts while seeing regular action on special teams in his debut as a true freshman. The blocked punts came in a 24-0 second quarter for CSP in a season-opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. The first, recovered by junior defensive back **Preston Piltoff**, set up a two play scoring drive while the second was recovered by junior defensive back **Lorenzo Kendricks** for a touchdown at the end of the quarter for a 27-7 halftime lead over the Cougars.

The special teams is led by third year special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**, with the Golden Bears blocking 10 kicks and punts since 2017 in 24 games.

DEEP & EXPERIENCED ON THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE

The 2019 Golden Bears' strength is up front, returning all but one combined starter between the offensive and defensive lines. While four year starting tackle Terrell Taylor graduated from the offensive line, the Golden Bears actually return five blockers with starting experience, along with all four starting defensive linemen. (Games started listed below)

On defense, the four starters: **Kelly Pierce** (28), **Jackson Dobbs** (27), **Dylan Wood** (22) and **Chris Garrett** (14) have played a majority of snaps together over the past three years.

On offense, Rich Kelly (32), Ethan Aune (22), Tanner Haechten (13), Cris Wasylciw (10) and Matthew Montgomery (4) have provided the Golden Bears with the muscle up front. Montgomery earned the starting center role in 2018 as a redshirt freshman before his season ended with injury earlyon, but is now in his third year in the program while Wasylciw was a transfer with prior experience.

SENIORS FLANK GARRETT ON D-LINE

While junior **Chris Garrett** garners the attention that comes with All-America and Preseason All-America honors, he's joined by four tenacious seniors who are accomplished in their own right: **Dylan Wood, TJ Diallo** and **Kelly Pierce** on the interior and **Jackson Dobbs** on the opposite end.

The statistical leader of the trio, Dobbs has compiled 133 career tackles, 21.5 tackles for loss and 13.0 sacks across 30 games.

In 29 games, Pierce has 106 tackles, 17.5 for loss and 10.0 sacks while Wood has played in the most games (35) with 108 tackles, 18.0 for loss and 11.5 sacks. Diallo, a second year transfer, earned the start in week two alongside Wood and has made 18 tackles (1.0 TFL) in 13 games.

So far in 2019, Pierce has 10 tackles, 1.0 TFL and 0.5 sacks, Dobbs with 9 tackles, 1.5 TFL and 0.5 sacks while Wood has 7 tackles, 1.5 TFL

The depth on the defensive line is notable with senior **Cole Marmor** and sophomores **Richard Ficociello** and **Shawn Aarhus**. Ficociello had a big season opener with five tackles, 1.5 TFL and a sack and Aarhus added a sack.

The defensive line combined for five of the team's six sacks in the season opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls and has seven of the team's eight sacks on the season.

SHAQ & LP LEAD A DEEP GROUND GAME

The running back group is led by sophomore **Shaq Johnson** and junior **Lajuan Preston**. Preston became an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention rusher a year ago when Johnson's season ended in week four against Wayne State.

Prior his season ending injury, Johnson was on a torrid pace with over 100 combined rushing/receiving yards per game (367 rushing, 49 receiving) and five total touchdowns in four games. He had 22 carries for 110 yards and 2-26 receiving with a TD against Upper lowa and two touchdowns in the season opener at Sioux Falls.

Preston picked up where Johnson left off, gashing Minnesota Duluth, Northern State and Minnesota Crookston for 100-plus rushing yards in a four game stretch including 21-141 against Northern. He finished the year averaging 6.5 per carry with 704 rushing yards.

Through two games, Preston leads the team with 152 yards, a 6.1 average and two touchdowns and is just 12 yards away from 1,000 for his career with 166 carries for 988 yards and a 6.0 career average.

Johnson made his debut in week two, reaching 100-plus yards for the third time in his career with 12 carries for 118 yards, adding a 36 yard catch and 25 yard kickoff return for 179 yards on 14 touches. He also found the end zone for his ninth touchdown (10 with passing included).

Adding to CSP's ground threat is athletic quarterback **Maxon Hutton**. The senior, who had 100-plus rushing in the 2018 finale at Winona State last year, has already rushed for 129 yards on 23 carries (5.6 avq) with a TD run.

All three have 100-yard performances: Preston (3), Johnson (3) and Hutton (1).

NEWCOMERS TO THE BACKFIELD

It was senior **Cole Kirchoff** who drew the start in week one, producing 21 combined yards on eight touches with 6-12 rushing and 2-9 receiving. He found the end zone in week two at UIU.

Kirchoff joined the football roster in 2019 after a four year run with the baseball team where he was a starting out-fielder with three homers, three triples, 17 stolen baes and was third on the team with 20 RBIs.

Darios Crawley-Reid made his debut at Upper lowa, and the true freshman got off to a strong start with 7-45 rushing and a touchdown and a 15 yard catch. Crawley-Reid is the younger brother of Chris Garrett

Look for DI transfer **Ethan Falaniko** from South Dakota to also make an impact in the ground game, so far with one carry for four yards but also without the ball as a strong blocking back.

HUTTON UNDER CENTER

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has ascended to the starting quarterback role after starting multiple games each of the past two seasons. The dual-threat quarterback has compiled 2,383 yards of total offense and 15 total touchdowns in his

In the season opener, Hutton completed 13-of-22 (.591) for 159 yards and two touchdowns while adding 67 rushing yards on 14 carries and a touchdown. The senior also showed the poise necessary to lead a turnover-free offense.

Since Coach Currier has returned in 2016, the Golden Bears have produced a 5-3 record when winning the turnover battle. During that same time, CSP is 2-15 when losing the turnover margin and 4-6 when turnovers are even.

Backing him up is senior **Jared Olsgaard**, a transfer from Alabama A&M by way of Minnesota State Community & Technical College. In addition to being the backup QB, Olsgaard has the unique distinction of a dual-role as the top option at punt returner where he holds an 8.5 average on the year (4-34).

Depth at the position is provided by junior transfer **Johnny Saavedra** and redshirt freshmen **Darion Manning** and **Abe Schwartz**. Schwartz has earned a role on the roster as a special teams contributor, and has made two tackles in each game.

THREE DEEP WITH SENIOR WIDE RECEIVERS

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has three senior wide receiver targets with complimentary skillsets: fourth year starter **Marcus Gustaveson**, second year junior college transfer **MJ Williams** and graduate Division I transfer **Jabril Clewis**.

In week one, Hutton completed nine of his 13 passes to the trio for 129 of his 159 passing yards and all three had a catch for 20 or more yards and two of them had touchdowns.

Williams led the group with 5-61 with a 33 yard touchdown, Clewis was 2-43 with a long of 37 and Gustaveson was 2-25 with a 20-yard score.

Through two full games, Clewis leads the unit with 78 receiving yards on five catches and a 15.6 average.

GUSTAVESON CLIMBING THE RECEIVING CHARTS

Fourth year starting wide receiver **Marcus Gustaveson** has established himself as one of CSP's top receivers in recent years. He has four career 100-yard performances and is climbing the CSP career receiving charts.

He's tied for ninth in career touchdown catches (17), 10th in receptions (112) and 11th in receiving yards (1,681). He opened the year with two catches for 25 yards and a 20-yard TD in a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls.

BASSETT AT SAFETY & IN THE RETURN GAME

Sophomore safety **Dez Bassett** enters 2019 as the team's starting strong safety (rover) and is a kickoff return option. In the opener, he averaged 24.5 yards on a pair of kick returns with a long of 31. Bassett has a career 21.4 average and long of 55 on 13 returns.

He had three tackles in the 2019 opener and four in week two. He was second on the team a year ago with 65 tackles after breaking into the starting lineup in week three. His redshirt freshman 2018 season also included seven pass breakups and a 77-yard interception return for touchdown in a win at UMary.

Joining Bassett at the safety position are fellow sophomores **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers** at free safety.

Sheehan started all 11 games last year and the first two of 2019 and has nine tackles with a pass breakup through two games. He's up to 46 career tackles in his young career.

Powers has 27 career tackles, four pass breakups and an interception and also had three tackles in the 2019 opener.

SMERCHEK IN WEEK ONE, PORTZ IN WEEK TWO FOR LBs

While sophomore **Jake Portz**, the mike linebacker, was the team leader with 77 tackles a year ago, it was junior WLB **Dalton Smerchek** who had the impact performance in week one to earn NSIC Player of the Week honors.

Smerchek made nine tackles, 1.5 for loss, forced a fumble at the goal line, recovered a muffed punt, had a pass breakup and pair of hurries. One of his tackles was a TFL at the goal line, forcing a field goal two plays later and one of his hurries came on fourth down in the second half.

Initially a long snapper and key special teams contributor, Smerchek has turned into one of the top players on the defense in his junior season. In 24 games, he's record 69 tackles, 3.5 for loss, three fumble recoveries and two forced fumbles. He has 12 tackles, 1.5 TFL, 1 FF and 1 FR in two games in 2019.

Portz picked up where he left off a year ago when he started all 11 games and averaged seven tackles per contest as a redshirt freshman. He opened the season with seven tackles in the win over Sioux Falls, before producing the second most tackles in a game in school history in CSP's 28-23 win at Upper lowa to keep the NSIC Defensive Player of the Week in the CSP linebacker family for a second straight week.

Portz leads the league and is fifth in the Northern Sun with 25 tackles in two games (12.5 per game) and topped the 100-mark with 103 in his first 13 career games (5.0 for loss).

The unit is flanked by SLB **Gabe Nkumu** who has eight tackles in two weeks. Nkumu rejoined the program after a year away when he played nine games as a freshman in 2017 with six tackles, 2.5 for loss, 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble.

CORNERS PRODUCE IN NEW ROLES

The Golden Bears have a pair of new starters at corner, junior transfer **Preston Piltoff** and junior **Lorenzo Kendricks** in his third year in the program. Kendricks was one of the team's co-captains in week one, making three tackles and falling on a blocked punt for a touchdown. He's played in 24 career games with 47 tackles and four pass breakups in his career.

Piltoff had four tackles (three solo) in his debut with CSP, also adding a fumble recovery at the goal line and recovering a blocked punt in a busy first half. In two games, he has matched Kendricks' seven tackles and added a pass breakup.

The secondary helped hold Sioux Falls to under 50-percent (16-of-33) passing for 217 yards.

LAUDET ASSUMES KICKING AND PUNTING DUTIES

Replacing one of the top kickers in the country is not an easy task, but the Golden Bears turned to an internal option with **Danny Laudet** who is in his third year in the program and has familiarity with the graduated **Jonas Schenderlein**.

Further, Schenderlein has remained in the program as a graduate assistant, working with the kicking game.

Laudet has responded to the additional duties, converting 2-of-2 field goals (30, 29), all five PATs for 11 points, three of eight kickoffs for touchbacks in his debut at kicker in the 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. Through two weeks, he's cashed in all nine of his PATs and has four touchbacks

As a punter, Laudet continued to deliver on his reputation

for high, long hang time punts that confound opponents. He averaged 37.4 yards on five punts, forced three fair catches and pinned one inside the 20. One of his punts was muffed, and recovered by the Golden Bears, as well.

He upped his game in week two with a 48.0 average on four punts with a long of 51 and two inside the 20.

He's averaging 42.11 on the young season and his career average of 39.31 puts him in line to contend for the season (41.32) and career (39.32) records.

TRENDING TOPICS: QB PERCENTAGE

A point of emphasis for the Golden Bears entering 2019 is a more efficient passing game. Even a slight improvement in completion percentage and a decrease in interceptions can lead to a significant boost in wins.

Since Shannon Currier has returned to the program in 2016, when the Golden Bears complete at least 54 percent of passes, the team is an above .500 squad with a 6-5 record including wins in three of the last four when doing so.

TRENDING TOPIC: SACKS / WINS CORRELATION

In the 35 games since head coach Shannon Currier has been back with the program since 2016, the CSP defense has produced 4-plus sacks 10 times and had more sacks than the opponent 14 times.

In the 4-plus sack games, Concordia has a 7-3 record and has won four of its last five games when sacking the quarterback four or more times including the 2019 season opener with six sacks.

When producing more sacks than the opponent which factors line play on both sides, Concordia is 9-6 but has won four of the last five including the first two games of 2019 when CSP had a 6-2 advantage in sacks against Sioux Falls and 2-1 at Upper Iowa.

FOUR DIFFERENT PLAYERS WITH RUSHING TDS

In Concordia's 28-23 win at Upper Iowa in week two, the Golden Bears had four different players reach the end zone on the ground, in order: Cole Kirchoff, Shaq Johnson, Darios Crawley-Reid and Lajuan Preston.

The last time Concordia had four different players score rushing touchdowns in the same game was a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston on October 7, 2005 when Aaron Cawthorn scored four rushing touchdowns while James McNear, Brian Holmes and John Robinson each had one.

GROUND CONTROL LEADS TO VICTORIES

Since 2016 when Shannon Currier returned to CSP's sidelines, Concordia has rushed for 200-plus yards 10 times, producing a 7-3 record including last week's 28-23 win at Upper lowa with a 300-yard team effort.

By contrast, when Concordia holds opponents under 100 yards, a much tougher feat, the Golden Bears are 5-1. Five of those six sub-100 opponent rushing games came last year with CSP producing a 4-1 record, only falling 24-20 in the season finale at Winona State.

Just four times since 2016 have the Golden Bears rushed for 200-plus and held an opponent to under 100 yards in the same game - all coming in 2018 with Concordia beating Upper Iowa (34-7), UMary (17-7) and Minnesota Crookston (21-13) while losing at Winona State (20-24).
