THIS WEEK: GOLDEN BEARS HOST BSU FOR HOMECOMING

The Golden Bears will play their first-ever NSIC North Division game on Homecoming at Sea Foam Stadium, hosting Bemidji State. The Beavers will play in their first homecoming game at Sea Foam Stadium, where Concordia holds a 3-8 record in homecoming games since moving back to campus in 2009.

Last week, Bemidji State opened NSIC North Division play with a 49-35 win over Minot State at home, while Concordia played its final NSIC South Division opponent for the year with a 58-10 loss at Minnesota State. CSP and MSU were the only teams to play an North-South game last week.

CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

In 2018, head coach **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his 10th overall season at Concordia, carries a 48-45 career record, has a 29-15 home record and is 9-0 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship and the program's first-ever postseason appearance at the 2003 Mineral Water Bowl.

2021 TEAM CAPTAINS

CSP head coach **Shannon Currier** features rotating team captains each week for the third year in a row in 2021. Captains are selected by the coaching staff based on performance on the field and as a leader in practice, meetings and day-to-day activities.

This week's game captains: freshman quarterback **Conner Cordts** (6x) and sophomore center **Sam Marshalek** (5x) on offense and senior cornerback **Preston Piltoff (4x)** and junior safety **Rhett Sheehan** on defense.

SMERCHEK SELECTED FOR BILLY BROWN'S #26 IN 2021

Senior linebacker **Dalton Smerchek** changed jersey numbers from 32 to 26 to honor **Billy Brown, Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May of 2018. Billy passed away in 2018 shortly after graduating while working out near his home in the Twin Cities in June. Head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

A native of Casco, Wisconsin, Smerchek has played in all 38 games over his career, recording 139 tackles, 12.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks, six fumble recoveries and five forced fumbles. In 2021, the senior has compiled 22 tackles (15 solo) with 2.0 for loss and a forced fumble.

He is a CoSIDA Academic All-America Second Team selection from 2020-21 and was an All-NSIC South Division honorable mention performer in 2019 when he made 60 tackles, 8.5 for loss, had three sacks, four fumble recoveries and three forced fumbles.

"It was an honor to wear Billy's number when the coaches asked mel" said Smerchek. "Billy was one of my main role models my freshman year, showing me how to take on college football and college in general. He strived to "Be Great!" and brought others with him."

NOTES ABOUT THE BEAVERS

Entering 2021, Bemidji State was picked second in the NSIC North Division Preseason Coaches' Poll and picked up a first place vote, and picked sixth overall in the 14-team NSIC Overall poll.

BSU is coming off of an 8-3 overall record in 2019, tied for tops in the NSIC North Division with Minnesota Duluth, but finished 6-1 in NSIC North play, a game behind 7-0 UMD for the division title.

The Beavers have continued at a similar pace in 2021, with a 3-2 overall record and 1-0 mark in the North Division. After winning their first two games to open the year, 24-16 at Sioux Falls and 38-28 over Wayne State, BSU fell 45-24 at Minnesota State and 52-24 at home to Augustana before bouncing back last week in the NSIC North opener 49-35 over Minot State.

So far, BSU has done its damage in the air, boasting the seventh ranked passing attack in the country with 339 yards per game and ranked 24th with 15 yards per completion. They also protect the QB, allowing just three sacks through five games to rank seventh in the nation, and only 17 tackles for loss against on the year, eighth nationally. With 455 yards of total offense per game, BSU has the 20th ranked output and the nation's 25th-ranked turnover margin (11-7).

Leading the team is QB **Brandon Alt**, ranked third in the league and fourth in the country with 1,619 yards but has completed 48.2 percent of his 222 passes with a 16-6 TD-INT ratio.

His top target, **Brendan Beaulieu** (31-549, 2 TD) is fifth in the league and 11th nationally in receiving yards and **Malik Williams** (17-304, 5 TD) ranks 10th NSIC while **Dhel Duncan-Busby** (18-234, 1 TD) is in the top-20 in the league.

On the ground, **Makaio Harn** is ninth NSIC with 334 yards, averaging 4.9 per carry.

SERIES HISTORY: BEMIDJI STATE 9, CONCORDIA 8

The Golden Bears and Beavers have had a competitive history entering the 18th all-time meeting dating back to 1999 when CSP joined the Northern Sun.

Concordia dominated the early years, winning all four games in head coach Shannon Currier's first term from 2000-03 after dropping the opening tilt in 1999, and won five of the first seven overall.

Bemidji State flipped the momentum with four straight wins between 2006 and 2009, but the teams have split the most recent six contests from 2010 to present.

The teams played every year from 1999 to 2011 before the NSIC's division split caused the series to shift to an every other year format. But in 2021, the teams are in the same division once again.

Concordia is 2-2 against BSU at Sea Foam Stadium (2009-present) and 6-2 against BSU in home games including the Griffin Stadium era.

LAST MEETING, 2019: CONCORDIA 24, BSU 23 (OT)

Concordia cornerback **Preston Piltoff** intercepted BSU quarterback **Emmett Enright** on Bernidji State's two-point try in overtime in a fitting end to a game that CSP led throughout thanks to three first half turnovers by the Beavers.

Junior defensive end **Chris Garrett** set the CSP sack record in the victory with a pair of first half strip sacks with CSP recovering both fumbles, and deflected a pass that was intercepted by linebacker **Gabe Nkumu** as CSP built a 17-7 lead at the break.

Garrett finished the game with 11 tackles, 3.0 TFLs, 2.0 sacks, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and a pass breakup.

Concordia improved to 5-3 with the win while BSU fell to the same record.

Garrett set the career sacks record with 33.5 in just 25 games, a feat that is even more impressive as he broke the record held by **Zach Moore**, who had 33.0 sacks from 2009-13 across 39 games in four seasons.

Moore would become Concordia's first-ever NFL Draft pick, taken in the 6th round in the 2014 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots, winning a Super Bowl in his rookie season and would go on to play in five NFL seasons.

Garrett, meanwhile, had his senior year stripped due to COV-ID-19 and while prepared to play his final year of eligibility in 2021 with CSP, he would instead become Concordia's second NFL Draft Pick in the 2021 NFL Draft by the Los Angeles Rams in the seventh round, making the roster this fall.

In the 2019 game, Garrett's younger brother **Darios Crawley-Reid** had his first career 100-yard rushing performance with 15-106 and two touchdowns. He was joined in the 100-yard club that day by running back **Shaq Johnson**, who had 103 combined yards with 21-68 rushing and 4-35 receiving.

It was a windy fall afternoon at Sea Foam Stadium, and with CSP winning the coin toss, had the advantage to play the conditions and build the lead and momentum in the first half.

Entering the fourth quarter, CSP had a 20-11 edge in first downs and 28:13 to 16:47 margin in time of possession to go with the 17-7 lead.

BSU converted a field goal with 9:30 to play and used an 11-play, 70-yard drive across 4:09 to tie the game on a 13-yard passing TD with 1:51 to play, sending the game to overtime.

CSP had the ball first, with Johnson's 14 yard run followed by a nine yard run by Crawley-Reid, who punched it in from a yard out two plays later for the upper hand, 24-17.

BSU wasn't able to pick up a first down on its attempt, facing a 4th-and-9 from the CSP 24 yard line, but scored on the fourth down play before Piltoff sealed the win with the INT on the two point attempt.

Each team rushed for 196 yards in the game and BSU out-paced

CSP by 13 yards (169-156) in the air, but Concordia forced four total turnovers to BSU's two

Maxon Hutton completed 18-35 for 156 yards and a TD while adding 22 rushing yards. He found six different targets, hitting five of them at least twice while three players had four receptions each including **Jabril Clewis** (4-47), who had a 17-yard TD catch in the first quarter to make it a 10-0 lead for CSP early.

BSU running back **Jalen Frye** was busy, pounding the ball with 46 carries for 151 yards with a long of 32, averaging 3.2 per carry and adding three catches for eight yards to total 49 touches.

Enright completed 14-25 for 169 yards and three TD passes but was intercepted twice. **Malik Williams** had 2-18 receiving with a pair of touchdowns, and added a 51-yard run in the game.

LAST WEEK: MINNESOTA STATE 58, CONCORDIA 10

Playing in its final NSIC North-South contest of the season, Concordia was unable to spoil Minnesota State's homecoming, falling to the 17th-ranked Mavericks 58-10 at Blakeslee Stadium.

Freshman running back Brandon Marenco was CSP's offensive bright spot, rushing eight times for 67 yards including a 36-yard TD burst in the fourth quarter.

Three Golden Bear running backs totaled 144 rushing yards on 28 carries, with Brian Lankford Johnson rushing for a season-best 39 yards on nine carries with a long of 27 and Jaylin Richardson adding 38 on 11 carries with a long of 15.

Overall, CSP finished with its second-straight 100-yard rushing game with 37-121 as a team.

MSU countered by rushing for 352 yards on 53 team rushing attempts and five touchdowns led by Charles Coleman's 6-88 and two scores while Deyon Campbell added 3-70 and Micah Cooper 9-66.

CSP was able to hold MSU to under 100 team passing yards, stifling QB JD Ekowa to 1-8 passing for 16 yards, but the veteran QB did manage two rushing touchdowns on 4-27 yards. Hayden Ekern completed 4-5 for 81 yards and two TDs, as well.

For CSP, Joey Farley had the biggest play in the pass game, a 23-yard reception from Conner Cordts, who spread out his five completions to five different targets, finishing 5-20 for 46 yards while playing turnover-free under center.

Rhett Sheehan and Caden Baarts led CSP's defense with five tackles each, with Baarts chipping in 1.0 of the team's 8.0 TFLs and Jake Richardson added a sack up front. Shawn Aarhus also disrupted the backfield, pressuring and tipping Ekowa's pass to start the third quarter that would be intercepted and returned to the 1-yard line by Andrew Egnarski, setting up CSP's first points of the day on a 25-yard Sam Henson field goal.

Freshman punter **Parker Dahlman** had a big day, coming up one punt shy of the single game record, punting 11 times for 450 yards, the third most punting yards in a game. He had a 40.9 yard average, blasted a pair of 50-plus yard punts and had one inside the 20.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak including the first two games of 2018 for the first time in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first three game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 29-15 career record in home games at Concordia, a perfect 9-0 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

The Golden Bears are now 11-13 at Sea Foam Stadium under Currier since 2016 including winning seasons in 2018 (3-2) and

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

Concordia head coach Shannon Currier has improved to 9-0 in his CSP career in home openers including 5-0 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the nine home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.1 to 9.0 margin of victory, a total of 271 to 81.

NEW TO THE NORTH

The 2021 Golden Bears have shifted to the NSIC North Division after the elimination of football at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston - both former members of the North Division.

The result of the 14-team NSIC is two 7-team divisions, where each program plays the other six teams once every year, rotating between home sites, while facing five of the seven teams from the opposite division.

Previously, CSP played seven games against the NSIC South Division, with that total cut down by two in 2021; and played the NSIC North four times, with that total increased by two.

In 2021, Concordia will not face Wayne State for the first time since joining the league in 1999, or Augustana for the first time since 2004, including four non-conference games with the Vikings eaach year from 2004 to 2007 with Augie joining the NSIC

The Golden Bears will now face every north team at home every other year, and welcome MSU Moorhead to Sea Foam Stadium for just the third time when the Dragons visit St. Paul on November 6. Meanwhile, Minnesota Duluth won't come to St. Paul this year, and have only played at Sea Foam Stadium twice, as well, in 2012 and 2016.

Under head coach Shannon Currier, the Golden Bears are 16-11 against the NSIC North Division teams across his career and 5-7 against NSIC North Division teams since rejoining the program in 2016.

TURNOVERS MATTER

Since head coach Shannon Currier rejoined the program in 2016, Concordia has produced a 9-5 record when winning the

Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the Year. The conference

title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 9-0 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 29-15 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji

State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a guarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

turnover battle. Meanwhile, when losing the turnover battle, CSP is 2-20 and CSP is 5-8 when turnovers are even.

CSP hadn't committed an offensive turnover until week four this year, fumbling on the first offensive play in a 34-24 loss to SMSU at Sea Foam Stadium. Of Concordia's five turnovers on the year, three have been a result of fumbles on kickoff returns.

The Golden Bears entered 2021 with freshman **Conner Cordts** declared the starter, just the second freshman opening day starting quarterback for the program since moving to NCAA Division II in 1999, joining CSP Athletic Hall of Famer, two-time NSIC Champion and a former Harlon Hill candidate **James McNear** (2002-05).

Cordts is just the sixth freshman to start a game at quarterback since CSP football has been a Division II program - all of them having used a redshirt season prior to making their debut.

He made his debut at Winona State, completing 25-of-40 for 130 yards while leading the team in rushing with 39 yards on 11 attempts. He did not commit any turnovers.

His breakout game was a week 2 win over Upper lowa, completing 20-of-27 for 249 yards and two touchdowns, once again playing turnover-free football under center.

Cordts topped the 300-yard mark for total offense in a game for the first time in week 4 against SMSU, passing for 260 yards and three TDs and rushing for 41 yards on nine attempts (301).

It took him until his fourth career game until committing his first turnover, an interception that snapped a streak of 111 consecutive passes without an INT to start his career.

Through five weeks, the rookie signal-caller has committed only one turnover and has a new streak of 27 passes without an INT.

A point of emphasis for the Golden Bears is a more efficient passing game. Even a slight improvement in completion percentage and a decrease in interceptions can lead to a significant boost in wins.

Since **Shannon Currier** has returned to the program in 2016, when the Golden Bears complete at least 54 percent of passes, the team is an above .500 squad with a 10-9 record.

PILTOFF PRESEASON NATIONALLY-RANKED CORNERBACK

Senior cornerback **Preston Piltoff** is on the national map, ranked as the #4 cornerback in the country by CFB Network entering the 2021 season. He led the league in pass breakups as a junior in 2019, also leading the team with two interceptions including one for a 92 yard touchdown - the longest INT in the NSIC in 2019.

In 2021, he is third on the team with 27 tackles with a team-high 20 solo stops and four pass breakups.

Piltoff is a junior college transfer, competing at Grossmont College in 2018 with 36 tackles, eight pass breakups and two interceptions after an All-Conference freshman year at Shasta College with 16 tackles and five pass breakups.

CONCORDIA ST CLOUD GOLDEN HUSKIES

At the conclusion of the 2019 football season, the administrations at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston made the difficult decision to end their football programs.

Immediately, the CSP coaches put together a plan and worked with Concordia administration to provide an opportunity for student-athletes to continue to pursue their goals towards graduating from college while remaining members of an NSIC football program.

Coach Currier and his staff successfully recruited 11 members of the 2019 SCSU football team, and one from UMC.

Robby Carrillo, Luke Dunsmoor, Jake Edwards, Nathan Gimza, Taylon Hensley, Sarek Hoerth, Robert Kraklow, Dominic La-Combe, Luke Shepherd, Mason Van Zeeland and Nick Webley all joined Concordia from SCSU while Ryan Martin changed his golden from the Eagles to the Bears. They've been part of the campus community since the pandemic shortened spring 2020 semester and were with us through the 2020-21 academic year.

Of that group, all have challenged for a travel roster spot while **Robert Kraklow** (LT), **Luke Shepherd (TE)**, **Nathan Gimza** (WR) and **Mason Van Zeeland** (WR) have earned starting roles.

Kraklow is a returning All-NSIC North Division Second Team offensive lineman, while Gimza was leading the team in catches (11), yards (153) and long (65) before an injury has held him out in weeks four and five.

Van Zeeland leads the team with a 28.2 yard per catch average, ranking third on the team with 141 yards on just five catches including a touchdown. Van Zeeland's shortest reception is 11 yards, and his other four catches have been for at least 25 yards with a long of 42.

Shepherd had ascended to the top of the TE depth chart before falling victim to injury ahead of week 4.

THREE FRESHMEN CLASSES?!

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic forcing the cancellation of NSIC football in 2021, and the eligibility waivers handed down by the NCAA, the Golden Bears have a large number of freshmen on the roster.

The roster includes 25 redshirt freshmen, players who did not compete in 2019 in their first year of college football whether it was at CSP or elsewhere.

The bigger number is 57 true freshmen, players who had their first season as college student-athletes in the 2020-21 academic year that didn't lose eligibility, as well as first year players new to Concordia in 2021-22.

Second year freshmen who have made an impact on the field include: starting right tackle Jac Carver who ascended into the starting role in week 4, special teams linebacker Brayden Hilgemann, linebacker Caden Baarts who earned his first career start in week 5, starting safety Cyrus McClure who has been in and out of the lineup due to injury, special teams safety Anthony Ukofia, special teams linebacker Max Giannini, kicker Sam Henson, special teams defensive back Kahlil Robinson, starting quarterback Conner Cordts, starting running back Jaylin Richardson, and reserve running back Brandon Marenco.

True first year freshmen making an early impact on the roster include: wide receiver Jahiem Arnold, punter Parker Dahlman and defensive tackle Brad Walker while two other true freshmen have travelled but yet to make their debuts: running backs Keron Franklin and TJ Holmes.

SKILL POSITION TURNOVER

The Golden Bears entered 2021 looking to replace all but one passing attempt (**Abe Schwartz**), 88 percent of its rushing yards with its leading returner being **Lajuan Preston** (177) and over 90 percent of its receptions with its leader being **Kevin Ventura-Cortes** (11-76).

PRESTON BOOSTED BY DI TALENT IN BACKFIELD

Concordia's running game entered 2021 led by junior **Lajuan Preston**, the top returner from a strong and versatile rushing attack in 2019. "LP" has played in 30 career games with 1,040 rushing yards and a 5.5 career average. His breakout year was in 2018 when he averaged 6.5 per carry and rushed for 704 yards.

He was off to another strong start in 2019 with 177 yards in four games with two touchdowns and a 5.5 average before a season-ending injury.

He missed the 2021 opener with an injury but has returned to the backfield rotation and produced his top performance of 2021 in week 4 with 7-43 and a long of 15 against the Mustangs.

He's aided by Purdue junior transfer **Brian Lankford-Johnson** and Northern lowa freshman transfer **Jaylin Richardson**.

Lankford-Johnson played in 12 games including a start in 2016 as a freshman for the Boilermakers, earning Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors with 18 carries for 127 yards and a touchdown against Illinois and finished the year second on the team with 314 yards on the ground and 6.5 per carry, adding the team's longest run (48) and 11 catches for 90 yards. He played in six games as a sophomore with 22-86 rushing before deciding to transfer to CSP for the spring 2020 term.

Richardson was a highly recruited RB from the Kansas City area, initially committing to Kansas before signing with Northern lowa where he was an early enrollee in spring 2020. He made his debut in the 2021 COVID shortened spring season for the Panthers, and retained his full eligibility for his first year with CSP.

In 2021, Richardson leads the backfield with 47 carries for 170 rushing yards with two touchdowns and has added 11-80 receiving. He had team-highs of 7-69 receiving in his debut at Winona State.

Lankford-Johnson is third on the team with 36 carries for 80 yards.

New to the scene, second year freshman running back **Brandon Marenco** made his debut in week 5 at Minnesota State with eight carries for 67 yards and the team's longest run of the year, a 36-yard TD against the Mavericks.

Ethan Falaniko, a transfer from South Dakota who came to CSP for the 2019 season, was a factor in the backfield rotation before an injury has forced him to be inactive so far in 2021. He had six carries in five games in 2019 and was poised for a bigger role in 2021.

GROUND CONTROL LEADS TO VICTORIES

Since 2016 when **Shannon Currier** returned to CSP's sidelines, Concordia has rushed for 200-plus yards 11 times, producing an 8-3 record.

By contrast, when Concordia holds opponents under 100 yards, the Golden Bears are also 8-3.

Just five times since 2016 have the Golden Bears rushed for 200-plus and held an opponent to under 100 yards in the same game - with CSP producing a 4-1 record in those contests, most recently a 2019 week 10 win over SMSU.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTES

While the Golden Bears replaced four starting offensive linemen, the unit brings back plenty of experience led by transfer tackle **Robert Kraklow**, an All-NSIC North Division Second Team performer at St. Cloud State and former Division I player at Northern Illinois.

The top returner is guard **Matthew Montgomery**, a regular starter at center in 2019, while new center **Sam Marshalek** had stepped into a starting guard role late in 2019. The two players flipped positions on the line for 2021.

At the other tackle opposite Kraklow, freshman **Jac Carver**, a second year player, has ascended to the top of the depth chart while the other guard spot has been occupied by **Brody Card**, a redshirt freshman in his third year.

The Golden Bears also roll out a sixth offensive lineman multiple times per game, with backup tackle **Jake Edwards** frequently utilized in that capacity.

BROTHERLY LOVE

The 2021 Concordia-St. Paul roster features four sets of brothers: Jake and Jaylin Richardson, Mel and El-Osiris Jeudy, Robby and Austin Carrillo, and Justin and Connor Higgins.

The **Richardsons**, from Kansas City, are newcomers to the program in 2021 as Division I transfers.

Jake, a senior, transferred to CSP from South Dakota where he played 25 games across three seasons for the Coyotes, securing 16 tackles, 5.0 for loss and 5.0 sacks along with two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery. At CSP, he's picked up a pair of sacks and made six tackles on the year.

Jaylin, a freshman, transferred to CSP from Northern Iowa where he competed during UNI's shortened spring season in 2021 and was not charged a season of eligibility due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He made his college football debut against #5 South Dakota State, recording a tackle. He's been a key part of CSP's backfield in 2021, leading the backfield with 47-170 rushing and a pair of touchdown runs along with 11-80 receiving while contributing 112 combined kick/punt return yards for a team-leading 362 all-purpose yards.

The **Jeudys** are from Miami, Florida with Mel joining the program as a transfer prior to the 2020 spring term and El-Osiris being a freshman during the 2020-21 academic year.

Mel, a junior nose tackle, played three games at Alderson Broaddus University, a Division II program in 2019 after spending his first two years of college football at Division I Eastern Kentucky, including a redshirt season. The junior has played all five games for CSP including four starts up front and has made six tackles with 1.0 TFL.

El-Osiris, a freshman linebacker, has also appeared in all fivegames, primarily as a special teams contributor.

The **Carrillos** are offensive linemen from Case High School in Racine, Wisconsin with **Robby** joining the program prior to the 2020 spring term as a transfer from St. Cloud State with four years of eligibility remaining after redshirting with the Huskies in the final season of SCSU's program. He made his CSP debut in week 5 at MSU. **Austin** is a true first year freshman.

The **Higgins** are defensive acks from Rochester, Minnesota and the only set of brothers from this group to both join CSP as freshmen. Graduates of John Marshall High School, the duo are each preparing to make their college football debuts.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS ON DEFENSE

The Golden Bears have a pair of defensive starters who earned CoSIDA Academic All-America Second Team honors for the 2020-21 academic year, that was held without a season in the NSIC: **Shawn Aarhus** and **Dalton Smerchek**.

Smerchek, a senior linebacker, is a returning 2019 All-NSIC South Division honorable mention performer when he had 60 tackles, 7.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks, led the NSIC with four fumble recoveries and ranked second in the league with three forced fumbles.

He has played in 38 career games with 139 tackles, 12.5 TFL,

3.0 sacks, six fumble recoveries and five forced fumbles.

He led CSP with seven tackles and 1.0 TFL in the season opener at WSU and forced a fumble in week 2's win over Upper Iowa. Through five games, he is fourth on the defense with 22 tackles and handles long/short snapping duties as a special teams standout.

Aarhus is a junior defensive tackle who has played in 27 career games while stepping into a starting role in 2021. He has 56 total tackles, 7.0 TFL, 5.5 sacks and three fumble recoveries in his career. In 2021, he leads all CSP defensive linemen with 19 tackles

EXPERIENCED LINEBACKERS GROUP

All three of Concordia's starting linebackers from 2019's 6-5 squad returned for 2021: senior whip Dalton Smerchek, junior mike Jake Portz and junior sam Gabe Nkumu.

Smerchek and Portz earned All-NSIC South Division honorable mention honors as Smerchek led the league in fumble recoveries and added 8.5 TFL with 60 tackles while Portz was second in the league with 105 tackles and had an 18 tackle performance, third most in a game in school history. Nkumu, meanwhile, topped Portz's 18 tackles with 19, an NSIC single-game high for the year as he finished second on the team with 73 tackles.

In 2021, Smerchek led the team in tackles in week 1 with seven including 1.0 TFL at Winona State and added a forced fumble in week 2 against Upper Iowa.

Nkumu was fifth on the defense with 18 tackles including 3.0 TFL through four weeks before missing week 5 due to injury and Portz has contributed 17 tackles.

The unit was bolstered with the emergence of Andrew Egnarski, who has ascended to the starting MLB spot. He had his breakout effort in week 2 against Upper Iowa with a team-high 11 tackles, 3.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and recovery, earning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors.

His 3.5-sack performance is an NSIC single game high while the 3.5 TFL are tied for third-most in a game in the NSIC this year.

On the year, Egnarski is 15th in the league with 4.5 TFL and his 3.5 sacks are fifth in the league. He leads the team and is 24th in the NSIC with 27 tackles.

Adding depth at the position is Foster Conzet at the whip, and a tribute to the quality and the depth at the linebacker position, Conzet is tied for the team lead and 24th in the NSIC with 28 total tackles.

With an injury to Nkumu prior to week 5, freshman Caden Baarts made his first career start, making a seasonhigh five tackles, a team high for the game, and has 14 tackles on the season.

TRENDING TOPIC: SACKS / WINS CORRELATION

In the 49 games since head coach Shannon Currier has been back with the program since 2016, the CSP defense has produced 4-plus sacks 13 times and had more sacks than the opponent 19 times.

In the 4-plus sack games, Concordia has a 10-3 record and has won six of its last seven games when sacking the guarterback four or more times including week 2's five sack performance against Upper Iowa.

When producing more sacks than the opponent which factors line play on both sides, Concordia is 12-8 since 2016.

DEFENSIVE LINE SEES MAJOR TURNOVER

The 2021 Golden Bears were supposed to feature the return of two-time All-American and two-time NSIC sack champion Chris Garrett, the NCAA DII career record holder with 15 forced fumbles and CSP career sack record holder.

But Garrett was drafted following the cancelled COVID season in the seventh round by the Los Angeles Rams, making the 53 man roster this fall.

Going with Garrett were the other three outgoing senior starting linemen, as well as three key rotation reserves.

In 2021, the Golden Bears have filled the defensive line with three players who played key roles in 2019: ends Richard Ficociello and Mark O'Reilly and tackle Shawn Aarhus

while impact transfers **Mel Jeudy** joined Aarhus in the middle and Jake Richardson joined the defensive end rotation.

Aarhus has played in 27 career games with 56 tackles, 7.0 TFL and 5.5 sacks, Ficociello has played in 20 career games with 40 tackles, 7.5 TFL and 2.0 sacks and O'Reilly has secured 23 tackles, 8.5 TFL and 4.0 sacks across 16 career games.

In 2021, Aarhus leads the line with 19 total tackles followed by Ficociello with 17 tackles and a DL-best 3.5 TFL and 1.0 sack, O'Reilly adds 2.0 TFLs and 11 tackles while Richardson adds a pair of sacks and six total tackles

The unit also features SCSU transfer Luke Dunsmoor and returners **Keegan Larson** and **Carter Hislop** with freshman Brad Walker making his debut on the interior in week 3 at

Dunsmoor has come on strong as a reserve as of late, making 14 tackles with 1.5 TFL on the year, with 13 of those tackles coming in the last three games.

ROOKIE KICKING GAME

Concordia-St. Paul has featured some of the top kickers and punters in the Northern Sun as well as nationally over the past decade, and in 2021 the kicking and punting jobs will be handled by a pair of talented freshmen: second year kicker Sam Henson and first year punter Parker Dahlman.

Henson had a standout debut, converting his only two field goal attempts from 38 and 48 yards, before adding 3-3 PAT and 1-2 FG in a week 2 win over Upper Iowa. His 48 yard field goal is the second longest in the Northern Sun this year. Overall, Henson is 5-7 on field goal attempts with his only misses coming from 40 and 52 yards and he leads the team in scoring with 24 points while adding four kickoff touchbacks in his rookie season.

Dahlman has been busy so far, as well and is second in the league with a 43.2 season punting average on a leaguehigh 34 punts. His eight punts of 50-plus vards is tied for the league lead and he's pinned six punts pinned inside the 20, just two shy of the league leader.

His 77 yard punt at Sioux Falls is the second longest in the league so far and he holds two of the top five single game punting averages on the year, 50.2 (at USF) is ranked third and 47.3 (at UIU) is ranked fifth.

His first four game pace is on track to set the CSP single season and career punting average records.
