#### THIS WEEK: CSP HOSTS MINOT STATE FOR SENIOR DAY

Saturday's season finale at Sea Foam Stadium is CSP's senior day as the program honors its 13 graduating seniors prior to the game against Minot State.

## WEATHER OUTLOOK

Kickoff on Saturday at noon features a temperature of 29 degrees and a NNW wind at 10mph and temperatures only expected to top out at 30 degrees in the afternoon with mostly cloudy skies.

## CSP LED BY "COACH C" - ALL-TIME WINS LEADER AT CSP

In 2018, head coach **Shannon Currier** became the school's all-time wins leader, winning his 41st game 16-10 at SMSU in week 10 on November 3, 2018, surpassing **Mark Mauer** (40-39), who coached the program for seven seasons from 2004-10.

Currier, now in his 11th overall season at Concordia, is closing in on becoming the first coach to reach the 50-win milestone with a 48-61career record. He has a 29-23 home record and is 9-1 in home openers. He's been head coach across two different stints, 2000 to 2003 and 2016-present while also serving as head coach at Truman State for five seasons from 2004-08. He was 2003 NSIC Coach of the Year, leading the program to its first NSIC Championship and the program's first-ever postseason appearance at the 2003 Mineral Water Bowl. *More on Coach Currier on page 3*.

## **CHEEKS SELECTED FOR BILLY BROWN'S #26 IN 2022**

Sophomore safety **Davaris Cheeks** changed jersey numbers from his new number (14) to #26 to honor the memory of **Billy Brown**, **Jr.**, a linebacker who graduated from CSP in May of 2018. Billy passed away in 2018 shortly after graduating while working out near his home in the Twin Cities that summer. Head coach **Shannon Currier** has opted to honor Brown by selecting a player who fits Billy's work ethic and commitment to the program to wear the number each season.

"Billy Brown's legacy has been talked about since the day I became a part of this football program, and rightfully so," said Cheeks. "The mark he left was one that was full of love for this team, passion for the game, and doing whatever it took to win. It is an honor to be able to wear that jersey as I know he is watching down on us and has sowed a seed that will never be forgotten."

Cheeks, a native of Aurora, Illinois, debuted in game action in 2021 with the jersey number 31, after redshirting in 2019 and missing 2020 due to the COVID-19 season cancellation. As a third-year member of the program, Cheeks played in seven games, including four starts at safety, finishing the year with 17 tackles (10 solo) with a season-high six tackles at UMD (10/16).

He played in the first six games in 2022, picking up a start in week five against Minnesota State. On the year, he's made 11 tackles with a fumble recovery in seven games in 2022 and in his career, Cheeks has made 28 tackles in 14 games while securing a pair of fumble recoveries.

#### **NOTES ABOUT THE BEAVERS**

The Beavers snapped a 9-game losing streak with their 17-10 week 10 win over UMary in their home finale. On the season, Minot State has scored 20-plus points twice, falling 27-20 in overtime at SMSU in week four and 33-22 at Upper lowa in week eight.

Further, Minot State has held teams under 30 points just three times, a 24-10 loss to Winona State in the opener, the 27-20 OT loss to SMSU and the week 10 win (17-10) over UMary.

They are the least penalized team in the nation, being flagged 3.3 times per game for just 33 yards. They've also only lost four fumbles, second-best in the NSIC and 15th in the nation, while their 11 interceptions rank foruth in the NSIC and have helped them produced the league's third-best turnover margin and the fourth-fewest turnovers committed in the NSIC.

The offense runs through running back **Ali Mohamed** with 558 yards and five touchdowns while adding 15-106 with a score through the air.

Three receiving targets: **Peyton Lamoureux** (27-369, TD), **Nathan Young** (33-347, TD) and **Erik Palmquist** (33-322, 3 TD) have cleared 300 yards apiece.

**Dawson Macleary** has passed for 1,529 yards, five TDs and 10 INTs on 53% (149-281) passing.

The defense leader is **Carson Cayko** with 71 tackles, 7.5 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and one INT while **Isaiah Bigby** adds 56 tackles, 5.5 TFLs and a pair of INTs.

The Beavers have secured 11 interceptions as a defense led by **Knylen Miller-Levi's** four picks, adding 38 tackles and 2.5 TFLs. He ranks third in the NSIC and 21st in the nation in INTs.

Minot State's special teams is powered by punter **Justin Cash** with a 40.7 average, ranking second in the NSIC and 24th nationally, but the team holds a 33.2 net punting average, seventh in the league and 91st in the country.

He served last year as the CSP Student-Athlete Advisory Committee President and this year was appointed as the NSIC's NCAA Division II National SAAC representative. Further, he was elected as the 2022-23 CSP Student Body President and appointed as one of the first two student-athletes to serve on the NCAA Division II President's Council, the highest-ranking body of NCAA DII governance.

Cheeks is a public relations major at Concordia with a minor in business management and marketing.

## **SERIES HISTORY: CONCORDIA 6, MINOT STATE 3**

The Golden Bears and Beavers will meet for the 10th time in a series that began in the final year CSP played at Griffin Stadium in 2008, with CSP welcoming Minot State to St. Paul with a 55-13 win against the former NAIA program.

The teams met annually for four years in non-conference play, with CSP picking up wins in three of the four non-league games.

The teams had their first NSIC matchup in 2013, a 29-0 shutout win by CSP at Sea Foam Stadium, winning the first three NSIC games in the series.

The series opened with Concordia winning six of the first seven games and included a five-game CSP winning streak from 2010 to 2017

The Beavers finally snapped the streak in 2019, a 38-31 win in Minot and followed it up by with a 28-20 win in Minot last season in CSP's first season as NSIC North Division members.

The series is heavily tilted towards the home squad, with CSP holding a 4-0 lead in St. Paul (3-0 at Sea Foam Stadium) and Minot State holding a 3-2 edge in games played in Minot.

Concordia has shutout the Beavers in their most recent two trips to Sea Foam Stadium, 29-0 in 2013 and 24-0 in 2017, with Minot's last points scored at Sea Foam Stadium happening over a decade ago with a field goal at the 8:22 mark of the third quarter on September 4, 2010 in CSP's 38-17 win in the season opener.

Head coach **Shannon Currier** holds a 1-2 record against Minot State and is 1-0 against the Beavers at Sea Foam Stadium.

## LAST MEETING, 2021: MINOT STATE 28, CONCORDIA 20

Playing in his final game as a Golden Bear, running back **Lajuan Preston** rushed for a career-high 143 yards on a cold, snowy and windy afternoon at Herb Parker Stadium.

He had missed the previous five games due to injury, but returned to the field to notch CSP's first 100-yard performance of the season. He secured his 143 yards on 23 carries with a long of 33 and finished his career with 221 carries for 1,266 yards and a 5.7 career average per carry.

CSP rushed for a season-high 178 yards on 33 attempts, averaging 5.4 as a team on a day when working the ground was vital.

But the Beavers also used the ground game as **Ali Mohamed** carried the day by winning the league's rushing title, picking up 125 yards on 34 carries as Minot State compiled 242 team rushing yards on 54 attempts.

On a tough kicking day, **Sam Henson** finished off an impressive freshman season by converting a 25-yard field goal in the first quarter to make it 7-3 Minot State, and hit a 45-yard field goal late in the first half to bring CSP within a 1-score game, trailing 21-13. He finished the year 10-13 on field goals.

CSP also picked up a long touchdown by **Evan Peterson** as the wide receiver scored on a 59-yard run.

In the second half, quarterback **Abe Schwartz**, who was playing in his final game, returned from missing the previous two games due to injury and engineered a scoring drive early in the third quarter, marching 75 yards on nine plays in 4:44 to cut the score to 21-20 to open the second half, cutting the score to 21-

20.

On the drive, Preston carried the ball on the first four plays including a 33-yard run into Minot State territory, while Schwartz hit Mason Van Zeeland on a 3rd-and-7 for 19 yards to the Beaver 20 yard line. The drive was capped by a Schwartz TD strike to Jaheim Arnold from 10-yards out.

But despite so much time remaining in the game, CSP only had three more possessions on the day, managing only one more first down in the contest.

The pivotal moment was Minot State's long, plotting fourth quarter drive. Leading 21-20, Minot State took over at their own 1-yard line with 11:55 to play, and turned to Mohamed to move the chains repeatedly. He put together runs of 5,12, 4 and 2 yards before the Beavers were put into a 3rd-and-4 situation, completing a 6-yard pass to the Minot 30 yard line. Following another 3-yard run by Mohamed, Beaver quarterback Marshaun Campbell escaped for a 47-yard keeper to the CSP 20-yard line.

The Golden Bear defense responded, backing up Minot State 13 yards for a 3rd-and-23 from the CSP 33 yard line, but a face mask after a rush for no gain gave Minot State an automatic first down at the CSP 18 yard line. They converted one more third down before punching it in two plays later with 2:51 to go.

The end result was a 14-play, 99-yard drive lasting 9:04 in cold, windy weather with three 3rd-down conversions.

A short kickoff following a 15-yard Minot State unsportsmanlike conduct penalty put Concordia in great field position at the MSU 40 yard line, but the Beavers were able to contain the Concordia passing game on downs before running the clock out.

Concordia's defense held Minot State under 300 yards of total offense with 285 yards. The secondary held Minot to 43 passing yards on 10 attempts (four completions), the third time holding an opponent under 100 yards and a season-best.

The defensive effort was led by defensive end Richard Ficociello's 3.0 tackles for loss, also forcing a fumble while three others, Dalton Smerchek, Mark O'Reilly and Keegan Larson each had 1.0 TFL. Smerchek also added nine tackles, one shy of Andrew Egnarski's team-high 10, while freshman Anthony Ukofia had seven tackles and a forced fumble.

## LAST WEEK: MSU MOORHEAD 21, CONCORDIA 20

The Golden Bears came up a point short in their final road game of the 2022 season, their first 1-point loss since a 21-20 loss at Augustana in the 2019 season during a year when CSP also had a 1-point overtime win over Bemidji State.

The Golden Bears registered a season-high eight sacks on defense, adding 11.0 tackles for loss with the defensive line accounting for all eight sacks and nine of the TFLs.

Redshirt freshman **Javon Jones** had 3.5 sacks while **Koffi Gbekle** had 2.0 sacks.

Behind the line, junior linebacker **Andrew Egnarski** made it five-straight games with 10-plus tackles with 11 stops and a fumble recovery in the contest, giving him 87 on the year through eight games played.

Offensively, CSP used a 140-102 rushing advantage and compiled 400 yards of total offense behind sophomore quarterback **Conner Cordts**, who put up 310 yards of total offense on 260 passing and 50 rushing yards.

Cordts passed for one TD and added a score on the ground.

The ground game was led by junior **Gayflor Flomo** with 17 carries for 78 yards and wasn't tackled for loss in the game.

Cordts once again looked to a diverse group of targets, targeting eight receivers in the pass game, but it was redshirt freshman **Troy Ellison** who had seven catches on 11 targets for 104 yards, the first 100-yard receiving game since **Jake Tanner** in the 2019 season finale.

Ellison was versatile once again, compiling a career-high 158 all-purpose yards, adding 11 rushing and 43 kick return yards.

He scored his third touchdown of the season, tying CSP's longest play of the year on a 75-yard scoring strike from Cordts.

On the game's final drive, Cordts completing 5-of-6 for 52 yards

including a 23-yard connection with Nathan Gimza to push the ball near midfield. He added a 4th-and-4 15-yard completion to Jack Munsterteiger to get to the MSUM 31-yard line, and picked up 18 rushing yards on the 11-play, 71-yard drive to the Dragon 8-yard line, coming up empty in the red zone with a missed field goal with four seconds to play.

Jack Strand led the Dragon offense by completing 23-of-41 for 292 yards and three touchdowns despite taking eight sacks. He connected with Gage Florence six times for 61 yards, both well under his season averages which put him among the nation's top wide receivers. Luke Imdieke rolled up 98 rushing yards on 15 carries while Hayden Boll had 13-45 on the ground for the Dragons.

## FROM THE "GRIFF MYTH" TO "HOME SWEET FOAM"

Prior to head coach Shannon Currier returning to lead the Golden Bears, CSP had posted an 11-24 record at Sea Foam Stadium (2009 to 2015) and had never posted more than two home wins in a row with just two winning seasons since football returned to campus in 2009.

In Currier's first season back, the Bears won the 2016 home opener and did so again to start the 2017 season.

In 2017, CSP also nabbed a win in the home finale, a 37-20 win over SMSU that started a three game home winning streak, including the first two games of 2018, for the 3-game streak in Sea Foam Stadium's history. It was also the first 3-game home winning streak since the 2005 NSIC Championship season, played down the street at St. Paul Central High School's Griffin Stadium.

In Currier's first term leading the Bears (2000-03), he posted an 18-2 home record at Griffin Stadium, starting the "Griff Myth," a 19-game home winning streak that began in 2002 and spanned four full seasons of perfect home football (2002, 2003, 2004, 2005).

Currier now holds a 29-23 career record in home games at Concordia, a solid 9-1 mark in home openers, a 4-4 mark in home finales and led the team to a winning record at Sea Foam Stadium in 2018 for the third time since 2009.

The Golden Bears are now 11-21 at Sea Foam Stadium under Currier since 2016 including winning seasons in 2018 (3-2) and 2019 (4-2), the only back-to-back winning seasons in Sea Foam Stadium's history.

## **HOME OPENER SUCCESS**

Concordia head coach Shannon Currier holds a 9-1 record in his CSP career in home openers including 5-1 at Sea Foam Stadium in his second stint. Across the nine home opener wins between Sea Foam and Griffin Stadium, Currier's Bears have average a 30.1 to 9.0 margin of victory, a total of 271 to 81.

#### **HEAD COACH SHANNON CURRIER | 11TH SEASON**



Originally the 8th head coach of CSP football in 2000, Shannon Currier returned to lead the program for his 2nd stint in December, 2015.

He became the program's all-time wins leader on November 3, 2018 with a 16-10 win at SMSU.

In his first stint, he compiled a 32-12 (.727) record and brought the program its first NSIC Championship in 2003 when he was named NSIC Coach of the

Year. The conference title also brought a berth in the Mineral Water Bowl, the first postseason game in school history.

He coached Concordia to four consecutive winning seasons and is the only coach in program history to achieve the feat consecutive or cumulative.

## THE GRIFF MYTH - PROTECTING HOME TURF

The team also established the longest home winning streak in school history under his guidance. Known to teams of the era as the "Griff Myth," Concordia tallied 19 consecutive home victories down the street at Griffin Stadium. The streak began in 2002 and stretched two years after Currier left through the 2005 season, finally falling at the beginning of 2006.

In Currier's first four years, his teams only lost two home games, producing a record of 18-2 after winning his first and last nine home games

He opened his return to the program with a 17-0 shutout win over U-Mary in 2016, snapping a 6-game home losing streak and a former school record 8-game overall losing streak. His CSP teams are 9-1 all-time in home openers and he holds a career 29-23 home mark at Concordia between Griffin & Sea Foam Stadium.

## **CAREER AT TRUMAN**

Following the program's 2003 NSIC title run, Currier accepted the head coach position at Truman State where he turned a losing program into a pair of 6-5 winning campaigns in his 3rd and 4th seasons.

His tenure was highlighted in his third year, leading the Bulldogs to a 6-3 record in a strong MIAA, finishing fourth in the league. He left the program following a 4-7 season in 2008 with a 20-35 overall record.

## PRIOR TO REJOINING CONCORDIA'S SIDELINES

Following his departure from Truman, Currier spent seven years working outside of the coaching profession as a senior sales manager with iHigh.com working to build a digital platform for high school sports, reaching up to 1.5 million Minnesotans in his final year with the company.

Concordia's week two road trip to face Southwest Minnesota State featured seven former St. Cloud State Huskies facing their former head coach **Scott Underwood**, who now patrols the SMSU sidelines in his first season with the Mustangs.

At the conclusion of the 2019 football season, the administrations at St. Cloud State University and the University of Minnesota Crookston made the difficult decision to end their football programs.

Immediately, the CSP coaches put together a plan and worked with Concordia administration to provide an opportunity for student-athletes to continue to pursue their goals towards graduating from college while remaining members of an NSIC football program.

**Coach Currier** and his staff successfully recruited 11 members of the 2019 SCSU team, and one from UMC.

Robby Carrillo, Luke Dunsmoor, Jake Edwards, Nathan Gimza, Taylon Hensley, Sarek Hoerth, Robert Kraklow, Dominic LaCombe, Luke Shepherd, Mason Van Zeeland and Nick Webley all joined Concordia from SCSU while Ryan Martin changed his golden from the Eagles to the Bears. They became a part of the campus community during the pandemic shortened spring 2020 semester and continued through the 2020-21 academic year.

In 2022, six of the Huskies: Carrillo, Dunsmoor, Edwards, Gimza, Hensley and Hoerth, along with Martin from UMC, remain with team

Meanwhile, Kraklow joined the coaching staff as a first-year graduate assistant working with the OL for the 2022 season.

## **DIVISION I TRANSFERS**

For the second year in a row, the Golden Bears have infused the roster with nine players who have experience as members of NCAA Division I programs on the roster. ## SOPHOMORE QUARTERBACKS

In 2021 as freshmen, quarterbacks **Conner Cordts** and **Bryce Sievers** became the seventh and eighth players to start a game at quarterback as a freshman (or redshirt freshman) since Concordia made the jump to NCAA Division II in 1999.

Cordts joined elite company in becoming just the second freshman to start a season opener at quarterback, joining **James McNear**, who is a CSP and NSIC Hall of Famer and ended his career as the Division II leader in career total offense, playing from 2002-05.

Cordts started the first six games before a season-ending injury derailed his rookie season, committing just one turnover with one INT in 141 pass attempts after starting his career INT-free for 111 passes. Sievers earned playing time in six games, starting three.

#### 300-YARD PASSERS

Sophomore quarterback **Conner Cordts** registered his first career 300-yard passing performance, completing 18-46 for 306 with three TDs and one INT in week three against Sioux Falls, averaging 17 yards per completion in the first 300-yard passing game since November 4, 2017 (**Ron Johnson**, at Augustana). Cordts also achieved a career-high of 365 yards of total offense and 59 rushing yards in the contest.

## EGNARSKI AMONG DIVISION II TACKLES LEADERS

Junior **Andrew Egnarski** returned to the field in week three, and shortly thereafter returned to the starting lineup. Despite missing two games and playing in a reserve role in three others, Egnarski is seventh in the country and leading the NSIC with 10.9 tackles per game, making 87 total stops in eight contests, adding 3.5 TFLs, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

He set the school record with 22 total tackles in week nine against UMary, the third-most tackles in a Division II game in the 2022 season, and has the top two single game totals in the NSIC, making 19 tackles against Bemidji State, which was one shy of the school record at the time.

He's currently had at least 10 tackles in a game in five straight contests, piling up 72 tackles in the five game span.

In 2021, Egnarski led the team with 68 total tackles, earning NSIC Defensive Player of the Week honors in CSP's week two win over Upper lowa with 11 tackles, 3.5 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, a forced fumble and fumble recovery. He produced 6.0 TFLs, tied for the team lead with 5.0 sacks and had an INT on the season.

As a Golden Bear, Egnarski has accumulated 170 career tackles in 30 games, adding 10.5 TFLs, 5.0 sacks, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and an interception.

## SHEEHAN LEADS THE SAFETIES

Sixth-year senior **Rhett Sheehan** has remained a top leader in the program, putting together a strong 2022 campaign before a season-ending injury cut his final season short.

He opened the season with eight tackles including 2.0 TFLs while helping shut down the Augustana pass game to just 7-14 for 62 yards.

He continued in week two by matching his career-high with 10 tackles at SMSU, adding another TFL while helping limit the Mustangs to 106 passing yards on 8-17 passing with two INTs.

Arguably his top individual performance of the season came in week eight at Northern State, registering three turnovers in the second half with a pair of interceptions and a fumble recovery while adding a pair of pass breakups and five tackles.

His 3.0 tackles for loss on the year set a new career-high for the veteran safety, who is second on the team with 54 tackles and tied for the team lead with six passes defended (4 PBU, 2 INT).

As a junior in 2021, Sheehan was an All-NSIC North Division Second Team safety, ranking second on the team and 23rd in the NSIC with 63 total tackles. His three interceptions, all in CSP's five home games, ranked ninth in the Northern Sun, and he acked up 85 return yards in the process while adding two pass breakups for five passes defended, second-most on the team while contributing a team-leading two forced fumbles.

In his career, Sheehan has secured 197 tackles and 6.0 TFLs across 42 games with a career-high 63 tackles in 2021. He has 18 career passes defended on 13 breakups and five interceptions, adding three forced fumbles with two fumble recoveries.

## MCCLURE WITH FOUR INTS

Safety **Cyrus McClure** had a tremendous start to his sophomore season, securing three interceptions in the first two weeks, twice in the season's opening quarter against #25 Augustana, now a 6-1 squad, and securing another INT in week two at SMSU. He added his fourth pick in week nine against UMary.

He's fourth in the league lead with his four INTs, ranking 34th in the country.

It's the second-straight year a Golden Bear safety has registered at least three interceptions in a season, with McClure joining his teammate **Rhett Sheehan**, who had three INTs in 2021 as a junior, with Sheehan adding two more in 2022

As a sophomore, McClure has a career-high 48 tackles, adding 1.5 TFLs, four INTs and two pass breakups, tying for the team-high with six passes defended.

McClure has played in 18 career games, registering 74 tackles with eight passes defended (4 PBU, 4 INT), a forced fumble and a blocked kick.

## **DIVISION I BACKFIELD**

Concordia's running game entering the 2022 season features its top four backs as Division I transfers: Northern Iowa transfer **Jaylin Richardson**, now a sophomore in his second year at CSP, has opened the year as the lead back. He's backed up by Kansas transfer **Gayflor Flomo** and Northern Colorado transfer **Jaire Moore**, with all three backs playing a role consistently throughout the season.

## RICHARDSON TOPS 100-RUSHING

Sophomore running back **Jaylin Richardson** had his best game as a college running back in week two at SMSU, rushing for 175 yards on 12.5 per carry (14-175). He got stronger as the game wore on, with 9-151 in the second half, ripping off runs of 20, 31 and 74 yards in the process. While it's his lone 100-yard rushing performance, he's consistently topped 100 all-purpose yards (below).

## **RICHARDSON TOPS 100 ALL-PURPOSE YARDS**

**Richardson** has topped 100 all-purpose yards four times in 2022, starting with his career-best 207 all-purpose yards in week two at SMSU (14-175 rush, 2-7 rec, 1-25 KR).

While topping 100 all-purpose yards four times, Richardson has also surpassed 85 all-purpose yards in eight out of nine games this season.

He's seventh in the NSIC in all-purpose yards with 103.2 per game. The versatile back is also among the team leaders with 23 receptions out of the backfield (23-244) and leads the team with four total touchdowns (2 rush, 2 rec).

Richardson was a highly recruited RB from the Kansas City area, initially committing to Kansas before signing with Northern lowa where he was an early enrollee in spring 2020. He made his debut in the 2021 COVID shortened spring season for the Panthers, and retained his full eligibility for his CSP career.

In 2021, Richardson led CSP with 61.6 all-purpose yards per game, playing in seven games with three starts. He was second on the team in rushing yards (234) while leading the backfield with two rushing TDs. He added 15-85 rec and 5-99 on KR.

In his two seasons with CSP, Richardson has compiled 821 rushing yards in 16 games, averaging 4.6 yards per carry with four TDs while adding 38-329 with two receiving TDs, 9-197 on kickoff returns and 4-13 on punt returns for 1,360 all-purpose yards.

Flomo is second on the team with 554 all-purpose yards with a team-high 372 on kickoff returns (21.9 avg, 55 long) while Moore's 381 all-purpose yards feature balance with 177 rushing, 105 receiving and 99 via kickoff returns.

Flomo handled the workload with Richardson and Moore out in week 10, with season-highs in carries (17), rushing yards (78), rushing long (15) and receptions (3) at MSU Moorhead.

**Flomo**, originally from the metro (Fridley) and graduate of Totino-Grace High School, was a standout at lowa Western Community College out of high school before transferring to Kansas where he was an Academic All-Big 12 Second Team selection, playing in nine games and earning six carries for the Jayhawks.

**Moore** is originally from Dallas, Texas and rushed 12-38 for Northern Colorado in 2021, spending three seasons there including a redshirt and a missed year due to COVID-19.

## CONTINUITY DEFINES OFFENSIVE LINE

The 2022 offensive line is defined by its continuity, with nearly the entire two-deep having played together for at least three seasons and many having gained valuable playing experience last season.

Junior center **Sam Marshalek** is the leader up front with 31 games played and 23 starts under his belt, occupying the center position for the past two seasons. Left tackle **Jake Edwards** has been a steady performer, moving to the LT spot in 2022 and has 15 career starts among his 21 games played at CSP.

The line features four former St. Cloud State players: Edwards, guards **Taylon Hensley** and **Sarek Hoerth** and tackle **Robby Carrillo**. All of the SCSU transfer offensive linemen have started in their time at CSP and are continuing to contribute to the travel roster and offensive line rotation.

The group also features sophomores **Elliott Wolfe** (18 GP, 11 GS) at guard and **Jac Carver** (15 GP, 10 GS) at right tackle.

As a unit, the CSP offensive line ranks 25th in the country and third in the NSIC with 1.30 sacks allowed per game, and ranks 21st in the country and fourth in the NSIC in fewest TFLs allowed per game (4.60).

The line is coming off of a strong performance at North-

ern State three weeks ago, helping the offense rack up 511 yards of total offense, the highest output since week three of 2016, while issuing no sacks and three TFLs to one of the top-ranked defenses in the country with the Wolves ranking 12th in total defense, fourth in sacks and fifth in TFLs entering the game.

## **50-PLUS YARD WIDE RECEIVERS**

Concordia's pass game is built upon its depth, with six different targets picking up at least 22 catches and 244 yards: Joep Farley (26-252, TD), Drew Enke (24-346, TD), Troy Elison (24-289, 3 TD), Jack Munsterteiger (23-253), Jaylin Richardson (RB) (23-244, 2 TD), and Nathan Gimza (22-317).

Eight different players have found the end zone among the 11 touchdown passes including a pair of running backs, with Ellison's three receiving TDs leading the team.

Six different players have topped 50 receiving yards in a game this year with Richardson leading the team with three 50-plus games while Enke and Gimza have each topped 70 yards twice and Ellison being the lone 100-yard receiver.

## DAHLMAN LEADS PUNTING UNIT

Sophomore **Parker Dahlman** continues to provide one of the top legs in the country on a punt unit that plays to its coverage unit and directional kicking.

In 2022, Dahlman is fourth in the NSIC and 41st in the country with a 39.7 average on the seventh-fewest punts (44), but more importantly has dropped 11 inside the 20, has 11 fair catches and six 50-plus yard punts with a long of 61.

His directional punting and hangtime have helped the special teams produce the nation's 16th-ranked and league-leading opposing punt return average of 2.71 yards per return along with the 28th-ranked net punt average (36.98), second-best in the NSIC.

In week two at SMSU, Dahlman put together three punts for a consistent 41.0 average with a long of 45 and all three punts pinning SMSU inside the 20.

In week four, he averaged 49.0 yards on three punts with a long of 61 yards at Wayne State, the fifth-best single game

average in school history with at least two punts in a game.

He's produced a 41-plus yard punting average in a game four times on the year and topped 38.0 yards in eight out of nine contests with only two touchbacks.

As a freshman in 2021, Dahlman ranked fifth in the league with a 40.1 season punting average on a league-high 67 punts. His 12 punts of 50-plus yards topped the league charts, and his 14 punts inside the 20 finished two off the league lead, ranking third. He forced 12 fair catches and only had five touchbacks.

His 77 yard punt at Sioux Falls was the third longest in the league last year and the third-longest in program history.

His top single-game effort in his career, a 6-punt, 50.2 average at Sioux Falls (2021) with four punts of 50-plus yards, ranks as the best single-game punting average with at least five punts in a game.

In his young career, Dahlman's 39.98 career average is on pace to be a career record and his name is already plastered on the game, season and career punting charts for the program. He's climbed to fourth with 111 career punts and fourth with 4,438 career punt yards, as well.

## HENSON IN THE KICKING GAME

Concordia-St. Paul has featured some of the top kickers in the country over the past decade with sophomore **Sam Henson** handling the duties in 2021 and 2022.

Henson entered the 2022 season as the 13th-ranked kicker in Division II football by The College Football Network and 20th-ranked by FBPI Football.

Henson was recently named a Fred Mitchell Award Watch List candidate for his performance on the field and in the community for September, 2022, his fourth time earning monthly watch list honors for the award that honors the top placekicker for their on-field and volunteer service in small college football (FCS, DII, DIII, NAIA, NJCAA).

Henson had a standout debut season in 2021, leading the NSIC and ranking 21st nationally with a 76.9 field goal percentage (10-13) while hitting 10-11 from inside of 50 yards with a long of 48 which he converted in his career debut at Winona State.

He ranked 40th in the country and fifth in the NSIC with 0.91 field goals made per game, a well.

He led the team in scoring in 2021 with 48 points, averaged 53.3 yards on 41 kickoffs with 10 touchbacks and made two field goals in a game twice.

In 2022, his 3-11 field goal rate has been misleading, with all but one of his misses all being either from 42-plus yards (42, 46, 47, 50) or being blocked (3). He added his third career 2-field goal performance in week two at SMSU.

In his career, he's connected on 13 of his 24 field goal attempts with a long of 48 yards and he's cashed in all but three of his career PATs (30-33).

He's added power to his kickoffs in 2022, upping his average to 59.9 yards with seven touchbacks on 31 kickoffs.


