

#### THIS WEEK: CSP TRAVELS TO NORTHERN STATE

The Golden Bears will make their first appearance at NorthernState's new on-campus home, Dacotah Bank Stadium for a Saturday night kickoff at 6 p.m. in an NSIC North Division game.

#### WEATHER OUTLOOK

Saturday in Aberdeen is headed for a warm and calm afternoon with a high of 71 degrees and a SSW wind of 9 mph with partly to mostly cloudy skies. Saturday evening features a low of 45 degrees, with temperatures expected to remain warmer in the early evening hours, with winds shifting to ENE at 5-10mph overnight.

#### THIRD-RANKED STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE IN DIVISION II

The Golden Bears have had a daunting first half of the season, with a combined opponent record of 37-12 through seven week. All seven of CSP's opponents have a winning record, including the league's top-two teams, Sioux Falls (7-0) and Augustana (6-1).

The Golden Bears add another winning opponent in a tough road tilt at Northern State (4-3).

Entering week eight, CSP holds the 3rd-toughest strength of schedule in Division II football with a past opposition winning percentage of .714 (excluding CSP games).

CSP is closely followed by UMary with the fourth-ranked SOS in DII against a .690 opposition (29-13), with the next closest NSIC team being Minot State with the 25th-ranked strength of schedule (25-17, .595).

While unable to put a positive mark in the win column, the Golden Bears have remained competitive deep into the second half against Augustana (6-1), Southwest Minnesota State (4-3), Minnesota State (5-2) and Bemidji State (5-2).

The good news for the Golden Bears is their future opposition holds a combined 7-21 record (.250), tied with UMary and Minot State for the fifth-lightest strength of schedules in the country down the stretch.

#### CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

In 2018, head coach **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week

10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his 11th overall season at Concordia, is closing in on becoming the first coach to reach the 50-win milestone with a 48-58 career record. He has a 29-22 home record and is 9-1 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship and the program's first-ever postseason appearance at the 2003 Mineral Water Bowl.

#### NOTES ABOUT THE WOLVES

The Wolves enter Saturday winners of their last two, beating a 5-2 Winona State team 42-21 two weeks ago in Aberdeen before winning 38-10 at Minot State. They are 3-0 at home in 2022 and are 6-2 at the second-year Dacotah Bank Stadium, opened in 2021.

Northern State boasts the second-ranked run defense in the country, allowing just 58.1 yards per game on the ground. They've piled up 4.14 sacks per game, ranking fourth in the nation along with 9.7 TFLs per game, the fifth-most in the land.

Their total defense is ranked 12th (259.6), scoring defense 22nd with a league-best 16.3 points allowed per game along with the 21st-ranked red zone defense as teams scored on 64.7 percent of trips. hey've allowed just 106 first downs in seven games, ranking 23rd in the country and have the country's 29th-best fourth down defense (33.3%) and 33rd-ranked third down defense (31.4%).

The unit is led up front from the interior by **lan Marshall**, who ranks third in the nation in both TFLs (2.6/game, 18.0 total) and sacks (1.43/game, 10.0 total) on a defense that has 13 different players with sacks.

**Brennan Kutterer** adds a team-high 42 tackles, 9.0 TFLs and 3.5 sacks.

Offensively, four different players have between 180 and 222 rushing yards led by **Stanley Haskins** (52-222) while QB **Will Madler** adds 63-186 and a teamhigh three rushing TDs, completing 92-171 (53.8) for 110 yards and a 10-6 TD-INT ratio. **Michael Bonds** has also contributed, completing 44-70 (62.9%) for 385 yards and a 3-2 TD-INT mark.

**Ben Noland** leads the receivers with 29-377 and three TDs while six different targets have 100-plus receiving yards and 11-plus receptions.

#### CHEEKS SELECTED FOR BILLY BROWN'S #26 IN 2022

Sophomore safety **Davaris Cheeks** changed jersey numbers from his new number (14) to #26 to honor the memory of **Billy Brown**, **Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May of 2018. Billy passed away in 2018 shortly after graduating while working out near his home in the Twin Cities that summer. Head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

"Billy Brown's legacy has been talked about since the day I became a part of this football program, and rightfully so," said Cheeks. "The mark he left was one that was full of love for this team, passion for the game, and doing whatever it took to win. It is an honor to be able to wear that jersey as I know he is watching down on us and has sowed a seed that will never be forgotten."

Cheeks, a native of Aurora, Illinois, debuted in game action in 2021 with the jersey number 31, after redshirting in 2019 and missing 2020 due to the COVID-19 season cancellation. As a third-year member of the program, Cheeks played in seven games, including four starts at safety, finishing the year with 17 tackles (10 solo) with a season-high six tackles at UMD (10/16).

He played in the first six games in 2022, picking up a start in week five against Minnesota State. On the year, he's made 10 tackles and picked up a fumble recovery. In 13 career games, Cheeks has 27 tackles, a pass breakup and a pair of fumble recoveries.

He served last year as the CSP Student-Athlete Advisory Committee President and this year was appointed as the NSIC's NCAA Division II National SAAC representative. Further, he was elected as the 2022-23 CSP Student Body President and appointed as one of the first two student-athletes to serve on the NCAA Division II President's Council, the highest-ranking body of NCAA DII governance.

Cheeks is a public relations major at Concordia with a minor in business management and marketing.

#### SERIES HISTORY: NORTHERN STATE 9, CONCORDIA 7

After dropping the first two meetings in the series, Concordia responded by winning four straight from 2001 to 2005 amid a 7-2 stretch of football against the Wolves between 2001 and 2011

The Wolves have responded with a current five game win streak starting in 2012 including CSP's last two trips to Aberdeen in 2012 and 2016. Concordia is 2-5 in seven prior trips to Aberdeen, last winning in 2010.

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds a 3-4 record in his career against the Wolves including a 1-3 road record with his lone win in 2002.

#### LAST MEETING, 2021: NSU 38, CONCORDIA 17

The Golden Bears looked to keep one of the nation's top passing offenses at bay by keeping them off the field, as CSP utilized a 36:03 to 23:57 time of possession advantage to slow down **Hunter Trautman** and his 24-2 TD-INT ratio and 300-plus passing yard per game average.

In the first quarter, CSP took its first lead when **Brian Lankford-Johnson** capped a nearly seven minute long scoring drive with an 8-yard TD run for a 7-3 lead late in the first quarter.

CSP extended the lead early in the second quarter when quarterback **Abe Schwartz** connected with wide receiver **Joey Farley** for a 6-yard TD for a 14-3 lead.

After the CSP defense came up with a 3-and-out stop to keep the momentum building, NSU executed a fake punt for a 57-yard gain into the CSP red zone when safety **Rhett Sheehan** intercepted Trautman on the next play, ending the threat and preserving the CSP lead.

While CSP came up empty after the Sheehan INT, the Wolves scored to cut it to 14-10, with CSP responding by driving into

NSU territory but stalling on 4th-and-5 from the NSU 39 yard line

Trautman and the Wolves offense went back to work, completing a 15-yard pass into CSP territory but freshman defensive backs McKinley Egland-Young, Cyrus McClure and Davaris Cheeks converged, forcing and recovering a fumble near midfield with under two minutes to play in the half, still leading 14-10.

**Sam Henson** converted a 23-yard field goal in the red zone with under 30 seconds to play in the half for a 17-10 lead, but NSU returner **Vance Barnes** broke loose for a 74-yard return to the CSP 11-yard line.

CSP once again came up with a defining play as **Shawn Aarhus** blocked the NSU 28-yard field goal as time expired in the half.

In the second quarter, CSP came up with a red zone interception, a fumble recovery in CSP territory and a blocked field goal in the red zone to preserve a 17-10 advantage.

CSP's young secondary limited Trautman and the Wolves passing game to 8-17 for 69 yards and a 1-1 TD-INT ratio in the first half

But Trautman got right in the third quarter, completing five passes for 110 yards and two TDs, with the NSU defense adding a pick-six for a 31-17 lead. They'd add another score in the fourth.

CSP rushed for 156 yards, setting a new season-high with 42 rushing attempts led by Lankford-Johnson (17-55, TD) while **Brandon Marenco** rushed for 10-51 and a long of 21.

Schwartz completed 22-37 for 200 yards and added 13-32 rushing. He connected with Farley nine times for 39 yards with Farley racking up 57 yards after the catch.

Trautman finished 18-31 for 225 yards and three TDs and an INT.

CSP out-rushed NSU 156-120 with NSU's leading rusher with just 36 yards.

#### LAST WEEK: UMD 53, CONCORDIA 7

Concordia-St. Paul dropped a 53-7 home contest to Minnesota Duluth at Sea Foam Stadium.

Golden Bear sophomore quarterback **Bryce Sievers** connected with freshman wide receiver **Dion Green** to give CSP its lone score of the day, a 42-yard touchdown strike in the third quarter. Sievers finished 5-11 for 78 yards and a touchdown while the touchdown for Green was the first of his career.

CSP's ground game was led by sophomore running back Jaylin Richardson (6-21) and freshman wide receiver Troy Ellison (2-17), while Jack Munsterteiger added a 32-yard reception in the third quarter from sophomore quarterback Conner Cordts to round out the top offensive performers.

Defensively, junior linebacker **Andrew Egnarski** had his secondstraight double-digit tackle performance with 10, securing nine in the first half on the heels of his 19-tackle effort last week at Bemidji State.

Freshman cornerback **Zantavious Graham** matched Egnarski's 10 tackles, setting a new career-high with nine of his stops being solo tackles.

Senior safety **Rhett Sheehan** added five tackles and a forced fumble and the Golden Bears had six team tackles for loss with **El-Osiris Jeudy, Javon Jones, Lucas Becker** and **Isaac Reed** each producing 1.0TFLs.

The Bulldogs were led by running back **Wade Sullivan's** 100 rushing yards, needing just seven carries and adding a touchdown while quarterback **Kyle Walljasper** completed 11-16 for 132 yards and two scores while producing 12-67 with a rushing

UMD had four different players at the quarterback position combine to complete 23-33 for 269 yards while the run game produced a 304-yard day and five touchdowns.

#### FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach **Shannon Currier** returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home

opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak, including the first two games of 2018, for the 3-game streak in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first 3-game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004,

Currier now holds a 29-22 career record in home games at Concordia, a solid 9-1 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

The Golden Bears are now 11-20 at Sea Foam Stadium under Currier since 2016 including winning seasons in 2018 (3-2) and 2019 (4-2), the only back-to-back winning seasons in Sea Foam Stadium's history.

#### ADJUSTING TO THE NORTH

The Golden Bears have shifted to the NSIC North Division in the 2021 season after the elimination of football at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston - both former members of the North Division.

The result of the 14-team NSIC is two 7-team divisions, where each program plays the other six teams once every year, rotating

## **HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 11TH SEASON**



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the

Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

#### THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 9-1 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 29-22 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

#### **CAREER AT TRUMAN**

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

#### PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

#### **NSIC BACKGROUND & ST. PAUL PRIVATE EDUCATION**

He arrived at Concordia in 1999 as offensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator for former head coach and athletics director Dan O'Brien, now an assistant coach for the University of

Prior to joining Concordia, Currier spent two years each in similar roles at Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota

Crookston following his start in college coaching at Bemidji State as an offensive graduate assistant where earned his master's degree in physical education.

A native of Cosmos, Minnesota, Currier was a guarterback at Hamline University where he graduated with a degree in physical education in 1993.

between home sites, while facing five of the seven teams from the opposite division.

Previously, CSP played seven games against the NSIC South Division, with that total cut down by two starting in 2021; and previously played the NSIC North four times, with that total increased by two.

In 2021, Concordia did not face Wayne State for the first time since joining the league in 1999, or Augustana for the first time since 2004, including four non-conference games with the Vikings each year from 2004 to 2007 with Augie joining the NSIC in 2008.

In 2022, Concordia will not face Winona State, halting an annual series that dates back to 1999 (22 games) and Upper lowa, halting a streak of 15-straight meetings dating back to UIU's entry to the NSIC for the 2006-07 academic year.

The Golden Bears will now face every NSIC North team at home every other year, welcoming MSU Moorhead to Sea Foam Stadium for just the third time last year. Meanwhile, Minnesota Duluth returned to Sea Foam Stadium for the third-time ever last Saturday, previously playing in St. Paul in 2012 and 2016.

Under head coach **Shannon Currier**, the Golden Bears are 16-19 against the NSIC North Division teams across his career and 5-15 against NSIC North Division teams since rejoining the program in 2016. The Golden Bears are seeking their first division win as members of the NSIC North Division (0-8).

#### **CONCORDIA ST CLOUD GOLDEN HUSKIES**

Concordia's week two road trip to face Southwest Minnesota State featured seven former St. Cloud State Huskies facing their former head coach **Scott Underwood**, who now patrols the SMSU sidelines in his first season with the Mustangs.

At the conclusion of the 2019 football season, the administrations at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston made the difficult decision to end their football programs.

Immediately, the CSP coaches put together a plan and worked with Concordia administration to provide an opportunity for student-athletes to continue to pursue their goals towards graduating from college while remaining members of an NSIC football program.

**Coach Currier** and his staff successfully recruited 11 members of the 2019 SCSU team, and one from UMC.

Robby Carrillo, Luke Dunsmoor, Jake Edwards, Nathan Gimza, Taylon Hensley, Sarek Hoerth, Robert Kraklow, Dominic La-Combe, Luke Shepherd, Mason Van Zeeland and Nick Webley all joined Concordia from SCSU while Ryan Martin changed his golden from the Eagles to the Bears. They became a part of the campus community during the pandemic shortened spring 2020 semester and continued through the 2020-21 academic year.

In 2022, seven of the Huskies: Carrillo, Dunsmoor, Edwards, Gimza, Hensley, Hoerth, LaCombe and Shepherd, along with Martin from UMC, remain with team.

Meanwhile, Kraklow joined the coaching staff as a first-year graduate assistant working with the OL.

Look for the group to continue making a strong impact on the field for the Golden Bears.

#### **DIVISION I TRANSFERS**

For the second year in a row, the Golden Bears have infused the roster with nine players who have experience as members of NCAA Division I programs on the roster. All nine have seen significant game action this season, and all nine have earned spots on the team's travel roster. Below is a listing of the nine DI transfers on the roster:

#### **SOPHOMORE QUARTERBACKS**

In 2021 as freshmen, quarterbacks **Conner Cordts** and **Bryce Sievers** became the seventh and eighth players to start a game at quarterback as a freshman (or redshirt freshman) since Concordia made the jump to NCAA Division II in 1999.

Cordts joined elite company in becoming just the second freshman to start a season opener at quarterback, joining **James McNear**, who is a CSP and NSIC Hall of Famer and ended his career as the Division II leader in career total offense, playing from 2002-05.

Cordts started the first six games before a season-ending injury derailed his rookie season, committing just one turnover with one INT in 141 pass attempts after starting his career INT-free for 111 passes. Sievers earned playing time in six games, starting three.

#### **300-YARD PASSERS**

Sophomore quarterback **Conner Cordts** registered his first career 300-yard passing performance, completing 18-46 for 306 with three TDs and one INT against Sioux Falls, averaging 17 yards per completion in the first 300-yard passing game since November 4, 2017 (**Ron Johnson**, at Augustana). Cordts also achieved a career-high of 365 yards of total offense and 59 rushing yards in the contest.

#### SHEEHAN LEADS THE SAFETIES

Sixth-year senior **Rhett Sheehan** has remained a top leader in the program, putting together a strong first half of 2022.

He opened the season with a strong performance with eight tackles including two for loss while helping shut down the Augustana pass game to just 7-14 for 62 yards.

He continued in week two by matching his career-high with 10 tackles at SMSU, adding another TFL while helping limit the Mustangs to 106 passing yards on 8-17 passing with two INTs.

His 3.0 tackles for loss on the year in the first two games set a new career-high for the veteran safety, who has now made a teamhigh 46 tackles in seven games in 2022.

Sheehan is ninth in the NSIC with 6.6 tackles per game (46 total).

As a junior in 2021, Sheehan was an All-NSIC North Division Second Team safety, ranking second on the team and 23rd in the NSIC with 63 total tackles. His three interceptions, all in CSP's five home games, ranked ninth in the Northern Sun, and he acked up 85 return yards in the process while adding two pass breakups for five passes defended, second-most on the team while contributing a team-leading two forced fumbles.

In his career, Sheehan has secured 189 tackles and 6.0 TFLs across

40 games with a career-high 63 tackles in 2021. He has 12 career passes defended, three interceptions and three forced fumbles with one fumble recovery.

#### MCCLURE WITH THREE INTS

Sophomore safety **Cyrus McClure** had a tremendous start to his sophomore season, securing three interceptions in the first two weeks, twice in the season's opening quarter against #25 Augustana, now a 6-1 squad, and securing another INT in week two at SMSU.

 $\mbox{He}\mbox{'s}$  33rd in the country and second in the NSIC with three INTs.

It's the second-straight year a Golden Bear safety has registered three interceptions in a season, with McClure joining his teammate **Rhett Sheehan**, who had three INTs in 2021 as a junior.

As a sophomore, McClure has a career-high 31 tackles, adding 1.0 TFL, three INTs and a pass breakup.

McClure has played in 15 career games, registering 57 tackles with six passes defended (3 PBU, 3 INT), a forced fumble and a blocked kick.

#### **DIVISION I BACKFIELD**

Concordia's running game entering the 2022 season features its top four backs as Division I transfers: Northern Iowa transfer **Jaylin Richardson**, now a sophomore in his second year at CSP, has opened the year as the lead back. He's backed up by Kansas transfer **Gay**-

flor Flomo and Northern Colorado transfer Jaire Moore, with all three backs playing a role consistently throughout the season.

#### **RICHARDSON TOPS 100-RUSHING**

Sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** had his best game as a college running back in week two at SMSU, rushing for 175 yards on 12.5 per carry (14-175). He got stronger as the game wore on, with 9-151 in the second half, ripping off runs of 20, 31 and 74 yards in the process.

#### **RICHARDSON TOPS 100 ALL-PURPOSE YARDS**

Sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** has topped 100 all-purpose yards three times in 2022, starting with his career-best 207 all-purpose yards in week two at SMSU (14-175 rush, 2-7 rec, 1-25 KR). He added 121 yards against Minnesota State (18-81 rush, 3-7, TD rec, 1-33 KR) and 100 yards at Bemidji State (16-84 rush, 1-16 rec).

He's among the league's top-10 in rushing (476 yards) and all-purpose yards (102.1/game), ranking ninth in the NSIC in each, while leading CSP with 715 all-purpose yards on the year and ranking second on the team with 16 receptions out of the backfield (16-141).

Richardson and Moore lead the team with two touchdowns, each scoring once on the ground and once in the air.

Richardson was a highly recruited RB from the Kansas City area, initially committing to Kansas before signing with Northern lowa where he was an early enrollee in spring 2020. He made his debut in the 2021 COVID shortened spring season for the Panthers, and retained his full eligibility for his CSP career.

In 2021, Richardson led CSP with 61.6 all-purpose yards per game, playing in seven games with three starts. He was second on the team in rushing yards (234) while leading the backfield with two rushing TDs. He added 15-85 rec and 5-99 on KR.

In his two seasons with CSP, Richardson has compiled 710 rushing yards in 14 games, averaging 4.5 yards per carry with three TDs while adding 31-226 with a receiving TD, 9-197 on kickoff returns and 4-13 on punt returns for 1,146 all-purpose yards.

Flomo is second on the team with 362 all-purpose yards with a team-high 280 on kickoff returns (21.5 avg, 42 long) while Moore's 300 all-purpose yards feature balance with 141 rushing, 87 receiving and 72 via kickoff returns.

Flomo, originally from the metro (Fridley) and graduate of Totino-Grace High School, was a standout at lowa Western Community College out of high school before transferring to Kansas where he was an Academic All-Big 12 Second Team selection, playing in nine games and earning six carries for the Jayhawks.

**Moore** is originally from Dallas, Texas and rushed 12-38 for Northern Colorado in 2021, spending three seasons there including a redshirt and a missed year due to COVID-19.

#### **BROTHERLY LOVE**

The 2021 Concordia-St. Paul roster features two sets of brothers: Mel & El-Osiris Jeudy, along with Robby & Austin Carrillo.

The **Jeudys** are from Miami, Florida with Mel joining the program as a transfer prior to the 2020 spring term and El-Osiris being a freshman during the 2020-21 academic year.

Mel, a senior nose tackle, played three games at Alderson Broaddus University, a Division II program in 2019 after spending his first two years of college football at Division I Eastern Kentucky, including a redshirt season. He has played in 17 career games for CSP including 10 starts up front. In 2021, he put up 22 total tackles and 4.0 TFLs. He's made nine tackles in 2022 through seven weeks including a 5-tackle performance against USF in week three.

**EI-Osiris**, a sophomore linebacker, has appeared in 16 career games. With an increased role in 2022, he's made 24 tackles in seven games. He made his first career start in week three against USF, making a career-high six tackles, starting again in week four at WSC with another career-high of eight tackles against the Wildcats in the midst of a stretch of three-straight starts, including a week five forced fumble against Minnesota

The **Carrillos** are offensive linemen from Case High School in Racine, Wisconsin with **Robby** joining the program prior to the 2020 spring term as a transfer from St. Cloud State with four years of eligibility remaining after redshirting with the Huskies in the final season of SCSU's program.

**Robby** played each of the final seven games in 2021 while **Austin** redshirted in his first year in the program in 2021. The brothers each appeared in the first three games to start the 2022 season. Robby picked up three straight starts at right tackle in weeks 4-6 and is in the regular offensive line rotation.

#### HILGEMANN STEPS UP AT MLB

Sophomore linebacker **Brayden Hilgemann** cracked the starting linebacker group at the MIKE position to start the year before moving to one of the OLB spots. He was second on the team and 15th in the NSIC with 37 total tackles, adding 2.0 TFLs, 1.0 sacks and his INT at SMSU was deep in the red zone in the fourth quarter in a tight week two loss to the Mustangs before a season-ending injury in week six at BSU.

In the 2022 opener in his first career start, Hilgemann produced a career-high eight tackles with a sack and a TFL. In week two, he showed consistency in his hometown of Marshall, Minnesota, adding seven tackles to go with his INT. He's had at least four tackles in each game this season.

Hilgemann played all 11 games in 2021, primarily on special

teams, making 16 total tackles with 0.5 TFL.

#### **EGNARSKI PILES UP THE TACKLES**

Junior Andrew Egnarski returned to the field in week three, and eventually returned to the starting lineup. Despite missing two games and playing in a reserve role in three others, Egnarski is already second on the team with 44 total tackles (1.5 TFL), producing the second-most tackles in a game in school history with 19 in a week six loss at Bemidji State.

Egnarski's 19 tackles are the fifth-most in the country in 2022 and an NSIC single-game high, just one shy of the Concordia single-game record.

He's tied for 12th in the Northern Sun in total tackles and has back-to-back double-digit 10-plus tackle games, with 10 tackles in week seven against UMD.

In 2021, Egnarski led the team with 68 total tackles, earning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors in CSP's week two win over Upper lowa with 11 tackles, 3.5 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and fumble recovery. He produced 6.0 TFLs, tied for the team lead with 5.0 sacks and had an INT on the season.

#### DUNSMOOR LEADS DEFENSIVE LINE

The 2022 Concordia defensive line has been led by senior defensive end **Luke Dunsmoor**, who made a career-high nine tackles in week two at SMSU while playing against his former head coach Scott Underwood.

The St. Cloud State transfer is seventh on the defense and leads the position group with 26 tackles on the season, adding a team-high four quarterback hurries with his first hurry of the year in week one on a pass that was deflected by McKinley Egland-Young and intercepted by Cyrus McClure. He also has 2.0 TFLs and a half sack on the season.

As a Golden Bear, Dunsmoor has played in 18 games, starting five times in the 2022 season, and has amassed 54 total career tackles with 6.0 TFLs and a 1.0 sacks.

Also making an impact from the DE position is South Dakota transfer **Lucas Becker** who is tied with **Rhett Sheehan** for the team lead with 3.0 TFLs, adding 18 total tackles.

While Dunsmoor has been the top statistical producer from the defensive end position, Northern State sophomore transfer **Koffi Gbekle** has piled up 24 tackles from the defensive tackle position group including four games with at least four tackles and a high of six in week four at Wayne State.

The defensive line opened the year with improved depth over the 2021 group, and has continued to bolster itself with the return of established linemen throughout the season who opened the year returning from injuries, such as Keegan Larson, Brad Walker, Connor Weiss and Abe Elazazy.

#### **CONTINUITY DEFINES OFFENSIVE LINE**

The 2022 offensive line is defined by its continuity, with nearly the entire two-deep having played together for at least three seasons and many having gained valuable playing experience last season.

Junior center **Sam Marshalek** is the leader up front with 28 games and 20 starts under his belt, occupying the center position in 2022. Left tackle **Jake Edwards** is credited by the coaching staff as being among the league's best at his position and has 12 career starts among his 18 games played at CSP.

The line features four former St. Cloud State players: Edwards, guards **Taylon Hensley** and **Sarek Hoerth** and tackle **Robby Carrillo**. All of the SCSU transfer offensive linemen have started in their time at CSP and are continuing to contribute to the travel roster and offensive line rotation.

The group also features starting guard **Elliott Wolfe** and sophomore tackle **Jac Carver**, who has started four of the seven games this year.

As a unit, the offensive line ranks 30th in the country and fifth in the NSIC with 1.29 sacks allowed per game, and ranks 29th in the country and fifth in the NSIC in fewest TFLs allowed per game (4.71).

They've paved the way for sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** who is the league's ninth leading rusher with 68.0 rushing yards per game while averaging 5.7 per carry while the three quarterbacks have combined for just four interceptions in 216 team pass attempts while being sacked just nine times.

#### 70-PLUS YARD WIDE RECEIVERS

Concordia's pass game is built upon its depth, with five different targets picking up at least 13 catches and 141 yards: Jack Munsterteiger (17-170), running back Jaylin Richardson (16-141, TD), Joey Farley (16-177, TD), Drew Enke (14-206, TD), and Nathan Gimza (13-167)

Seven different players have found the end zone among the seven touchdown passes including a pair of running backs.

On the year, **Joey Farley** (3-81, TD vs USF), **Drew Enke** (3-73 at WSC) and **Nathan Gimza** (4-76) have topped 70 receiving yards in a game as different players continue to step forward in the receiving game depending on the opposition.

#### HENSON IN THE KICKING GAME

Concordia-St. Paul has featured some of the top kickers and punters in the Northern Sun as well as nationally over the past decade, and after new kickers debuted in 2021, the two roles will be consistent once again in 2022 with the kicking game led by sophomore **Sam Henson**.

Henson entered the 2022 season as the 13th-ranked kicker in Division II football by The College Football Network and 20th-ranked by FBPI Football.

Henson was recently named a Fred Mitchell Award Watch List candidate for his performance on the field and in the community for September, 2022, his fourth time earning monthly watch list honors for the award that honors the top placekicker for their on-field and volunteer service in small college football (FCS, DII, DIII, NAIA, NJCAA).

Henson had a standout debut season in 2021, leading the NSIC and ranking 21st nationally with a 76.9 field goal percentage (10-13) while hitting 10-11 from inside of 50 yards with a long of 48 which he converted in his career debut at Winona State.

He ranked 40th in the country and fifth in the NSIC with 0.91 field goals made per game, a well.

He led the team in scoring in 2021 with 48 points, averaged 53.3 yards on 41 kickoffs with 10 touchbacks and made two field goals in a game twice.

In 2022, he's 3-10 on field goals, with his misses all being either from 42-plus yards (42, 46, 47, 50) or being blocked (3). He's connected on his other three attempts from 22, 24 and 25 yards. He added his third career 2-field goal performance in week two at SMSU.

In his career, he's connected on 13 of his 23 field goal attempts with a long of 48 yards and he's cashed in all but one of his PATs (27-28).

He's added power to his kickoffs in 2022, upping his average to 60.5 yards with five touchbacks on 20 kickoffs.

#### DAHLMAN IN THE PUNTING GAME

Like the kicking game, sophomore **Parker Dahlman** continues to provide one of the top legs to CSP for his second year as the Golden Bear punter.

In 2022, Dahlman is fifth in the NSIC with a 38.7 average on the fourth-fewest punts (27), but more importantly has dropped five inside the 20, has seven fair catches and a pair of 50-plus yard punts (57, 61).

His directional punting and hangtime have helped the special teams hold opponents to just four punt return attempts for nine yards on the season for a standout 37.4 net punting average, ranking second in the NSIC and 32nd nationally.

In week two at SMSU, Dahlman put together three punts for a consistent 41.0 average with a long of 45 and all three punts pinning SMSU inside the 20.

In week four, he averaged 49.0 yards on three punts with a long of 61 yards at Wayne State, the fifth-best single game average in school history with at least two punts in a game. As a freshman in 2021, Dahlman ranked fifth in the league with a 40.1 season punting average on a league-high 67 punts. His 12 punts of 50-plus yards topped the league charts, and his 14 punts inside the 20 finished two off the league lead, ranking third. He forced 12 fair catches and only had five touchbacks.

His 77 yard punt at Sioux Falls was the third longest in the league last year and the third-longest in program history.

His top single-game effort in his career, a 6-punt, 50.2 average at Sioux Falls (2021) with four punts of 50-plus yards, ranks as the best single-game punting average with at least five punts in a game.

In his young career, Dahlman's 39.77 career average is on pace to be a career record and his name is already plastered on the game, season and career punting charts for the program. (see full punting records on page 11)
