THIS WEEK: CSP HEADS TO "THE BOB" IN SIOUX FALLS

The Golden Bears look to pick up their first road win of 2021 this Saturday with a 1 p.m. kickoff against Sioux Falls for Military Appreciation Day at Bob Young Field. While CSP is seeking its first road win of the season, the Cougars are seeking their first home win.

CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

In 2018, head coach Shannon Currier became the school's alltime wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing Mark Mauer (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his 10th overall season at Concordia, carries a 48-42 career record, has a 29-14 home record and is 9-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship and the program's first-ever postseason appearance at the 2003 Mineral Water Bowl.

SMERCHEK SELECTED FOR BILLY BROWN'S #26 IN 2021

Senior linebacker Dalton Smerchek changed jersey numbers from 32 to 26 to honor Billy Brown, Jr., a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May of 2018. Billy passed away in 2018 shortly after graduating while working out near his home in the Twin Cities in June. Head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

A native of Casco, Wisconsin, Smerchek has played in all 35 games over his career, recording 126 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks, six fumble recoveries and five forced fumbles. In 2021, the senior has compiled nine tackles (eight solo) with 1.0 for loss and a forced fumble. He is a CoSIDA Academic All-America Second Team selection from 2020-21 and was an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention performer in 2019 when he made 60 tackles, 8.5 for loss, had three sacks, four fumble recoveries and three forced fumbles.

"It was an honor to wear Billy's number when the coaches asked me!" said Smerchek. "Billy was one of my main role models my freshman year, showing me how to take on college football and college in general. He strived to "Be Great!" and brought others with him."

NOTES ABOUT THE COUGARS

The Cougars are coming off of an 8-4 overall season (8-3 NSIC) that included a 4-3 finish in the NSIC South Division. The Cougars qualified for the NCAA playoffs, falling 24-21 at Colorado School of Mines.

Entering 2021, USF was picked fourth overall in the 14-team NSIC and tied for third with Winona State in the NSIC South Division.

The Cougars opened with a 24-16 home loss to Bemidji State before bouncing back with a 49-10 road win at Minot State in week 2.

Thuro Reisdorfer leads the league with 273 rushing yards at a 7.0 per carry pace while Jacqueze Lockett adds 18-89 on the ground.

Quarterback **Adam Mullen** has completed 34-49 (69.4) for 362 yards and four touchdowns. His top target is **Dominic Pegley**, ninth in the league with 192 receiving yards on 14 catches with a touchdown.

Joey Wehrkamp leads the Cougar defense with 3.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks while **David Martinez** adds 2.0 TFLs and a sack.

SERIES HISTORY: SIOUX FALLS 12, CONCORDIA 2

The Golden Bears have tangled with the Cougars 14 times with USF holding a 12-2 lead in the all-time series. The Golden Bears won the first meeting in 1971 and the most recent meeting in 2019, with USF winning the 12 in between.

Prior to CSP's move to Division II (1999 season), the teams met four times in a row from 1971-74 and again in 1982 and 1983. The series was reopened in 2012 when Sioux Falls made the move from NAIA to NCAA Division II and joined the NSIC in 2012, playing every year since.

In Sioux Falls, the Golden Bears are 0-4 since the Cougars joined the league with CSP looking for its first win at Bob Young Field.

LAST MEETING, 2019: CONCORDIA 41, SIOUX FALLS 17

The Golden Bears opened the season by snapping a 12-game losing streak against the Cougars with a 41-17 victory at Sea Foam Stadium, extending Coach **Shannon Currier's** home opening winning streak to eight games.

Quarterback **Maxon Hutton** completed 13-of-22 for 159 yards and two touchdowns, and added 14 carries for 67 yards and a touchdown on the ground.

Trailing 7-3 after each team had one possession, Concordia thwarted a goal line drive by the Cougars as linebacker **Dalton Smerchek** stripped USF quarterback **Caden Walters** at the one yard line with cornerback **Preston Piltoff** recovering.

Smerchek had a big day, and would later be named NSIC Defensive Player of the Week in what would be an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention season. He had a game-high nine tackles, had 1.5 tackles for loss, a forced fumble on the goal line and recovered a fumble on the punt team. He also had a pass breakup and one of his two QB hurries came on a fourth down play early in the fourth quarter in CSP territory.

The Golden Bears converted the goal line turnover into a second field goal, and on USF's third drive of the game, the CSP special teams came through, putting pressure on the punter to force a short 6-yard punt to give CSP the ball at the 23 yard line.

Two plays later, Hutton found **Marcus Gustaveson** for a 20-yard touchdown a 13-7 lead early in the second quarter. Concordia added two more scores before halftime in a big second quarter, with Hutton connecting with **MJ Williams** for a 33-yard TD strike followed by **Devin Flakes** blocking a punt recovering by **Lorenzo Kendricks** for a touchdown and a 27-7 halftime lead.

While Hutton put Concordia ahead 34-17 with six minutes left with a nine yard rushing touchdown, it was **Lajuan Preston** who would bury the Cougars with his seven yard touchdown just just over four minutes to go.

Preston had 80 yards on the ground on 13 carries, averaging 6.2 per carry in the game.

Defensive end **Chris Garrett**, coming off of a 2018 sophomore season when he led the country in sacks per game, had a strong debut with 1.5 sacks, also adding a hurry, a pass breakup and five tackles.

Concordia out-gained the Cougars 385-315 in the win and also had a 20-yard average field position advantage, with CSP also holding USF to 0-3 fourth down conversions in the game and won the turnover margin 2-0, converting them to 10 points.

LAST WEEK: CONCORDIA 24, UPPER IOWA 6

The Golden Bears made it nine straight home opener victories under head coach **Shannon Currier** (2000-03, 2016-present) with a 24-6 win over Upper Iowa at Sea Foam Stadium.

Concordia has now won three in a row against UIU, improves to 5-1 against the Peacocks at Sea Foam Stadium and 11-4 in the all-time series

The Golden Bears also improved to 19-18 at Sea Foam Stadium when scoring at least 20 points and 16-0 when holding opponents under 20 points at their on-campus stadium.

Sophomore linebacker **Andrew Egnarski** had his breakout performance with career-highs of 11 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and recovery.

He was the catalyst for a CSP defense that held the Peacocks to 257 yards of total offense at just 3.8 yards per play, including 33-78 on the ground.

Offensively, it was freshman quarterback Conner Cordts with the breakout performance, completing 20-27 for 249 yards and

two touchdowns while playing his second straight turnover-free game under center. He connected with nine different receivers, targeting 10 in the game.

Junior safety **Rhett Sheehan** provided the first spark early in the second quarter, intercepting a UIU pass at the UIU 40 yard line and returning it 30 yards to the 10 to set up the first score of the game, freshman running back **Jaylin Richardson's** first career touchdown from one yard out.

Richardson finished with 13 carries for 61 yards.

Concordia's three touchdowns were all career firsts, starting with Richardson's. Later in the second quarter, it was Cordts' first career TD pass to redshirt freshman **Mason Van Zeeland**, his first career TD haul from 25 yards, set up by a 35-yarder between the pair earlier in the drive.

Van Zeeland finished with two catches for 60 yards as CSP went into halftime leading 14-0 at the break.

Freshman kicker **Sam Henson** converted a 38-yard field goal in the third quarter to push Concordia to a 3-score lead (17-0). On the ensuing drive, Egnarski forced and recovered a fumble as UIU approached the red zone, stopping their first big scoring threat.

Midway through the fourth quarter, Cordts delivered a strike 33 yards downfield over the middle to **Jaheim Arnold** as the freshman secured his first career TD catch for a 24-0 lead with 7:47 to go.

It wasn't until under three minutes to play when the Peacocks finally found the end zone, snapping the shutout on an 11 yard TD pass from backup OB **Marcus Orr** to **Xavier Saldana**.

CSP held UIU's quarterbacks to 8-17 passing each (16-34 total) for 179 yards, with each throwing an interception.

Joining Sheehan with strong performances from the secondary were cornerback **Preston Piltoff** with seven tackles and a pair of breakups while **Lorenzo Kendricks** also secured an INT.

The secondary benefited from a strong push from the pass rush as CSP produced five team scacks with **Jake Richardson** adding a solo sack to Egnarski's 3.5.

Nathan Gimza and **Joey Farley** tied for the team lead with five receptions each, Gimza going for 59 yards and Farley for 26.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak including the first two games of 2018 for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 29-14 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 9-0 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home inales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

The Golden Bears are now 11-12 at Sea Foam Stadium under Currier since 2016 including winning seasons in 2018 (3-2) and 2019 (4-2) with a 1-0 start at home in 2021 for an 8-4 record the past three seasons.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach **Shannon Currier** has improved to 9-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 5-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the nine home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.1 to 9.0 margin of victory, a total of 271 to 81.

NEW TO THE NORTH

The 2021 Golden Bears have shifted to the NSIC North Division after the elimination of football at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston - both former members of the North Division.

The result of the 14-team NSIC is two 7-team divisions, where each program plays the other six teams once every year, rotating between home sites, while facing five of the seven teams from the opposite division.

Previously, CSP played seven games against the NSIC South Division, with that total cut down by two in 2021; and played the NSIC North four times, with that total increased by two.

In 2021, Concordia will not face Wayne State for the first time since joining the league in 1999, or Augustana for the first time since 2004, including four non-conference games with the Vikings eaach year from 2004 to 2007 with Augie joining the NSIC in 2008

The Golden Bears will now face every north team at home every other year, and welcome MSU Moorhead to Sea Foam Stadium for just the third time when the Dragons visit St. Paul on November 6. Meanwhile, Minnesota Duluth won't come to St. Paul this year, and have only played at Sea Foam Stadium twice, as well, in 2012 and 2016.

TURNOVERS MATTER

Since head coach Shannon Currier rejoined the program in 2016, Concordia has produced a 9-4 record when winning the turnover battle. Meanwhile, when losing the turnover battle under Currier since 2016, Concordia is 2-18 while CSP is 5-8 when turnovers are even.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 10TH SEASON

Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference

title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 9-0 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 29-14 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

PILTOFF PRESEASON NATIONALLY-RANKED CORNERBACK

Senior cornerback **Preston Piltoff** is on the national map, ranked as the #4 cornerback in the country by CFB Network entering the 2021 season. He led the league in pass breakups as a junior in 2019, also leading the team with two interceptions including one for a 92 yard touchdown - the longest INT in the NSIC in 2019.

In 2021, he's second on the team with 12 tackles (10 solo) with a pair of pass breakups in the first two games.

Piltoff is a junior college transfer, competing at Grossmont College in 2018 with 36 tackles, eight pass breakups and two interceptions after an All-Conference freshman year at Shasta College with 16 tackles and five pass breakups.

FRESHMAN QB CONNER CORDTS

The Golden Bears entered 2021 with freshman **Conner Cordts** declared the starter, just the second opening day starting quarterback for the program since moving to NCAA Division II in 1999, joining CSP Athletic Hall of Famer, two-time NSIC Champion and a former Harlon Hill candidate James McNear (2002-05).

Cordts is just the sixth freshman to start a game at quarterback since CSP football has been a Division II program - all of them having used a redshirt season prior to making their debut.

He made his debut at Winona State, completing 25-of-40 for 130 yards while leading the team in rushing with 39 yards on 11 attempts. He did not commit any turnovers. His breakout game was a week 2 win over Upper lowa, completing 20-of-27 for 249 yards and two touchdowns, once again playing turnover-free football under center

Since **Shannon Currier** has returned to the program in 2016, when the Golden Bears complete at least 54 percent of passes, the team is an above .500 squad with a 10-8 record.

CONCORDIA ST CLOUD GOLDEN HUSKIES

At the conclusion of the 2019 football season, the administrations at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston made the difficult decision to end their football programs.

Immediately, the CSP coaches put together a plan and worked with Concordia administration to provide an opportunity for student-athletes to continue to pursue their goals towards graduating from college while remaining members of an NSIC football program.

Coach Currier and his staff successfully recruited 11 members of the 2019 SCSU football team, and one from UMC.

Robby Carrillo, Luke Dunsmoor, Jake Edwards, Nathan Gimza, Taylon Hensley, Sarek Hoerth, Robert Kraklow, Dominic La-Combe, Luke Shepherd, Mason Van Zeeland and Nick Webley all joined Concordia from SCSU while Ryan Martin changed his golden from the Eagles to the Bears. They've been part of the campus community since the pandemic shortened spring 2020 semester and were with us through the 2020-21 academic year.

Of that group, all have challenged for a travel roster spot while **Robert Kraklow** (LT), **Nathan Gimza** (WR) and **Mason Van Zeeland** (WR) have earned starting roles. Kraklow is a returning All-NSIC North Division Second Team offensive lineman, while Gimza leads the team with nine catches for 72 yards and a long of 40 - all team highs, and Van Zeeland had two catches for 60 yards and a 25-yard touchdown against Upper lowa in week two.

THREE FRESHMEN CLASSES?!

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic forcing the cancellation of NSIC football in 2021, and the eligibility waivers handed down by the NCAA, the Golden Bears have a large number of freshmen on the roster.

The roster includes 25 redshirt freshmen, players who did not compete in 2019 in their first year of college football whether it was at CSP or elsewhere.

The bigger number is 57 true freshmen, players who had their first season as college student-athletes in the 2020-21 academic year that didn't lose eligibility, as well as first year players new to Concordia in 2021-22.

Second year freshmen who are making an early impact on the field include: reserve offensive lineman Jac Carver, special teams linebacker Brayden Hilgemann, reserve linebacker Caden Baarts, starting safety Cyrus McClure, special teams safety Anthony Ukofia, special teams linebacker Max Giannini, kicker Sam Henson, reserve defensive back Kahlil Robinson, starting quarterback Conner Cordts and starting running back Javlin Richardson.

True first year freshmen making an early impact on the roster include: wide receiver Jahiem Arnold and punter Parker Dahlman while three true freshmen have travelled but yet to make their debuts: defensive tackle Brad Walker and running backs Keron Franklin and TJ Holmes.

SKILL POSITION TURNOVER

The Golden Bears entered 2021 looking to replace all but one passing attempt (**Abe Schwartz**), 88 percent of its rushing yards with its leader being **Lajuan Preston** (177) and over 90 percent of its receptions with its leader being **Kevin Ventura-Cortes** (11-76)

attack in 2019. "LP" has played in 27 career games with 1,013 rushing yards and a 5.7 career average. His breakout year was in 2018 when he averaged 6.5 per carry and rushed for 704 yards. He was off to another strong start in 2019 with 177 yards in four games with two touchdowns and a 5.5 average before a seasonending injury. He missed the 2021 opener with an injury but returned to contributed in week two.

He's aided by Purdue junior transfer **Brian Lankford-Johnson** and Northern lowa freshman transfer **Jaylin Richardson**. Lankford-Johnson played in 12 games including a start in 2016 as a freshman for the Boilermakers, earning Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors with 18 carries for 127 yards and a touchdown against Illinois and finished the year second on the team with 314 yards on the ground and 6.5 per carry, adding the team's longest run (48) and 11 catches for 90 yards. He played in six games as a sophomore with 22-86 rushing before deciding to transfer to CSP for the spring 2020 term.

Richardson was a highly recruited RB from the Kansas City area, initially committing to Kansas before signing with Northern lowa where he was an early enrollee in spring 2020. He made his debut in the 2021 COVID shortened spring season for the Panthers, and retained his eligibility for his first year with CSP.

So far in 2021, Richardson leads the backfield with 63 rushing yards on 18 carries and added 7-69 receiving in the week 1 opener at Winona State. Lankford-Johnson is third on the team with 16 carries for 32 yards and thrid on the team with five catches (5-18). They are also involved in the return game.

Ethan Falaniko, a transfer from South Dakota who came to CSP for the 2019 season, was a factor in the backfield rotation before an injury has forced him to be inactive so far in 2021. He had six carries in five games in 2019 and was poised for a bigger role in 2021.

GROUND CONTROL LEADS TO VICTORIES

Since 2016 when **Shannon Currier** returned to CSP's sidelines, Concordia has rushed for 200-plus yards 11 times, producing an 8-3 record.

By contrast, when Concordia holds opponents under 100 yards, a much tougher feat, the Golden Bears are 8-3.

Just four times since 2016 have the Golden Bears rushed for 200-plus and held an opponent to under 100 yards in the same game - all coming in 2018 with Concordia beating Upper Iowa (34-7), UMary (17-7) and Minnesota Crookston (21-13) while Iosing at Winona State (20-24).

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTES

While the Golden Bears replaced four starting offensive linemen, the unit brings back plenty of experience led by transfer tackle **Robert Kraklow**, an All-NSIC North Division Second Team performer at St. Cloud State and former Division I player at Northern Illinois.

The top returner is guard **Matthew Montgomery**, a regular starter at center in 2019, while new center **Sam Marshalek** had stepped into a starting guard role late in 2019 before the two players flipped positions in 2021. At the other tackle, **Adam Cook** had stepped up in 2019, starting the final three games down the stretch and retaining the position in 2021, meaning the Golden Bears only had one spot awarded to a player with little or no experience. The other guard spot has been occupied by **Brody Card**, a redshirt freshman in his third year.

With most of the unit having the 2020-21 year together, expect the continuity and production to improve throughout the campaign.

The **Richardsons**, from Kansas City, are newcomers to the program in 2021 as Division I transfers.

Jake, a senior, transferred to CSP from South Dakota where he played 25 games across three seasons for the Coyotes, securing 16 tackles, 5.0 for loss and 5.0 sacks along with two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. At CSP, he picked up his first sack in week 2 against Upper lowa.

Jaylin, a freshman, transferred to CSP from Northern lowa where he competed during UNI's shortened spring season in 2021 and was not charged a season of eligibility due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He made his debut against #5 South Dakota State, recording a tackle. He's been a key part of CSP's backfield in 2021, with 63 rushing yards and a touchdown along with 69 receiving yards on seven catches while contributing 94 kickoff return yards on four attempts.

The **Jeudys** are from Miami, Florida with Mel joining the program as a transfer prior to the 2020 spring term and El-Osiris being a freshman during the 2020-21 academic year.

Mel, a junior nose tackle, played three games at Alderson Broaddus University, a Division II program in 2019 after spending his first two years of college football at Division I Eastern Kentucky, including a redshirt season. The junior has played both games for CSP including an opening day start and has made three tackles.

El-Osiris, a freshman linebacker, has also appeared in both games, primarily as a special teams contributor.

The **Carrillos** are offensive linemen from Case High School in Racine, Wisconsin with **Robby** joining the program prior to the 2020 spring term as a transfer from St. Cloud State with four years of eligibility remaining after redshirting with the Huskies in the final season of SCSU's program. **Austin** is a true first year freshman.

The **Higgins** are defensive acks from Rochester, Minnesota and the only set of brothers from this group to both join CSP as freshmen. Graduates of John Marshall High School, the duo are each preparing to make their college football debuts.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS ON DEFENSE

The Golden Bears have a pair of defensive starters who earned CoSIDA Academic All-America Second Team honors for the 2020-21 academic year, that was held without a season in the NSIC: **Shawn Aarhus** and **Dalton Smerchek**.

Smerchek, a senior linebacker, is a returning 2019 All-NSIC South Division honorable mention performer when he had 60 tackles, 7.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks, led the NSIC with four fumble recoveries and ranked second in the league with three forced fumbles. He has played in 35 career games with 126 tackles, 11.5 TFL, 3.0 sacks, six fumble recoveries and five forced fumbles. He led CSP with seven tackles and 1.0 TFL in the season opener at WSU and forced a fumble in week 2's

win over Upper Iowa.

Aarhus is a junior defensive tackle who has played in 24 career games while stepping into a starting role in 2021. He has 46 total tackles, 7.0 TFL, 5.5 sacks and three fumble recoveries in his career. In 2021, he's registered nine tackles with a half sack

EXPERIENCED LINEBACKERS GROUP

All three of Concordia's starting linebackers from 2019's 6-5 squad return for 2021: senior whip **Dalton Smerchek**, junior mike **Jake Portz** and junior sam **Gabe Nkumu**.

Smerchek and Portz earned All-NSIC South Division honorable mention honors as Smerchek led the league in fumble recoveries and added 8.5 TFL with 60 tackles while Portz was second in the league with 105 tackles and had an 18 tackle performance, third most in a game in school history. Nkumu, meanwhile, topped Portz's 18 tackles with 19, an NSIC singlegame high for the year as he finished second on the team with 73 tackles.

In 2021, Smerchek led the team in tackles in week 1 with seven including 1.0 TFL at Winona State and added a forced fumble in week 2 against Upper Iowa.

Nkumu has added eight tackles included 1.5 TFL through two weeks and Portz has contributed five tackles.

The unit was bolstered with the emergence of **Andrew Egnarski**, who has earned starts at the MLB spot to start the year. He had his breakout effort in week 2 against Upper lowa with a team-high 11 tackles, 3.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and recovery, earning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

His 3.5 sacks performance is an NSIC single game high while the 3.5 TFL are tied for the most in a game in the league so far.

On the year, Egnarski is third in the league with 4.0 TFL and his 3.5 sacks is second while his 15 tackles ranks 14th.

Adding depth at the position is **Foster Conzet** at the whip, ranking third on the team with nine tackles.

TRENDING TOPIC: SACKS / WINS CORRELATION

In the 46 games since head coach **Shannon Currier** has been back with the program since 2016, the CSP defense has produced 4-plus sacks 13 times and had more sacks than the opponent 19 times.

In the 4-plus sack games, Concordia has a 10-3 record and has won six of its last seven games when sacking the quarterback four or more times including week 2's five sack performance against Upper Iowa.

When producing more sacks than the opponent which factors line play on both sides, Concordia is 12-8.

DEFENSIVE LINE SEES MAJOR TURNOVER

The 2021 Golden Bears were supposed to feature the return of two-time All-American and two-time NSIC sack champion **Chris Garrett**, the NCAA DII career record holder with 15 forced fumbles and CSP career sack record holder.

But Garrett was drafted following the cancelled COVID season in the seventh round by the Los Angeles Rams, making the 53 man roster this fall.

Going with Garrett were the other three outgoing senior starting linemen, as well as three key rotation

Entering 2021, the Golden Bears will be filling the defensive line with three players who played key roles in 2019: ends **Richard Ficociello** and **Mark O'Reilly** and tackle **Shawn Aarhus** while impact transfers **Mel Jeudy** joins Aarhus in the middle and **Jake Richardson** joins the defensive end rotation.

Aarhus has played in 24 games with 5.5 sacks, Ficociello has played in 17 games with 30 tackles and 4.0 TFL and 0'Reilly has secured 7.0 TFL and 4.0 sacks across 13 games.

In 2021, Aarhus leads the unit with nine tackles and a half sack, Ficociello has seven tackles, a pass breakup and a pair of hurries, O'Reilly has four tackles, 0.5 TFL and three hurries while Richardson and Jeudy have three tackles each and Richardson has a sack.

The unit also features SCSU transfer Luke Dunsmoor and returners **Keegan Larson** and **Carter Hislop**.

ROOKIE KICKING GAME

Concordia-St. Paul has featured some of the top kickers and punters in the Northern Sun as well as nationally over the past decade, and in 2021 the kicking and punting jobs will be handled by a pair of talented freshmen: second year kicker **Sam Henson** and first year punter **Parker Dahlman**.

Henson had a standout debut, converting his only two field goal attempts from 38 and 48 yards, before adding 3-3 PAT and 1-2 FG in a week 2 win over Upper lowa. His 48 yard field goal is the second longest in the Northern Sun this year and his 38 yarder is fourth longest.

Dahlman has been busy so far, as well, tied for second in the league with 13 punts and second in the NSIC with a 42.2 punting average. His two punts of 50-plus yards, both in week 2 against Upper lowa, are tied for the league lead. His 56 yard punt is the fourth longest in the league so far and his 47.3 yard punting average in week 2 is a league single game high.
