#### THIS WEEK: ROAD FINALE AT AUGUSTANA

After closing out NSIC North-South Division crossover play with a win, moving to 2-2 against the NSIC North on the year, Concordia returns to NSIC South Division play for the final three games of the year and will play its last road game of 2019 at Augustana.

The 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State secured Concordia's fifth win of the year, matching last season's win total with three games remaining. It also secured at least a .500 home record for the fifth time since moving into Sea Foam Stadium in 2009 and boosted the team's home win total to three for the fifth time, as well.

This Saturday, Concordia aims for win number six to secure a winning campaign for the first time since 2011.

#### CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

Last year in his seventh as head coach at Concordia, **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his eighth season, carries a 46-39 career record, has a 27-13 home record and is 8-0 in home openers. He's

been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship.

#### AUGIE GAME TO BE FEATURED ON TWIN CITIES RADIO

Concordia's week nine game at Augustana will allow fans to listen in their vehicles, while doing yard work or in their homes on local radio station AM 1440 KYCR. The station, which also carries The Coaches Show following the MN High School Football Game of the Week, had programming time available with North Dakota State playing in the evening.

The game will be called by veteran play-by-play announcer **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score with **Blake Sorem** handling the color commentator role. Langfellow has been broadcasting high school football in the Twin Cities for 25 years including Prep Bowl broadcasts on FOX-9 and the Fox Sports Prep Zone. Sorem is a former offensive coordinator at Edina High School and played his prep football for famed coach **Mike Grant** of Eden Prairie HS and has worked alongside Langfellow several times in the booth.

#### COACHES SHOW RETURNS TO TWIN CITIES RADIO IN 2019

The Coaches Show with **Shannon Currier** is back for a second year, once again hosted by **Wally Langfellow** of Minnesota Score. The show airs following the Minnesota high school football game of the week, typically on Friday evenings in the 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. hour on KYCR 1440 AM radio, available in the Twin Cities metro area. This week's guests include sophomore safety **Dez Bassett** and redshirt freshman tackle **Adam Cook**.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show is accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, Apple Podcasts, Stitcher and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

## NOTES ABOUT THE VIKINGS (by Ben Diers)

Since the start of the 2018 season, the Vikings have found their way back to their winning ways. In the 2018 season, Augie finished 7-4 and placed 4th in the NSIC South. This season, the Vikings have picked up right where they left off in 2018 with a record of 6-2 through their first eight.

Coming into this game, the Vikings have won three in a row and five of their last six including a dominant 51-6 win over Minot State. The Vikings are also 4-0 at home this season with a point differential of +113 in home contests.

On the offensive side of the ball, it has been Augie's passing game that has shined so far. The Vikings currently rank second in the NSIC with 235.2 passing yards/game. Leaning heavily on the strong air attack, Augustana ranks third in the NSIC in scoring offense (30ppg). The ground attack hasn't been as potent, with the Vikings ranking ninth in the NSIC averaging 136.8 rushing yards per game.

Quarterback **Kyle Saddler** leads the NSIC with an average of 215.4 passing yards per game, also throwing 11 touchdowns on the year so far. **Sean Engel** has been the top target for the Vikings, catching 26 passes for 312 yards. **Jarod Epperson** leads Augie's rushing attack with 73.9 rushing yards per game, good for fifth in the NSIC while ranking ninth in the country with 7.2 yards per carry.

The Vikings defense has been equally impressive, allowing opponents to score an average of just 12 points per game (5th in the country) and rank eighth in the country with a 26.8% third down conversion defense. A big part of Augie's success on defense has been their ability to create turnovers. The Vikings lead the country in defensive turnovers (24) and are second in the nation in turnover margin (+13). Cornerback **Kenneth Griffin** has 4 interceptions this season, putting him in a tie for second in the NSIC while **Jake Polson** and **Eli Weber** each have 3 INTs. Augie ranks ninth in DII in interceptions (13) and has three defensive TDs.

Augie kicker **Luis Guarita** is among the nation's best, ranking third nationally in FG pct (92.9) and seventh in FG made (13, or 1.63/game).

This week's game captains: senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** (9x) and senior guard **Rich Kelly** (8x) on offense and junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** (7x) and sophomore safety **Dez Bassett** (2x) on defense.

## DOBBS HONORS FALLEN FRIEND WITH NUMBER CHANGE

Senior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** changed jersey numbers from 98 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May, 2018. Billy passed away shortly after graduating while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Last year, it was **Brandon Russell** who switched from 23 to 26 to honor his late friend.

Dobbs has racked up 159 career tackles, 27.5 TFL and 16.0 sacks in 36 games. As a sixth year senior, Dobbs has had a strong season in #26, posting 7.5 TFLs, 3.5 sacks and 35 total tackles.

## SERIES HISTORY: AUGUSTANA 11, CONCORDIA 4

After winning three of the first four meetings between the programs between 2004 and 2007, Concordia has dropped 10 of the last 11 meetings.

On a current four game slide against Augustana, Concordia has dropped each of the four games during the losing streak by at least 15 points, allowing 50-plus in three of the four losses.

Concordia has also lost five in a row on the road in Sioux Falls coinciding with Augie's opening of Kirkeby-Over Stadium.

After the series started with five of the first seven contests decided by seven points or less, only one of the past eight games has been decided by a single score, including Concordia's last win, a 17-7 victory for CSP at Sea Foam Stadium in 2014 to snap a six game losing streak to the Vikings. CSP's last road win at Augie came in 2007 (20-19).

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds an 0-3 career record against Augie, dropping the only road trip 28-13 in 2017. Currier did not face Augustana in his first four years with CSP in 2000-03.

## LAST MEETING, 2018: AUGUSTANA 52, CONCORDIA 24

Concordia's senior day opened with the teams trading scores: Augie scored on its opening drive and Concordia countered a few possessions later with a **Dom McKinzy** to **John Damrow** touchdown pass set-up by a **Marcus Haskins** interception and long return into the Augie red zone.

Late in the first quarter, Augustana converted a field goal after CSP's defense held in the red zone, with **Jonas Schenderlein** answering with a 55-yard field goal in the second quarter. It was Schenderlein's seventh career 50-plus yard field goal.

After the Vikings countered with a TD for a 17-10 lead, CSP's defense registered a stop and seemingly forced a 50-yard field goal attempt by **Luis Guarita** late in the half.

Instead, the Vikings snapped directly to Guarita, who pinned CSP at its own 1-yard line with 40 seconds to play. Able to suc-

cessfully run the ball three times and avoid a safety, the Vikings' use of timeouts forced a **Danny Laudet** punt from his own end zone.

Laudet answered the call with a soaring 48-yard punt, but Augie returner **Avram Tynes** executed a 54-yard touchdown with nine seconds to play before the break for a 24-10 Augie lead.

In the third quarter, CSP's opening drive stalled, and the Vikings struck quickly with a 3-play drive to take a 31-10 lead, and forced a strip sack returned for touchdown on the ensuing Concordia drive to take control, 38-10 in the third quarter.

The turn was devastating as Augie scored four straight touchdowns in a span of 15 minutes of football to break a 10-10 into a 38-10 game early in the third quarter.

With **Maxon Hutton** under center in the second half, the Golden Bears picked up a big play as Hutton connected deep with receiver **Jake Shepley** for a 76-yard TD and a second INT by Haskins set up an 8-yard keeper TD by Hutton to make it 38-24 with 3:25 left in the third.

With Augie facing a 3rd and 10 from the CSP 43 yard line late in the third quarter, quarterback **Kyle Saddler** was intercepted by **Jake Portz**, but a penalty wiped out the INT and moved Augie to the CSP 14 yard line to start the fourth quarter.

Three plays later, Augustana found the end zone to extend its lead back to three touchdowns: 45-24 with 14:11 to play.

It was the second critical and decisive moment of the contest, with Augustana capitalizing on both opportunities.

Hutton had a strong second half, completing 9-of-18 for 155 yards and a TD while adding 10-48 on the ground with a score. Joining Shepley in the receiving corps, **MJ Williams** had 4-48 and **Jake Tanner** had 4-40.

The QB duo of McKinzy and Hutton combined to connect with eight different targets while completing 18-of-37 for 229 yards and each had a TD strike.

Saddler finished 19-of-36 for 238 yards, two TDs and two INTs while adding a rushing TD. Augie had a pair of 100-yard rushers: **Rudolph Sinflorant** (18-100) and **Braiden Petersen** (7-100, 2 TDs).

Haskins led the CSP defense with 2 INTs, two pass breakups, a forced fumble and five tackles. The performance pushed his season totals to 19 pass breakups and seven INTs, and he helped the secondary limit Augie leading WR **Nickel Meyers** to just 2-22 and a TD after entering play averaging over 100 yards per game to rank third in the NSIC.

## LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 24, BEMIDJI STATE 23 - OT

Junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** had a hand in three turnovers with a pair of strip sacks, recovering one of his own forced fumbles and deflecting a pass that was intercepted by teammate **Gabe Nkumu**. That was all part of a massive first half as Garrett also set the CSP career sack record with 33.5 in just 25 games.

It helped Concordia establish a 17-7 lead at the break with Bemidji State rallying to tie the score at 17 with under two minutes to play in the fourth quarter.

In overtime, it was Garrett's brother, freshman **Darios Crawley-Reid** who scored first on a 1-yard TD run for a 24-17 lead. Bemidji State answered with a 4th-and-9 conversion for a 24-yard TD but the two-point try was intercepted by **Preston Piltoff** to end the game.

While Garrett broke a career record, Crawley-Reid is just establishing the foundation for his college career. He had his first 100-yard rushing game (15-106) and had two rushing TDs in a game for the first time in the win. He now leads CSP with seven total TDs and has scored five in the last three contests.

Garrett finished the game matching a career-high with 11 tackles, adding 3.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks, two FF, one FR, a breakup and a hurry.

Nkumu had one of the team's two interceptions, the other also coming from the linebacker position by **Opi Aghenu** while **Jake Portz** (11 tackles) and **Dalton Smerchek** (8 tackles) added strong performances from the position as well.

Piltoff's interception doesn't count statistically, coming on a two-point try, but he also had six solo tackles and a pair of breakups.

Crawley-Reid was aided in the running game by sophomore **Shaq Johnson** with 21 carries for 68 yards and he went over 100 combined yards, adding 4-35 receiving.

Under center, senior **Maxon Hutton** completed 18-of-35 for 156 yards and a 17-yard TD to senior **Jabril Clewis** (4-47 rec).

**PRESEASON & RETURNING ALL-AMERICAN: CHRIS GARRETT**  
Junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** entered 2019 as a D2Football.com Preseason All-America First Team selection. He has delivered on the field, registering at least a sack in five games and at least a half TFL in seven of eight games.

In week eight's 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State, he broke Zach Moore's (2009-13) career sack record (33) with 33.5, doing it in 14 fewer games (25) than Moore (39).

On the year, he's compiled 11.0 sacks, 16.5 TFLs, is second on the team with 54 total tackles, has forced six fumbles with two recoveries, had five pass breakups and six QB hurries on the year.

Through eight games, he leads the country with six forced fumbles, ranks second in the country with 1.38 sacks per game and is sixth with 2.1 TFLs per game, leading the NSIC in all three. Rare for a pass rushing defensive end, Garrett is 13th in the NSIC in tackles (6.8/game), as well.

He is coming off a year in which he was named All-America First Team by the AFCA and Associated Press, Second Team by D2C-CA and Third Team by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

Last year, he led the country with 1.65 sacks per game and was fourth in the nation with 1.90 tackles for loss per game.

He set the CSP single season sacks record in 2018 with 16.5 in just 10 games, and set the single game TFL record in week six in 2019 with 6.5 against MSU Moorhead, adding 5 sacks, second most in CSP history to earn D2Football.com National Defensive Player of the Week for the second time in his career.

After finishing his sophomore year on a torrid pace with 14.0 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss and 36 total tackles in the last six games, Garrett's streak has carried over into 2019, giving him 25.0 sacks, 32.5 TFL and 90 total tackles across 14 games.

## HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 8TH SEASON



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first post-season game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat - consecutive or cumulative.

## THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 8-0 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 27-13 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

## CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

## PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

## NSIC BACKGROUND &amp; ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of Minnesota.

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where he earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a quarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

## FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak including the first two games of 2018 for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 27-13 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 8-0 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

## HOME SWEET FOAM: HOW SWEET IS IT?

With a 3-2 home record in 2018, Concordia-St. Paul enjoyed a home field advantage a year ago. The run game topped 200 yards in four out of five home games and held opponents to 131 yards or less four times. Concordia averaged 5.1 yards per carry in home games while opponents mustered just 3.1 yards per rush.

Overall, CSP held a 403.2 to 364.2 average total offense margin and racked up 5.9 yards per play while limiting foes to 4.8 in 2018 home games.

The defense also racked up 6.8 TFL per game while the offensive line limited the damage to just 3.4 opponent TFLs per home contest. Further, the defense held a 17-to-11 margin in sacks leading to 104-to-57 difference in lost yardage. The defense also stifled opponents on fourth down to just 2-for-12 (16.7%).

In the 2019 home opening win over Sioux Falls (41-17), Concordia won the turnover margin 2-0, registered six sacks and held the Cougars to 0-of-3 on fourth down and 4-of-13 on third down.

After a 29-3 loss to Minnesota State in week three, Concordia rebounded with a 24-17 home win over MSU Moorhead, holding the Dragons to school records -97 rushing yards and 22 tackles for loss while tying the NCAA Division II single game sacks record with 14.

The Golden Bears added another win against the NSIC North in week eight, a 24-23 overtime win to move to 2-0 in overtime games held at Sea Foam Stadium

## HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 8-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 4-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the eight home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.9 to 9.4 margin of victory, a total of 247 to 75.

## TOUGH HOME SLATE IN 2019 &amp; OTHER SCHEDULE NOTES

After playing a tough road schedule a year ago, the flipped opponents in the South Division leads to a rough home slate in 2019. Concordia's six home opponents in 2019 combined for a 45-21 overall record last year, and only one of them (SMSU) had a losing season (4-7). The Golden Bears host, in order, Sioux Falls (7-4), Minnesota State (11-0), MSU Moorhead (8-3), Bemidji State (7-4), SMSU (4-7) and Winona State (8-3) in 2019.

Those opponents have combined for a 32-6 record in 2019 with five of the six producing at least a .500 record.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 18 straight games to ranked teams.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven in 2018 with a 17-7 win at UMary, snapped a 12-game NSIC South road losing streak in week 10 at SMSU in 2018 and in 2019 the program snapped a 10 game road night game losing streak with a 28-23 win over Upper Iowa in a streak that dated back to 2013.

## TURNOVERS MATTER

As CSP's program has grown under head coach **Shannon Currier**, the team's steady veteran offensive line has provided more protection for its quarterbacks, leading to more consistent ball control. Defensively, a talented and deep defensive line has helped create pressure in opposing backfields, with more forced fumbles and hurried passes leading to interceptions down field under third year defensive coordinator **Craig Stern**.

Since Currier has rejoined the program in 2016, Concordia has produced a 7-3 record when winning the turnover battle including five straight wins. In week two at Upper Iowa, the Golden Bears lost the turnover battle (2-0) but came away with a 28-23 win, just the second time they've done so in 18 games since 2016 when losing turnover margin. When turnovers are even, CSP is 5-7 since 2016.

## DEEP &amp; EXPERIENCED ON THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE

The 2019 Golden Bears' strength is up front, returning all but one combined starter between the offensive and defensive lines. While four year starting tackle **Terrell Taylor** graduated from the 2018 offensive line, the Golden Bears actually return five blockers with starting experience, along with all four starting defensive linemen. (*Games started listed below*)

On defense, the four starters: **Kelly Pierce** (33), **Jackson Dobbs** (33), **Dylan Wood** (26) and **Chris Garrett** (19) have played a majority of snaps together over the past three years. Senior **TJ Diallo** worked his way into the interior defensive line starting lineup four times while sophomore **Shawn Aarhus** got the start in week three against MSU.

On offense, **Rich Kelly** (38), **Ethan Aune** (28), **Cris Wasylciw** (16), **Tanner Haechten** (14) and **Matthew Montgomery** (10) have provided the Golden Bears with the muscle up front.

Montgomery earned the starting center role in 2018 as a red-shirt freshman before his season ended with injury early on, but is now in his third year in the program while Wasylciw was a transfer with prior experience.

In week four, it was redshirt freshman **Sam Marshalek** making his first career start in Haechten's spot due to injury while

sophomore **Tyson Kauffman** earned the start the past three weeks against MSUM and Minot State. Beginning in week five, junior college transfer **Dejon Hart** cycled into the backup rotation at guard as the Bears have used a team effort to fill Haechten's void since week four.

#### SENIORS FLANK GARRETT ON D-LINE

While junior **Chris Garrett** garners the attention that comes with All-America and Preseason All-America honors, he's joined by four tenacious seniors who are accomplished in their own right: **Dylan Wood, TJ Diallo** and **Kelly Pierce** on the interior and **Jackson Dobbs** on the opposite end.

The statistical leader of that group, Dobbs has compiled 159 career tackles, 27.5 tackles for loss and 16.0 sacks across 36 games.

In 35 games, Pierce has 123 tackles, 20.0 for loss and 12.0 sacks while Wood has played in the most games (41) with 135 tackles, 20.0 for loss and 11.5 sacks. Diallo, a second year transfer, has started three times this year on the interior and has made 34 tackles (1.5 TFL) in 19 career games.

So far in 2019, Pierce has 27 tackles, 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks, Dobbs with 35 tackles, 7. TFL and 3.5 sacks while Wood has 34 tackles, 3.5 TFL.

The depth on the defensive line is notable as six other defensive linemen have recorded at least a half sack with backups led by sophomore ends **Shawn Aarhus** and **Mark O'Reilly** with three sacks each while senior end **Cole Marmor** and sophomore end **Richard Ficociello** each have a sack.

The defensive line combined for 13 of an NCAA DII record-tying 14 sacks in a 24-17 week six win over MSU Moorhead, and five of the team's six sacks in the season opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls.

On the year, the defensive line has racked up 26 of the team's 29 sacks.

#### SHAQ & LP: FLORIDA DUO COVERS FOR EACH OTHER

The running back group is led by sophomore **Shaq Johnson** and junior **Lajuan Preston**, both Florida natives. Preston became an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention rusher a year ago when Johnson's season ended in week four against Wayne State, while Preston was lost for the season this year in week four at Wayne State.

Prior to his season ending injury last year in 2018, Johnson was on a torrid pace with over 100 combined rushing/receiving yards per game (367 rushing, 49 receiving) and five total TDs in four games.

Preston picked up where Johnson left off after Shaq's injury, gashing Minnesota Duluth, Northern State and Minnesota Crookston for 100-plus rushing yards in a four game stretch including a high of 21-141 against Northern State. He finished the year averaging 6.5 per carry with 704 rushing yards.

Although Preston suffered a season-ending injury in week four at Wayne State this season - the exact timetable and opponent as Johnson a year ago, 'LP' turned in a strong first four games with 177 yards at 5.5 per carry and a pair of TDs.

In the week four win at Wayne State, Preston surpassed 1,000 career rushing yards with 1,013 on 173 carries, averaging 5.9 per carry, and Johnson is also approaching 1,000 rushing yards with 929 entering week nine at Augie.

Johnson made his 2019 debut in week two, reaching 100-plus yards for the third time in his career with 12 carries for 118 yards, adding a 36 yard catch and 25 yard kickoff return for 179 all-purpose yards on 14 touches in a win at Upper Iowa.

He reached 100 combined yards in a week eight 24-23 win over Bemidji State with 21-68 rushing and 4-35 receiving (103).

A versatile back, Johnson leads the team with 511 all-purpose yards, ranking both third on the team in rushing (321) and receiving (20-165). In his career, he has 929 rushing and 247 receiving yards with 10 combined TDs (11 with passing).

Adding to CSP's ground threat is athletic quarterback **Maxon Hutton**. The senior, who had his second career 100-yard rushing game with 120 yards and a 76-yard TD run in week four at Wayne State, leads the team in rushing with 347 yards and a

Concordia now has four players on the roster with 100-plus yard rushing performances: Preston (3), Johnson (3), Hutton (2) and freshman **Darios Crawley-Reid** (1).

#### CRAWLEY-REID LEADS NEWCOMERS IN BACKFIELD

**Darios Crawley-Reid** made his career debut in week two at Upper Iowa, and the true freshman got off to a strong start with 7-45 rushing and a touchdown and a 15 yard catch.

The younger brother of **Chris Garrett**, Crawley-Reid had his first career 100-yard performance in a week eight win over Bemidji State (15-106), adding a pair of TDs.

His importance in the backfield continues to amplify as the season progresses, he's second on the team in rushing yards (331) and has a team-best 6.6 average and leads the team with seven total TDs (six rushing). He's also fourth on the team in catches (12) and receiving yards (105).

It was senior **Cole Kirchoff** who drew the backfield start in week one, producing 21 combined yards on eight touches with 6-12 rushing and 2-9 receiving. He also found the end zone for the first time in week two at UIU.

Kirchoff joined the football roster in 2019 after a four year run with the baseball team where he was a starting outfielder with three homers, three triples, 17 stolen bases and was third on the team with 20 RBIs.

#### HUTTON UNDER CENTER

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has ascended to the starting quarterback role after serving as the backup as a sophomore and junior while making spot starts. The dual-threat QB topped 3,000 career yards of total offense in week five at SCSU. He now has 3,625 yards of total offense and 21 total TDs in his career (17 pass, 4 rush).

In 2019, Hutton has become one of the more efficient and versatile QBs in the NSIC. He ranks sixth in completion percentage (.569) and eighth in pass efficiency (113.0), passing yards (1,277) and passing TDs (7). He's also committed just six turnovers on the year and engineers an offense that has committed just 11 turnovers in eight games, ranking 39th in the country and third in the NSIC.

He's hit new career-highs for a season in both passing (1,277) on 120-211 and rushing (347).

In the season opener, Hutton completed 13-of-22 (.591) for 159 yards and two touchdowns while adding 67 rushing yards on 14 carries and a touchdown. The senior also showed the poise necessary to lead a turnover-free offense.

In a week four win at WSC, he was named NSIC Offensive Player of the Week as he produced league-highs for the week in total offense (292) and rushing yards (120) while playing turnover-free football on the road and complet-

ing 66.7 percent (16-24) of his passes. The 16 completions would become a new career-high, temporarily. He also had a 76-yard TD run to put CSP ahead in the third quarter.

Hutton has since topped 16 completions three times in the past four games including 21 at SCSU and 22 at Minot State, where he set new highs of 22-39 for 257 yards and had 302 yards of total offense in the road loss to the Beavers.

Backing him up is senior **Jared Olsgaard**, a transfer from Alabama A&M by way of Minnesota State Community & Technical College. In addition to being the backup QB, Olsgaard opened the year as the team's punt returner, averaging 8.5 (4-34) and has now ascended to a starting role at wide receiver. He's also been taking snaps under center in recent weeks, including an 11-yard keeper TD run in week seven at Minot State.

Olsgaard has recorded 11-90 receiving and 7-34 rushing, adding 4-34 on punt returns and his first two pass attempts.

Depth at the position is provided by junior transfer **Johnny Saavedra** and redshirt freshmen **Darion Manning** and **Abe Schwartz**. Schwartz has earned a role on the roster as a special teams contributor, and is tied for the team lead in special teams tackles (5) with a team-high (4) on punts.

#### THREE DEEP WITH SENIOR WIDE RECEIVERS

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has three senior wide receiver targets with complimentary skillsets: fourth year starter **Marcus Gustaveson**, second year junior college transfer **MJ Williams** and graduate Division I transfer **Jabril Clewis**.

In eight games, the trio has combined for nearly 60 percent of the team's receiving yards and six of its seven TD catches.

Clewis leads the team with 353 yards and is tied with Williams for the lead with 24 catches, with Williams ranking second on the team with 298 yards. Gustaveson's output has been slowed by injury, but he has the team's best average (15.8) on 6-95 receiving and has a pair of TDs

**GUSTAVESON CAREER RECEIVING RANKINGS**

Fourth year starting wide receiver **Marcus Gustavson** has established himself as one of CSP's top receivers in recent years. He has four career 100-yard performances and is climbing the CSP career receiving charts.

He's tied for eighth in career touchdown catches (18), 10th in receptions (116) and 10th in receiving yards (1,751). He's hauled in a pair of TDs in 2019, both in victories, and leads the team with 15.8 per catch (6-95).

**SOPHOMORE SAFETIES**

Sophomore safety **Dez Bassett** entered 2019 as the team's starting strong safety (rover) and was the second leading tackler a year ago as a redshirt freshman with 65. In 2019, Bassett is fifth on the team with 40 tackles with a season-high of eight in week five at SCSU.

Bassett's redshirt freshman 2018 season also included seven pass breakups and a 77-yard interception return for touchdown in a win at UMary in addition to the 65 total tackles.

Joining Bassett at the safety position are fellow sophomores **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers** at free safety.

Sheehan has started 17 of 19 career games with 63 career tackles, producing 26 stops in eight games in 2019, adding a pair of pass breakups and 1.5 TFLs.

Powers has 33 career tackles, five pass breakups and an interception across 19 games. He has a pair of three tackle performances against Sioux Falls and Minnesota State among his nine tackles in 2019.

**LINEBACKERS PUTTING UP BIG NUMBERS IN 2019**

A key benefit of having an experienced, physical defensive line is the ability for the linebackers to be free to make plays.

In 2019, Concordia's linebackers opened the year with back-to-back NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

Sophomore MLB **Jake Portz** has emerged as one of the nation's elite tacklers in 2019. His 10.0 per game average ranks 21st in the country and leads the Northern Sun. The team's leading tackler in 2018 as a redshirt freshman with 77, he has already surpassed that total with 80 tackles with three games to go in 2019.

Portz produced 18 tackles in a 28-23 road win at Upper Iowa to earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors and followed that up with 15 tackles against #3 Minnesota State.

The 18 tackle performance is now the third most tackles in a game in school history, and the third most in an NSIC game this season.

It's part of a season resume that includes four double-digit tackle performances and at least five tackles in all eight games.

While Portz has been among the national leaders throughout the season, it was junior WLB **Dalton Smerchek** who had the impact performance in week one to earn NSIC Player of the Week honors.

In a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls, Smerchek made nine tackles, 1.5 for loss, forced a fumble at the goal line, recovered a muffed punt, had a pass breakup and pair of hurries. One of his tackles was a TFL at the goal line, forcing a field goal two plays later and one of his hurries came on fourth down in the second half as he continued to make impact plays of all kinds.

Initially a long snapper and key special teams contributor, Smerchek has turned into one of the top players on the defense in his junior season. In 30 career games, he's recorded 105 tackles, 7.0 for loss, four fumble recoveries and three forced fumbles.

Smerchek is fourth on the team with 48 tackles, adding 5.0 TFL, 2.0 sacks, 2 FF and 2 FR in seven games in 2019.

The unit is complimented by SLB **Gabe Nkumu** who topped Portz's 18 tackle performance with a 19-tackle game in week seven at Minot State, second most in the NSIC this year and second-most in school history. He is third on the defense with 53 tackles, adding two pass breakups and an interception.

Nkumu rejoined the program after a year away when he played nine games as a freshman in 2017 with six tackles, 2.5 for loss, 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble.

**CORNERS PRODUCE IN NEW ROLES**

The Golden Bears have a pair of new starters at corner, junior transfer **Preston Piltoff** and junior **Lorenzo Kendricks** in his third year in the program. Kendricks was one of the team's co-captains in week one, making three tackles and falling on a blocked punt for a touchdown in a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. He's played in 30 career games with 61 tackles and five pass breakups in his career.

Kendricks secured his first career INT in week three against Minnesota State.

Piltoff had four tackles (three solo) in his debut with CSP, also adding a fumble recovery at the goal line and recovering a blocked punt in a busy first half in a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. Through eight weeks, Piltoff has registered 30 tackles (26 solo) with at least three tackles in seven of eight games. He leads the team with seven pass breakups and had a game-sealing INT on a two-point conversion in the 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State in week eight.

**LAUDET ASSUMES KICKING AND PUNTING DUTIES**

Replacing one of the top kickers in the country is not an easy task, but the Golden Bears turned to an internal option with **Danny Laudet** who is in his third year in the program

and has familiarity with the graduated **Jonas Schenderlein**.

Further, Schenderlein has remained in the program as a graduate assistant, working with Laudet and the other specialists.

Laudet responded well to the additional duties immediately, converting 2-of-2 field goals (30, 29), all five PATs for 11 points, three of eight kickoffs for touchbacks in his debut at kicker in the 41-17 season opening win over USF.

Through eight weeks, Laudet is one of the nation's best at both jobs, ranking seventh in the country field goals per game (1.63), 5th in the NSIC in FG pct (.722) and seventh in the NSIC in punt average (39.7).

He's also cashed in all 19 of his PATs and has hammered 18 touchbacks on 41 kickoffs.

His early season performance was punctuated with an NCAA Division II long 82-yard punt from the back of his own end zone in a week four win at Wayne State.

He earned NSIC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his week four performance, hitting the longest FG in the league for the week (second longest of 2019 in the NSIC) from 49 yards, bashing 5-of-6 kickoffs for touchbacks, averaging an NSIC season-best 51.0 yards on four punts and the nation's season long of 82 yards.

In week five, he was arguably even better, making a 4th quarter game-tying and a go-ahead field goal and adding another go-ahead field goal in overtime at SCSU. He also delivered a 53-yard punt with a -2 return (55 net) late in the fourth quarter against the Huskies.

It was part of a 5-field goal performance at SCSU, the first in the NSIC since 2010, a school record and the only recorded 5-for-5 field goal performance in league history dating back to when stats are displayed (1998-present). He is one of just four players with 5 FGM in a game in the country this season.

His 39.67 season average and 39.12 career averages have been contending with the single season CSP punt average record (41.32) and career records (39.32) all year.

#### DEVIN FLAKES OPENS CAREER WITH 2 BLOCKS

Freshman defensive back **Devin Flakes** got off to an exceptional start to his college career, blocking a pair of punts while seeing regular action on special teams in his debut as a true freshman. The blocked punts came in a 24-0 second quarter for CSP in a season-opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. The first, recovered by junior cornerback **Preston Pilloff**, set up a two play scoring drive while the second was recovered by junior cornerback **Lorenzo Kendricks** for a TD at the end of the quarter for a 27-7 halftime lead over USF.

The special teams is led by third year special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**, with the Golden Bears blocking 10 kicks and punts since 2017 in 30 games.

In addition to an increased ability to block kicks or disrupt an opponents kicking game with pressure, special teams standouts include sophomore **Hunter Thompson** with a team-high five tackles on kickoff returns and redshirt freshman **Abe Schwartz** with a team-high four tackles on punt coverage. Both players lead the team with five total special teams tackles while junior **Lorenzo Kendricks**, sophomore **Gabe Nkumu** and redshirt freshman **Andrew Egnarski** each have four special teams tackles.

#### TRENDING TOPICS: QB PERCENTAGE

A point of emphasis for the Golden Bears entering 2019 is a more efficient passing game. Even a slight improvement in completion percentage and a decrease in interceptions can lead to a significant boost in wins.

Since **Shannon Currier** has returned to the program in 2016, when the Golden Bears complete at least 54 percent of passes, the team is an above .500 squad with an 8-7 record.

#### TRENDING TOPIC: SACKS / WINS CORRELATION

In the 41 games since head coach **Shannon Currier** has been back with the program since 2016, the CSP defense has produced 4-plus sacks 11 times and had more sacks than the opponent 15 times.

In the 4-plus sack games, Concordia has an 8-3 record and has won five of its last six games when sacking the quarterback four or more times.

When producing more sacks than the opponent which factors line play on both sides, Concordia is 10-6 but has won five of the last six including three times in 2019: 6-to-2 against USF in week one, 2-to-1 at Upper Iowa in week two and most recently 14-to-1 in week six against MSUM.

#### FOUR DIFFERENT PLAYERS WITH RUSHING TDS

In Concordia's 28-23 win at Upper Iowa in week two, the Golden Bears had four different players reach the end zone on the ground, in order: **Cole Kirchoff**, **Shaq Johnson**, **Darios Crawley-Reid** and **Lajuan Preston**.

The last time Concordia had four different players score rushing touchdowns in the same game was a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston on October 7, 2005 when **Aaron Cawthorn** scored four rushing touchdowns while **James McNear**, **Brian Holmes** and **John Robinson** each had one.

On the year, four ball carriers have reached paydirt at least twice for Concordia in the run game: **Darios Crawley-Reid** (6), **Shaq Johnson** (2), **Lajuan Preston** (2) and **Maxon Hut-ton** (2) while **Cole Kirchoff** and **Jared Olsgaard** give the team six different players who've scored on the ground.

#### GROUND CONTROL LEADS TO VICTORIES

Since 2016 when **Shannon Currier** returned to CSP's sidelines, Concordia has rushed for 200-plus yards 10 times, producing a 7-3 record including a week two 28-23 win at Upper Iowa with a 300-yard team effort.

By contrast, when Concordia holds opponents under 100 yards, a much tougher feat, the Golden Bears are 6-1. Five of those six sub-100 opponent rushing games came last year with CSP producing a 4-1 record, only falling 24-20 in the season finale at Winona State.

This year, CSP's defense set a program record for fewest rushing yards allowed in a game by stifling (and sacking) MSU Moorhead for a loss of -97 rushing yards in a week six win.

Just four times since 2016 have the Golden Bears rushed for 200-plus and held an opponent to under 100 yards in the same game - all coming in 2018 with Concordia beating Upper Iowa (34-7), UMary (17-7) and Minnesota Crookston (21-13) while losing at Winona State (20-24).
