THIS WEEK: CSP TRAVELS TO NORTHERN STATE

The Golden Bears will make their first appearance at NorthernState's new on-campus home, Dacotah Bank Stadium for a Saturday night kickoff at 6 p.m. in an NSIC North Division game.

WEATHER OUTLOOK

Saturday in Aberdeen is headed for a warm and calm afternoon with a high of 71 degrees and a SSW wind of 9 mph with partly to mostly cloudy skies. Saturday evening features a low of 45 degrees, with temperatures expected to remain warmer in the early evening hours, with winds shifting to ENE at 5-10mph overnight.

#5 NCAA STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

The Golden Bears have had a daunting season, with a combined opponent record of 37-19 through eight weeks and CSP has yet meet a club with a losing record.

It adds up to CSP holding the 5th-toughest strength of schedule in Division II football with a past opposition winning percentage of .661 (excluding CSP games). The next closest NSIC team is UMary with the ninth-ranked strength of schedule (35-21, .625).

While unable to put a positive mark in the win column, the Golden Bears have remained competitive into the second half against Augustana (6-2), Southwest Minnesota State (4-4), Minnesota State (6-2), Bemidji State (6-2) and Northern State (5-3)

CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

In 2018, head coach **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his 11th overall season at Concordia, is closing in on becoming the first coach to reach the 50-win milestone with a 48-59 career record. He has a 29-22 home record and is 9-1 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship and the program's first-ever postseason appearance at the 2003 Mineral Water Bowl.

CHEEKS SELECTED FOR BILLY BROWN'S #26 IN 2022

Sophomore safety **Davaris Cheeks** changed jersey numbers from his new number (14) to #26 to honor the memory of **Billy Brown**, **Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May of 2018. Billy passed away in 2018 shortly after graduating while working out near his home in the Twin Cities that summer. Head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

"Billy Brown's legacy has been talked about since the day I became a part of this football program, and rightfully so," said

NOTES ABOUT THE MARAUDERS

The Marauders have faced a schedule nearly as tough as Concordia's, currently rated as the ninth-hardest in the nation with opponent winning percentage of .625 (35-21) excluding results against UMary while CSP has had the fifth-ranked strength of schedule at .661 (37-19).

UMary scored its lone of the season in week five, a 27-26 overtime victory at home over Northern State in their first week of NSIC North Division play. The Marauders have also had a number of competitive losses against Wayne State (28-33), at Winona State (17-25), Southwest Minnesota State (28-31), at Minnesota State (28-31) and against MSU Moorhead (38-40), racking up five losses by a one-score margin.

They are led by **Danny Kittner**, a wide receiver and returner who is seventh in the nation with 166.1 all-purpose yards per game, second in the NSIC. Kittner has racked up 515 combined return yards, 14th in the country while his 833 receiving yards is ninth in the nation, drawing 8.9 receptions per game which is second in Division II football.

Kittner, the reigning NSIC Special Teams Player of the Week, had a school record 381 all-purpose yards last week while setting the NSIC career records for receptions (272) and receiving yards (3,498).

While Kittner leads the team with 71-833 receiving and five TDs, **Collin Gapen** has found the end zone a team-high six times on 26-279 receiving.

Logan Nelson is the veteran quarterback, ranking fourth in the NSIC with 204.3 yards per game, completing 60.0 percent of his passes with 13 touchdowns and eight interceptions while backup **Jesse Forknell** has also completed 34-57 (59.6%) for 442 yards, four TDs and one INT.

On the ground, **Dave Small** is the league's sixth leading rusher with 558 yards on 4.4 per carry with seven touchdowns, adding 13-105 receiving and another touchdown, leading the team in scoring.

Devyn Charles leads UMary's defense with the fifth-most tackles in the NSIC (65) while ranking seventh with 8.5 TFLs and adding 3.0 sacks and a pair of forced fumbles. **Ty'Rhae Gibson** has a team-high three INTs with six pass breakups.

Cheeks. "The mark he left was one that was full of love for this team, passion for the game, and doing whatever it took to win. It is an honor to be able to wear that jersey as I know he is watching down on us and has sowed a seed that will never be forgotten."

Cheeks, a native of Aurora, Illinois, debuted in game action in 2021 with the jersey number 31, after redshirting in 2019 and missing 2020 due to the COVID-19 season cancellation. As a third-year member of the program, Cheeks played in seven games, including four starts at safety, finishing the year with 17 tackles (10 solo) with a season-high six tackles at UMD (10/16).

He played in the first six games in 2022, picking up a start in week five against Minnesota State. On the year, he's made 10 tackles and picked up a fumble recovery. In 13 career games, Cheeks has 27 tackles, a pass breakup and a pair of fumble recoveries.

He served last year as the CSP Student-Athlete Advisory Committee President and this year was appointed as the NSIC's NCAA Division II National SAAC representative. Further, he was elected as the 2022-23 CSP Student Body President and appointed as one of the first two student-athletes to serve on the NCAA Division II President's Council, the highest-ranking body of NCAA DII governance.

Cheeks is a public relations major at Concordia with a minor in business management and marketing.

SERIES HISTORY: UMARY 5, CONCORDIA 4

The Golden Bears and Marauders will meet for the 10th time dating back to the 2006 season when the programs squared off for the first time in Bismarck in the only non-conference meeting between the teams, with UMary joining the NSIC in 2007.

Last year in Bismarck, UMary broke a 4-4 tie in the series with a 42-17 win in week nine, and the Golden Bears are 1-3 all-time in four prior contests played at home against the Marauders.

CSP has won two of the last three contests with the Marauders as head coach **Shannon Currier** holds a 2-1 record against UMary in his career at Concordia, and coached CSP to a shutout win (17-0) in his only home game against UMary in 2016, his first back with the program since the 2003 season.

This will be UMary's fourth visit to Sea Foam Stadium, previously playing at CSP's new stadium in 2009, 2012 and 2016.

LAST MEETING, 2021: UMARY 42, CONCORDIA 17

Although the host Marauders scored first and led 7-0 at the quarter break, Concordia came back with a strong second quarter as freshman **Daimarion Nelson** scored his first career rushing touchdown at the goal line, and **Sam Henson** followed with a 48-yard field goal for a 10-7 lead with 7:29 to play in the second.

The Marauders scored two more touchdowns before halftime including one with 16 seconds to play, and added two more third quarter touchdowns for a 35-10 lead.

In the fourth, freshman quarterback **Bryce Sievers**, making his first career start and becoming the eighth freshman to start at QB in Concordia's Division II-era (1999-present), completed a 7-yard touchdown to **Mason Van Zeeland**.

Sievers finished the game 22-51 for 173 yards and a TD.

Wide receiver **Joey Farley** had 10 receptions on 19 targets for 53 yards while Van Zeeland had 4-78 receiving including a 31-yard catch on a fake punt from **Parker Dahlman**.

In addition to his fake punt completion, Dahlman had a big day punting, averaging 45.8 yards on four punts with a long of 61 and one inside the 20.

On defense, **Richard Ficociello** had a sack in a third-straight game, adding 2.0 TFLs and a forced fumble. **Rhett Sheehan** led the team with seven tackles, a forced fumble and a pass breakup.

The Marauders' Logan Nelson completed 22-31 for 332 yards

and four TDs and a rushing TD, connecting with **Danny Kittner** for 11-179 and a TD and **Luke Little** 5-93 and two TDs.

LAST WEEK: NORTHERN STATE 49, CONCORDIA 20

The Golden Bears had opportunities to run with the Wolves last Saturday in Aberdeen, but costly turnovers and big plays proved too much to overcome.

The Concordia defense came up with a 3-and-out on the game's opening drive, with senior returner **Joey Farley** returning the first punt 17 yards to the 50 yard line. A 34-yard pass from **Conner Cordts** to **Drew Enke** on CSP's first play from scrimmage put the Golden Bears in the red zone, poised to grab the game's first lead.

But a fumble two plays later forced CSP to come up empty in the red zone.

The Wolves would score twice in the first quarter on passes of 42 and 50 yards before CSP scored first in the second quarter after a long Cordts pass to **Nathan Gimza** allowed Cordts to surge in on the next play from the goal line.

The Wolves scored two more long touchdowns in response, passes of 73 and 20 yards, the 20 yard TD being their shortest TD of the seven they'd score in the contest.

Late in the first half, the Golden Bears executed in the 2-minute offense as Cordts connected with **Troy Ellison** for an 8-yard touchdown with 14 seconds to play.

Despite a pair of first half turnovers and the Wolves securing an onside kick after their first TD, setting up their second score, the late first half TD gave CSP added life.

CSP opened with the ball in the third quarter trailing 28-13, but were unable to continue the momentum, with NSU responding with a long drive deep into CSP territory.

Sixth-year senior **Rhett Sheehan** kept Concordia alive with an interception near the goal line, returning it 13 yards to give CSP's offense some breathing room deep in its own territory.

The Golden Bears responded with a long drive of their own, only to have the Wolves intercept a pass on 4th-and-goal from the 2-yard line to prevent CSP from coming within a one score margin in the third quarter.

The Wolves then buried the Golden Bears with an 80-yard TD pass with 1:41 to play in the third quarter, extending the lead with a 37-yard TD strike early in the fourth.

Cordts found sophomore **Jaheim Arnold** from 32-yards out with 7:49 to play in the fourth quarter, but despite three second half turnovers from Sheehan (2 INTs & 1 FR), the Wolves continued to score from distance, adding a 57-yard TD run with under five minutes to play.

Northern State's six touchdown passes totaled 302 yards with three of them coming on 3rd-and-6 or longer, with the seventh TD being a 57-yard running play.

Concordia racked up 511 yards of total offense, their highest total since week three of 2016 in a 52-49 shootout loss at home to Minnesota Duluth.

The big offensive day came at the expense of one of the nation's top defenses as the Wolves averaged 259.6 yards per game entering the day, 12th in the nation. The CSP offensive line allowed no sacks and 3.0 TFLs to a defense averaging 4.14 sacks (4th DII) and 9.7 TFLs (5th DII).

Cordts had his second career 300-yard passing day with a career-high 310 yards (22-47) with two passing TDs while adding 8-34 rushing with a rushing TD.

He found Enke four times for a season-high 83 yards and Gimza four times for 75 yards.

Sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** topped 100 combined yards for the fourth time this season on 9-66 rushing and 3-53 receiving with a long run of 27 and long catch of 25 yards.

While Sheehan had three turnovers, junior linebacker **Andrew Egnarski** led the defense with 10 tackles and had the forced fumble on Sheehan's recovery.

Farley finished with 3-37 on punt returns and 5-25 receiving while the kick return game was also producive with Gayflor Flomo averaging over 30 yards on three kickoff returns with a long of 55 and Jaire Moore adding a 27-yard return as CSP had 154 combined return yards in the game.

Sophomore punter Parker Dahlman added a 42.4 yard punt average on four punts with two inside the 20 and a long of 54 yards.

FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach Shannon Currier returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak, including the first two games of 2018, for the 3-game streak in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first 3-game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004,

Currier now holds a 29-22 career record in home games at Concordia, a solid 9-1 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

The Golden Bears are now 11-20 at Sea Foam Stadium under Currier since 2016 including winning seasons in 2018 (3-2) and 2019 (4-2), the only back-to-back winning seasons in Sea Foam Stadium's history.

Across the nine home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.1 to 9.0 margin of victory, a total of 271 to 81.

HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 11TH SEASON



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the

Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games.

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 9-1 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 29-22 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

CAREER AT TRUMAN

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

ADJUSTING TO THE NORTH

The Golden Bears have shifted to the NSIC North Division in the 2021 season after the elimination of football at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston - both former members of the North Division.

The result of the 14-team NSIC is two 7-team divisions, where each program plays the other six teams once every year, rotating between home sites, while facing five of the seven teams from the opposite division.

Previously, CSP played seven games against the NSIC South Division, with that total cut down by two starting in 2021; and previously played the NSIC North four times, with that total increased by two.

In 2021, Concordia did not face Wayne State for the first time since joining the league in 1999, or Augustana for the first time since 2004, including four non-conference games with the Vikings each year from 2004 to 2007 with Augie joining the NSIC in 2008.

In 2022, Concordia will not face Winona State, halting an annual series that dates back to 1999 (22 games) and Upper lowa, halting a streak of 15-straight meetings dating back to UIU's entry to the NSIC for the 2006-07 academic year.

The Golden Bears will now face every NSIC North team at home every other year, welcoming MSU Moorhead to Sea Foam Stadium for just the third time last year. Meanwhile, Minnesota Duluth returned to Sea Foam Stadium for the third-time ever this year, previously playing in St. Paul in 2012 and 2016.

Under head coach **Shannon Currier**, the Golden Bears are 16-20 against the NSIC North Division teams across his career and 5-16 against NSIC North Division teams since rejoining the program in 2016. The Golden Bears are seeking their first division win as members of the NSIC North Division (0-9).

CONCORDIA ST CLOUD GOLDEN HUSKIES

Concordia's week two road trip to face Southwest Minnesota State featured seven former St. Cloud State Huskies facing their former head coach **Scott Underwood**, who now patrols the SMSU sidelines in his first season with the Mustangs.

At the conclusion of the 2019 football season, the administrations at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston made the difficult decision to end their football programs.

Immediately, the CSP coaches put together a plan and worked with Concordia administration to provide an opportunity for student-athletes to continue to pursue their goals towards graduating from college while remaining members of an NSIC football program.

Coach Currier and his staff successfully recruited 11 members of the 2019 SCSU team, and one from UMC.

Robby Carrillo, Luke Dunsmoor, Jake Edwards, Nathan Gimza, Taylon Hensley, Sarek Hoerth, Robert Kraklow, Dominic La-Combe, Luke Shepherd, Mason Van Zeeland and Nick Webley all joined Concordia from SCSU while Ryan Martin changed his golden from the Eagles to the Bears. They became a part of the campus community during the pandemic shortened spring 2020 semester and continued through the 2020-21 academic year.

In 2022, seven of the Huskies: Carrillo, Dunsmoor, Edwards, Gimza, Hensley, Hoerth, LaCombe and Shepherd, along with Martin from UMC, remain with team.

Meanwhile, Kraklow joined the coaching staff as a first-year graduate assistant working with the OL.

Look for the group to continue making a strong impact on the field for the Golden Bears.

DIVISION I TRANSFERS

For the second year in a row, the Golden Bears have infused the roster with nine players who have experience as members of NCAA Division I programs on the roster. All nine have seen significant game action this season, and all nine have earned spots on the team's travel roster. Below is a listing of the nine DI transfers on the roster:

SOPHOMORE QUARTERBACKS

In 2021 as freshmen, quarterbacks **Conner Cordts** and **Bryce Sievers** became the seventh and eighth players to start a game at quarterback as a freshman (or redshirt freshman) since Concordia made the jump to NCAA Division II in 1999.

Cordts joined elite company in becoming just the second freshman to start a season opener at quarterback, joining **James McNear**, who is a CSP and NSIC Hall of Famer and ended his career as the Division II leader in career total offense, playing from 2002-05.

Cordts started the first six games before a season-ending injury derailed his rookie season, committing just one turnover with one INT in 141 pass attempts after starting his career INT-free for 111 passes. Sievers earned playing time in six games, starting three.

Sophomore quarterback **Conner Cordts** registered his first career 300-yard passing performance, completing 18-46 for 306 with three TDs and one INT in week three against Sioux Falls, averaging 17 yards per completion in the first 300-yard passing game since November 4, 2017 (**Ron Johnson**, at Augustana). Cordts also achieved a career-high of 365 yards of total offense and 59 rushing yards in the contest.

SHEEHAN LEADS THE SAFETIES

Sixth-year senior **Rhett Sheehan** has remained a top leader in the program, putting together a strong first half of 2022.

He opened the season with a strong performance with eight tackles including two for loss while helping shut down the Augustana pass game to just 7-14 for 62 yards.

He continued in week two by matching his career-high with 10 tackles at SMSU, adding another TFL while helping limit the Mustangs to 106 passing yards on 8-17 passing with two INTs.

Arguably his top individual performance of the season came in

week eight at Northern State, registering three turnovers in the second half with a pair of interceptions and a fumble recovery while adding a pair of pass breakups and five tackles.

His 3.0 tackles for loss on the year in the first two games set a new career-high for the veteran safety, who is now second on the team and 13th in the league with 51 tackles

As a junior in 2021, Sheehan was an All-NSIC North Division Second Team safety, ranking second on the team and 23rd in the NSIC with 63 total tackles. His three interceptions, all in CSP's five home games, ranked ninth in the Northern Sun, and he acked up 85 return yards in the process while adding two pass breakups for five passes defended, second-most on the team while contributing a team-leading two forced fumbles.

In his career, Sheehan has secured 194 tackles and 6.0TFLs across 41 games with a career-high 63 tackles in 2021. He has 16 career passes defended, five interceptions and three forced fumbles with two fumble recoveries.

MCCLURE WITH THREE INTS

Sophomore safety **Cyrus McClure** had a tremendous start to his sophomore season, securing three interceptions in the first two weeks, twice in the season's opening quarter against #25 Augustana, now a 6-1 squad, and securing another INT in week two at SMSU.

He's tied for third in the conference with a team-leading three interceptions.

It's the second-straight year a Golden Bear safety has registered three interceptions in a season, with McClure joining his teammate **Rhett Sheehan**, who had three INTs in 2021 as a junior, with Sheehan adding two more in 2022.

As a sophomore, McClure has a career-high 37 tackles, adding 1.0 TFL, three INTs and a pass breakup.

McClure has played in 16 career games, registering 63 tackles with six passes defended (3 PBU, 3 INT), a forced fumble and a blocked kick.

DIVISION I BACKFIELD

Concordia's running game entering the 2022 season features its top four backs as Division I transfers: Northern lowa transfer **Jaylin Richardson**, now a sophomore in his second year at CSP, has opened the year as the lead back. He's backed up by Kansas transfer **Gayflor Flomo** and Northern Colorado transfer **Jaire Moore**, with all three backs playing a role consistently throughout the season.

RICHARDSON TOPS 100-RUSHING

Sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** had his best game as a college running back in week two at SMSU, rushing for 175 yards on 12.5 per carry (14-175). He got stronger as the game wore on, with 9-151 in the second half, ripping off runs of 20, 31 and 74 yards in the process.

RICHARDSON TOPS 100 ALL-PURPOSE YARDS

Richardson has topped 100 all-purpose yards four times in 2022, starting with his career-best 207 all-purpose yards in week two at SMSU (14-175 rush, 2-7 rec, 1-25 KR).

He's among the league's top-10 in rushing (542 yards) and all-purpose yards (104.3/game). The versatile back is also third on the team with 19 receptions out of the backfield (19-194).

Richardson was a highly recruited RB from the Kansas City area, initially committing to Kansas before signing with Northern lowa where he was an early enrollee in spring 2020. He made his debut in the 2021 COVID shortened spring season for the Panthers, and retained his full eligibility for his CSP career.

In 2021, Richardson led CSP with 61.6 all-purpose yards per game, playing in seven games with three starts. He was second on the team in rushing yards (234) while leading the backfield with two rushing TDs. He added 15-85 rec and 5-99 on KR.

In his two seasons with CSP, Richardson has compiled 776 rushing yards in 15 games, averaging 4.6 yards per carry with three TDs while adding 34-279 with a receiving TD, 9-197 on kickoff returns and 4-13 on punt returns for 1,265 all-purpose yards.

Flomo is second on the team with 458 all-purpose yards with a team-high 372 on kickoff returns (23.2 avg, 55 long) while Moore's 364 all-purpose yards feature balance with 168 rushing, 97 receiving and 99 via kickoff returns.

Flomo, originally from the metro (Fridley) and graduate of Totino-Grace High School, was a standout at lowa Western Community College out of high school before transferring to Kansas where he was an Academic All-Big 12 Second Team selection, playing in nine games and earning six carries for the Jayhawks.

Moore is originally from Dallas, Texas and rushed 12-38 for Northern Colorado in 2021, spending three seasons there including a redshirt and a missed year due to COVID-19.

BROTHERLY LOVE

The 2021 Concordia-St. Paul roster features two sets of brothers: Mel & El-Osiris Jeudy, along with Robby & Austin Carrillo.

The **Jeudys** are from Miami, Florida with Mel joining the program as a transfer prior to the 2020 spring term and El-Osiris being a freshman during the 2020-21 academic year.

Mel, a senior nose tackle, played three games at Alderson Broaddus University, a Division II program in 2019 after spending his first two years of college football at Division I Eastern Kentucky, including a redshirt season. He has played in 18 career games for CSP including 10 starts up front. In 2021, he put up 22 total tackles and 4.0 TFLs. He's made 10 tackles in 2022 including a 5-tackle performance against USF in week three.

El-Osiris, a sophomore linebacker, has appeared in 17 career games. With an increased role in 2022, he's made 26 tackles. He made his first career start in week three against USF, making a career-high six tackles, starting again in week four aw WSC with another career-high of eight tackles against the Wildcats in the midst of a stretch of three-straight starts, including a week five forced fumble against Minnesota State.

The **Carrillos** are offensive linemen from Case High School in Racine, Wisconsin with **Robby** joining the program prior to the 2020 spring term as a transfer from St. Cloud State with four years of eligibility remaining after redshirting with the Huskies in the final season of SCSU's program.

Robby played each of the final seven games in 2021 while **Austin** redshirted in his first year in the program in 2021. The brothers each appeared in the first three games to start the 2022 season. Robby picked up three straight starts at right tackle in weeks 4-6 and has been a regular in the offensive line rotation, while Austin has seen a regular role on the PAT and FG units.

EGNARSKI PILES UP THE TACKLES

Junior Andrew Egnarski returned to the field in week three, and shortly thereafter returned to the starting lineup. Despite missing two games and playing in a reserve role in three others, Egnarski is already leading the team and 10th in the NSIC with 54 total tackles (1.5 TFL), and coming off of three-straight 10-plus tackle perforamnces.

His season to date has been highlighted by producing the second-most tackles in a game in school history with 19 in a week six loss at Bemidji State.

Egnarski's 19 tackles are the fifth-most in the country in 2022 and an NSIC single-game high, just one shy of the Concordia single-game record.

In 2021, Egnarski led the team with 68 total tackles, earning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors in CSP's week two win over Upper lowa with 11 tackles, 3.5 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and fumble recovery. He produced 6.0 TFLs, tied for the team lead with 5.0 sacks and had an INT on the

As a Golden Bear, Egnarski has compiled 137 career tackles in 28 games, adding 8.5 TFLs, 5.0 sacks, two forced fumbles, a recovery and an interception.

CONTINUITY DEFINES OFFENSIVE LINE

The 2022 offensive line is defined by its continuity, with nearly the entire two-deep having played together for at least three seasons and many having gained valuable playing experience last season.

Junior center **Sam Marshalek** is the leader up front with 29 games played and 21 starts under his belt, occupying the center position in 2022. Left tackle **Jake Edwards** is credited by the coaching staff as being among the league's best at his position and has 13 career starts among his 19 games played at CSP.

The line features four former St. Cloud State players: Edwards, guards **Taylon Hensley** and **Sarek Hoerth** and tackle **Robby Carrillo**. All of the SCSU transfer offensive linemen have started in their time at CSP and are continuing to contribute to the travel roster and offensive line rotation.

The group also features starting guard **Elliott Wolfe** and sophomore tackle **Jac Carver**, who has started four of the seven games this year.

As a unit, the CSP offensive line ranks 21st in the country and fifth in the NSIC with 1.12 sacks allowed per game, and ranks 21st in the country and third in the NSIC in fewest TFLs allowed per game (4.50).

The line is coming off of a strong performance at Northern State, allowing the offense rack up 511 yards of total offense, the highest output since week three of 2016, while issuing no sacks and three TFLs to one of the top-ranked defenses

in the country with the Wolves ranking 12th in total defense, fourth in sacks and fifth in TFLs entering the game.

70-PLUS YARD WIDE RECEIVERS

Concordia's pass game is built upon its depth, with six different targets picking up at least 13 catches and 140 yards: Joey Farley (21-202, TD), Jack Munsterteiger (20-202), Jaylin Richardson (RB) (19-194, TD), Drew Enke (18-289, TD), Nathan Gimza (17-242) and Troy Ellison (13-142, 2TD).

Eight different players have found the end zone among the nine touchdown passes including a pair of running backs, with Ellison leading the team with a pair of receiving scores.

Five different players have topped 50 receiving yards in a game this year with Enke, Gimza and Richardson each surpassing the mark twice.

HENSON IN THE KICKING GAME

Concordia-St. Paul has featured some of the top kickers and punters in the Northern Sun as well as nationally over the past decade, and after new kickers debuted in 2021, the two roles will be consistent once again in 2022 with the kicking game led by sophomore **Sam Henson**

Henson entered the 2022 season as the 13th-ranked kicker in Division II football by The College Football Network and 20th-ranked by FBPI Football.

Henson was recently named a Fred Mitchell Award Watch List candidate for his performance on the field and in the community for September, 2022, his fourth time earning monthly watch list honors for the award that honors the top placekicker for their on-field and volunteer service in small college football (FCS, DII, DIII. NAIA. NJCAA).

MINOT

Henson had a standout debut season in 2021, leading the NSIC and ranking 21st nationally with a 76.9 field goal percentage (10-13) while hitting 10-11 from inside of 50 yards with a long of 48 which he converted in his career debut at Winona State.

He ranked 40th in the country and fifth in the NSIC with 0.91 field goals made per game, a well.

He led the team in scoring in 2021 with 48 points, averaged 53.3 yards on 41 kickoffs with 10 touchbacks and made two field goals in a game twice.

In 2022, he's 3-10 on field goals, with his misses all being either from 42-plus yards (42, 46, 47, 50) or being blocked (3). He's connected on his other three attempts from 22, 24 and 25 yards. He added his third career 2-field goal performance in week two at SMSU.

In his career, he's connected on 13 of his 23 field goal attempts with a long of 48 yards and he's cashed in all but two of his PATs (29-31).

He's added power to his kickoffs in 2022, upping his average to 60.5 yards with six touchbacks on 24 kickoffs.

DAHLMAN IN THE PUNTING GAME

Like the kicking game, sophomore **Parker Dahlman** continues to provide one of the top legs to CSP for his second year as the Golden Bear punter.

In 2022, Dahlman is fifth in the NSIC with a 39.3 average on the fourth-fewest punts (32), but more importantly has dropped seven inside the 20, has eight fair catches and three 50-plus yard punts (57, 61, 54).

His directional punting and hangtime have helped the special teams hold opponents to just five punt return attempts for five yards on the season, with the 1.0 punt return average ranking eighth in the country and a standout 38.12 net

punting average, ranking 19th in the country and leading the Northern Sun.

In week two at SMSU, Dahlman put together three punts for a consistent 41.0 average with a long of 45 and all three punts pinning SMSU inside the 20.

In week four, he averaged 49.0 yards on three punts with a long of 61 yards at Wayne State, the fifth-best single game average in school history with at least two punts in a game.

As a freshman in 2021, Dahlman ranked fifth in the league with a 40.1 season punting average on a league-high 67 punts. His 12 punts of 50-plus yards topped the league charts, and his 14 punts inside the 20 finished two off the league lead, ranking third. He forced 12 fair catches and only had five touchbacks.

His 77 yard punt at Sioux Falls was the third longest in the league last year and the third-longest in program history.

His top single-game effort in his career, a 6-punt, 50.2 average at Sioux Falls (2021) with four punts of 50-plus yards, ranks as the best single-game punting average with at least five punts in a game.

In his young career, Dahlman's 39.90 career average is on pace to be a career record and his name is already plastered on the game, season and career punting charts for the program. He's climbed to fourth with 99 career punts and fourth with 3,950 career punt yards, as well. (see full punting records on page 11)
