THIS WEEK: CSP TO PLAY MILESTONE CONTESTS

With its road trips behind them, Concordia will focus on closing out the 2019 season with a pair of home games the next two Saturdays, with a pair of noon kickoffs.

This Saturday against SMSU, Concordia will be playing in its 500th game as a college program, dating back 50 years ago to the inaugural season in 1969. The team was celebrated in week three against Minnesota State.

Additionally, Concordia will be playing its 200th official NSIC conference game, making the move from NAIA and the UMAC to the NCAA DII and NSIC ranks 20 years ago in 1999.

Concordia holds a 223-274-2 overall all-time record in its 51st season, and is 89-110 in its 21st year as a Northern Sun member.

This Saturday, Concordia also aims for win number six to secure a winning campaign for the first time since 2011. CSP is seeking its 19th winning college football season, its ninth at the Division II level and fifth for head coach **Shannon Currier**, now in his eighth season as head coach (2000-03, 2016-present).

CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

Last year in his seventh as head coach at Concordia, **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his eighth season, carries a 46-40 career record, has a 27-13 home record and is 8-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship. *More on Coach Currier on page 3.*

This week's guests include senior wide receiver **MJ Williams** and senior defensive tackle **Dylan Wood**.

For fans who miss the show or are outside of the radio station's Twin Cities reach, the entire show is accessible via the CSP Bears Podcast, available in Spotify, Apple Podcasts, Stitcher and Google Play Music. It will typically be uploaded late Friday night (after the initial air time) or Saturday morning prior to the game.

NOTES ABOUT THE MUSTANGS

The Mustangs enter Sea Foam Stadium with a 3-1 road record on the season but have dropped two in a row at home and are now 1-4 in NSIC South Division play. SMSU's only road loss was a 19-13 overtime defeat in week two at Wayne State, winning three in a row on the road at Upper lowa (35-28), Minot State (21-17) and St. Cloud State (42-38).

The matchup pits SMSU at a Golden Bear squad that is 3-1 at home. While SMSU has had six of its nine games decided by seven points or less, Concordia has had seven of its nine decided by seven or less.

The Mustangs are led by senior receiver **Daniel Davis** who is second in the country with 8.0 receptions per game and seventh in receiving yards (945), adding 10 TDs. He's had 2,058 career receiving yards in just 20 games.

Quarterback **Boyer Bouman** leads the league with 223.6 passing yards per game. He's one of three to start at QB this year and has 1,565 yards, 12 TDs and 4 INTs in seven starts.

Senior **Max Simmons** compliments the offense on the ground with 2,305 career rushing yards and 10 career 100-yard games. He has 413 yards and a 4.6 average as a senior.

Defensively, linebacker **Onte Burns** leads the league with 89 tackles (9.9/game). **Davaeon Johnson** adds 72 tackles and a pair of INTs with five pass breakups.

On special teams, **Skyler Crew** has made 4-of-6 FG and is 2-of-2 from 40-plus yards, converting from 40 and 43 in week 2 at Wayne State. Since week 2, he's attempted just two FG, going 1-for-1. He has not attempted an FG the past three games.

2019 TEAM CAPTAINS

CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** will have rotating team captains each week for the second year in a row in 2019. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

This week's game captains: senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** (10x) and senior guard **Rich Kelly** (9x) on offense and junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** (8x) and senior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** (2x) on defense.

DOBBS HONORS FALLEN FRIEND WITH NUMBER CHANGE

Senior defensive end **Jackson Dobbs** changed jersey numbers from 98 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May, 2018. Billy passed away shortly after graduating while working out in the Twin Cities in June. The two were close friends, and head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

Last year, it was $\bf Brandon \ Russell \ who \ switched \ from \ 23 \ to \ 26 \ to \ honor his late friend.$

Dobbs has racked up 165 career tackles, 30.5 TFL and 18.0 sacks in 37 games. As a sixth year senior, Dobbs has had a strong season in #26, posting 10.5 TFLs, 5.5 sacks and 41 total tackles.

SERIES HISTORY: CONCORDIA 12, SMSU 10

When **Shannon Currier** was named head coach prior to the 2000 season, the Golden Bears/Comets had posted an 0-3 record against SMSU, formerly known as Southwest State.

Currier put an end to the three game skid to start the series, beating the Mustangs four times in a row from 2000-03 to start a six game winning streak over SMSU.

When he rejoined the program in 2016, CSP was bested 28-14 by SMSU in Marshall but has since rattled off back-to-back wins under Currier in 2017 and 2018 to give him a 6-1 record against the Mustangs.

Overall, SMSU has not led in the series since Currier started the six game winning streak but it was tied at 6-6 and again at 10-10.

In St. Paul, Concordia is 3-4 against SMSU and has only played the Mustangs twice at Sea Foam Stadium, splitting games in 2015 (L, 28-14) and 2017 (W, 37-20). Concordia's 37-20 win in 2017 snapped a three game home skid to SMSU and was the first home win over the Mustangs since 2004 (63-21), played at Griffin Stadium.

CSP and SMSU have also tangled four times on a neutral field - all at Metrodome in Minneapolis, where CSP is 3-1 against the Mustangs.

LAST MEETING, 2018: CONCORDIA 16, SMSU 10

Battling the cold, rainy conditions in Marshall in addition to the host Mustangs, Concordia was led by soon-to-be All-Americans **Chris Garrett** and **Jonas Schenderlein** in grinding out a road win.

Garrett had four sacks and Schenderlein made three field goals including a pair from 50-plus yards (53, 52). Schenderlein produced the 11th three field goal game in team history, the fourth time he had achieved it. Three FGM was a school record until 2019 when **Danny Laudet** made five at SCSU.

The win propelled head coach **Shannon Currier** to the program's career wins record with his 41st career victory, surpassing Mark Mauer (40-39, 2004-10).

The win was also CSP's second straight road victory, the first time the program had won back-to-back road games since 2014, and came after winning their previous road game at UMary to snap a 13-game road losing streak.

Garrett's four sack performance was part of a defensive effort that produced seven team sacks which contributed to SMSU

rushing for 15 yards on 33 attempts. Concordia's defense also held SMSU to 0-of-4 on fourth down and 6-of-17 on third down.

The Mustangs were led by quarterback **Blake Gimbel**, who completed 32-of-46 for 353 yards and a TD. Including the seven sacks, Gimbel and the Mustangs ran 53 passing plays. Gimbel topped 10,000 career yards in the game for SMSU.

Concordia quarterbacks **Dom McKinzy** and **Maxon Hutton** combined for 10-of-23 passing for 165 yards. Hutton threw a TD and had 7-34 rushing while McKinzy had 116 passing yards.

Wide receiver **MJ Williams** had a 100-yard day, with five catches for 105 yards and a long of 44.

CSP rushed for 116 yards led by **Lajuan Preston's** 50 yards on 10 carries and a long of 21. Preston came through when it counted, rushing six times for 53 yards in the fourth quarter after being held for -3 yards on four attempts in the first three.

While **Andy Aune** had a team-high 11 tackles from the linebacker position, Garrett was joined by three defensive line teammates: **Jackson Dobbs**, **Kelly Pierce** and **Dylan Wood** who each contributed a sack up front.

The secondary was led by safety **Dez Bassett's** seven tackles and two pass breakups, adding three kick returns for 108 yards and a long of 55.

LAST WEEK: AUGUSTANA 21, CONCORDIA 20

For the second straight week, Concordia football was involved in a 1-point game, this time falling in the final minute on the road at Augustana 21-20 in CSP's final road game of 2019 at Kirkeby-Over Stadium in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

The Golden Bears actually trailed 14-3 in the first half, but an 8-yard touchdown pass from **Jared Olsgaard** to **Marcus Gustaveson** that was set-up by a 36-yard connection from Olsgaard to Jabril Clewis sent CSP into half down by four, 14-10.

In the second half, CSP's defense took over. Between Augustana's second touchdown to go ahead 14-3 early in the second quarter and their game winning score late in the fourth quarter, Concordia held the Vikings to just 60 yards on 29 plays on nine possessions including six punts, two fumbles and a kneel down at half.

In the third quarter specifically, CSP held Augie to one yard on 15 plays with three punts and two fumbles on five possessions.

The dominant defensive effort allowed freshman **Darios Crawley-Reid** to break free for a go-ahead 27-yard rushing touchdown with 6:45 to play in the third quarter, and a **Danny Laudet** field goal early in the fourth quarter put Concordia ahead 20-14 with 14:45 to play.

With just under five and a half minutes to play in the game, Laudet launched a 45 yard punt with Augustana returning to its own 27 yard line trailing by six points with 5:20 to go.

At that time, Augustana had rushed for just 20 yards on 21 carries throughout the game. After three passes for 47 yards surrounding an 8-yard run put the Vikings into the red zone with a 1st and 10 from the CSP 18 yard line, they started pounding on the ground. They ran the ball seven straight times, executing a 4th-and-1 from the CSP 9-yard line with just over a minute to play, and scored on a 3rd-and-goal from the CSP 2-yard line with 52 seconds left.

Crawley-Reid finished with his second career and second consecutive 100-yard rushing game on just 11 carries (11-102) along with his team leading seventh rushing and eighth overall TD.

Laudet had two field goals, from 31 and 35 yards and added a strong punting effort with a 45.5 average. He's now converted 15 field goals on the year, third most in school history and three shy of the single season record.

The defensive dominance was sparked by senior $\bf Jackson\ Dobbs$, who produced six tackles, 3.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and a forced fumble.

In the final tally, CSP carried a +10 advantage in total offense with 330 yards to Augie's 320, aided by a 168 to 46 rushing advantage.

CSP also won the turnover margin, 3-to-2 with Concordia's second turnover coming on a desperation pass as time expired.

STANDOUT BROTHERS ON O & D

Concordia-St. Paul's roster features a pair of brothers, with junior defensive end Chris Garrett and freshman running back Darios-Crawley Reid from Milwaukee, Wisconsin, as well as sophomore defensive back Hunter Thompson and freshman tight end Jackson Thompson from Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

With the Thompsons, Jackson has yet to appear in a game and is likely headed for a redshirt campaign while Hunter has worked his way into the secondary rotation and is a key special teams player. He leads the team with six tackles on kickoff coverage and has 13 total tackles with one interception on the season.

Garrett and Crawley-Reid have excelled in 2019. For the second year in a row, Garrett is among the national leaders in multiple statistics: first in forced fumbles (6), fourth in sacks (1.22/game) and sixth in tackles for loss (1.9/game). He set the school's career sacks record in his junior year with 33.5 and is third with 45.5 TFLs. Additionally, he set the single-game TFL record with 6.5 and put up the second most sacks in a game in team history with 5.0.

Crawley-Reid has made a name for himself as a true freshman, much like Garrett two years ago, breaking out as the season has progressed with a pair of 100-yard rushing games in week eight against Bemidji State (15-106, 2 TDs) and at Augustana (11-102, TD). In eight games, he has 538 combined rushing and receiving yards and eight total TDs, averaging 7.1 per rush (61-433) and 8.8 per catch (12-105).

PRESEASON & RETURNING ALL-AMERICAN: CHRIS GARRETT Junior defensive end Chris Garrett entered 2019 as a D2Football.com Preseason All-America First Team selection. He has delivered on the field, registering at least a sack in five games and at least a half TFL in eight of nine games.

CURRIER | 8TH SEASON HEAD COACH SHANNON



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference

title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 8-0 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 27-13 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji

State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a guarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

In week eight's 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State, he broke **Zach Moore's** (2009-13) career sack record (33) with 33.5, doing it in 14 fewer games (25) than Moore (39).

On the year, he's compiled 11.0 sacks, 17.5 TFLs, is third on the team with 57 total tackles, has forced six fumbles with two recoveries, has five pass breakups and seven QB hurries.

Through nine games, he leads the country with six forced fumbles, ranks fourth in the country with 1.22 sacks per game and is sixth with 1.9 TFLs per game, leading the NSIC in all three. Rare for a pass rushing defensive end, Garrett is 17th in the NSIC in tackles (57), as well.

He is coming off a year in which he was named All-America First Team by the AFCA and Associated Press, Second Team by D2C-CA and Third Team by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

Last year, he led the country with 1.65 sacks per game and was fourth in the nation with 1.90 tackles for loss per game.

He set the CSP single season sacks record in 2018 with 16.5 in just 10 games, and set the single game TFL record in week six in 2019 with 6.5 against MSU Moorhead, adding 5 sacks, second most in CSP history to earn D2Football.com National Defenisve Player of the Week for the second time in his career.

After finishing his sophomore year on a torrid pace with 14.0 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss and 36 total tackles in the last six games, Garrett's streak has carried over into 2019, giving him 25.0 sacks, 33.5 TFL and 93 total tackles in the last 15 games.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak including the first two games of 2018 for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 27-13 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 8-0 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

HOME SWEET FOAM: HOW SWEET IS IT?

With a 3-2 home record in 2018, Concordia-St. Paul enjoyed a home field advantage a year ago. The run game topped 200 yards in four out of five home games and held opponents to 131 yards or less four times. Concordia averaged 5.1 yards per carry in home games while opponents mustered just 3.1 yards per rush.

Overall, CSP held a 403.2 to 364.2 average total offense margin and racked up 5.9 yards per play while limiting foes to 4.8 in 2018 home games.

The defense also racked up 6.8 TFL per game while the offensive line limited the damage to just 3.4 opponent TFLs per home contest. Further, the defense held a 17-to-11 margin in sacks leading to 104-to-57 difference in lost yardage. The defense also stifled opponents on fourth down to just 2-for-12 (16.7%).

In the 2019 home opening win over Sioux Falls (41-17), Concordia won the turnover margin 2-0, registered six sacks and held the Cougars to 0-of-3 on fourth down and 4-of-13 on third down.

After a 29-3 loss to Minnesota State in week three, Concordia rebounded with a 24-17 home win over MSU Moorhead, holding the Dragons to school records -97 rushing yards and 22 tackles for loss while tying the NCAA Division II single game sacks recod with 14.

The Golden Bears added another win against the NSIC North in week eight, a 24-23 overtime win to move to 2-0 in overtime games held at Sea Foam Stadium

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 8-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 4-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the eight home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.9 to 9.4 margin of victory, a total of 247 to 75.

TOUGH HOME SLATE IN 2019 & OTHER SCHEDULE NOTES

After playing a tough road schedule a year ago, the flipped opponents in the South Division leads to a rough home slate in 2019. Concordia's six home opponents in 2019 combined for a 45-21 overall record last year, and only one of them (SMSU) had a losing season (4-7). The Golden Bears host, in order, Sioux Falls (7-4), Minnesota State (11-0), MSU Moorhead (8-3), Bemidji State (7-4), SMSU (4-7) and Winona State (8-3) in 2019.

Those opponents have combined for a 37-17 record in 2019 with five of the six producing a winning record.

CSP's last win over a nationally-ranked team was a 27-24 win vs #24 Wayne State in 2011 at Sea Foam Stadium and the last win over a nationally-ranked team on the road was a 28-26 win at #11 Minnesota State in CSP's 2010 Mineral Water Bowl campaign. CSP has now lost 18 straight games to ranked teams.

The Bears snapped a 13-game road losing streak in week seven in 2018 with a 17-7 win at UMary, snapped a 12-game NSIC South road losing streak in week 10 at SMSU in 2018 and in 2019 the program snapped a 10 game road night game losing streak with a 28-23 win over Upper lowa in a streak that dated back to 2013.

TURNOVERS MATTER

As CSP's program has grown under head coach **Shannon Currier**, the team's steady veteran offensive line has provided more protection for its quarterbacks, leading to more consistent ball control. Defensively, a talented and deep defensive line has helped create pressure in opposing backfields, with more forced fumbles and hurried passes leading to interceptions down field under third year defensive coordinator **Craig Stern**.

Since Currier has rejoined the program in 2016, Concordia has produced a 7-4 record when winning the turnover battle. In week two at Upper lowa, the Golden Bears lost the turnover battle (2-0) but came away with a 28-23 win, just the second time they've done so in 18 games since 2016 when losing turnover margin. When turnovers are even, CSP is 5-7 since 2016.

jority of snaps together over the past three years. Senior **TJ Diallo** worked his way into the interior defensive line starting lineup four times while sophomore **Shawn Aarhus** has a pair of starts.

On offense, Rich Kelly (39), Ethan Aune (29), Cris Wasylciw (16), Tanner Haechten (14) and Matthew Montgomery (11) were the opening week starters.

Montgomery earned the starting center role in 2018 as a redshirt freshman before his season ended with injury early on, but is now in his third year in the program while Wasylciw was a transfer with prior experience.

When Haechten's season ended due to injury in week four, CSP has rotated three players: sophomore **Tyson Kauffman**, redshirt freshman **Sam Marshalek** and junior college transfer **Dejon Hart** into his guard position. Kauffman has emerged as the starter for the past four games and likely going forward, and has now started 10 career games in his two years.

WINONA ST

In week nine at Augustana, redshirt freshman tackle **Adam Cook** earned his first career start and has been listed first on the two deep entering week 10.

SENIORS FLANK GARRETT ON D-LINE

While junior **Chris Garrett** garners the attention that comes with All-America and Preseason All-America honors, he's joined by four tenacious seniors who are accomplished in their own right: **Dylan Wood, TJ Diallo** and **Kelly Pierce** on the interior and **Jackson Dobbs** on the opposite end.

The statistical leader of that group, Dobbs has compiled 165 career tackles, 30.5 tackles for loss and 16.0 sacks across 37 games.

In 36 games, Pierce has 123 tackles, 20.0 for loss and 12.0 sacks while Wood has played in the most games (42) with 140 tackles, 20.0 for loss and 11.5 sacks. Diallo, a second year transfer, has started three times this year on the interior and has made 35 tackles (1.5 TFL) in 20 career games.

So far in 2019, Pierce has 27 tackles, 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks, Dobbs has 41 tackles, 10.5 TFL and 5.5 sacks while Wood has 39 tackles. 3.5 TFL.

The depth on the defensive line is notable as six other defensive linemen have recorded at least a half sack with backups led by sophomore **Shawn Aarhus** (4.0) and redshirt freshman **Mark O'Reilly** (3.0) while sophomore **Richard Ficociello** adds 3.0 TFL and 1.0 sack. Senior **Cole Marmor** also contributes one sack to the mix.

The defensive line combined for 13 of an NCAA DII recordtying 14 sacks in a 24-17 week six win over MSU Moorhead, and five of the team's six sacks in the season opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls.

On the year, the defensive line has racked up 29 of the team's 32 sacks and has piled up five fumble recoveries and eight forced fumbles.

CRAWLEY-REID BREAKS LOOSE

Freshman **Darios Crawley-Reid** has reached a new level in the second half of his breakout freshman season. He's averaged at least 5.0 yards per carry in all seven games with at least three carries, but over the last four weeks has elevated to a new level. He's had at least 79 combined rushing and receiving yards in the last four games with six total TDs, scoring a TD in each game with a pair of 2-TD performances.

After averaging over nine yards per carry with a TD on 8-73 rushing at Minot State in week seven, Crawley-Reid has put together back-to-back 100-plus yard efforts against a pair of stout rushing defenses with 15-106 and 2 TDs in a 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State before going for 102 yards on 11 carries with a long of 59 and a 27-yard rushing TD in a 21-20 loss at Augustana in week nine.

He leads the team in rushing with 433 yards on just 61 carries, averaging 7.1 per rush and adding 8.8 per reception on 12-105 through the air.

In the Northern Sun, he's 13th in the league with 54.1 yards per game on the ground and he's fourth in the conference with 7.1 yards per carry and with seven rushing TDs.

as a freshman, the running back group has had a key dynamic the past three years with sophomore **Shaq Johnson** and junior **Lajuan Preston**, both Florida natives.

Preston became an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention rusher a year ago when Johnson's season ended in week four against Wayne State, while Preston was lost for the season this year in week four at Wayne State.

Prior to his season ending injury last year in 2018, Johnson was on a torrid pace with over 100 combined rushing/receiving yards per game (367 rushing, 49 receiving) and five total TDs in four games.

Preston picked up where Johnson left off after Shaq's injury, gashing Minnesota Duluth, Northern State and Minnesota Crookston for 100-plus rushing yards in a four game stretch including a high of 21-141 against Northern State. He finished the year averaging 6.5 per carry with 704 rushing yards.

Although Preston suffered a season-ending injury in week four at Wayne State this season - the exact timetable and opponent as Johnson a year ago, 'LP' turned in a strong first four games with 177 yards at 5.5 per carry and a pair of TDs.

In the week four win at Wayne State, Preston surpassed 1,000 career rushing yards with 1,013 on 173 carries, averaging 5.9 per carry. Johnson is also approaching 1,000 rushing yards with 936 entering week 10 against SMSU.

Johnson made his 2019 debut in week two, reaching 100-plus yards for the third time in his career with 12 carries for 118 yards, adding a 36 yard catch and 25 yard kickoff return for 179 all-purpose yards on 14 touches in a win at Upper lowa.

He reached 100 combined yards in a week eight 24-23 win over Bemidji State with 21-68 rushing and 4-35 receiving (103).

A versatile back, Johnson is second on the team with 528 allpurpose yards, ranking both third on the team in rushing (328) and receiving (23-175). In his career, he has 936 rushing and 257 receiving yards with 10 combined TDs (11 with passing).

Adding to CSP's ground threat is athletic quarterback **Maxon Hutton**. The senior, who had his second career 100-yard rushing game with 120 yards and a 76-yard TD run in week four at Wayne State, is second on the team in rushing with 348 yards and a pair of scores.

Concordia now has four players on the roster with 100-plus yard rushing performances: Preston (3), Johnson (3), Hutton (2) and Crawley-Reid (2).

KIRCHOFF HEADS FROM DIAMOND TO GRIDIRON

Senior **Cole Kirchoff** drew the backfield start in week one, producing 21 combined yards on eight touches with 6-12 rushing and 2-9 receiving. He also found the end zone for the first time in week two at UIU.

He's appeared in six games, registering 13 carries for 23 yards and a TD and adding 2-9 receiving.

Kirchoff joined the football roster in 2019 after a four year run with the baseball team where he was a starting outfielder with three homers, three triples, 17 stolen bases and was third on the team with 20 RBIs.

HUTTON UNDER CENTER

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has ascended to the starting quarterback role after serving as the backup as a sophomore and junior while making spot starts. The dual-threat QB topped 3,000 career yards of total offense in week five at SCSU. He now has 3,637 yards of total offense and 21 total TDs in his career (17 pass, 4 rush).

In 2019, Hutton has become one of the more effient and versatile QBs in the NSIC. He ranks fifth in completion percentage (.563) and committed just six turnovers on the year. He engineers an offense that has committed just 13 turnovers in nine games.

He's hit new career-highs for a season in both passing (1,288) on 121-215 completions and rushing (106-348).

In the season opener, Hutton completed 13-of-22 (.591) for 159 yards and two touchdowns while adding 67 rushing yards on 14 carries and a touchdown. The senior also showed the poise necessary to lead a turnover-free offense.

In a week four win at WSC, he was named NSIC Offensive Player of the Week as he produced league-highs for the week in total offense (292) and rushing yards (120) while playing turnover-free football on the road and completing 66.7 percent (16-24) of his passes. The 16 completions would become a new career-high, temporarily. He also had a 76-yard TD run to put CSP ahead in the third quarter.

Hutton then topped 16 completions three times in a four game stretch including 21 at SCSU and 22 at Minot State, where he set new highs of 22-39 for 257 yards and had 302 yards of total offense in the road loss to the Beavers.

Backing him up is senior **Jared Olsgaard**, a transfer from Alabama A&M by way of Minnesota State Community & Technical College. In addition to being the backup QB, Olsgaard opened the year as the team's punt returner, averaging 8.5 (4-34) and then ascended to a starting role at wide receiver.

Taking more spot snaps under center as the season progressed, Olsgaard had an 11-yard keeper TD run in week seven at Minot State. He then relieved Hutton due to injury in week nine at Augustana, completing 12-21 for 128 yards and a TD and adding 14-53 rushing in a 1-point loss.

Olsgaard has recorded 11-90 receiving, 21-87 rushing, 4-34 on punt returns 12-23 passing for 128 yards. He has a passing and a rushing TD. The week 10 two-deep continues to list Hutton as the starter and Olsgaard second.

Depth at the position is provided by junior transfer **Johnny Saavedra** and redshirt freshmen **Darion Manning** and **Abe Schwartz**. Schwartz has earned a role on the roster as a special teams contributor, and is tied for the team lead with four tackles on punt returns and is third on the team with five special teams tackles.

THREE DEEP WITH SENIOR WIDE RECEIVERS

Senior quarterback **Maxon Hutton** has three senior wide receiver targets with complimentary skillsets: fourth year starter **Marcus Gustaveson**, second year junior college transfer **MJ Williams** and graduate Division I transfer **Jabril Clewis**.

In nine games, the trio has combined for over 60 percent of the team's receiving yards and seven of its eight TD catches.

Clewis leads the team with 402 yards and is second with 26 receptions. Williams leads the team with 27 catches and is second to Clewis with 327 yards. Gustaveson's output had been slowed by injury, but he remains tied for the team lead with Clewis with three TD catches.

GUSTAVESON CAREER RECEIVING RANKINGS

Fourth year starting wide receiver **Marcus Gustave-son** has established himself as one of CSP's top receivers in recent years. He has four career 100-yard performances and is climbing the CSP career receiving charts

He's eighth in career touchdown catches (19), ninth in receiving yards (1,796) and 10th in receptions (120).

SOPHOMORE SAFETIES

Sophomore safety **Dez Bassett** entered 2019 as the team's starting strong safety (rover) and was the second leading tackler a year ago as a redshirt freshman with 65. In 2019, Bassett is fifth on the team with 44 tackles with a season-high of eight in week five at SCSU.

Bassett's redshirt freshman 2018 season also included seven pass breakups and a 77-yard interception return for touchdown in a win at UMary in addition to the 65 total tackles.

Joining Bassett at the safety position are fellow sophomores **Rhett Sheehan** and **Parker Powers** at free safety.

Sheehan has started 18 of 20 career games with 69 career tackles, producing 32 stops in nine games in 2019, adding four pass breakups, a fumble recovery and 1.5 TFLs.

Powers has 35 career tackles, five pass breakups and an interception across 20 games. He has a pair of three tackle performances against Sioux Falls and Minnesota State among his nine tackles in 2019.

LINEBACKERS PUTTING UP BIG NUMBERS IN 2019

A key benefit of having an experienced, physical defensive line is the ability for the linebackers to be free to make plays.

In 2019, Concordia's linebackers opened the year with back-to-back NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

Sophomore MLB **Jake Portz** has emerged as one of the nation's elite tacklers in 2019. His 9.6 per game average ranks 29th in the country and second in the Northern Sun. The team's leading tackler in 2018 as a redshirt freshman with 77, he has surpassed that total with 86 tackles with two games left in 2019. He's now at 164 tackles in 20 career games.

Portz produced 18 tackles in a 28-23 road win at Upper Iowa

to earn NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors and followed that up with 15 tackles against #3 Minnesota State.

The 18 tackle performance is now the third most tackles in a game in school history, and the third most in an NSIC game this season.

It's part of a season resume that includes four double-digit tackle performances and at least five tackles in all nine games.

While Portz has been among the national leaders throughout the season, it was junior WLB **Dalton Smerchek** who had the impact performance in week one to earn NSIC Player of the Week honors.

In a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls, Smerchek made nine tackles, 1.5 for loss, forced a fumble at the goal line, recovered a muffed punt, had a pass breakup and pair of hurries. One of his tackles was a TFL at the goal line, forcing a field goal two plays later and one of his hurries came on fourth down in the second half as he continued to make impact plays of all kinds.

Initially a long snapper and key special teams contributor, Smerchek has turned into one of the top players on the defense in his junior season. In 31 career games, he's recorded 108 tackles, 7.0 for loss, five fumble recoveries and four forced fumbles.

Smerchek is fourth on the team with 51 tackles, adding 5.0

TFL, 2.0 sacks, 3 FF and 3 FR in nine games in 2019.

The unit is complimented by SLB **Gabe Nkumu** who topped Portz's 18 tackle performance with a 19-tackle game in week seven at Minot State, second most in the NSIC this year and second-most in school history. He is second on the defense with 61 tackles, adding two pass breakups and an INT.

Nkumu rejoined the program in 2019 after a year away when he played nine games as a freshman in 2017 with six tackles, 2.5 for loss, 1.5 sacks and a forced fumble.

JUNIORS LOCK DOWN CORNERBACK POSITION

The Golden Bears have a pair of new starters at corner, junior transfer **Preston Piltoff** and junior **Lorenzo Kendricks** in his third year in the program. Kendricks was one of the team's co-captains in week one, making three tackles and falling on a blocked punt for a touchdown in a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. He's played in 31 career games with 66 tackles and five pass breakups in his career.

Kendricks secured his first career INT in week three against Minnesota State.

Piltoff had four tackles (three solo) in his debut with CSP, also adding a fumble recovery at the goal line and recovering a blocked punt in a busy first half in a 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. Through nine weeks, Piltoff has registered 32 tackles (28 solo) with at least three tackles in seven of nine games. He

leads the team with eight pass breakups and had a gamesealing INT on a two-point conversion in the 24-23 OT win over Bemidji State in week eight.

The two corners have combined for 58 tackles, of which 48 have been solo stops.

LAUDET ASSUMES KICKING AND PUNTING DUTIES

Replacing one of the top kickers in the country is not an easy task, but the Golden Bears turned to an internal option with **Danny Laudet** who is in his third year in the program and has familiarity with the graduated **Jonas Schenderlein**.

Further, Schenderlein has remained in the program as a graduate assistant, working with Laudet and the other specialists.

Laudet responded well to the additional duties immediately, converting 2-of-2 field goals (30, 29), all five PATs for 11 points, three of eight kickoffs for touchbacks in his debut at kicker in the 41-17 season opening win over USF.

Through nine weeks, Laudet is one of the nation's best at both jobs, ranking fourth in the country field goals per game (1.67), seventh in the NSIC in FG pct (.714) and 36th in the country and fourth in the NSIC in punt average (40.4).

He's made 15-of-21 field goals on the year and is just three FGM shy of tying Tom Obarski (2014) and Jonas Schender-lein (2017) for the single season FGM record (18).

He's also cashed in all 21 of his PATs and has hammered 18 touchbacks on 46 kickoffs.

His early season performance was punctuated with an NCAA Division II long 82-yard punt from the back of his own end zone in a week four win at Wayne State.

He earned NSIC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for his week four performance, hitting the longest FG in the league for the week (second longest of 2019 in the NSIC) from 49 yards, bashing 5-of-6 kickoffs for touchbacks, averaging an NSIC season-best 51.0 yards on four punts and the nation's season long of 82 yards.

In week five, he was arguably even better, making a 4th quarter game-tying and a go-ahead field goal and adding another go-ahead field goal in overtime at SCSU. He also delivered a 53-yard punt with a -2 return (55 net) late in the fourth quarter against the Huskies.

It was part of a 5-field goal performance at SCSU, the first in the NSIC since 2010, a school record and the only recorded 5-for-5 field goal performance in league history dating back to when stats are displayed (1998-present). He is one of just four players with 5 FGM in a game in the country this season.

His 40.44 season and 39.71 career averages have been contending with the single season CSP punt average record (41.32) and career records (39.32) all year.

DEVIN FLAKES OPENS CAREER WITH 2 BLOCKS

Freshman defensive back **Devin Flakes** got off to an exceptional start to his college career, blocking a pair of punts while seeing regular action on special teams in his debut as a true freshman. The blocked punts came in a 24-0 second quarter for CSP in a season-opening 41-17 win over Sioux Falls. The first, recovered by junior cornerback **Preston Piltoff**, set up a two play scoring drive while the second was recovered by junior cornerback **Lorenzo Kendricks** for a TD at the end of the quarter for a 27-7 halftime lead over USF.

The special teams is led by third year special teams coordinator **Jake Munkwitz**, with the Golden Bears blocking 10 kicks and punts since 2017 in 30 games.

In addition to an increased ability to block kicks or disrupt an opponents kicking game with pressure, special teams standouts include sophomore **Hunter Thompson** with a team-high six tackles on kickoff returns and redshirt freshmen **Abe Schwartz** and **Andrew Egnarski** with team-highs four tackles on punt coverage. It's sophomore **Gabe Nkumu** who leads the team with seven total special teams tackles including five on kickoffs, while junior **Lorenzo Kendricks** is tied with Schwartz for third with five special teams takcles (3 KO, 2 PR).

TRENDING TOPICS: QB PERCENTAGE

A point of emphasis for the Golden Bears entering 2019 is a more efficient passing game. Even a slight improvement in completion percentage and a decrease in interceptions can lead to a significant boost in wins.

Since **Shannon Currier** has returned to the program in 2016, when the Golden Bears complete at least 54 percent of passes, the team is an above .500 squad with an 8-7 record.

TRENDING TOPIC: SACKS / WINS CORRELATION

In the 42 games since head coach **Shannon Currier** has been back with the program since 2016, the CSP defense has produced 4-plus sacks 11 times and had more sacks than the opponent 16 times.

In the 4-plus sack games, Concordia has an 8-3 record and has won five of its last six games when sacking the quarter-back four or more times

When producing more sacks than the opponent which factors line play on both sides, Concordia is 10-7.

FOUR DIFFERENT PLAYERS WITH RUSHING TDS

In Concordia's 28-23 win at Upper Iowa in week two, the Golden Bears had four different players reach the end zone on the ground, in order: Cole Kirchoff, Shaq Johnson, Darios Crawley-Reid and Lajuan Preston.

The last time Concordia had four different players score rushing touchdowns in the same game was a 73-13 win over Minnesota Crookston on October 7, 2005 when **Aaron Cawthorn** scored four rushing touchdowns while **James McNear**, **Brian Holmes** and **John Robinson** each had one.

On the year, four ball carriers have reached paydirt at least twice for Concordia in the run game: Darios Crawley-Reid (7), Shaq Johnson (2), Lajuan Preston (2) and Maxon Hutton (2) while Cole Kirchoff and Jared Olsgaard give the team six different players who've scored on the ground.

GROUND CONTROL LEADS TO VICTORIES

Since 2016 when **Shannon Currier** returned to CSP's sidelines, Concordia has rushed for 200-plus yards 10 times, producing a 7-3 record including a week two 28-23 win at Upper lowa with a 300-yard team effort.

By contrast, when Concordia holds opponents under 100 yards, a much tougher feat, the Golden Bears are 6-2. Five of those sub-100 opponent rushing games came last year with CSP producing a 4-1 record, only falling 24-20 in the season finale at Winona State.

This year, CSP's defense set a program record for fewest rushing yards allowed in a game by stifling (and sacking) MSU Moorhead for a loss of -97 rushing yards in a week six win.

Just four times since 2016 have the Golden Bears rushed for 200-plus and held an opponent to under 100 yards in the same game - all coming in 2018 with Concordia beating Upper Iowa (34-7), UMary (17-7) and Minnesota Crookston (21-13) while losing at Winona State (20-24).
