THE MATCHUPS... Seventh-ranked Concordia-St. Paul continues NSIC play on the road this weekend as they travel to Augustana on Friday and Wayne State on Saturday for a pair of league con-

ABOUT THE VIKINGS... After a tough 2018 season on the court for Augustana, the Vikings have turned things around in a big way in 2019 as they have already matched their win total from last year. Augie rattled off seven wins in their first eight matches before splitting in the opening weekend of the conference season. Following mid-week loss to WSC, Augie jumped back in the win column with a weekend sweep in their home opening weekend.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS... Early in 2019, Wayne State has been dominant as they have picked up 10 sweeps in their 13 contests. The Wildcats have dropped just one match and five sets overall on the season as their lone loss came in straight sets at Northern State in the NSIC opening weekend. WSC followed with three straight home wins to head into this weekend on a high note.

Entering his 17th year as head coach of Concordia volleyball in 2019, three-time AVCA National Coach of the Year Brady Starkey and his staff have turned the squad into a premier program in the

The Golden Bears have captured nine NCAA Division II Championships in the past 12 years, including seven in a row, making them the only NCAA volleyball program to accomplish the feat at any of the three divisions. Their nine total volleyball titles are more than any program at the DII level as well, one shy of the overall NCAA record.

Among the nine championships, they've won on neutral floors (2007, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2016, 2017), their home floor in front of standing-room only crowds (2008, 2009) and on the road in front of a capacity crowd (2011). Their championships have come in the eastern, central and

Their first national championship in 2007 was the first women's team NCAA Division II champion-ship in the history of the Northern Sun and just the second overall team national championship for

In his 16 seasons, Starkey's teams have captured 14 Northern Sun championships, reached the NCAA Tournament every year and advanced to the region championship (also known as Sweet Sixteen) 15 times. They've captured 11 region championships, punching a ticket to the NCAA Elite Eight each time. In 11 NSIC Tournaments, the Golden Bears captured five of the championships

The team has produced at least 30 wins in 13 out of 16 campaigns, including a perfect 37-0 dream season in 2009 that culminated with their third straight national title, winning on their home floor at Gangelhoff Center for the second year in a row.

Additionally, the squad has excelled in the classroom, earning the AVCA Team Academic Award

Their dominance in one of the top volleyball conferences in the country is remarkable. The Golden Bears have lost just 18 league matches in 300 league outings, have produced six perfect conference ledgers, posted an 85-match NSIC winning streak and a 73-match NSIC road winning streak (Starkey's first-ever road NSIC loss came at Minnesota State in the first away NSIC match of 2012).

They've been able to raise their game in NCAA postseason play, carrying a 70-7 all-time record in the NCAA Tournament for a .909 winning percentage. They've never lost a first round regional match and are undefeated in 10 trips to the national semifinals (Final Four). They've only lost once in 11 national quarterfinal (Elite Eight) matches and are 9-1 in 10 national title matches.

He's coached some of the top players in NCAA Division II volleyball history, including two-time AVCA Player of the Year Maggie McNamara - the all-time assists record holder for Division II volleyball (total assists, and assists/set). McNamara, named the Honda Division II Female Athlete of the Year after her senior year (2009), was the first of four AVCA National Freshmen of the Year under Starkey (McNamara, Emily Palkert, Amanda Konetchy, Katie Habeck). The team also featured a top-9 finalist twice, Mary Slinger (2008-09) and Ellie Duffy (2012-13), for the NCAA Woman of the Year award which features the top female student-athletes from around the country across all three divisions and all women's sports sanctioned by the NCAA. Riley Hanson added to the list with an NCAA Today's Top 10 Award selection along with being named the CoSIDA Academic All-American of the Year.

The program has also featured 13 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans and 120 NSIC All-Academic student-athletes.

Impossible to predict, Starkey's first season as head coach in 2003 would set the tone for the program. The team stormed to a 15-1 mark in Northern Sun play to win their first league title and with a 27-3 regular season record earned the right to host the NCAA North Central Regional in their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance. They captured the regional championship and would advance to the Division II title match after beating the top-ranked team in the country, CSU San Bernardino, on their home floor in the national semifinals. They'd finish as the national runner-up in Starkey's rookie coaching year.

Starkey was named head coach after serving as an assistant for Concordia for three seasons under Geoff Carlston. Carlston, now a head coach at Ohio State University and previously the head coach at Ohio University, has coached 10 teams to the NCAA Tournament at the Division I level.

Together, Starkey assisted Carlston in rebuilding a Concordia volleyball program that was 0-18 in Northern Sun play the year before they arrived. By their third year working with the program, the Golden Bears achieved their first-ever national ranking and finished 24-9 with a 13-5 mark in

Before coming to Concordia, Starkey spent five seasons as an assistant coach at the University of St. Thomas. While at St. Thomas, the Tommies finished in the top four in the MIAC and won the conference title in 1999. During the 1998 season, Starkey had co-head coaching responsibilities with behavior.

Starkey began his coaching career in 1992 as an assistant coach at Minnetonka High School, where he worked with the b-squad and junior varsity teams. He spent a number of years with 17-open team of Minnesota One Junior Olympics and currently coaches the 17's team at Min-

Starkey earned his undergraduate degree in history from Metropolitan State University in 2002. He and his wife Penny are the parents of two daughters, Teagan Shea and Kayli Jade.

Prior to joining the Concordia staff, he was assistant volleyball coach at St. Scholastica in Duluth, Minn. from 1999 to 2002.

He also has coaching experience with the Junior Olympics with Minnesota Select from 2004 to present coaching 17-1's. He has coached numerous young athletes who have advanced to play collegiately through the Select team.

He is a graduate from the University of Minnesota Duluth with a degree in politi-cal science. He resides in Maple Grove, Minn. with his wife, Amanda and their

JOY TIETZ

Joy Tietz joined the Concordia volleyball coaching staff in the 2018 season.

Tietz (formerly Wubben) is a Golden Bear volleyball alum, graduating in 2005 with a degree in early childhood education and parent education from Concordia-St. Paul.

During her volleyball career at Concordia, Joy was a three-year captain, a two-time All-American and the 2004 NSIC Player of the Year. She helped the team reach their first even NCAA Division Il National Championship game in the 2003 season. Tietz remains the all-time leader in total blocks (540), ranks second in block solos (119) and points (2,073.5) and fifth in kills (1,603) at CSP.

Fietz spent 10 years as an assistant at the University of St. Thomas before spending two with the University of Minnesota.

Tietz was hired by MN Select Volleyball in September of 2015 as its Associate Director. Her responsibilities include coaching club teams, event schedule creation, assuring all travel logistics, coach support, and directing and coordinating all positional and camp training sessions.

She and her husband, Reed, live in Eden Prairie.

THE MATCHUPS

The seventh-ranked Concordia-St. Paul volleyball team continues NSIC play on the road this weekend as they travel to Augustana on Friday and Wayne State on Saturday for a pair of league

AUGUSTANA SERIES HISTORY

Concordia enters Friday's contest with the Vikings with a record of 25-1 in the all-time series with the Vikings. Augustana's lone win came back in 1988 as CSP has won all 25 meetings since the turn of the century. While the Golden Bears have consistently come out on top against Augie, five of the last six meetings have gone more than three sets, with four of which going five sets as Concordia has had to come from behind in all four of those matches. The Golden Bears have won all 10 meetings between the two schools in Sioux Falls.

LAST MEETING VS AUGIE

Back on Nov. 2, 2018, Concordia put together a dominant effort in a sweep of Augustana on Parents Night at Gangelhoff Center.

The Golden Bears kept the Vikings off-balanced with a strong serving performance as they put up their third match with double digits in aces at 10. CSP's offense also took care of business with a .384 hitting percentage as they tallied 44 kills with six errors in a strong all-around effort. On the other side of the net, Augie finished the match at .227 hitting with just one ace.

Hope Schiller did a little bit of everything in the match as she matched her career best with five aces while also tallying a double-double with 10 kills and 10 digs in the win. Elizabeth Mohr also matched a season high in aces with three to go along with 38 assists and five digs.

Offensively, Sara Macek was a force with 11 kills and no errors on 15 swings for a massive .733 hitting percentage. She also added three total blocks, including two solo blocks. Brooklyn Lewis matched Macek with 11 kills and three blocks while adding seven digs and an ace as well as a .417 hitting percentage.

On Saturday, the Golden Bears take on the Wildcats for the 47th time in the all-time series as CSP holds a record of 33-13 against WSC heading into the matchup. Since Wayne State won seven of the first eight meetings of the series, Concordia has rattled off 32 wins in the past 37 contests. That stretch included 19 wins in a row for CSP spanning from 2003-2009. The last nine meetings have featured five regular season wins for Concordia while Wayne State has claimed two wins in three postseason meetings. In 17 trips to Wayne, CSP has gone 14-3 against the Wildcats.

Back on Nov. 3, 2018, CSP closed out the regular season with a four-set loss to Wayne State at Gangelhoff Center.

Wayne State came out firing against the Golden Bears as they hit .359 or above in all three sets they won to finish the match at .353 with 58 kills as a team. It was their two outside hitters that did most of the damage with Katie Stephens leading all players with 20 kills while Alyssa Ballenger followed close behind with 18. Serving also played a factor for the Wildcats as they collected six aces and just three service errors while CSP had four aces and eight errors.

Concordia actually finished with more kills in the match as they tallied 69 in the loss, but they were unable to match WSC's efficiency as they committed 22 errors to put up a .296 hitting percentage.

Elizabeth Mohr spread the ball around as all five CSP hitters finished with at least 12 kills, led by Kennedy Brady's career-best 17. Brady shattered her previous career high of 12 as she hit an incredibly efficient .583 in the loss. Mohr put up her second best assist total of the season with 64 as she surpassed the 60-assist mark for the fifth time on the year.

It was also a career night for redshirt freshman Leah Damerow as she tripled her previous career best with 15 kills and just three errors to give her a .324 hitting percentage. Her three blocks trailed only Sara Macek's five on the day for Concordia. Macek also reached double figures in kills with 13 as she hit .435

LAST TIME OUT

Last weekend, the Golden Bears split in their home-opening weekend as they fell to then-#4 Minnesota Duluth in three sets before knocking off then-#15 St. Cloud State in five sets.

With a pair of back-and-forth matches on the weekend, the statistics backed it up as CSP finished nearly even in almost every category over the two matches. Concordia finished the weekend at .221 hitting with 109 kills while their opponents tallied 110 kills while hitting .205. The Golden Bears also held a 17.0-14.0 advantage in total blocks while their opponents led 13-7 in service aces and 130-129 in digs.

Jasmine Mulvihill paced the squad with 3.88 kills per set with a .282 hitting percentage while Kennedy Brady ranked second with 2.57 kills per set. Tori Hanson finished with a team-best 5.12 digs per set while Erin Fallert followed with 3.12 digs per set as well as 2.25 kills per set.

Following a 1-1 weekend against a pair of ranked opponents at home, the Golden Bears remained #7 in the polls this week. Concordia has been a mainstay near the top of the poll for over a decade as they haven't ranked outside the top-10 since 2003 and they have ranked outside the top-5 just seven weeks since October 2012. The Golden Bears have spent an incredible 83 weeks at #1 since they debuted there in the 2004 preseason poll. Since the 2007 season, CSP has ranked #1 at least once every season heading into this year.

After reaching the 1,000 career dig mark late in her sophomore season, junior libero Tori Hanson has started to move her way up in the career record book at Concordia. Hanson currently ranks 12th in DII-era history at CSP with 1,279 digs, putting her 19 away from moving into the top-10. She isn't the only Golden Bear piling up career statistics as Erin Fallert sits 162 digs shy of 1,000 with 838 and Sara Macek sits 204 kills shy of 1,000 with 796.
